# HEAD COACH STEPHANIE WHITE

## Stephanie **WHITE**

Head Coach / First Season



Stephanie White was named the head coach for Vanderbilt women's basketball program on May 24, becoming just the fifth all-time head coach in the history of the Vanderbilt program.

Having enjoyed success at virtually every level of basketball as a player and coach, White arrived at Vanderbilt after spending two seasons as the head coach of WNBA's Indiana Fever. White took the Fever to the playoffs in each of her two seasons, including a trip to the WNBA finals in 2015.

"The opportunity to lead Vanderbilt's women's basketball program is an opportunity that I simply could not pass up," White said. "The combination of Vanderbilt's culture, where achievement -- both on and off the court - is so highly valued, together with the institution's fan support, and a legacy of winning basketball to build upon, is incredibly exciting to me. I appreciate the support and understanding that I have received from the Indiana Fever, from management to the players, regarding my passion to coach college basketball at an elite institution."

White -- who played five seasons in the WNBA after a decorated playing career at Purdue -- was named head coach for the Fever in September 2014. In 2015, she guided the Fever to the WNBA finals, becoming the first rookie coach in league history to lead a team to the finals.

"Above all else, academics, research, scholarship, and service define the Vanderbilt experience, yet we also compete at the highest levels in athletics," Vanderbilt Chancellor Nicholas S. Zeppos said in announcing White. "Coach White's values align perfectly with those in our university community. I welcome Stephanie to Vanderbilt and look forward to working with her as she leads our women's basketball program to fulfill our goals and highest potential."

As a collegiate player, White enjoyed a highly successful career at Purdue, where she earned national Player of the Year honors after helping lead the Boilermakers to the 1999 NCAA championship as a senior. That season, she also received the Wade Trophy (given to the nation's top female player) and was named Big Ten Conference Player of the Year.

"Stephanie White has been a winner in every phase of her career," Vanderbilt athletic director David Williams said. "She was the nation's high school player of the year, she was the NCAA's Player of the Year on a national championship team and she led her WNBA team into the finals in her first year. She was an outstanding scholar. She wants to coach at Vanderbilt and we believe she is just the person to lead our program back into national prominence."

White averaged double-figure scoring in all four seasons of her college career, including 20.2 points per game as a senior. White was inducted into the Purdue Athletics Hall of Fame on April 21, 2006.

She was also a star in the classroom at Purdue. She was a member of Phi Beta Kappa and was an Academic All-American.

White was an assistant coach with the Chicago Sky from 2007-2010, then joined the Fever staff as an assistant in 2011. She was promoted to associate head coach in 2014 before being named head coach after Lin Dunn's retirement. While coaching in the WNBA, White served as a college basketball analyst for ESPN and the Big Ten Network. She also covered the NBA's Indiana Pacers for FOX Sports Indiana.

Prior to coaching in the WNBA, White coached in the college ranks, serving as an assistant at Toledo (2005-07), Kansas State (2004-05) and Ball State (2003-04).

Before beginning her coaching career, White enjoyed a productive five-year WNBA career, spending one season with the Charlotte Sting and four with the Indiana Fever, before retiring in 2004.

At the completion of her four seasons with the Fever, she ranked third in games played (112) and 3-pointers (92), and fourth in scoring (684). She was named to the Fever's All-Decade Team that was announced in 2009.

White and her wife, Michelle, have three boys: Landon, age 5, and twins, Aiden & Avery, age 2.

## THE LOWDOWN ON TODAY'S GAME

On the strength of a nine-game winning streak, the Vanderbilt women are beginning to create some national attention. This week, they'll have a chance to get much more of it.

The Commodores (10-1) -- who have received votes in the AP Poll in each of the past three weeks -- are hosting No. 8-ranked Louisville tonight at 7 p.m. The Cardinals (11-2) will be the highest-ranked opponent to come to Memorial Gym since Jan. 7, 2016, when No. 2-ranked South Carolina held off the Commodores, 71-61.

## UPDATE ON THE 'DORES

The Commodores enter today's game with hopes of extending their winning streak to 10 games. It would be only the fourth time since 2000-01 that Vanderbilt has won 10 straight games.

Vanderbilt's winning streak has spanned well over a month, dating back to a 94-61 loss at Indiana on Nov. 13.

The Commodores, who are 6-0 at home this season, are led in scoring by a trio of double-digit scorers: Christa Reed is averaging a team-high 12.7 points per game, Rachel Bell is averaging 12.1 and Rebekah Dahlman is averaging 11.1. . . . Marqu'es Webb is Vanderbilt's top rebounder, and ranks among the SEC's best, with 9.3 boards per game.

## WHAT'S TRENDING

Here's a look at what's trending for Vanderbilt through the first 11 games of the season:

- ◆ The Commodores lead the SEC and rank sixth in the nation in 3-point accuracy at 41.7 percent.
- ◆ Vanderbilt is second in the SEC and 10th in the nation in free throw percentage (78.4).
- ◆ VU ranks fourth in the conference and 38th in the nation in scoring, averaging 76.5 points per game.
- ◆ Vanderbilt leads the SEC in 3-pointers made per game (8.0) and total 3-pointers made (88).
- ◆ VU ranks fourth in the SEC and 12th in the country in free throws made.
- ◆ For the season, Vanderbilt has converted 182 free throws, which is almost as many free throws as their opponents have attempted (188) (Note: Conference and national rankings in "What's trending" are through Tuesday afternoon).

## IN ELITE COMPANY

Redshirt junior guard Rebekah Dahlman leads the SEC and ranks 16th in the country in free throw percentage at 91.7 percent. She also ranks 14th in the SEC at 3.4 assists per game.

Senior post player Marqu'es Webb ranks fourth in the conference in rebounding at 9.3 per game.

Cierra Walker and Dahlman rank sixth and seventh, respectively, in the SEC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.3 and 2.2.

## MAD SUCCESS AT MEMORIAL

Coming into today's game, the Commodores have won 16 straight non-conference games on their home floor, dating back to a loss to Dayton on Dec. 21, 2014. Vanderbilt has gone 46-2 against non-conference foes on its home floor since the start of the 2010-11 season.

## SUPER SUBS

The Commodores are getting plenty of production off the bench thus far this season. That's been especially true in the past three games, when the Vanderbilt reserves have outscored the opponents' bench by a combined total of 103-43 (including 30-4 against ETSU, 23-4 against Tulane and 50-35 against Tennessee Tech). For the season, VU's bench has outscored the opponents' bench in nine of the first 11 games..

## DANDY IN DECEMBER

By winning their first six games this month, the Commodores have extended their tradition of December success. They've won 13 straight December games -- dating back to a loss to Dayton on Dec. 21, 2014 -- and have posted a 30-3 record in December since 2011.

## ON THE RADAR

The Commodores have been among the teams receiving votes in the Associated Press Top-25 poll in each of the past three weeks. It is the first time since the preseason poll of the 2015-16 season that Vanderbilt has been in the "receiving votes" category. Vanderbilt was last ranked in the AP poll in Week 15 of the 2013-14 season, when the Commodores were ranked No. 16.

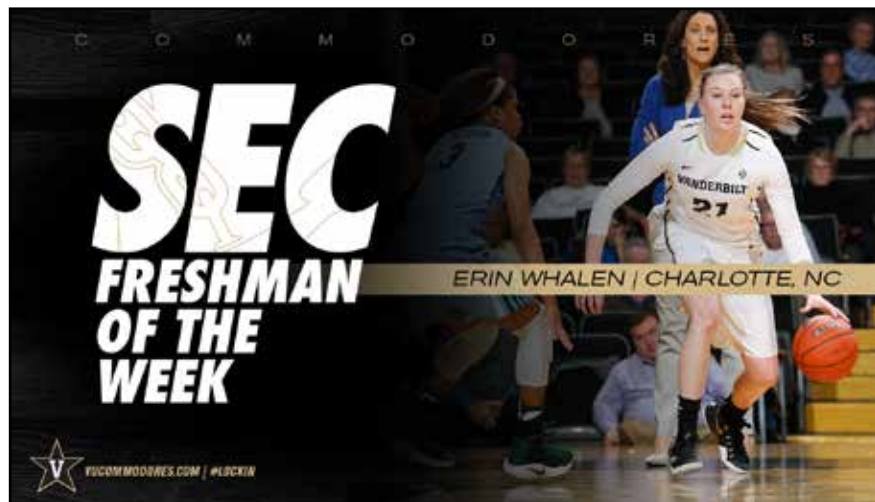
## MILESTONE FOR MARQU'ES

Senior post player Marqu'es Webb notched her 500th career rebound in the first quarter of Vanderbilt's win against Air Force on Dec. 2. . . . Webb ranks seventh among active SEC players in career rebounds with 542 (through Tuesday).

## MARQU'ES WEBB: A LEADER AMONG HER PEERS

After serving as a representative for Vanderbilt at the SEC's first-ever Leadership Council, senior Marqu'ès Webb was chosen by her peers to be the chair of the group. Her duties as chair will include participating in conference calls with the league office during the year, attending a portion of the Senior Women's Administrator's meeting during the 2017 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament and potentially attending the SEC Spring Meetings in Destin, Fla., this summer.

## THIS AND THAT

Here are a few notes and numbers to keep an eye on as the Commodores enter today's game:

◆ Vanderbilt has three players who rank among the SEC's Top-10 in career 3-pointers among active players: Rebekah Dahlman ranks sixth with 116, Christa Reed ranks ninth with 90, and Rachel Bell is 10th with 86.

◆ The Commodores finished November with a 5-1 record, marking the first time since the 2011 that Vanderbilt emerged from November with less than two losses.

◆ The Commodores made 14 3-pointers against Kennesaw State in the season opener (finishing 14-of-26), which represents the most 3-pointers by an SEC team in a game this season.

## FRESH AND RE-FRESH

Vanderbilt has captured SEC Freshman of the Week honors twice this month, with Erin Whalen and Kayla Overbeck each winning the honor. Overbeck was given the award on Dec. 13 after scoring 18 points and pulling down

13 rebounds -- establishing new career highs in both categories -- during Vanderbilt's 80-72 road win over ETSU. Overbeck went 8-of-9 from the foul line while notching her first career double-double. Whalen was named the SEC Freshman of the Week the previous week after averaging 17 points per game and shooting 59 percent from the floor -- making 16-of-27 shots -- during Vanderbilt's wins over Air Force, SIUE and Tulane.

## DANCY WITH THE STARS

Junior guard Myka Dancy played a significant role in Vanderbilt's win over SIUE on Dec. 3. Dancy played a career-high 13 minutes in the victory and scored a career-high five points. She was in the starting lineup to open the second half, and played the entire third quarter. Dancy finished 2-of-5 from the floor and also added a free throw.

## LOOKING AHEAD

After Wednesday's game, the Commodores are idle until Dec. 28, when they visit Memphis.

## TODAY'S MATCHUP: VANDERBILT (10-1) vs. LOUISVILLE (11-2)



### SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

◆ The Cardinals, members of the Atlantic Coast Conference, come into Wednesday's game on a five-game winning streak that started with a 69-67 overtime victory against rival Kentucky on Dec. 4.

◆ Louisville ranks second in the nation in total assists, 10th in assists per game (19.2), fifth in total rebounds (550), and eighth in turnover margin.

◆ The Cardinals have three double-digit scorers, led by Asia Durr at 17.4 points per game. Myisha Hines-Allen is averaging 11.2 points per game and Mariya Moore is averaging 11.2.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Wednesday's game is the 13th all-time meeting between the teams, with Vanderbilt owning an 8-4 lead in the series.
- The most recent matchup between the teams came during the 2011 NCAA Tournament, when Louisville beat Vanderbilt 81-62 in Cincinnati.
- Vanderbilt has won five straight against Louisville in Nashville, with the most recent meeting coming during the 2005-06 season, when the Commodores posted a 76-64 victory at Memorial Gym.

Paced by Monique Reid's game-high 22 points!, the Cardinals beat Vanderbilt 81-62 in the first round of the 2011 NCAA Tournament. Jasmine Lister scored a team-high 13 points for Vanderbilt.

Louisville shot 60 percent from the field and went 13 of 14 from the free-throw line in the victory. The Commodores used a 12-0 run in the second half to pull within 49-42 with 12 minutes to go, but the Cardinals answered with a 13-0 run to build a 62-42 with 8:11 left..

## Commodores zoom to ninth consecutive victory

*Vanderbilt outscores Tennessee Tech 28-6 in the second quarter while extending win streak*

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Christa Reed scored 25 points, Erin Whalen added 23 and LeaLea Carter had 18 -- new career highs for all three -- to help the Commodores extend their winning streak to nine games with an 89-57 victory over Tennessee Tech at Memorial Gym.

Whalen also pulled down a career-best 11 rebounds for Vanderbilt (10-1). Yaktavia Hickson led all scorers with 31 points for Tennessee Tech (3-8).

The Commodores played much of the second half without senior star Marquès Webb, who was taken off the floor on a stretcher after a collision.

Vanderbilt owned a 17-16 lead after the first quarter, but then dominated the next 10 minutes, outscoring Tennessee Tech 28-6 to carry a 45-22 lead into the half.

The Commodores -- who were playing their first game since Dec. 8 -- opened the second quarter with a 15-2 run and finished 9-of-15 from the floor and 9-of-10 from the foul line during the period.

Vanderbilt, which came into the game as the SEC leaders in 3-point percentage and ranked No. 2 in the conference in free throw percentage, went 18-of-21 from the foul line (85.7 percent) and 7-of-19 (36.8 percent) from 3-point range in the win.

The game was a homecoming for Tennessee Tech first-year head coach Kim Rosamond, who was an assistant coach at Vanderbilt for nine years.

Reed scored her 25 points while going 10-of-12 from the floor. She also pulled down six rebounds. Carter, a freshman, was 8-of-12 from the floor and had seven rebounds. Carter's 18 points easily surpassed her previous season high of seven.
