## First Round Recap:

Vanderbilt Cruises Past PR-Mayaguez in San Jan Shootout Opener; Cage, Byars En Fuego in Victory
San Juan, PUERTO RICO -- Dan Cage tied a career high with 18 points to lead six Commodores in double figures as Vanderbilt cruised past tournament-host Puerto Rico-Mayaguez, 102-59, Tuesday in the first round of the San Juan Shootout at Mario Morales Coliseum.

The victory extended Vanderbilt's win streak to six games.
Cage put Vanderbilt on track early with eight consecutive points, including a layup and two 3-pointers for a 17-6 advantage less than four minutes into the game. The last 3-pointer caught the attention of the local public address announcer who enthusiastically noted that Cage was "En Fuego."

Cage ended the game seven of 11 from the field with four 3-pointers. He tallied 15 of his 18 points in the second half.
"I haven't been shooting the ball well lately, but I got some easy looks early and that helped set the tone for the team," Cage said. "The great thing about this team is we have a lot of unselfish guys and they were working hard to keep getting me open looks at the basket."

Teammate Derrick Byars caught fire in the second stanza with 12 of his 16 points coming after intermission. Like Cage, Byars collected his points early, hitting two jumpers, a break away dunk and a pair of 3-pointers in the first seven minutes of the second half.

Byars finished seven of 12 from the field and also earned "En Fuego" acclaim from the public address announcer during the second half.
"If we want to have the success that we're looking for in this tournament then Dan and Derrick are going to have to play well," Vanderbilt head coach Kevin Stallings said. "I was very pleased with their effort today."

Vanderbilt, who led 52-30 at intermission, started the second half on a $24-8$ run and never led by less than 30 points after the 14minute mark. The Commodores enjoyed as much as a 44 -point lead twice in the game before finishing with their largest margin of victory under Stallings.

Ross Neltner scored 15 points and grabbed seven rebounds. Ted Skuchas was perfect from the field in five attempts in posting 12 points and seven rebounds. Shan Foster had 11. Jermaine Beal added 10.

Mayaguez post player Williset Del Valle led the Bulldogs with a game-high 24 points to go along with seven rebounds.

## Scouting the Opponent: Tennessee Tech (5-4)

Vanderbilt is 12-6 all-time against Tennessee Tech... The Commodores are 11-1 against the Golden Eagles at Memorial Gymnasium in Nashville and 1-5 against Tennessee Tech in Cookeville... The Commodores have won the last four meetings in the series, including a 98-79 victory on Dec. 13, 2003 in Nashville... Today's matchup in San Juan marks the first neutral site meeting in series history... Vanderbilt's Kevin Stallings is 1-0 all-time against Tennessee Tech.

The Golden Eagles edged Northwestern, 66-65, in their first round contest at the San Juan Shootout Tuesday. Belton Rivers hit a 3-point shot with 58 seconds left and finished with 22 points in leading Tennessee Tech. Rivers put TTU ahead by four points with his sixth 3-pointer of the game before the Wildcats closed the scoring on a 3-point basket by Craig Moore with 25 seconds left. The game was tied seven times, and neither team led by more than five points.

Anthony Fisher scored 12 points and had seven assists for Tennessee Tech. Daniel Northern added 10 points.
The Golden Eagles were picked to finish in third place in preseason balloting by head coaches and the league’s Sports Information Directors.

## Against the Ohio Valley Conference:

Vanderbilt is 48-7 (.873) all-time against teams from the Ohio Valley Conference. The Commodores' last game against an OVC opponent came in last season's opener against Jacksonville State, a 67-46 Vanderbilt victory on Nov. 16... Vanderbilt has won 24 consecutive games against teams from the OVC since Tennessee Tech's
89-76 win over the Commodores on Nov. 29, 1989 at Memorial Gymnasium. Kevin Stallings is 11-0 against
the OVC. Stallings is 1-0 against Tennessee Tech.

## More on the PR-Mayaguez Win:

Vanderbilt recorded its largest margin of victory in the Kevin Stallings era ( +43 ) in its 102-59 win against tournament-host Puerto Rico-Mayaguez ... The Commodores forced the Bulldogs into 26 turnovers Tuesday, the most by a Commodore opponent this season. In fact, Vanderbilt has forced each of its last three opponents into more than 20 miscues (Georgia Tech 25, Nicholls State 23) ... Shan Foster (181) was 1-of-3 from 3-point range on Tuesday to move to within three 3-pointers of moving past former Commodore Matt Freije (183) for seventh place on the career list ... Vanderbilt head coach Kevin Stallings needs one win to move into sole possession of third place among the winningest coaches in school history. Stallings is currently tied with C.M. Newton (129) behind Roy Skinner (278) and Bob Polk (197) ... Vanderbilt extended its streak of most consecutive games with a made 3-pointer to 640 games.
