JUNIOR SEASON PUSHING SHURMUR UP VU CHARTS

Kyle Shurmur's junior season was one for the record books as he broke Whit Taylor's single-season school record for touchdown passes with 26 and put him in position to challenge Vanderbilt legend Jay Cutler for the school's top marks in career passing yards and touchdowns.



SHURMUR

The rising senior enters his final season on West End needing less than 3,000

yards to become Vanderbilt's all-time leader in passing yards and 20 touchdowns to move by Cutler for the school record in TD passes.

Only two quarterbacks have recorded 3,000-yard seasons at VU with Cutler passing for 3,073 as a senior in 2005 and Kurt Page setting the single-season school record with 3,178 yards in 1983. Shurmur's 2,823 yards last fall was the second-most ever by a

Vanderbilt junior signal-caller and trailed only Missouri's Drew Lock in the SEC.

Shurmur will be among a veteran group in the SEC next fall as 12 teams bring back their starting quarterbacks.

RETURN OF THE LINEMEN

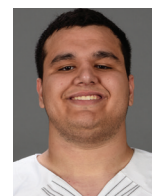
Unlike a season ago, the Commodores welcome back an offensive line virtually intact.

Vanderbilt brings back the entire starting line, anchored by center Bruno Reagan who will enter the 2018 season having started 27 straight games.

Justin Skule has 27 career starts and is one of three Dores on the offensive side of the ball (Shurmur & Reagan) returning after starting all 12 games in 2017.

Devin Cochran started 10 games as a redshirt freshman and Egidio DellaRipa took over the starting right guard position for the final eight games. Saige Young made a solid debut in his first season in Nashville, making eight starts at left guard.

The experienced group adds four more bodies to the mix this spring with Bryce Bailey, John Learned, Grant Miller and Johnathan Stewart coming off redshirt seasons last fall.



REAGAN

REPLACING RALPH

For the first time in four years the Commodores will be in search of a starting running back with the departure of Vanderbilt all-time leading rusher Ralph Webb.

Four Commodores will compete during the spring with Khari Blasin-game, Ke'Shawn Vaughn, Josh Crawford and Jamauri Wakefield all expected to get touches during spring practice.



THE WRIGHT RUSHING STUFF

Charles Wright was a force in 2017, recording nine sacks to lead the Commodores and rank fourth in the SEC. His nine sacks were the most by a Vandy player since James Manley recorded nine in 1994 and are the second-most by a Commodore in a single-season.

Wright will be among the SEC's leading sack artists in the fall along with Mississippi State's Montez Sweat and Texas A&M Landis Durham.

NEW FACES CATCHING PASSES

Vanderbilt will be looking to replace the majority of the team's receiving corps from last fall with the graduation of CJ Duncan, Trent Sherfield and Caleb Scott - three of the team's top five pass catchers in 2017.

The trio combined for 120 receptions, 1,424 yards and 12 touchdowns. The rest of the offense combined for 112 catches, 1,499 yards and 15 scores.

Kalija Lipscomb is the top returning target after catching a team-best eight touchdown passes last fall. The rising junior snagged 37 passes for 610 yards. Jared Pinkney led all VU tight ends with 22 receptions for 279 yards and three TDs.

Along with Lipscomb, six other Commodores who caught at least one pass last season return - Donaven Tennyson and Sam Dobbs caught eight passes each, Khari Blasingame six, Trey Ellis five, Jamauri Wakefield three and Jackson Winrow one.

Chris Pierce played as a true freshman in 2017 but fellow wideouts James Bostic and Keithian Starling are coming off redshirt seasons. They will be joined by CJ Bolar, who signed with VU during the early signing period in December.

New wide receivers coach Aaron Moorehead will lead the group for the first time this spring after joining the Dores from Texas A&M.

OPPORTUNITIES ON DEFENSE

With the departure of eight starters on defense, this spring presents the first opportunity to begin to fill those roles.

The defense returns 22 letterwinners and adds 11 more student-athletes to the mix, who redshirted during the fall.

For the first time in three years, the defense will be under the direction of someone other than head coach Derek Mason. Jason Tarver joins the staff as the Dores' new defensive coordinator after spending time with the San Francisco 49ers and Oakland Raiders. Tarver and Mason teamed up as co-defensive coordinators at Stanford in 2011.

2018 SCHEDULE = CHALLENGING

The Commodores' 2018 schedule will offer plenty of challenges with six of the 12 teams coming off bowl berths, including Georgia who finished national runner-up.

The Dores play three nonconference games early in the season with home dates against Middle Tennessee and Nevada before a trip to Notre Dame in mid-September. The Dores and Irish are set to meet for the third time in history, first time since 1996 and first time in South Bend since 1995.

Introduced Jan. 17, 2014 as the 28th head coach in team history... Notched first career victory as head coach in dramatic style, guiding team to 34-31 win over UMass on Sept. 13, 2014... After 2014 season, took over Vanderbilt defensive coordinator responsibilities...

Earned first road win at MTSU in October 2015... Earned first SEC victory Oct. 24, 2015 with 10-3 win over Missouri... Mason's 2016 team improved win total for second straight year, winning the final two games of the regular season against Ole Miss and Tennessee to get to six wins and earn an invitation to the Camping World Independence Bowl... Also earned first win over ranked foe on the road vs. Georgia... Offense improved in nearly every category in 2016, finishing sixth nationally in red zone efficiency... THE NEW GUYS

Head coach Derek Mason added four new coaches to the staff during the offseason, naming Jason Tarver the Commodores' defensive coordinator and outside linebackers coach, Aaron Moorehead the team's wide receivers coach, Shawn Mennenga the special teams coordinator and Terrence Brown the cornerbacks coach.

The rest of the Commodores' coaching staff returns intact with Andy Ludwig as the team's offensive coordinator but taking over the running backs. C.J. Ah You is set to coach the defensive line for the third year, Gerry Gdowski continues his work with the quarterbacks, former Commodore Chris Marve is in charge of the team's inside linebackers for the third season, Marc Mattioli goes into his fourth season at VU and will again coach the secondary and Cameron Norcross is back for his third season leading the offensive line.



Jason Tarver will serve as the Commodores' new defensive coordinator taking over for Mason, who has served as his own defensive coordinator since 2015. The California native brings 16 years of NFL experience to Nashville after working with the San Francisco 49ers and Oakland Raiders. In his second tenure with the 49ers, Tarver worked in a variety of roles, most recently as the team's senior defensive assistant. He also coached outside linebackers (2016) and was the senior defensive assistant/linebackers coach (2015). Tarver was also a member of the staff in San Francisco from 2001-10, spending time as an offensive quality control coach (2001-03), assistant running backs/offensive assistant (2004) and outside linebackers coach (2005-10). Prior to rejoining the 49ers, Tarver served as defensive coordinator for the Oakland Raiders (2012-14). During his time in Oakland, Tarver turned a defense that ranked 29th in the NFL prior to his arrival into the league's 18th-ranked unit in his first season. He served one season at Stanford alongside Mason as the co-defensive coordinator for the Cardinal (2011).

Aaron Moorehead comes to the Commodores after serving as the wide receivers coach at Texas A&M, the same role he will fill for VU. He spent the last three seasons with the Aggies after spending two years at Virginia Tech (2013-14), three at Stanford (2010-12) and beginning his career at New Mexico. At Texas A&M, Moorehead developed Christian Kirk into one of the most explosive playmakers in the Southeastern Conference. Kirk's 919 yards receiving last fall ranked fourth in the SEC. Kirk's junior year came on the heels of an All-SEC sophomore campaign after catching 83 passes for 928 yards alongside Josh Reynolds, who caught 61 passes for 1009 yards. At Virginia Tech, Moorehead had three wide receivers post 40-plus catches in the same season twice for the first time in program history. He also spent five seasons in the NFL with the Indianapolis Colts, winning Super Bowl XLI. He and his father, Emery, were the first father-son combo to both win a Super Bowl.



Shawn Mennenga (MEN-in-guh) returns to college football as the Commodores' special teams coordinator after spending the last seven seasons as the Cleveland Browns' special teams assistant coach. During his tenure in Cleveland he helped numerous players set NFL and franchise records, including Travis Coons who set an NFL record by making the first 18 field goals of his career. This past season, the Browns ranked seventh in the NFL in punting average and kickoff coverage and eighth in kickoff return average. Prior to joining the Browns, Mennenga made six stops at different levels of college football. His last collegiate stop was as the linebackers coach at South Dakota State (2009-10) before making the jump to professional football. He brings three years of head coaching experience to Vanderbilt after having led the program at Culver-Stockton College from 2002-04. He was the defensive coordinator at Fort Hayes State (2005-08), Culver-Stockton College (2001) and Hutchinson Community College (1998-2000).

Terrence Brown joins the Commodores' staff as the team's new cornerbacks coach after spending the last three seasons as a defensive graduate assistant for the Washington Huskies. While with the Huskies, he helped transform the team's defense into one of the Pac-12's and nation's best units. Last season, Washington ranked first in the Pac-12 in scoring and total defense while ranking fifth nationally in scoring defense and eighth in total defense. In 2016, Brown worked with consensus All-American safety Budda Baker, second-team All-American cornerback Sidney Jones and Pac-12 Defensive Freshman of the Year Taylor Rapp. That Huskies defense led the Pac-12 and ranked eighth in FBS in scoring defense while also leading the Pac-12 in total defense en route to a College Football Playoff appearance. Brown played for Mason at Stanford, where he was a two-year starter at cornerback.
