BROOKINGS, S.D. – South Dakota State quickly overcame the disappointment of not earning an NCAA Tournament bid, and used that as motivation in an 86-76 win over No. 1 seed Colorado State in the first round of the NIT on Wednesday for the program's first-ever Division I postseason win.

The win sends the No. 8 seed Jackrabbits to Nashville, Tenn., for a game against No. 5 seed Vanderbilt on Friday at 8:30 p.m., and can be seen live on ESPNU. Fans can also listen to the game live on the jackrabbit Sports Network or on the Jackrabbit Extra on Golacks.com for free.

The Commodores (20-13) advanced the second round of the tournament with a 75-64 win at St. Mary's (Calif.) on Wednesday in Moraga, Calif.,

The Jackrabbits (24-10) won their last two postseason games in the state of Colorado, with the final Division II postseason win coming over Northern State at the Division II North Central Regional on March 13, 2004 in Denver, and the first Division I postseason win coming on Wednesday at Colorado State.

**NEXT UP FOR THE JACKRABBITS:** A Jackrabbit moves them into the NIT quarterfinals against either No. 3 seed Rhode Island or No. 2 seed Stanford on either March 24 or 25.

## JACKRABBIT QUICK HITS

- SDSU plays in its fourth straight postseason (NCAATournament in 2012, 2013; CBI in 2014, NIT in 2015)
- SDSU is in the midst of its 22nd 20-win season in school history, the 11th for Scott Nagy
- The Jacks jumped 212 spots in RPI from Dec. 3 (292) to Feb. 27 (80)
- The Jackrabbits combined for 126 blocked shots this season, 24 more than last year's total of 102
- SDSU is 6-0 this season when Cody Larson fouls out of the game and 2-5 when he posts a double-double
- Larson starts his team-high 67th straight game tonight
- Larson enters the game ranked ninth at SDSU with 72 career blocks (in just two seasons)
- Larson, Jake Bittle and Deondre Parks are the only players to start all 34 games this season
- Scott Nagy is one of only 12 Division I coaches with at least 20 years as the head coach at their current school
- Nagy is one of 16 finalists for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award
- SDSU's last two postseason wins came in the State of Colorado; the final DII and the first DI postseason win
- SDSU committed a season-low seven turnovers in last two games, three times overall this season
- SDSU is 0-3 against the SEC at the Division I level, with losses at Kentucky, at Georgia and at Alabama

## NOTEWORTHY

**BLOCK PARTY:** SDSU players combined for 102 blocks last season, the first time with more than 100 blocks since the Jacks recorded 129 in 2001-02. The Jacks enter tonight's game already with 127, 25 more than last year's total.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** The 2014-15 roster includes a total of nine new players; seven with no collegiate playing experience, three true freshmen, three redshirt freshmen, one junior college transfer, one Division I transfer and one Division II transfer.

**TOUGH AT HOME:** The Jacks own a 51-3 record at Frost Arena over the last four seasons, which includes a 30-game home winning streak from Jan. 29, 2011 through Nov. 14, 2013, and their current 17-game home winning streak.

**3-POINTER STREAK:** SDSU made at least one 3-point basket in 270 straight games. The last time SDSU did not make a 3-pointer in a game came on Jan. 25, 2007, at Utah Valley (0 for 13).

**JACKRABBITS IN DOUBLE FIGURES:** At least one Jackrabbit scored in double figures in each of the last 242 games. The last time an SDSU player did not score at least 10 points came on Jan. 12, 2008, at IUPUI, when Anthony Cordova led the Jacks with nine points. The Jaguars won the game, 72-44.

**BALANCED SCORING:** Eleven different Jackrabbits scored at least 10 points in a game this season, five led the team in scoring in a game and four scored in double figures in the same game eight times; at Buffalo, at Idaho, vs. Chadron State, vs. Idaho, vs. Idaho State, at Northern Iowa, at Omaha, at IPFW and at Colorado State, with five players reaching double figures three times; vs. Fort Wayne on Jan. 21, and vs. North Dakota State on Feb. 14 and at Western Illinois on Feb. 18.

**GRADUATING 1,000 POINT HISTORY:** SDSU graduated three 1,000 point scorers and 4,441 career points from last year's four seniors. In contrast, SDSU returned a total of 1,067 points scored from the rest of the returning players.

**1,000 POINT SCORING STREAK:** SDSU played a total of 173 straight games with at least one 1,000 point scorer on the floor from Jan 31, 2009 through the final game of the 2013-14 season. A total of seven players played a part in that streak.

**20-WIN SEASONS:** SDSU posted 20 wins in a season a total of 22 times, with 11 of them coming in the Scott Nagy era, including three of the last four seasons.

**BROOKINGS TO BRAZIL:** The Jacks played four games in Brazil in August, posting a 3-1 record. The three wins came in convincing fashion, while lone loss on the trip came to one of the top professional teams in the top league in Brazil. In addition to playing four games on their 10-day trip, the team spent plenty of time seeing the sights, which included a trip to the Christ Redeemer Statue, Sugarloaf Mountain and plenty of time on Copacabana Beach in Rio de Janeiro.

**SOUTH DAKOTA STATE JACKRABBITS:** Please call us South Dakota State or SDSU. Please **do not** call us San Diego State or SDST. Please **do not** call us South Dakota. **What's the difference?** Great Question. Calling us "South Dakota" is like calling Colorado State "Colorado" or Oregon State "Oregon." Calling South Dakota State "San Diego State" is just not cool, so please don't do it. Also, Jackrabbits is one word, not Jack Rabbits or JackRabbits. Our jackrabbit mascot is modeled after a real species of rabbit, not a rabbit named Jack ... technically speaking, a jackrabbit is a hare, but that's not relevant in this case. Calling us the Jacks is an acceptable second reference.

## THE LAST TIME OUT FOR THE JACKRABBITS

### March 18, 2015, at Colorado State – Jacks Upend Top-Seeded Rams to Advance in NIT

FORT COLLINS, Colo. – South Dakota State got 24 points from George Marshall and 17 from Deondre Parks, as the No. 8 seed Jackrabbits opened NIT play with an 86-76 win at No. 1 seed Colorado State on Wednesday for the program's first-ever Division I postseason win.

The Jacks improve to 24-10 in the season and advance to the second round of the NIT to play at Vanderbilt on Friday. The Rams season comes to a close with a 27-7 record.

"I just can't even believe how proud I am of our guys, that game was incredibly physical and we knew that it would be, we talked about it for two days," head coach Scott Nagy said. "We knew they would be upset not getting into the NCAA Tournament, but we were upset, too, and we had to get ourselves turned around and this needed to be a big game for us. In my opinion, this is one of the biggest wins in our program's history."

The Jacks fell behind 5-3 early, but used a 9-0 run, part of a 16-4 run, that ended with a George Marshall 3-pointer to put SDSU in front 21-9 with 11 minutes, 12 seconds left in the first half.

The Rams answered with a quick 7-0 spurt over the next minute to cut the lead to 21-16, but SDSU quickly got the lead back to double figures, and led by as many as 16 points at 44-28 with 2:41 on the first half clock, a lead that CSU to 47-38 at halftime, thanks in part to a Gian Clavell 3-pointer at the halftime buzzer.

The Rams carried that momentum into the second half, scoring the first six points to cut the SDSU lead to 47-44, less than two minutes into the half. They would cut the lead to as few as two points a minute later, but the Jacks countered with a 12-1 run, that pushed the lead to 61-48 with just over 14 minutes left.

The hosts made one final push to get within five at 66-61 with under eight minutes to play, but the Jacks quickly got the lead back to double figures, and led by as many as 16 points before the Rams closed the gap back to 10 in the final minute.

Marshall added a career-high six assists and tied a career-high with five 3-pointers in getting his 24 points. Parks added a career-high eight rebounds to go with his 17 points, while Jake Bittle added 15 points and Reed Tellinghuisen 10 points in the win. Cody Larson finished with six points and led the Jacks with nine rebounds.

J.J. Avila led three Rams in double figures with 19 points, adding 11 rebounds for the game's only double-double. Daniel Bejarano added 17 points and Stanton Kidd 14 points in the loss.

## LAST GAME LEFTOVERS

Wednesday's game marked the first meeting between SDSU and CSU ... the teams played with two experimental rules: a 30 second shot clock and a four-foot restricted arc in the paint ... the teams' played in front of 3,391 fans at Moby Arena ... four Jackrabbits scored in double figures in a game for the eighth time this season ... SDSU improves to 21-1 this season when leading at the half, to 14-3 when making more than eight 3-pointers, to 17-3 when making more 3-pointers than the opponent, to 10-0 when scoring at least 80 points, to 7-0 on Wednesday and to 6-0 when Larson fouls out of the game ... SDSU won its last Division II postseason game and its first Division I postseason game in the state of Colorado, with the DII win coming on March 13, 2004 over Northern State at the North Central Regional in Denver ... Friday's game marks the first-ever meeting with Vanderbilt

## JACKRABBITS IN THE PROS

### Nate Wolters – Grand Rapids Drive (NBA D-League)

At SDSU from 2009-13: The Jackrabbits all-time leader with 2,363 points and with 669 assists, the Washington Wizards drafted Wolters with the 38th overall pick in the 2013 NBA Draft, then traded him to the Philadelphia 76ers, who traded him to the Milwaukee Bucks, all on the same night. Wolters played in 58 games, with 31 starts, as a Bucks rookie, averaging 7.2 points per game. The Bucks waived him on Jan. 9, and he signed the first of two 10 day contracts with the New Orleans Pelicans on Jan. 14, but they let him go on Feb. 3, making him a free agent again. The Grand Rapids Drive claimed Wolters from the player pool on March 6, and he made his NBA D-League debut on March 7, at the Sioux Falls Skyforce.

**March 18 at Saint Mary's (Calif.) – Vanderbilt knocks off Saint Mary's 75-64 in NIT 1st round**

MORAGA, Calif. (AP) -- St. Mary's five senior starters jumped out early on a young Vanderbilt team, but couldn't make it last.

The Commodores outscored the Gaels the rest of the first half and built an eight-point lead at intermission, never trailing again in its 75-64 win in the first round of the National Invitation Tournament on Wednesday.

Damian Jones scored 21 points and Riley LaChance added 17 for Vanderbilt. Reserve Jeff Roberson scored 10 points for the Commodores (20-13), and Wade Baldwin IV also had 10.

The Commodores started three freshmen, one sophomore and one senior.

"I think probably just the first postseason game for all these guys, or most of them," Vanderbilt coach Kevin Stallings said of the slow start. "They just needed to get the cobwebs out a little bit and get hit in the face, and we got hit in the face and that kind of woke us up."

Garrett Jackson scored 23 points and had nine rebounds for the Gaels (21-10), who lost their third straight game. Brad Waldow had 12 points and 13 rebounds, while Aaron Bright scored 17 points for St. Mary's.

Vanderbilt will host South Dakota State Friday at 8:30 p.m. CT at Memorial Gym.

Damian Jones, a sophomore center, shot 10 of 14 from the field, tying his career high for field goals made. He had seven rebounds.

"He was dominant the whole game," LaChance said of Jones. "He's the best player on our team and he definitely played like that tonight. That's what we need from him."

The Gaels trailed by eight points at halftime and by as many as 10 early in the second half. They cut the lead to 53-47 with 8:24 left as Waldow made two free throws, the center's first points since 6:30 of the first half.

"We had the experience out on the court, but we just weren't able to get it done today," Waldow said.

Vanderbilt led 57-51 with 5:10 remaining, but LaChance drilled a 3-point shot, hit a jumper and scored from the key, increasing the Commodores' advantage to 11 with 3:15 left.

"My teammates did a good job of setting me up, getting me good looks," LaChance said. "I was able to get a few to go down."

Roberson scored 10 first-half points, and the Commodores' bench outscored St. Mary's reserves 16-2. Jones had eight points on 4-of-6 shooting.

Jackson led the Gaels in the first half with nine points. St. Mary's shot 30.8 percent from the field but went 11-for-11 from the line.

Vanderbilt took its first lead of the game at 20-19 with 8:10 left in the first half when Shelton Mitchell, another reserve, scored on a driving lay-in. Mitchell drove for another basket, and James Siakam scored inside, extending the Commodores' lead to 24-19.

"That team's good," Gaels coach Randy Bennett said of Vanderbilt. "They didn't do what they needed to do for the course of the year, but they're playing like an NCAA Tournament team right now."

### TIP-INS

Vanderbilt: With the victory against St. Mary's, coach Stallings recorded his eighth 20-win season at the school.

St. Mary's: Gaels guard Aaron Bright was the Most Outstanding Player of the 2012 NIT when he played on Stanford's title team as a sophomore. He scored 17 points but shot just 7-for-17 against Vanderbilt in his final game for St. Mary's.

## HEAD COACH SCOTT NAGY – 384-231, 20TH SEASON

Scott Nagy returns for his 20th season at South Dakota State after guiding the Jackrabbits to three straight postseason appearances, which includes back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths in 2012 and 2013, and a bid to the College Basketball Invitational in 2014. He also led the Jacks to eight NCAA Tournaments at the Division II level.

The most prolific coach in school history, Nagy seems to hit a personal or team milestone every season, with the latest being the program's 1,400th win on March 1, 2014 against South Dakota in the final game of the 2013-14 regular season.

The 2012-13 season saw a slough of milestones for Nagy, both individual and team related, starting on Dec. 22, 2012, with a win at No. 16 New Mexico, the Jacks first-ever win over a ranked team. The season culminated with the team's second straight NCAA Tournament appearance and included the Jackrabbits second straight undefeated season at home, which pushed the home winning streak to 30 in a row, a school record and the longest streak in all of Division I basketball at the start of the 2013-14 season.

All those milestones came on the heels of a record-setting 2011-12 season that saw Nagy win his 300th career game on Dec. 28, 2011, a 94-58 win over IPFW at Frost Arena, his Jackrabbits tied a school record with 27 wins and earned a chance to dance for the first time in Division I.

In his 19 years at SDSU, Nagy guided the Jackrabbits through the transition from Division II to Division I, built an impressive 360-221 record (.620 winning percentage) at the Division I and Division II levels, and guided the Jacks to North Central Conference championships in 1996, 1997, 1998 and 2002,

adding Summit League Tournament titles in 2012 and 2013, along with a Summit League regular season title in 2013.

Nagy also directed the Jacks to the NCAA Regional Tournament from 1996-1998 and from 2000-2004, and hosted the North Central Regional Tournament in 1997, 1998 and 2000. He also led the Jacks to the Elite Eight tournament in 1997. All of those accomplishments played a part in him earning North Central Conference Coach of the Year five times in 1996, 1997, 1998, 2002 and 2003.
