### Setting the Scene...

Coming off closing a three-game homestand with a 90-47 victory over Grand Canyon, the Duke women's basketball team (4-0) will travel to Nashville, Tenn., to face Vanderbilt (2-1) Sunday, Nov. 20 for a 3 p.m. (ET). The game will be aired live on the SEC Network-Plus from Memorial Gymnasium.

Calling the game for the SEC Network-Plus will be Kevin Ingram (pxp) and Jessica Mooney (color). It will also be carried on the Blue Devil IMG Sports Network on www.GoDuke.com with Chris Edwards on the air beginning at 2:45 p.m. It will be aired live on 1550 AM and 99.9 HD3, Tuneln Radio app and www.GoDuke.com.

### What is Next?...

Duke will return home to host Old Dominion Tuesday, Nov. 22 at 7 p.m., before traveling to the West Coast to face Long Beach State and Pepperdine during Thanksgiving.

### Storylines/Other Blue Devil Notes...

Duke will face a third straight alumna Sunday at Vanderbilt where 2010 Duke graduate Joy Cheek is an assistant coach. The Blue Devils took on 2008 alumna Wanisha Smith (Longwood) and 2011 alumna Krystal Thomas (Grand Canyon) earlier this week.

Head coach Joanne P. McCallie needs only one more win to reach 250 in her 10 years with the Blue Devils.

Kyra Lambert, a 5-9 guard, has 10 offensive rebounds, which ranks second behind Kendall Cooper (11). She only had 13 offensive rebounds in 32 games as a freshman. Lambert also has a 14-3 assist/turnover ratio.

Senior Oderah Chidom swatted her 100th career blocked shot versus Grand Canyon. She also scored a season-high 18 points, which 10 came in the second half.

Duke held Grand Canyon to only 47 points Thursday and improved to 97-0 under head coach Joanne P. McCallie when holding teams to 50 points or under.

Rebecca Greenwell's 22.5 points per game average currently ranks second in the ACC and ranks 33rd nationally. Her 90 points also ranks tied first nationally along with Kelsey Plum of Washington.

With her 3.5 blocks per game average, Oderah Chidom ranks 14th nationally. Her 14 blocks in four games leads the nation.

As a team, Duke leads the nation with 69 free throws made, 80 assists, 190 rebounds and 63 steals. The Blue Devils are second with 95 free throw attempts.

Rebecca Greenwell and Lexie Brown are the only two players in the ACC so far with multiple 20+ scoring contests. Greenwell now ranks tied ninth in Duke history with 17 games with 20+ scoring over her career.

With the Blue Devils scoring 90+ points Thursday versus Grand Canyon, it marks the first time since the 2005-06 campaign Duke has registered 90+ points in three out of the first four games. The Blue Devils advanced to the NCAA Championship that season.

The Blue Devils swiped 29 steals versus Longwood, which was the second-most in a single game in Duke history.

Duke has drained 26 three-pointers in the first four games with the trio of Rebecca Greenwell,

- In four games, the Blue Devils are averaging 20.0 assists a contest. Duke is coming off averaging only 13.8 assists in 2015-16.

- Duke has averaged 50.0 points in the paint to open the season.

- In the Penn contest, Duke jumped out to a 13-0 lead and Kyra Lambert scored six points in the first 25 seconds of play.

- The Blue Devils notched 98 points in the season opener, which is the most in an opener since Nov. 13, 2009 at Houston Baptist.

- Duke featured four games in seven days to open the regular season, including three straight home games against Penn, Longwood and Grand Canyon. The Blue Devils have six overall contests in 12 days to open the year.

- The Blue Devils feature 13 players from 10 different states on the 2016-17 roster.

## A Look at Vanderbilt...

Vanderbilt owns a 2-1 record under first year head coach Stephanie White. Rebekah Dahlman (16.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 8 treys) has led the Commodores so far on the year. Christa Reed (9.0 points), Marqu'es Webb (8.0 points, 11.0 rebounds), Rachel Bell (7.7 points) and Kayla Overbeck (7.7 points) have also been key components for Vanderbilt early in the season. Through three games, Vanderbilt is 2-0 at home.

## The Series with Vanderbilt...

The Blue Devils and Commodores will be meeting for the eighth time in history. Duke has a record of 5-2 against Vanderbilt. At home, Duke has maintained a record of 3-0. At Vanderbilt, the Blue Devils have a mark of 1-1.

The last time Duke and Vanderbilt played was on November 21, 2013 in Durham, N.C., with the Blue Devils an 88-69 win.

## Games on November 20...

The Blue Devils have registered a 6-0 record in games played on Nov. 20. The wins have come against George Washington (1981), N.C. Central (1984), Penn State (2000), Old Dominion (both in 2005 and 2014), and Western Kentucky (2011).

## Duke Versus the SEC...

The Blue Devils have played 58 total games against teams in the Southeastern Conference. Of those 58 games, Duke has a record of 37-21. Here is a breakdown of how the Blue Devils have fared against the SEC: Auburn (5-0), Georgia (3-0), Mississippi State (2-0), Alabama (2-1), Arkansas (2-1), Florida (2-1), Kentucky (5-2), LSU (3-2), South Carolina (1-3), Tennessee (6-5), Texas A&M (1-4) and Vanderbilt (5-2).

### Great Defensive Effort...

The Blue Devils have locked down their four opponents so far this season holding them to 28.0 percent shooting, 20.8 percent from downtown and only 56.1 percent from the line.

Duke's opponents are averaging only 47.0 points and averaging 25.3 turnovers.

### Big First & Fourth Quarters...

Duke has averaged 27.0 points in the first quarter and held an average lead of 11.0 points through the first 10 minutes this season. The Blue Devils have hit 53.5 percent of their field goals and 68.4 percent (13-of-19) from downtown.

As the games wind down, Duke has averaged 24.0 points and held a 12.5 scoring margin. The Blue Devils have hit 56.3 percent from the field and 46.7 from three-point land.

### Mathias Earns Starts...

Junior Erin Mathias has started each of the first four games of the 2016-17 season, after starting just three of her first 57 contests.

She has already set eight career highs this season and is coming off totaling back-to-back double-digit scoring games for the first time in her career.

### Lambert Picks up Where She Left Off...

Sophomore Kyra Lambert has scored double-digits in nine collegiate games and five of those have come over her last seven games.

Lambert has hit 12-of-19 from three-point land over that seven-game stretch.

The guard has opened the 2016-17 season scoring double-digits in three of the four games and is averaging 11.8 points. She is coming off notching a career-high 17 points as she hit 6-of-10 field goals.

Her back-to-back double-figure scoring games against Liberty and Penn was a first for her short career.

### Greenwell Opens Strong...

Blue Devil redshirt junior Rebecca Greenwell has jumped off to a hot start to open the season.

She is averaging 22.5 points, 7.8 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 2.3 steals. Greenwell owns a team-best 12 three-pointers made and hitting 40.0 percent from downtown.

Greenwell posted a career-high 30 points versus Longwood and 28 points at Liberty.

She registered her eighth career double-double and first of the season versus Grand Canyon with 15 points and 10 rebounds.

### Brown Looking Good in Duke Uniform...

After redshirting the 2015-16 campaign, junior Lexie Brown has four games under her belt as a Blue Devil.

She is now averaging 15.8 points, 3.8 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.3 steals. Brown was saddled with foul trouble in the season opener at Liberty and totaled nine points, but come back with 20 points versus Penn and 27 points against Longwood.

Brown notched a career-high eight steals at home versus Longwood, while dishing seven assists. She drained one three-pointer at Liberty, three against Penn

### Chidom Looks to Build off Strong End of Year...

After closing her junior season in a strong way, senior Oderah Chidom looks to build off that success and have a strong final season at Duke.

Chidom averaged 14.0 points, 7.6 rebounds, 2.6 blocks and 1.5 assists over the final eight contests. She registered a career-high 20 points in back-to-back games against North Carolina and Virginia, while also pulling down nine rebounds. In those two games, she hit a combined 16-of-28 field goals and swatted seven shots. Chidom also averaged 10.6 points, 6.5 rebounds, 1.7 blocks, 1.4 steals and 1.4 assists in 14 ACC games.

### One of Tallest Teams...

Duke continues its theme of having tall teams in 2016-17 as the Blue Devils will feature the tallest team in school history standing an average of 73.39 inches.

The 73.39 average height beat out the 2011-12 and 2014-15 squads that averaged a height of 73.25 inches.

Duke is the second-tallest team in the ACC with a 6-1 average, while Virginia holds the tallest squad standing 6-1 (75.58).

The Blue Devils feature 10 players standing 6-0 or taller and seven at 6-2 or better on the 2016-17 roster. The seven players at 6-2 or taller is tied with Virginia for the most in the ACC.

### Recapping the Exhibition Contest...

Duke cruised to a 129-46 victory over Charleston Sunday, Nov. 6 as Rebecca Greenwell led all scorers with 27 points and seven assists. Seven different Blue Devils scored double-digits as Duke hit 59.8 percent from the floor.

Senior Oderah Chidom (18 points, 7 boards), freshman Leaonna Odom (16 points, 8 rebounds) and sophomore Kyra Lambert (10 points, 9 boards, 5 rebounds) also had solid outings.

Duke held an 80-10 advantage in the paint and scored 62 points off 40 Golden Eagle turnovers.

### Odom Expected to Make Impact...

Freshman Leaonna "Ducky" Odom is expected to make an immediate impact with the Blue Devils, after turning in a solid senior season at Chaminade H.S.

The No. 9 overall recruit in the class, Odom was a McDonald's All-America selection and competed in the Jordan Brand Classic.

As a senior, she averaged 21.5 points, 9.9 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 1.5 steals and 2.1 blocks and was named the 2016 Daily News All-Area Girls Basketball Co-Player of the Year.

She started for the West Team in the McDonald's All-America game and notched 10 points in 18 minutes.

Odom was given the nickname "Ducky" in summer school. It came from the movie Land Before Time.

### From Long Range...

The Blue Devils continue to be one of the top three-point shooting teams over the last number of years.

Duke led the nation in 2013 and 2014 for three-point field goal percentage. In 2014, the Blue Devils hit 40.7 percentage, while in 2013 Duke drained 40.5 percent from downtown.

### Nancy Lieberman Award Honors...

Duke redshirt junior Lexie Brown has been named one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Award. Now in its 17th year, the award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit the floor leadership, play-making and ball-handling skills of Hall of Famer Nancy Lieberman.

A 5-9 guard from Suwanee, Ga., Brown transferred from Maryland after leading the Terrapins to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances. Brown was a 2015 Associated Press Third Team All-America, All-Big Ten First Team, All-Big Ten Defensive Team and Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player as a sophomore at Maryland. She averaged 13.3 points, 4.5 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 2.2 steals, while draining 69 three-pointers in 2014-15. Brown sat out the 2015-16 campaign due to NCAA transfer rules.

It marks the third time Brown has been selected a candidate as she was also named to the list as a freshman and sophomore at Maryland.

The Selection Committee for the Nancy Lieberman Award is composed of top women's college basketball personnel including media members, head coaches, sports information directors and Hall of Famers. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2017 Lieberman Award will be narrowed to just 10. In March, five finalists will be presented to Ms. Lieberman and

### **Gorecki Still on the Mend...**

Duke sophomore Haley Gorecki is still recovering from a hip injury that sidelined her for most of the 2015-16 campaign.

Gorecki is progressing well and hoping to be back in practice prior to ACC action starting. She had appeared in 14 games as a rookie, while averaging 4.5 points, 2.6 rebounds, 1.1 assists and 1.1 steals.

### **Cooper Back for Senior Season...**

After missing the second semester of her junior season, Kendall Cooper is back for her final year with the Blue Devils.

A product of Carson, Calif., Cooper saw action in 11 contests averaging 3.7 points, 3.6 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.2 blocks last season.

Cooper has appeared in 76 career matches and blocked 67 shots in those games.

### **Schubert to Miss Season with Torn ACL...**

Duke head coach Joanne P. McCallie announced Blue Devil freshman Emily Schubert will miss the 2016-17 campaign, after suffering a torn ACL during practice. The 6-4 center will apply for a medical redshirt and have four years remaining.

Schubert, a native of Elizabethton, Tenn., was an All-Region, All-District and All-Conference selection in her final year at Elizabethton H.S. She led her high school squad to a 124-10 overall record with four district, regional and sectional titles. As a senior, Schubert averaged 11.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 4.0 blocks.

### **Duke Picked Sixth in Preseason ACC Poll...**

The ACC released the 2016-17 preseason women's basketball polls at the annual media day in Charlotte, N.C., with the Blue Devils tabbed No. 6 in a vote by the Blue Ribbon Panel and 15 league head coaches.

Duke, which returns three starters off its squad that totaled a 20-12 overall record a year ago, received 516 points by 54 Blue Ribbon Panel voters.

Defending ACC Champion Notre Dame totaled 795 points and 44 first place votes to take the top slot, while Louisville (8 first place votes), Florida State (2 first place votes), Syracuse, Miami, Duke, NC State, North Carolina, Georgia Tech, Virginia, Wake Forest, Virginia Tech, Pittsburgh, Boston College and Clemson rounded out the preseason ledger.

On the 10-member Blue Ribbon Panel Preseason All-ACC Team, Duke redshirt junior Rebecca Greenwell was included, while Shakayla Thomas (Florida State), Asia Durr (Louisville), Myisha Hines-Allen (Louisville), Leticia Romero (Florida State), Mariya Moore (Louisville), Adrienne Motley (Miami), Lindsay Allen (Notre Dame), Brianna Turner (Notre Dame) and Alexis Peterson (Syracuse) were selected. Hines-Allen earned preseason ACC Player of the Year accolades.

Duke redshirt junior Lexie Brown and freshman Leaonna Odom were voted to the Newcomer Watch List along with Chatrice White (Florida State), Erin Boley

(Notre Dame) and Jackie Young (Notre Dame).

The coaches also voted on a preseason poll with Notre Dame (13 first place votes), Louisville (1 first place vote), Florida State (1 first place vote), Syracuse, Miami, Duke, NC State, Georgia Tech, North Carolina, Virginia, Wake Forest, Virginia Tech, Boston College, Pittsburgh and Clemson listed.

The Coaches Preseason All-ACC Team and Newcomer Watch list was the same as the Blue Ribbon Panel.

### **Duke Captains...**

The Blue Devils feature three captains in 2016-17 as senior Oderah Chidom, redshirt junior Lexie Brown and redshirt junior Rebecca Greenwell were selected by the team. It marks the second straight year Greenwell and Brown have been named captains.

### **Blue Devil Duo Win WNBA Crown...**

The Duke tandem of Alana Beard and Chelsea Gray helped lead the Los Angeles Sparks to the 2016 WNBA crown in October.

Both were key components in the Sparks claiming their first title since 2003. The WNBA championship for Beard and Gray were their first titles as a professional.

With the win, a Blue Devil alum has been a part of the last three WNBA Championship teams as Tricia Liston won in 2015 with the Minnesota Lynx and Mistie Bass won in 2014 with the Phoenix Mercury. Beard and Gray became the fourth and fifth Duke women's basketball players to win a WNBA Championship as Karima Christmas also won in 2012 with the Indiana Fever.

### **Duke Not Ranked in Preseason...**

The Blue Devils were not ranked in the preseason Associated Press or USA Today top 25 polls, but did receive votes. It marked the first time since the 1994-95 season Duke was not preseason ranked in either poll.

### **Duke Adds New Staff to Mix...**

Over the summer of 2016, Duke hired Ashleigh Beaver along with Pat Chasse to help with the women's basketball program.

Beaver is the new sports performance coach for the team, while Chasse is a physical therapist and assistant athletic trainer.

## **Accomplishments (Heading into 2016-17)**

- Inducted into the Maine Basketball Hall of Fame in August of 2014.
- Named the ACC Coach of the Year in 2010, 2012 and 2013.
- Led the Blue Devils to the 2010, 2011 and 2013 ACC Championship, which gave Duke the eighth conference title in school history.
- Guided the Blue Devils to at least the share of the ACC regular season title in four straight years from 2010-13.
- Has led Duke to 245 overall wins and 108 league victories in her nine years with the Blue Devils.
- Reached the 500-win mark in 2013, joining a group of 29 active coaches in Division I with at least 500 wins.
- Brought in back-to-back No. 1 classes in 2010 and 2011 as well as the No. 1 class in 2015, while securing the No. 2 class in 2013 and 2014.
- Had five Blue Devils taken in the first round of the WNBA Draft since arriving at Duke, while a total of 10 Duke players have been drafted over the last eight years.
- Collected 200 victories in only 240 games becoming the fourth-quickest Division I head coach to reach 200 wins at a school.
- Is the third-quickest NCAA Division I head coach to reach 150 wins at an institution doing so in only 182 games.

• Became the first Division I head coach to win a conference title in four different leagues - ACC, Big Ten, America East, North Atlantic.

• Won 82 games in her first three years at Duke, which is the second-most in NCAA Division I history by a coach in the first three years at a school.

• Is the first Division I head coach to be named conference coach of the year in four different conferences.

• Reached 100 wins at Duke in only 122 games, the second-quickest to ever reach 100 wins at a school.

• Led Duke to its 10th 30-win season out of the last 13 years in 2012-13.

• Became only the second Division I head coach to lead two different programs to 30-win seasons and lead two different programs to a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

• Won 383 games in the last 15 seasons, an average of 27 wins.

• Is one of only three Division I head coaches to guide three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.

• Coach P is one of only four head coaches in Division I history to lead three different programs to 25 or more wins in a single season.

• Won a gold medal as coach of the 2006 U20 National team and the 2007 U21 World Championship team.

• In 2005, led MSU to the Big Ten regular season and tournament championships and the NCAA National Championship game.
