Bulldogs Close Out 2012 At Vanderbilt

YEAR END: Butler will try to add to a successful year when it closes out 2012 in Nashville, Tenn., with a game against Vanderbilt on Saturday, Dec. 29. The contest at the Commodores' Memorial Gymnasium will tip at 8 p.m. (ET) and will be televised on ESPNU. Butler opened 2012 with a victory at Wright State, 63-62, on Jan. 6. The 12 months since have seen the Bulldogs advance to the semifinals of the Horizon League Tournament and the postseason College Basketball Invitational, change conferences, finish runner-up at the Maui Invitational and knock off top-ranked Indiana. Butler (9-2) is making just its second visit ever to Vanderbilt and its first since 1924-25! The Bulldogs picked up their sixth consecutive victory with a 75-67 decision over visiting Evansville in their last outing on Dec. 22. Vanderbilt (5-5) has won three of its last four outings, including two straight at home. Among the Commodores' wins this season is an overtime victory at Xavier. Butler and Vanderbilt will meet again next season at Hinkle Fieldhouse.

Butler is 23-10 since Jan. 1, 2012.

POLLING PLACE: Butler's victory over top-ranked Indiana on Dec. 15 vaulted the Bulldogs into the "Top 25" of both major national polls for the first time this season. The Bulldogs joined the Associated Press "Top 25" at No. 19 and the USA Today Coaches Poll at No. 25. This week's A.P. poll has Butler ranked No. 18, while the Bulldogs are No. 21 in the coaches' poll. Butler has appeared in the national "Top 25" in six of the past seven seasons.

HOLIDAY TREAT: The Bulldogs ended their pre-Christmas schedule at home with a victory over state foe Evansville, 75-67. It was Butler's first win over the Purple Aces in three years, and it gave the Bulldogs a perfect 5-0 mark against teams from Indiana this season. A three-point field goal by senior **Rotnei Clarke** midway through the first half capped an 8-0 Butler run that broke a 17-17 tie and put the Bulldogs on top for good. Butler then stretched a 35-31 halftime lead to as many as 14 points in the second half, before a late Evansville rally threatened to send the game into overtime for the third consecutive year. Down 67-53 with three-and-a-half minutes remaining, the Aces went on a 14-4 run that trimmed Butler's advantage to 71-67 with 0:26 left. But the Bulldogs ended the threat with four consecutive free throws in the game's final 25 seconds.

Series Notes

Butler at Vanderbilt

•Butler and Vanderbilt are meeting for the fourth time overall and for the first time since 1929-30. Butler has won the first three meetings in the series.

•The Bulldogs last faced Vanderbilt in the fifth game of the 1929-30 season and came away with a 39-14 victory at Hinkle Fieldhouse. It was the fourth season for Butler head coach Paul D. "Tony" Hinkle and just one year after Butler had been awarded the John J. McDevitt Trophy as the collegiate national champions.

•Butler and Vanderbilt met twice in the 1924-25 season. The Bulldogs captured a 37-17 decision at Hinkle Fieldhouse and then won at Vanderbilt, 33-13, later in the year. The Bulldogs were coached by Harlan O. "Pat" Page in 1924-25. The previous season, Butler won the national championship at the A.A.U. National Tournament in Kansas City, Mo.

BIG LIFT: Senior **Andrew Smith** continued a strong pre-Christmas surge with 20 points, six rebounds, four assists, two blocked shots and a steal in Butler's victory over Evansville. He shared the team scoring lead with senior **Rotnei Clarke**, while leading the squad in both assists and blocked shots. The four assists matched his career-high, set a year ago against Milwaukee. In the past three games, the 6-11 Butler center has averaged 18.7 points and 8.3 rebounds, while shooting .704 from the field, .750 from beyond the three-point arc and .750 from the free throw line. He had his first double-double of the season (and the fifth of his career) with 24 points and 10 rebounds at Northwestern.

Andrew Smith has scored in double-figures in each game of Butler's current winning streak.

FAMILIAR LEADER: Butler senior **Rotnei Clarke** posted his ninth consecutive double-figures scoring performance and shared Butler's scoring lead with 20 points in the Bulldogs' victory over Evansville. He hit three of six three-point field goal attempts in the win, including one that gave the Bulldogs their biggest lead at 64-50 with under five minutes to play. The 6-0 point-guard from Verdigris, Okla., has had at least three three-point field goals in 10 of Butler's 11 games this season. He's scored in double-figures 10 times in 11 games, including a season-high 27 points against Illinois in the championship game of the Maui Invitational, and he's has averaged 18.6 points over Butler's last nine contests. He's had at least a share of Butler's scoring lead in eight of the Bulldogs' first 11 games.

Rotnei Clarke ranks second in the Atlantic 10 Conference in scoring (17.7 ppg).

RESERVE TANK: The Bulldogs have had several players come off the bench with strong performances this season, and the Evansville game was no exception. Sophomore **Kameron Woods** and freshman **Kellen Dunham** each played a significant role in Butler's win over the Purple Aces. Woods scored 10 points and led all players with 12 rebounds in 24 minutes of action against the Aces. He hit three of four shots from the floor and four of six from the free throw line, and he added two assists and a blocked shot, while recording his fourth career double-double. His 12 rebounds were a career-high, as were his four free throws made. Dunham chipped in with 13 points and matched his career-high with five rebounds. He scored nine of his points in the first half, helping Butler to a four-point halftime lead. The two Butler players out-scored Evansville's bench, 23-17.

CHARITABLE EFFORT: Butler's bid against Evansville featured a season-best performance at the free throw line. The Bulldogs connected on their first 15 free throw attempts in the game, including all 11 in the first half. Butler finished the game hitting a season-best 23 of 27 (85.2%) from the charity stripe, topping the previous team best of 80% (20-25) against #9 North Carolina at the Maui Invitational. Senior **Rotnei Clarke** and freshman **Kellen Dunham** each hit five of five free throws against the Aces, while senior **Andrew Smith** connected on seven of his nine attempts.

BOARDING PASS: The Bulldogs, led by sophomore **Kameron Woods**, out-rebounded Evansville, 39-29. Woods led all players with 12 rebounds, including a game-high nine defensive boards. The Bulldogs, who continue to lead the Atlantic 10 Conference in rebounding margin (+7.3), have had a rebounding advantage over their opponent in nine of their first 11 games this season. Butler leads the A-10 in offensive rebounding percentage (.397), while ranking second in the league in defensive rebounding percentage (.714).

DECEMBER STREAK: The Bulldogs have won all five of their December games and enter the Vanderbilt contest with a six-game winning streak. The streak includes four home decisions, one road victory and a neutral court win over top-ranked Indiana. It's the ninth time since Brad Stevens took over as Butler's head coach that the Bulldogs have had a winning streak of at least six games.

Butler has averaged 81.3 points over its last six games.

•Senior **Rotnei Clarke** has been named to the watch list for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award, presented to the nation's top point-guard. Finalists will be announced in January.

•**Rotnei Clarke** played in his 100th career game in Butler's win over IUPUI. He had his 100th career start one game later at Northwestern.

•**Rotnei Clarke** leads the Atlantic 10 Conference and ranks fourth in the NCAA Division I in three-point field goals made per game (4.0).

•**Rotnei Clarke** has averaged 3.1 three-point field goals per game for his career.

•**Rotnei Clarke** has hit a three-point field goal in each of his last 23 collegiate games, dating back to his final season at Arkansas.

•**Rotnei Clarke** scored 36 points in his last visit to Vanderbilt in his junior season at Arkansas. Clarke hit 12 of 16 shots from the field, including six of eight from beyond the three-point arc, to help Arkansas beat the No. 19-ranked Commodores. It was his top scoring performance in an SEC game.

•**Rotnei Clarke** ranks seventh in the A-10 and 20th in the NCAA in three-point field goal percentage (.454).

•Senior **Chase Stigall** needs one three 3-point field goal to reach 100 for his career.

•Sophomore **Roosevelt Jones** posted his third consecutive double-figures scoring performance with 12 points against Evansville. Jones hit five of six shots from the field and both of his free throw attempts in the win.

•**Roosevelt Jones** is shooting .652 from the field over Butler's last three games.

•**Roosevelt Jones** ranks tenth in the Atlantic 10 Conference in field goal shooting (.548).

•Freshman **Kellen Dunham** leads the A-10 and ranks third in the NCAA Division I in free throw shooting (.951). He had a streak of 26 consecutive free throws made earlier this season.

•Butler had five players score in double-figures in the victory over Evansville. It was the fourth time in the past six games that five Butler players reached twin-digits in scoring.

•Butler has five "Top 10" wins under head coach **Brad Stevens**. The Bulldogs defeated #4 Syracuse and #7 Kansas State in the 2010 NCAA Tournament and #4 Pittsburgh in the 2011 national tournament, prior to beating #1 Indiana and #9 North Carolina this season.

•Butler has won its last 13 games when holding its opponent under 60 points.

•Butler is 57-6 under head coach Brad Stevens when hitting at least nine three-point field goals in a game.

Notes From The 2012-13 Butler Vault:

•Senior **Rotnei Clarke** is one of 50 players named to the Atlanta Tipoff Club 2012-13 Naismith Early Season Watch List.

•**Rotnei Clarke** was one of six players named to the All-Tournament Team at the conclusion of the Maui Invitational. Clarke, who averaged 21.3 points in Butler's three tournament games, was joined on the All-Tournament squad by Brandon Paul and DJ Richardson of Illinois, Vander Blue of Marquette, Reggie Bullock of North Carolina and De'Andre Haskins of Chaminade. Clarke scored 20 points, including the game-winning three-point field goal at the buzzer, to lead Butler past Marquette, and then he shared team scoring honors with 17 points in the Bulldogs' victory over #9 North Carolina. He finished his three-game run with a game-high 27 points against Illinois.

•The Bulldogs were picked to finish sixth in the Atlantic 10 Conference this season in the preseason poll of league coaches and media. Saint Joseph's was tabbed as the preseason favorite, narrowly edging out Saint Louis for the top spot in the poll. Newcomer VCU came in third, followed by Temple, Massachusetts and Butler. La Salle was tabbed seventh, followed by Dayton, Xavier, Richmond, St. Bonaventure, Charlotte, George Washington, Fordham, Rhode Island and Duquesne. Butler received two first place votes in the poll.

•The top seven single season win totals in Butler basketball history have been recorded since **Brad Stevens** joined the Bulldogs' coaching staff. He's guided the Bulldogs to the No. 1 (33 in 2009-10), No. 2 (30 in 2007-08), No. 4 (28 in 2010-11) and No. 6-T (26 in 2008-09) win totals as Butler's head coach, and he served as an assistant coach on teams that posted the No. 3 (29 in 2006-07), No. 5 (27 in 2002-03) and No. 6-T (26 in 2001-02) totals.

•Butler added three men's basketball recruits on the first day of the NCAA's fall signing period. Joining the Bulldogs' 2013-14 freshman class were 6-10 **Nolan Berry** of Saint Louis, Mo., 6-7 **Andrew Chrabascz** of Portsmouth, R.I., and 6-2 **Rene Castro** of Milton, Mass. Berry, the grandson of former NBA player Ed Macauley, averaged 19.5 points and 9.2 rebounds as a junior at De Smet Jesuit H.S., while Chrabascz averaged 17 points and nine rebounds at 20-7 Cushing Academy (Mass.). Castro, the Massachusetts Gatorade Player of the Year, averaged 23.4 points, while shooting 42% from three-point range, at Worcester (Mass.) Academy.

ON THIS DATE: A thundering, rebound slam dunk by Joel Cornette with 0:03.4 remaining in the game lifted Butler to a 66-64 victory over Indiana in the championship game of the Hoosier Classic at Conseco Fieldhouse on Dec. 29, 2001. The Bulldogs became the first champ other than host Indiana in the 20-year history of the tournament, which was discontinued the following year.

FROM THE ARCHIVES:

Butler's last trip to Nashville, Tenn., produced a remarkable individual performance and a 20-point win. Darnell Archey (current Butler Coordinator of Basketball Operations) came off the bench to hit five of eight three-point field goal attempts and lead all scorers with 26 points, while helping Butler to a 76-56 victory over Lipscomb on Dec. 3, 2001.

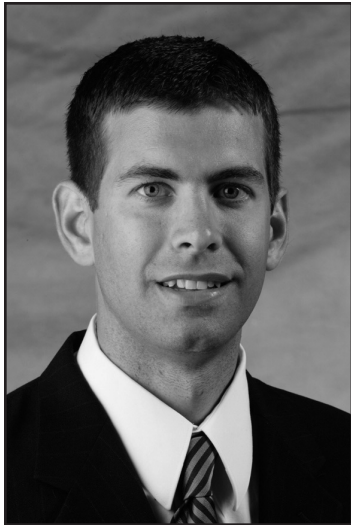

Brad Stevens

Head Coach, Butler University



No coach in the history of NCAA Division I basketball has done it better. In five seasons as a Butler's head coach, Brad Stevens has compiled a record of success unmatched in NCAA annals.

The 36-year-old Butler coach has led the Bulldogs to a 139-40 record, four Horizon League regular season championships, three league tournament titles and five trips to postseason tournament play. He owns the top two single season win totals in Butler and Horizon League history, and he's the only coach in school and league history to lead a team to the NCAA Division I national championship game, something he's done twice!

Stevens, who owns two Horizon League Coach of the Year awards, has rewritten the NCAA record book for Best Coaching Starts by Wins. He captured the five-year record (139), moving ahead of Everett Case of North Carolina State (1947-51) in 2011-12, and he owns the three-year (89) and four-year (117) records. He's second on the two-year list with 56 wins.

This past season (2011-12), Stevens led a young Butler team to a 20-win season, a third place finish in the Horizon League regular season race and a return trip to postseason play. He helped the Bulldogs to the semifinals of the Horizon League Tournament and to the semifinals of the College Basketball Invitational.

One year earlier, he guided Butler to a 28-10 campaign, a league-record fifth consecutive Horizon League regular season championship, a second straight league tournament title, a fifth consecutive

trip to the NCAA Tournament and a second straight national runner-up finish.

In 2009-10, Stevens engineered the most remarkable season in Butler basketball history! The Bulldogs posted a 33-5 overall record, the Horizon League's first 18-0 conference mark and fourth overall unbeaten record, a fourth consecutive league regular season championship, a second Horizon League Tournament crown in three years and a national runner-up finish in the NCAA Tournament. The Bulldogs were nationally-ranked for the fourth straight year, and Butler compiled a school-record, 25-game winning streak, the longest winning streak in the nation! The Butler coach was named NABC All-District 12 Coach, and he was a finalist for several additional national coaching awards. Butler ended the season as the No. 2-ranked team in the final ESPN/USA Today national poll.

In his debut season in 2007-08, Stevens helped Butler become the first team in school and Horizon League history to record 30 wins. The 30-4 Bulldogs captured the Great Alaska Shootout, won a second consecutive Wooden Tradition trophy, and wrapped up Horizon League regular season and tournament championships. Butler won a first-round NCAA Tournament game, before falling in overtime to #5 Tennessee in the second round. The Bulldogs were ranked in the "Top 25" of the A. P. and ESPN/USA Today national polls for 19 consecutive weeks, including a record three weeks in the "Top 10." Butler set school- and league-records for regular season wins (27) and became just the second team in league history to record 16 league victories.

Only three coaches in NCAA Division I history - Bill Guthridge, North Carolina (34), Bill Hodges, Indiana State (33) and Jamie Dixon, Pittsburgh (31) - posted more first-year wins than the Butler coach. And at 31, Stevens became the third-youngest Division I coach to guide his team to 30 wins - the youngest in more than half a century!

In addition to becoming the first men's basketball coach in Butler history to lead the Bulldogs to 30 wins, Stevens broke the 34-game Butler coaching record (28-6) shared by three coaches. He moved into seventh place on Butler's all-time list for coaching victories after just one season.

His second season produced perhaps an even more remarkable record! He guided a Butler team picked fifth in the Horizon League, with no seniors and just one returning starter, to 26 wins, a "Top

25" national ranking, a second consecutive league regular season championship and another trip to the NCAA Tournament. He recorded his 50th career win faster than any other coach in Butler men's basketball history, and faster than all but four coaches in Division I history! Only Guthridge (58-14, 1998-99) posted more wins in his first two seasons! Stevens was the mid-season recipient of the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year Award, and he was cited as the Horizon League Coach of the Year.

Stevens was introduced as the new men's basketball head coach at Butler University on April 4, 2007, just three days after his former boss, Todd Lickliter, was named head coach at the University of Iowa. He became the third consecutive former Butler assistant coach to be named head coach of the Bulldogs, and he served under the previous two - Thad Matta and Lickliter.

Stevens worked with Lickliter for six seasons, 2001-07. During his tenure as an assistant coach with the Bulldogs, Butler compiled a 131-61 record, won three Horizon League regular season championships and made four trips to postseason tournament play. In 2006-07, Butler compiled a 29-7 record and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Bulldogs won the NIT Season Tip-Off at Madison Square Garden in New York, and the team was ranked in the "Top 25" of both the Associated Press (A.P.) and ESPN/USA Today national polls for 16 consecutive weeks.

Stevens joined the Bulldogs' staff in 2000-01 as coordinator of basketball operations, handling a variety of administrative duties. He was offered a full-time assistant coaching position by Lickliter in 2001-02.

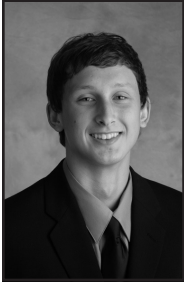
The Butler coach left a position as a marketing associate at Eli Lilly and Company in Indianapolis to pursue a career in basketball coaching. He served in a volunteer capacity in Butler's basketball office during the summer of 2000, before eventually gaining a full-time administrative position under Matta.

Stevens, who is a member of the NABC Board of Directors and serves as Chairman of the NABC Ethics Committee, earned a B.A. degree in economics from DePauw in 1999. He was a four-year member of the basketball team at DePauw, earning the squad's "Coaches Award" in 1998-99. He and his wife, Tracy, have two children, son Brady and daughter Kinsley.

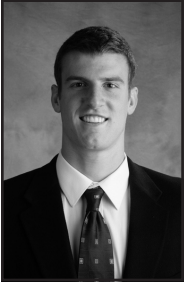

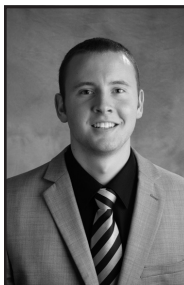

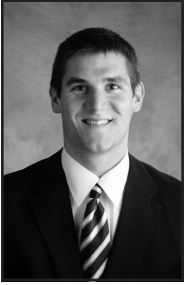
