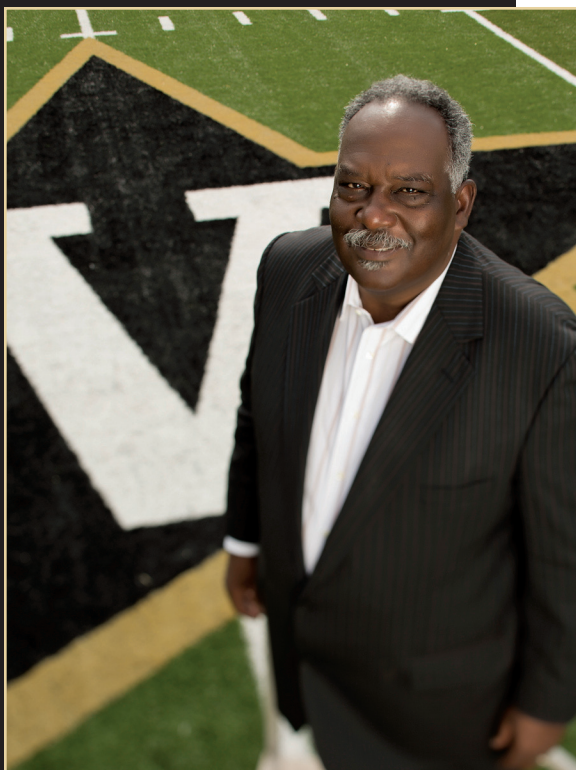


**A football seating

As we begin to prepare for the 2013 season, I would like to make you aware of some seating changes at Vanderbilt Stadium. The ticket renewal process for football seats in our current National Commodore Club sections will require an increased NCC donation in addition to purchasing the season tickets. Also, additional seats will be designated as NCC seats for this upcoming season.

Some seats on the home side of the field and all seats on the visitor side of the field will not require an NCC donation for this upcoming season. Moving forward, more sections in Vanderbilt Stadium may be designated as NCC sections. You can learn about NCC membership benefits, specifically priority seating and parking, by referring to the NCC information sheet.

Major improvements—from the video board to the artificial surface—have already been made to Vanderbilt Stadium. More improvements to the stadium, including those to enhance the fan experience, are on the horizon, and we hope to share those with you soon. We have retained the finest coaching staff in America, and Vanderbilt is fully committed to the continued success of our football program.

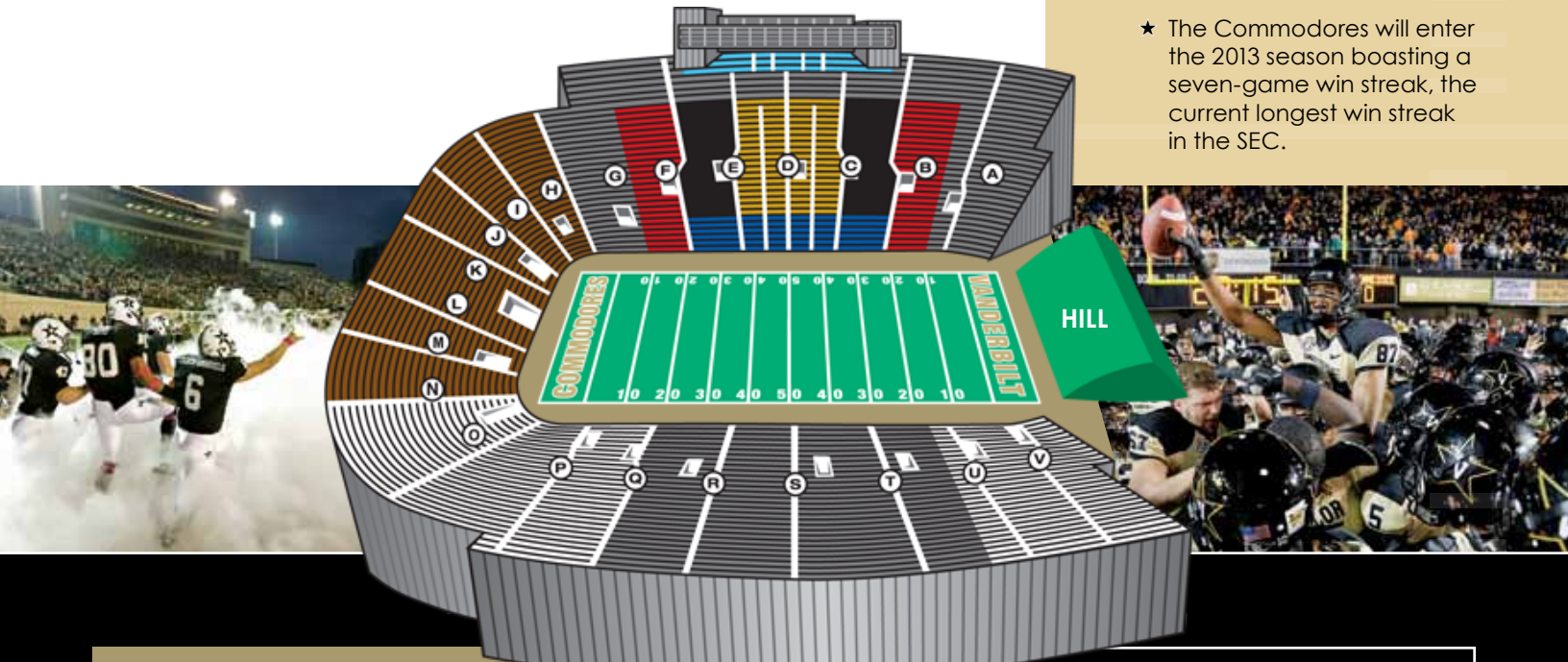

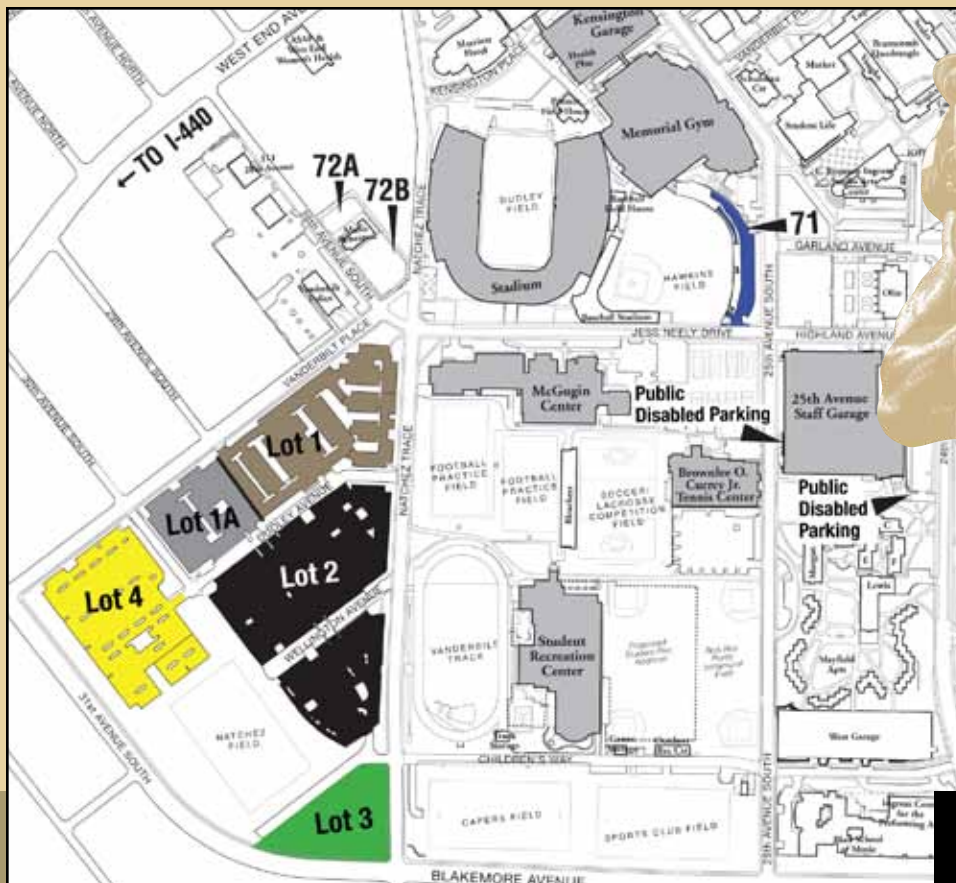
Vanderbilt Athletics requires an annual donation per seat through the National Commodore Club for specific seats in addition to the season ticket price.
