#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Nicholls opens its 54th season of basketball against Vanderbilt on Saturday
- The Colonels open up with an SEC opponent for the second consecutive year
- Its the fifth time since 2000 Nicholls has begun the season against the SEC
- The is the third all-time meeting against the Commodores in team history
- The last time the two teams met was Dec. 16, 2006 in Nashville
- In the previous two meetings, Nicholls has been outscored 160-77 and is averaging 38.2 points in the contests
- Nicholls is looking to snap a three-game losing streak dating back to last season
- The last time the Colonels won a season opener was against New Orleans on Nov. 19, 2008
- Nichols returns four starters and nine letterwinners from last year
- Over 58-percent of the team's scoring will return in 2012
- The team sustained three season-ending injuries during the season last year (Lachlan Prest, Pedro Maciel, Trevon Lewis) and shuffled the starting lineup over a dozen times due to other injuries
- Nicholls was picked to finish eighth in the preseason coaches and SID polls
- Redshirt senior Fred Hunter was a preseason second-team all-SLC selection

## VANDERBILT NOTES

• Vanderbilt won its first tournament title since 1951 in winning the SEC last season

• The Commodores' 25 wins last season are the most since 2007-08, and have seven consecutive 20-win seasons.

• VU lost three players to the NBA draft and will have to replace 88-percent of its scoring punch from last season.

• Head coach Kevin Stallings is in his 13th year at Vanderbilt, tying for the second longest tenure in team history. His 261 career wins is second all-time.

• Vanderbilt has an all-time winning percentage of .786 in Memorial Gym, and a .908 percentage against non conference opponents since 1990.

• VU is 8-0 against Southland Conference teams, and the third all-time meeting against Nicholls will tie future member New Orleans for the most against a SLC school.

## Hunter's Return

In the 2012-13 season, Nicholls' all-conference guard Fred Hunter returns for his final year as a Colonel after sitting out all of last season to rehab a knee injury. Hunter has averaged double-digit points every season as a Colonel and has the sixth best field-goal percentage in school history making 53-percent of his shots.

## A Long December

A seven-game road swing in December will have the Colonels on the road the entire month, beginning with Michigan State on Dec. 1. Although the Colonels will stay fairly close with games at New Orleans and Tulane, the team finishes the month at the World Vision Challenge hosted by Utah State from Dec 20-22 and Nebraska on Dec. 29.

## Older and Wiser

Last year the Nicholls men's basketball team had one of the youngest rosters in the nation with seven newcomers and just two players with significant playing time. This season the team returns four of five starters and nine total letterwinners, with over 50-percent of the team's scoring returning.

## Taking Care Of Home

Last year's 6-6 record at home gave the Colonels its seventh-straight season of a .500 or better record in Stopher Gym dating back to the 2005-06 season. Nicholls has not had a losing in Stopher since 2004, and has won at least six or more games in Thibodaux 25 times since 1980.

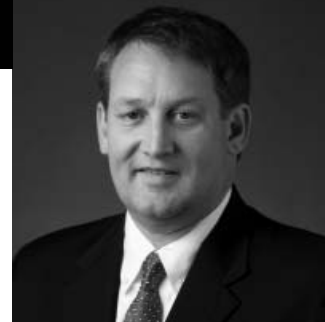
