JOHNNY JONES

Head Coach • 5th Year at LSU (17th Year as Head Coach)

The burning desire and passion, combined with the love of his alma mater, has made Johnny Jones and LSU a strong fit together as he enters his fifth year as head coach. Jones has proven his recruiting ability with multiple top five ranked classes and 80 wins in four years at LSU, the most four-year win total by any head coach in school history.

In fact, his first three wins in the 2016-17 season will push him past both C. C. Stroud and Press Maravich into fourth on the LSU Coaches win list behind only the three longest tenured coaches in school history who combined to handle the head coaching position for a period of 65 years.

More notably, all four years he has posted non-losing seasons in the difficult Southeastern Conference and his 40 league wins is the second best start among present league coaches who have been on the job at least four years.

But there are numbers that have to be taken into account when it comes to Jones' first-four years at LSU:

13 – Number of graduates in four years ... Every basketball player that has reached their senior season with the program under Jones has graduated from LSU, including three who returned to school during his tenure.

1 – No. 1 NBA Draft selection (Ben Simmons, 2016) ... Simmons became just the second LSU player to be picked No. 1 in the draft, joining Shaquille O'Neal (who Coach Jones was on the bench for as an assistant at LSU).

4 – NBA Draft selections last three years. -- Johnny O'Bryant III (2014, Milwaukee); Jarell Martin (1st rd, Memphis, 2015) and Jordan Mickey (Boston, 2015); and, Ben Simmons (No. 1, Philadelphia) in 2016.

80 – Wins (three shy of moving into fourth all-time at LSU)

2 – Post-season appearances

9 – All-SEC selections

3 -- Ranking in college basketball in 2016 in increase in average attendance from 8,897 in 2015 to 11,383 this past season.

\$200,000 – Money raised for Baton Rouge area flood relief by the Shaquille O'Neal-Coach Johnny Jones Golf Tournament.

For Jones, just the fifth LSU alum to hold the top position in the men's basketball program and the third to have played and serve as head coach, his beliefs about reaching out to fans and giving them an exciting style of basketball to watch in the Maravich Center has been a strong selling point to fans and recruits alike.

Jones, in his coaching career, has aimed to put teams on the floor that will play hard from start to finish and play a style of basketball that makes players want to come to LSU to showcase their talent in a team concept. His teams have averaged well over 70 points a game the last four years and has shown the ability to rally when necessary, including 10 times when down by five or more at the half.

Jones has a job that he has been preparing for years to accept and that call to be the head coach at LSU came on April 13, 2012. He returned to a place he had spent many years playing and coaching. It was the dream job scenario and what he did after leaving LSU the first time prepared him to make this return successful.

Jones believes in one of the long-time philosophies of LSU basketball – "HIT" – Hard. Intelligent. Together. It's a philosophy that LSU players learn very quickly that if they play hard, play with intelligence and play together, a lot of good things can happen. Throw in "Family" and you have the mantra of LSU Basketball under Johnny Jones.

It's a "family" that has worked together at such times as flood relief, unloading a giant 18-wheeler of supplies from Shaq for a local area, or making an annual visit to the local hospital children's wing to sing Christmas carols to patients. It's reading in school to kids or visiting and learning from children at the Louisiana School for the Visually Impaired.

It has been that way since day one for Coach Jones as he has gone out of its way to embrace all aspects of this community.

This is Jones' third career head coaching position as he served as the interim head coach at the University of Memphis during the 1999-2000 season and began his run as the head coach at the University of North Texas prior to the 2001-02 season.

The Mean Green advanced to four of the last six Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship games, which included each of the final three seasons Jones was the head coach there (2010, 2011, 2012).

Under Jones, the Mean Green averaged 21 wins per year over his last six seasons which included a school record 24 wins in 2010 and a pair of SBC titles and NCAA Tournament trips.

When Johnny Jones suited up for his first game as an LSU Tiger against Colgate in the Great Alaskan Shootout on Nov. 28, 1980, it would mark the first of 121 games that he would play for LSU.

Then the player would turn assistant coach and be on the bench with Coach Brown for another 407 contests. Jones is the only person in LSU history to both play (1981) and coach (1986, assistant) in an NCAA Final Four. After his Tigers went to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, he became the first person to play for the Tigers in an NCAA Tournament, serve as an assistant coach for LSU in the NCAA Tournament and to be LSU head coach in an NCAA Tournament game.

After Coach Brown's retirement following the 1996-97 season, Jones moved to Memphis to serve as Associated Head Coach in 1998 and 1999. Jones was named the interim head coach at Memphis just prior to the 1999-00 season and then spent a year as an assistant coach in the SEC with Alabama (2001). He was named the head coach at North Texas on April 16, 2001, where he stayed until the LSU job became his in April 2012.

JONES FOURTH WINNINGEST LSU HEAD COACH

With the win against North Florida (11/18), Johnny Jones moved into fourth on the all-time coaching win list at LSU (and after the Charleston game now) with 87 wins. The only three coaches above him are the three mentors that combined to coach LSU basketball for 65 of the 109 seasons and took LSU to four NCAA Final Fours.

LAST TIME OUT -- WAKE FOREST 110, LSU 76, (DEC. 22, WINSTON-SALEM)

The Tigers fell behind 10-0 at Wake Forest, was able to get back to within one with less than five minutes to go in the half, but never could get the lead in a game that turned into a shooting clinic for the Demon Deacons in the second half.

LSU trailed, 43-38, at halftime but Wake shot 73.5 percent (25-of-34) and 11-of-14 from the arc in the final 20 minutes to score 67 second-half points in the win. Also LSU committed 16 turnovers and that was leading to 25 points off turnovers by Wake.

Antonio Blakeney had his fifth 20-point game of the season with 21 points on 7-of-14 shooting, while Craig Victor II had 14 points and Duop Reath 12.

LSU shot 40 percent for the game (24-of-60) and 4-of-14 from the arc.

TIGERS GO 7-0 AT MARAVICH CENTER IN NON-CONFERENCE

Monday's win completed LSU's home non-conference schedule at 7-0, the third time in Johnny Jones five seasons that they Tigers have won all their non-conference home games ... Jones and the Tigers are 36-3 in the five seasons he has been the LSU head coach ... The Tigers lost to Rhode Island in Jan. 2014 and this past season lost to Wake Forest in Dec. 2015 and No. 1 Oklahoma in Jan. 2016.

LSU is on a nine-game home winning streak dating back to the final two SEC games of the 2015-16 season against Florida and Mizzou. In the calendar year of 2016, the Tigers are 15-2 at home.

The Tigers have played well in the seven home games, averaging 80.6 points a game, giving up 68.0, while shooting 49.8 percent overall and 39.3 percent from the arc. Opponents in the Maravich Center have shot 40.8 percent and just 26.3 percent from the arc. LSU has made 49 more field goals and eight more treys.

A DECEMBER LEAGUE OPENING

The Southeastern Conference has a December opening night for the first time since a conference game was played on Dec. 19, 1991 ... Ten teams that are involved in the late January SEC/Big 12 Challenge will open play on Thursday night in the playing date set before the entire league begins play on Jan. 3-4. The Saturday playing date was passed on to avoid New Year's Eve and the College Football Playoff semifinals that day.

So for the 10 teams this will be the first game coming off the Christmas break.

LSU's last SEC December game came way back on Dec. 10, 1988 when a young freshman named Chris Jackson (Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf) went off for 53 points in LSU's 111-101 win at Florida.

LSU is 45-37 in SEC opening night games with a 90-82 win last year in the opener at Vanderbilt. This will be LSU's first SEC home opener since the 2013-14 season when LSU lost to Tennessee.

THE GAME TONIGHT – VANDERBILT (8 PM CT, ESPNU)

Four of the last six games in this series including the last three in this series have been played in Nashville ... The last of two meetings in 2014 came in Memorial Gym and LSU returned there for the only meetings in 2015 and 2016.

But Vanderbilt leads the series, 60-53, with LSU a 31-19 advantage in games in Baton Rouge ... There have been a couple of streaks in the recent times in the series as LSU has won the last five meetings, but before that the Commodores won seven straight games in the period from 2007-2012.

Vanderbilt fell at Dayton, 68-63, in its last game on Dec. 21 as Matthew Fisher-Davis had 25 points (9-18 FG, 5 treys) and Nolan Cressler had 11. Vandy shot 35.4 percent from the field (23-of-65), but just 9-of-31 from the arc.

VANDY COACH BRYCE DREW

First-year Vanderbilt Coach Bryce Drew may not remember much of his time here but he was born in Baton Rouge on Sept. 21, 1974 as his dad, Homer Drew, was serving on the staff of Coach Dale Brown at LSU at that time.

Homer Drew was with Coach Brown for his first four seasons at LSU (1972-76) before beginning his head coaching career at Bethel.

Bryce Drew is in his sixth year as head coach after five years at Valparaiso with 129 victories.

MORE ON THE STARTS

LSU has been able to get off to good starts the last two home games, building a 10-point halftime advantage against Texas Southern (12/17) and Charleston (12/19) before coming back to the opposition in both games. LSU was down five in the second half to Texas Southern before winning 88-80 and then was tied with Charleston with 1:48 to play before scoring the game's final points.

For a while, LSU was struggling getting out of the box, most notably when LSU was down 13 twice in the first half against NCCU (12/13) after a 14-day exam break. But it is a trend for this Tiger team in the early going.

Against Wofford (11/15) – LSU down 9, 2:49 to play in the first half ... Tigers won, 91-69.

Against Old Dominion (11/23) – LSU down 6, 10:36 to play second half ... Tigers won, 66-60.

Against Houston (11/29) – LSU down 4, 4:28 to play in the first half ... Tigers won, 84-65.

Against NCCU (12/13) – LSU down 13, 12:54 to play in the first half ... Tigers won, 70-66.

FREE THROWS AREN'T ALWAYS FREE

So what a difference a month makes? In seven November games, LSU was 79-of-127 at the free throw line or 62.2 percent. Now in three December games, the Tigers are 57-of-81 or 70.3 percent.

The November stats includes a 17-of-21 performance in the opener, but four games of 56 percent or less. Even December's better numbers started off with a 5-of-11 versus NCCU (12/13). Brandon Sampson leads the regulars at 70.6 percent (24-34), while Skylar Mays is 11-of-16 (68.8%) ... Duop Reath, Antonio Blakeney and Craig Victor II are all at 66.7%

BLAKENEY 5 GAMES 20-PLUS AT HOME

Antonio Blakeney posted 20-plus point games in four starts for the Tigers at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center – 26 vs. Southern Miss (11/15); 20 vs. N. Florida (11/18); 23 vs. Houston (11/29); and, 27 vs. NCCU (12/13) – and added another on the road at Wake Forest (12/22), 21 points.

Twice this year already and twice as a freshman, Blakeney has posted games of 25 or more points for LSU. He is tied for second at LSU in games of 25 points or more since the start of the 2010-11 season:

Blakeney has 13 games of 20 or more points in his career. Blakeney is averaging 33.0 minutes per game, second in the SEC. He is now averaging 16.4 points per game and is ranked 5th in the SEC in scoring.

The LSU sophomore is 26-of-48 in the last four games from the field.

50 PERCENT FROM THE FIELD

LSU shot 50 percent or better for the fifth time in a game this year, hitting 29-of-58 shots against Charleston (12/19). LSU is 5-0 in the games in which its final field goal percentage was 50 percent or better.

In the 11 games, LSU has shot 50 percent or better in nine different halves ... The Tigers best shooting half this year was the 60.8% from the field in the Bahamas against ODU (11/24) ... LSU is 36-2 in the Jones era when shooting 50 percent for more for the game.

CRAIG VICTOR II

Junior Craig Victor II, after missing the exhibition game and the first three regular season games because of a "team rules" situation, saw action off the bench in all three games in the "Battle 4 Atlantis" before moving into the starting lineup against Houston (11/29).

Since moving into the starting lineup, his scoring average has gone from 5.7 to 10.5 in the last five games and his rebound average from 4.0 to 7.6.

In those five starts he has totaled a combined 49 rebounds in increments of 9, 11, 10, 10 and 9. Included in that was back-to-back double doubles with 14 points and 10 rebounds against Texas Southern (12/19) and 18 points and 10 rebounds against Charleston (12/22). Of his 49 rebounds, 18 of those are offensive boards.

In the last three games the New Orleans native is 16-of-32 from the field. For the season, he is averaging 10.5 points and 7.6 rebounds.

Victor averaged 11.5 points a game last year, starting 24-of-the-25 games he played in last year after becoming eligible following a transfer year after starting NCAA eligibility at Arizona. The New Orleans native was second on the team in rebound average a year ago at 5.6 boards a game. Victor shot 45.4 percent from the floor (108-238).

DUOP REATH BACK IN DOUBLE FIGURES

He got two fouls early in the Wake Forest game (12/22), but was able to get his fourth consecutive double figure scoring game, now 10-of-the-11-games played ... From the field in the last four games:

NCCU: 7-of-9 FG; TSU: 9-14 FG; CofC: 10-16 FG; WF: 4-10 FG

In the four games he shot 30-of-49 from the floor. His 23 points (12/19) against Charleston equaled his season opener against Wofford.

He is averaging 15.0 points per game and 6.2 rebounds along with 1.9 blocks a game. Reath is shooting 57.5 percent for the season (69-of-120) and that is third in the Southeastern Conference.

The big man from Perth made it a good debut on Nov. 12 as he became the sixth LSU player in the Johnny Jones era to post a game of 20 points and 10 rebounds in Saturday's 91-69 win over Wofford ... Reath posted 23 points on 9-of-13 shooting (5-7 FT) and 14 rebounds ... The other players who have had at least one 20-10 game in their careers during the Coach Jones era and the number of times accomplished:

Reath posted a second double double in the Atlantis win over Old Dominion (11/24) with 16 points and 10 rebounds.

TIGERS HAVE LOCAL CONNECTION STRONG AGAIN

The Tigers have a Baton Rouge connection working again this season with scholarship players sophomore Brandon Sampson and freshmen Skylar Mays and Wayde Sims joined by walk-on Reed Vial hailing from Baton Rouge. Another walk-on, Marshall Graves, prepped in Baton Rouge (at U-High) but is from Ponchatoula, Louisiana.

In all, the 15-player LSU roster has nine players from the state of Louisiana.

SKYLAR MAYS

Baton Rouge's Skylar Mays made the most of his first start at point guard for the Tigers in the Wofford game (11/12), scoring 10 points with six assists and no turnovers. Mays was 5-of-9 from the field and played 23 minutes with two steals. He did not score against Southern Miss (11/15), but for the second straight game he had six assists in 20 minutes of play.

Mays started the first four games of the season, but played 42 combined minutes in the ODU and VCU games (11/24, 11/25) scoring 20 points, including 14 on 5-of-7 shooting in the VCU contest.

Mays did the job for the Tigers off the bench against UH (11/29) and while he admitted he would have rather been "1-for" rather than not making a field goal attempt (0-4). But he did have 11 assists in the game and just one turnover in 23 minutes.

Mays 11 assists in the win over Houston was the most by an LSU player in the Johnny Jones era as head coach and he became the fifth player in that time span to record 10 or more assists joining Ben Simmons, Tim Quarterman, Josh Grady and Charles Carmouche.

For the season, Mays is averaging 4.9 points and 4.0 assists per game, eighth in SEC stats.

Mays played at University High in Baton Rouge before transferring to Findlay Prep for his senior season.

JALYN PATTERSON ALSO CONTRIBUTING AT THE POINT

Junior Jalyn Patterson, who has been featured primarily at the off-guard position during his first two years and who will continue to be featured at the position this season, moved into the starting lineup for three games.

Patterson scored just one point against UNF (11/18) after back-to-back 7-point games, but Patterson had a career high eight assists in the game.

Patterson had seven assists in the VCU game, but has also shown a guard's rebounding mentality with nine boards against Wichita State (11/23) and seven in the ODU win (11/24).

After his first double figure scoring game against Texas Southern (12/17) of 12 points to go with four assists and three steals, Patterson is now averaging 4.8 points per game, 4.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.

BRANDON SAMPSON WANTS TO BE BETTER

Those who traveled or watched the five game exhibition tour to Australia in August 2015, saw what Brandon Sampson was capable of as he averaged double figures and was shooting from the FIBA international three-point line without problem. But it never quite transferred to the last regular season as little nagging injuries slowed him at

times and the Madison Prep (Baton Rouge) star averaged just 4.0 points in 13.2 minutes per game.

But this year, Sampson is averaging 29.5 minutes per game, 12.1 points and 3.3 rebounds. He is 48-of-94 from the field (51.1%) after shooting just 32.1 percent as a freshman. In fact there are some categories in 10 games that are already past all of last year's numbers:

Sampson has seven games in double figures this year, but his most impressive by far was the 30 minutes in the Old Dominion (11/24) win when he hit 7-of-10 field goals with a trey and helped seal the game as part of his 9-of-9 effort at the free throw line. It all added up to a career high of 24 points, topping the 18 he had a year ago twice with one of those coming in a neutral site tournament in Brooklyn.

Against Charleston (12/19), he posted his second 20-point game, hitting 8-of-12 field goal attempts.

REATH, HAYWARD GETTING NOTICED IN HOME COUNTRY

With both Duop Reath and Kieran Hayward coming from Australia, basketball twitter sites in that country have been keeping an eye on these two and giving both of them some notice down there. Again this year, several LSU games are aired (with the time change) as mid-day affairs on the ESPN Australia/New Zealand network.

Reath hails from Perth, moving there as a youngster from South Sudan, an area his family was forced to leave to avoid the civil war in that country. Hayward is a freshman from Sydney who had some of the three-point shooting range and lack of fear when shooting of a guy who was very successful for a couple of years here from the arc, Keith Hornsby.

HAYWARD GETTING MORE PLAYING TIME

After not seeing any playing time in a game against Houston (11/29), the freshman Kieran Hayward has been able to find his mark, playing 46 minutes in the last four games ... He played a season tying high of 17 minutes against Texas Southern (12/17), scoring 8 points on 3-of-4 shooting that included two treys with three rebounds. He is averaging 10.4 minutes a game and 1.7 points.

WAYDE SIMS WITH SOME GOOD EFFORTS, FOLLOWING IN DAD'S FOOTSTEPS

Dad and former LSU player Wayne Sims had to be smiling as his son, Wayde, has had a good start, averaging 14.9 minutes off the bench in the first 10 contests.

In the opening contest against Wofford (11/12). Sims came off the bench to score 13 points, hitting 5-of-7 field goals including 2 treys in 24 minutes of play. He added 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting in 23 minutes in the Southern Miss game (11/15).

Sims, averaging 4.6 points and 2.7 rebounds per game through the first 11 contests, also was a multi-time state title holder at University High in Baton Rouge.

Dad Wayne Sims played for LSU from 1987-91 under Coach Dale Brown and an assistant coach named Johnny Jones. Wayne Sims is No. 33 on the school scoring list with 1,107 points, topped by a 13.3 scoring average his sophomore year (1988-89). He is also 26th on the school rebound list with 603 boards. The elder Sims is one of 22 players to have 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds.

The Sims join such family combos as Geert and Shane Hammink, Pete and Josh Maravich, Collis Jr. and Collis III and Garrett Temple, and, Rick and Paul Wolfert to name some.

AARON EPPS STILL CONTRIBUTING

He hasn't played as much with the success of Craig Victor II (and an ankle injury that limited him to three minutes and a DNP), but Aaron Epps was a big contributor for the Tigers before Victor returned to playing. Epps had 17 against Wofford, 14 versus North Florida and 11 against VCU this season and is averaging 15.6 minutes per game, 6.3 points and 4.4 rebounds. He is 7-of-13 from the arc this year, showing his versatility and range on the court.

SO HOW YOUTHFUL IS THIS ROSTER?

Last year, Kenpom.com had LSU's level experience as the 320th of the 351 Division I teams. Kenpom.com ranks LSU's experience at 1.09 or No. 328 in experience on the chart. Four other SEC teams have lower experience rankings than LSU.

FAST PACE, POSSESSIONS

The Tigers have been known under Coach Jones as a fast-paced offensive squad and have averaged over 70 possessions a game throughout the first four years, including 74-plus a season ago.

Through 11 games, the Tigers are averaging 74.4 possessions a game ... LSU's official number was 74.7 last year.

TWO-POINTERS GOOD

When you take the Tigers 63-of-191 from three-point range out of LSU's field goal percentage, the Tigers are 251-of-482 from two-point range or 52.1 percent ... A total of 141 teams are shooting 50 percent or better on two-point attempts ... According to TEAMrankings.com, LSU is averaging 45.6 points from two-point range, 14th in Division I; and just 17.2 points from the arc (No. 303 in the country) ... According to TEAMrankings, LSU is getting the nation's fourth best 60.7 percent of its points from two-point field goals, up from 54.7 percent a year ago.

RECORD YEAR FOR TIGERS IN NBA

The Tigers opened the 2016-17 NBA season with a record eight players on NBA rosters:
