

NOTEWORTHY NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- Two Tigers recorded career-high point totals, but Mizzou (8-15, 1-9 SEC) could not score enough in the final minutes to overcome Alabama, falling 80-71, Saturday, Feb. 6, at Coleman Coliseum. Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** scored a season-high 22 points, while senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** scored a career-high 17 points.
- Puryear reached 20 or more points for the second time this season and the first time since scoring 20 points in his Tiger debut in Mizzou's season-opening win over Wofford (Nov. 13).
- Rosburg scored in double digits for the third time this season, recording 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field. Rosburg also had a team-high seven rebounds in the game.
- In the second half, Rosburg scored 10-straight points for the Tigers between the 9:10 and 6:34 mark.

PURYEAR STANDING OUT AMONG MIZZOU FRESHMEN, ALL-TIME


- Mizzou freshman forward **Kevin Puryear**'s scored 22 points, a season-high, and grabbed six rebounds at Alabama (Feb. 6), becoming the 12th freshman in program history to record a 200-point, 100-rebound debut season.
- Puryear is just the second Mizzou freshman in 12 seasons to accomplish the feat. As a freshman in 2013-14, forward Johnathan Williams III recorded 204 points and 227 rebounds.
- Since the 1993-94 season, only five Mizzou freshmen have posted at least 200 points and 100 rebounds in a season.

ROSBURG NOT GOING QUIETLY INTO THE NIGHT

- Mizzou senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** unfortunately knows the date of his final game as a Tiger when his squad plays Florida on Saturday, March 5.
- Since Mizzou Athletics announced on Jan. 13, it would self-impose a postseason ban this season on its men's basketball program, Rosburg has admirably played some of the best basketball of his career.
- ▶ With a career scoring average of 5.0 points per game, Rosburg has scored in double digits on two different occasions since Jan. 13, including a career-high 17 points (7-of-12 FG, 3-of-3 FT) at Alabama (Feb. 6). Over the last seven games, Rosburg has averaged 7.9 points per game.

PURYEAR STANDING TALL WITH FELLOW SEC FRESHMEN

- Mizzou freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** has averaged 10.7 points per game in the Tigers' first 10 conference contests the second-highest mark on head coach **Kim Anderson**'s squad.
- ▶ Puryear is one of seven freshmen in the conference to average double digit scoring in SEC action thus far.
- ▶ Puryear's 45.1-percent field goal shooting mark (37-of-82) ranks fifth in the conference among freshmen (min. 50 att.).



VERY EVEN ALL-TIME AGAINST THE COMMODORES

- Mizzou and Vanderbilt only played each other five times prior to the Tigers joining the Southeastern Conference for the 2012-13 season. With nine total meetings between the two schools, Vanderbilt holds a slim 5-4 series advantage.
- ▶ However, both programs have done an excellent job of protecting home courts. Mizzou and Vanderbilt are both 4-0 in home games in the series. The Tigers look to break that trend on Wednesday, Feb. 10, in Nashville.
- Vanderbilt claimed the lone off-campus matchup in the series with a 69-54 victory at the Silversword Classic in Wailuku, Hawaii, on Nov. 29, 1986. The Silversword Classic eventually became known as the Maui Invitational.

MORE ABOUT VANDERBILT

- Vanderbilt (13-10, 5-5) dropped its most recent SEC game at Ole Miss (Feb. 6) by a score of 85-78. After reeling off three-straight conference wins against Auburn (Jan. 12), Alabama (Jan. 16) and Tennessee (Jan. 20), the Commodores have alternated wins and losses over their last four games.
- Sophomore guard **Wade Baldwin IV** scored 19 points and dished out nine assists against the Rebels, continuing



▶ Junior forward **Luke Kornet** leads Vanderbilt with his 7.3 rebounds per game and also ranks eighth in the nation in blocks per game (2.9).

CLARK VERY CHARITABLE

- ▶ Junior guard **Wes Clark** was impressive at the free throw line vs. Ole Miss (Feb. 3), sinking a perfect 10-of-10 from the charity stripe en route to 20 points.
- ▶ Clark's performance was especially significant, as he was the first Tiger to shoot perfectly from the free throw line with a minimum of 10 attempts since the 2013-14 season. Jordan Clarkson hit 11-of-11 vs. Vanderbilt on Feb. 19, 2014, while Jabari Brown made 10-of-10 vs. UCLA on Dec. 7, 2013.

WRIGHT WENT TO BOARDING SCHOOL

- No Tiger has improved on the glass like sophomore guard **Namon Wright**, who narrowly missed his first career double-double with 16 points and nine rebounds against Mississippi State (Jan. 30). The nine boards were a career-high.
- ▶ Wright followed up his nine-board game against the Bulldogs with eight rebounds vs. Ole Miss (Feb. 3). He has snagged five or more rebounds in four of the last six games.
- Wright, averaging 4.7 rebounds per game this season, has more than doubled his rebounds-per-game average from his freshman campaign (2.3). The Tiger has 109 rebounds through 23 games after securing 69 in 30 games last season.

STEAL OUR HEARTS, TERRENCE

- There is a lot to love about freshman guard **Terrence Phillips**' aggressive style of play, especially on the defensive end. His 35 steals over Mizzou's 23 games leads the squad.
- Phillips put forth a defensive gem vs. Ole Miss (Feb. 3), recording a season-high five steals.
- Phillips' 1.9 steals per game in Southeastern Conference action ranks first in the league among freshman and tied for second overall. In overall games, Phillips' 1.5 steals-per-game average ranks sixth in the conference.

FRESHMEN FOCUS AT THE FREE THROW LINE

- Three Mizzou freshmen currently hold strong marks at the free throw line in conference action. Forward **Kevin Puryear**, guard **K.J. Walton** and guard **Terrence Phillips** are shooting 85.7 percent (30-of-35), 85.7 percent (12-of-14) and 80.0 percent (20-of-25), respectively.
- Mizzou is the only school in the conference with three freshmen shooting 80.0 percent or better from the free throw line in conference action.

DIGGING IN AT THE LINE

- Mizzou has seen improvement at the free throw line this season, shooting 71.5 percent (364-of-509) thus far in the 2015-16 campaign. Four Tigers are currently shooting better than 75.0-percent from the line, led by the strong charity stripe presence of freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** (81.6 percent, 71-of-87).
- All four of Mizzou's top four overall scorers are the squad's top four marksmen at the free throw line. Junior guard **Wes Clark** is shooting 82.3 percent (51-of-62), sophomore guard **Namon Wright** is shooting 77.5 percent (69-of-89) and freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** 77.1 percent (37-of-48).
- Last season, Mizzou finished with a 66.0-percent FT mark, with only two Tigers shooting above the 75.0-percent mark.

WELCOME HOME, JORDAN BARNETT

- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson** announced on Jan. 19, that former Texas forward **Jordan Barnett**, a St. Louis, Mo., native and former standout at Christian Brothers College High School, had transferred to the University of Missouri and joined the program.
- ▶ In his last game inside Mizzou Arena, Barnett scored 43 points, grabbed 20 rebounds and blocked three shots to lead CBC to an 86-77 overtime win over Hickman to claim the 2014 Missouri Class 5 State Championship. He averaged 20.8 points and 8.2 rebounds per game as a senior.
- ▶ Barnett (6-7, 215 pounds) will sit out as part of his transfer requirements for a year-long period and be eligible to play in the second half of the 2016-17 season as a junior.
- ▶ Barnett was widely considered one of the country's Top 100 players coming out of high school, as he was ranked 70th overall by *Rivals.com* and 86th by *ESPN.com*. He was named the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch*'s All-Metro Player of the Year at the conclusion of his final prep campaign.

CLARK CAREER GAME

- ▶ Junior guard **Wes Clark** had himself a day at No. 19 South Carolina (Jan. 16), recording his third 20-point game in a seven-game span with his career-high 26 points. Clark has reached 20 points or more four times during the 2015-16 season.
- ▶ Prior to the hot seven-game stretch for Clark (Dec. 23-Jan. 16), the Tiger guard was averaging 7.7 points per game.
- Clark reset his previously established personal scoring mark with 22 points vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2).
- ▶ Clark has led Mizzou in scoring six times this season, surpassing his five games doing so over last season.

#RALLYFORRHYAN

Rhyan Loos, the 5-year-old daughter of assistant Mizzou coach Brad Loos and his wife, Jen, has been diagnosed with neuroblastoma, a type of pediatric cancer. The Mizzou Men's Basketball program will be supporting Rhyan and the Loos Family throughout the season.

PEARL COMES AWAY IMPRESSED WITH MIZZOU

Mizzou came out swinging against Auburn in its Southeastern Conference home opener (Jan. 9), taking a 15-point halftime lead that was the Tigers' largest lead at the break in a league game since the 2013-14 season (38-22 vs. South Carolina, Jan. 25, 2014). Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl had the following to say postgame:

On Mizzou's performance...

"I thought Missouri played well, they're a talented team. They have a lot of good young talent, 10 guys who played double digit minutes and five guys in double digit scoring. They have great balance, we got beat 40-5 off the bench. They play better at home because they're a young team and they'll beat people in here."

FRESHMEN CAN FIND THE LINE

- ▶ Both K.J. Walton and Kevin Puryear have posted 9-of-10 games from the free throw line this season, both marks that tie for game highs for Mizzou this season.
- Puryear hit on 9-of-10 from the charity stripe in recent action at Georgia (Jan. 6), while Walton accomplished the feat vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore (Nov. 15).

FINISHED NONCONFERENCE IN STYLE

- Mizzou finished its nonconference schedule the way it should with big victories over visitors to Mizzou Arena, first with the 53-point win (78-25) over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). That win was the Tigers largest margin of victory over an opponent since defeating Central Arkansas by the same amount in a 116-63 win in 2010.
- ▶ The 25 points allowed by the Tigers in that victory were the fewest ever allowed by a Mizzou team inside Mizzou Arena and the fewest by a Mizzou team since Jan. 3, 1947, against lowa State when Mizzou won, 36-25.
- Mizzou also held UAPB to an all-time opponent low 15.4-percent field goal shooting mark. The previous was 18.3-percent by UAPB in 1998.
- The Tigers defeated Savannah State, 81-50, for a 31-point victory on Jan. 2, bringing Mizzou's two-game stretch to a whopping 84-point differential. That 84-point differential was Mizzou's largest since outscoring its opponents by 99 points in games vs. Texas Pan-American (100-44, Nov. 22, 2009) and Chattanooga (99-56, Nov. 24, 2009).

PSYCHO REBOUNDING

- Mizzou has worked to establish itself on the boards as a noticeably shorter squad. In fact, the Tigers rank 267th in all of Division I basketball in average height with a roster average of 76.2 inches, or 6 feet, 3.5 inches (according to Ken Pomeroy).
- ▶ The Tigers recorded the second +10 rebounding margin game of the Kim Anderson Era against Illinois (Dec. 23), 43-32 (+11).
- Mizzou followed that up with its first 50-rebound game in more than two seasons. The Tigers racked up 56 rebounds against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). The last time Mizzou grabbed 50 or more rebounds was on Feb. 9, 2013, with 50 vs. Ole Miss.

ALWAYS BETTER TO GIVE

- Mizzou recorded 19 assists (on 27 field goals) as a team in the 78-25 win vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29), the highest total of assists in the Kim Anderson era.
- Anderson's squad reached 18 assists (on 28 field goals) earlier in the season vs. Northern Illinois (Dec. 4).
- The Tigers had previously posted 18 assists or more with 19 against Mississippi State on March 1, 2014.

THREE 2016 SIGNEES SECURED FOR ANDERSON'S SQUAD

- A 6-6 small forward, **Willie Jackson** (Cleveland, Ohio) has been electric for Garfield Heights High School, averaging 18.0 points, 14.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game and helping head coach Sonny Johnson's group to a 24-4 record as a junior in 2014-15.
- ▶ Standing 6-9, **Reed Nikko** (Maple Grove, Minn.) powered Maple Grove High School to a 23-4 record last season while averaging 9.6 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game for head coach Nick Schroeder.
- A 6-9 forward, Mitchell Smith (Van Buren, Ark.) scored in bunches for Van Buren head coach Randy Loyd, averaging 18.1 points and 7.6 rebounds per game as a junior.

OFFSEASON FOCUSED ON BUILDING TEAM CHEMISTRY

- Head coach **Kim Anderson** knew the 2015 offseason was an important one in regards to fostering a stronger bond amongst his squad. Team activities that the Tigers participated in during the spring and summer included: hospital visits, bowling, flag football, Saturday tailgates before Mizzou Football games and team picnics.
- Anderson also commissioned Missouri National Guard's Camp Clark to teach leadership and communication skills to the Tigers in late September.
- Mizzou spent the weekend (Sept. 26-27) at Camp Clark (near Nevada, Mo.) learning from Captain Travis Miller's specialized crew of instructors, all active National Guardsmen.
- Activities included obstacle course and communication challenges, proper tactical and weapon operation, Humvee rollover training and paintball.

OUTSTANDING SUMMER IN THE CLASSROOM

- Head coach Kim Anderson's 2015-16 squad posted one of the program's highest summer session grade point averages in recent history.
- This season's Tigers group was the first to record a summer session GPA above the 3.0 mark in more than five years.

PROGRAM MOVING FORWARD

MIZZOU ANNOUNCES DETAILS OF NCAA REVIEW

- It was announced on Jan. 13, that for the past nineteen months, the University of Missouri had worked collaboratively with the NCAA enforcement staff to review potential violations in its men's basketball program. In December 2013, the NCAA enforcement staff received information regarding potential violations involving a then men's basketball student-athlete. A verbal notice of inquiry was provided to the institution on April 14, 2014.
- Mizzou is in agreement with the NCAA that five violations did occur and will work with the NCAA to bring closure to the issue through the NCAA Summary Disposition process.
- The violations originated under the tenure of the previous men's basketball staff and there is no evidence that any current staff members were aware of the violations. Though self-imposing a postseason ban for this season is difficult for Mizzou's student-athletes, the program's coaches and supporters, it is an appropriate measure in holding the institution accountable and is consistent with the NCAA penalty structure for these levels of violations.
- ▶ Because the NCAA enforcement process is ongoing, the university cannot provide additional details at this time regarding the violations or the sanctions.





HANK FOLEY

Statement from the University of Missouri's Chancellor on Wednesday, Jan. 13

"The University of Missouri has high expectations for every member of our community, including our faculty, staff and students, and those same expectations are applied to those who support our endeavors. It is clear from our collaborative investigation with the NCAA that a former member of our athletics staff and members of our donor community violated NCAA bylaws and we take those actions seriously. We have an obligation to adhere to all NCAA and SEC rules as a member institution and we will continue to improve our education and oversight to ensure that we compete with integrity."

"We have already taken many proactive steps to address concerns, including appropriate self-imposed sanctions. We will win at Mizzou and do so with integrity and class. Our working relationship with the current men's basketball staff is strong and I am confident in their commitment to upholding our standards and values for Mizzou Athletics."

@MIZZOUHOOPS DROPS HEARTBREAKER IN FINAL MINUTETO OLE MISS, 76-73



COLUMBIA, Mo. - Mizzou Men's Basketball (8-13, 1-8) dropped a hard-fought game to Ole Miss (14-8, 4-5), falling by a score of 76-73 Thursday night at Mizzou Arena. The Tigers led by four points with 1:05 left in the game after a jumper by junior guard **Wes Clark** (Detroit, Mich.), who finished with 20 points for his fourth game this season with 20 points or more.

Clark was a perfect 10-of-10 from the free throw line, the first time this season a Tiger has sank 10 attempts from the charity stripe. He shot 4-of-7 from the field (2-of-3 3PT), while also recording four rebounds, five assists and two steals.

Joining Clark in double figures were freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** (Orange County, Calif.) and sophomore guard **Namon Wright** (Los Angeles, Calif.), who had 14 and 12 points, respectively. Wright led the Tigers in rebounding for the second-straight game with eight boards, while Phillips recorded a season-high five steals. Freshman guard **Cullen VanLeer** (Pacific, Mo.) also chipped in 10 points off the bench, shooting 2-of-6 from three-point territory.

As the end of the first half approached, the Rebels had stretched their lead to 32-23 with an 11-3 run. The Tigers were not phased as they closed the half on a 7-3 run of their own, bringing the score to 35-30 going into the break.

In second half action, Phillips keyed a 9-0 run by grabbing two steals, hitting a three, and then finding a cutting Clark for a lay-in all within a matter of minutes to close the Ole Miss lead to one. The lid came off of Mizzou Arena when Wright hit a late-shot clock triple to give Mizzou its first lead of the second half at 13:52.

The Rebels and Tigers continued to trade buckets until Mizzou captured a late lead of four points, which was fueled by seven straight from Clark, followed by clutch three balls from both Phillips and Wright.

Clark had two decent looks to take the lead back from Ole Miss inside the final minute, and both shots were in and out of the bucket. The Rebels kept the win out of reach with clutch free throws.

The Tigers shot well from deep, hitting a season-high 47.6 percent of their threepoint attempts, including hitting on 7-of-9 from downtown in the second half.
