## GAMEDAY STORYLINES

- After an eight-day break between games, Troy returns to the court on Thursday at Vanderbilt. The Trojans are coming off of a 104-51 win over Nicholls at home last Tuesday. Troy is 3-0 at home this season, but 0-2 on the road with close losses to Samford and Belmont, who are a combined 13-4 on the season.
- The Trojans come into Memorial Gym with the nation's top scoring offense at 97.4 points per game, over 7.0 points more than second place UConn (90.2). Troy, in its fourth season under head coach Chanda Rigby, has led the Sun Belt in scoring in every season under Rigby.
- However, it's Troy's defense that made headlines in last week's 104-51 win over Nicholls. The Trojans held the Colonels to 25 percent shooting and forced them into 35 turnovers. Troy is forcing opponents into an average of 26.8 turnovers per game and grabbing 14.0 steals per game, both marks that rank second in the NCAA.
- Individually, Ashley Beverly Kelley leads the Trojans in scoring at 21.0 points per game, tops in the Sun Belt and 19th best in the NCAA. The senior Mid-Major All-American has scored in double figures in every game this season and in 19 straight dating back to last season.
- Beverly Kelley is second in the Sun Belt in assists and assist-turnover ratio to her teammate, Amanda Mendoza. The sophomore is averaging 6.6 assists and has a 4.1 assist-turnover ratio, good for 14th and sixth in the NCAA, respectively.
- Junior forward Caitlyn Ramirez is Troy's second leading scorer at 14.4 points per game. She enters Thursday's game as the NCAA's leader in field goal percentage at 69.0 percent on the season.
- Vanderbilt comes in having won six straight games overall and with a 6-0 record at Memorial Gym this season. The Commodores rank 13th in the NCAA giving up just 51.4 points per game.
- Troy is 0-2 all-time against Vanderbilt, but hasn't played the Commodores since 2005.

## SCOUTING THE COMMODORES

- Vanderbilt comes into Thursday's game having won six straight games, including a 65-39 win at home over ETSU on Saturday. The Commodores only two losses of the season came on the road against quality mid-major teams in Dayton and Green Bay. Vanderbilt is 6-0 at Memorial Gym this season.
- On Saturday against ETSU, the Commodores shot 62 percent in the second half and pulled ahead after leading, 25-15, at halftime.
- Vanderbilt has one of the top-20 scoring defenses in the nation, holding opponents to 51.4 per game. Outside of Dayton (81), the Commodores have held every opponent under 60 points this season.

## TROJAN NOTES

## TROY AGAIN TOPS IN SCORING

- Troy finds itself in a familiar place, leading the Sun Belt in scoring. After finishing the last three seasons as the Sun Belt's top scoring team, Troy is once again in first it is scoring at 97.4 points per game this season.
- Troy's 97.4 points per game also currently ranks as the best scoring average in all of the NCAA, over 7.0 points ahead of second place UConn (90.2).
- Troy has led the Sun Belt in scoring in every season under Chanda Rigby. In those threeplus seasons, the Trojans have scored 80 -plus points in 41 games and 100-plus nine times.


## TROY SUN BELT'S TOP SHOOTERS

- Troy is shooting 50.5 percent from the floor this season, the best mark in the Sun Belt and the fifth best in the NCAA.
- Troy has four players in the Sun Belt top 10 in FG percentage. Caitlyn Ramirez (69.0, 1st), Amahni Upshaw (64.0, 2nd), Amanda Mendoza (55.2, 5th) and Ashley Beverly Kelley ( $52.5,8$ th) all rank in the league's top 10.
- Troy also ranks first in the Sun Belt in 3-point percentage (37.6) with Amanda Mendoza leading the way at 57.9 percent (11-of-19).
- The Trojans also have the top free throw percentage (73.7) in the conference with Ashley Beverly Kelley leading the way at 92.9 percent (13-of-14).


## ABK ON TRACK EARLY

- Through just five games Ashley Beverly Kelley seems to be right back where she left off last season, scoring lots of points.
- The senior is averaging 21.0 points per game, the best mark in the Sun Belt and 19th best in the NCAA.
- She has scored in double figures in 19 straight games while her 1,421 are the most among active Sun Belt players.
- The Mid-Major All-American ranks first in the Sun Belt in free throw percentage (92.9) and second in assists ( $4.6 / \mathrm{g}$ ) and assistturnover ratio (2.6).


## BEVERLY KELLEY A TROY GREAT

- Ashley Beverly Kelley has already been one of the best in Troy history. She is a two-time All-Sun Belt selection and was also a MidMajor All-American following last season.
- Her 1,421 career points are already the ninth most in Troy history and just 65 away from moving into eighth place.
- The Adamsville, Ala., native ranks in the top 10 in Troy history in career 3-pointers (120), free throws (287), free throw percentage
(.822) and steals (197). A full list of her career rankings can be found on page 11.
- Beverly Kelley has played in 97 consecutive games (every game of her career). She is the only Trojan to play in every game that Chanda Rigby has coached.
- Last season Beverly Kelley ranked second in the Sun Belt in scoring (17.6 ppg), fifth in steals (2.3) and ninth in assists (2.8). She was one of just two in top 10 in all three.
- In addition, Beverly Kelley scored 19.8 points per Sun Belt game, the best mark in the league.


## GOOD WORKS NOMINEE

- Ashley Beverly Kelley was announced as one of 71 Division I nominees for the 2016 Allstate WBCA Good Works Team. She is the only nominee from a Sun Belt team.
- The award is a distinguished award that shines a spotlight on a select group of student-athletes who have shown dedication to service in their communities.
- From the nominations, a special voting panel, headlined by former Tennessee basketball athlete, NCAA champion and WNBA legend Tamika Catchings, will select a 10-member team comprised of five studentathletes from the NCAA Division I level and five student-athletes from Divisions II, III and the NAIA.
- Beverly Kelley is a leader in the Troy community, using her platform as a Sun Belt star to give back to the youth of the community.
- If she's not honing her own skills or studying for a degree in Exercise Science, Beverly Kelley can usually be found at the Troy Recreational Center tutoring kids.


## RAMIREZ NATION'S TOP SHOOTER

- Junior forward Caitlyn Ramirez is proving her worth as a Preseason All-Sun Belt selection. The Shawnee, Okla., native is averaging 14.4 points per game and leading the nation in field goal percentage.
- Ramirez is shooting 69.0 percent (29-of-42) on the season, the best mark in the NCAA and Sun Belt.
- Ramirez is also shooting 50.0 percent (5-of10) from 3-point range, the third best mark in the Sun Belt.
- She is one of two Trojans (Beverly Kelley) to score in double figures in every game this season. Ramirez's 14.4 points per game scoring average ranks seventh in the Sun Belt.


## MENDOZA DROPPING 3s / DIMES

- Sophomore guard Amanda Mendoza enters Thursday as the Sun Belt's assist leader at 6.6 per game, ranking 14th in the NCAA.
- She also leads the Sun Belt with a 4.1 assistturnover ratio, ranking sixth in the NCAA. On the season, Mendoza has 33 assists and just eight turnovers.
- A junior college transfer, Mendoza made quite a debut in Troy's season opener. The Miami native came off the bench and recorded 12 assists with no turnovers. In her 20 minutes, she also recorded four points.
- The 12 assists were the most by a Troy player in their debut since at least 1999-2000 when game statistics are first available.
- The 12 assists are also the most by a Trojan since Ashley Beverly Kelley had 13 against Georgia State in 2013-14.
- Mendoza also leads the Trojans with 11 made 3 -pointers in five games. She is 11 -of19 , good for 57.9 percent which is the best mark in the Sun Belt and second in the NCAA.
- Mendoza's 2.2 made 3 -pointers per game ranks fourth in the Sun Belt.


## UPSHAW'S IMPRESSIVE START

- True freshman Amahni Upshaw has started the last four games for the Trojans. The Brantly, Ala., native has scored in double figures twice.
- Upshaw is also currently Troy's leading rebounder at 6.0 boards per game, ranking 10th in the Sun Belt. The last Trojan freshman to lead the team in rebounding over a season was Thea Herring in 2000-01.
- She had 15 points and 10 rebounds against Fort Valley State, shooting 6-of-9 overall.
- The double-double was the first for the Trojans this season and the first by a Troy freshman since Ashley Beverly Kelley posted 17 points and 13 rebounds at Middle Tennessee in 2012-13.
- Upshaw also ranks second in the Sun Belt in field goal percentage, shooting 64.0 percent on the season.


## BRANTLEY CONNECTION AT TROY

- Upshaw is a native of Brantley, Ala., a town 30 miles from Troy with a population of just over 800 people. However, she isn't the only Brantley Bulldog doing big things on the hardwood at Troy.
- Troy men's basketball sophomore guard Wesley Person, last year's Sun Belt Freshman of the Year, is also a native of Brantley. Person is averaging 18.0 points per game this season for the Troy men.
- Troy football freshman linebacker Doug Salter is also a native of Brantley.

## EMERSON PROTECTING PAINT

■ In just over two seasons, Troy junior Kristen Emerson is already seventh in Troy history with 73 career blocked shots.
■ Emerson averaged 1.3 blocks per game last season, the sixth most in the Sun Belt. She is averaging 1.6 blocks per game this season to rank fourth in the league.

■ She is just sixth player in Troy history to average over 1.0 blocks per game in her career.

- Emerson is also the Trojans top returning rebounder after averaging 5.7 boards per game last season. The junior posted doublefigure rebounds in five games last season.


## HOME WINNING STREAK

- With their win over Nicholls the Trojans moved to 3-0 at Trojan Arena this season and extended their home winning streak to eight games dating back to last season.
- The streak is the third longest in Troy's Division I history, which began in 1994.
- The longest home winning streak in program history is 20 games, a streak that began in 1991-92 and finished in 1993-94.
- Included in the current streak is Troy's win over Little Rock last season, the eventual Sun Belt champion that went to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

## 100-POINT NOTES

- Troy has scored over 100 points in all three of its home games this season.
- The Trojans scored 103 points in their season opening win over West Alabama. It marked the first time in program history that the Trojans have scored 100 points in a season opener.

■ It also gave Troy a 100-point game in its fourth straight season for the first in program history.

- Troy has since scored 118 in a win over Fort Valley State and 104 in a win over Nicholls, giving the Trojans nine 100-point games in Chanda Rigby's four seasons.


## DISTRIBUTING MINUTES

■ Chanda Rigby and the Trojans are regularly substituting five players at a time this season in order to conserve energy in their up-tempo system.

- "We try to sub five at a time like a hockey game. We're teaching our team how to play very hard in a spurt of about two minutes," Rigby said.
■ In their most recent win over Nicholls, no Trojan played more than 23 minutes (Kristen Emerson) and only three played over 20 minutes. On the other hand, every player dressed for the game played at least six minutes.
- Troy is the only team in the Sun Belt with 13 different players averaging at least 7.0 minutes per game. Troy is one of four in the league with no players averaging over 30.0 minutes per game.


## TROJAN TURNAROUND

- Just four seasons ago (2011-12), the Troy women's basketball program went 2-26. Following that season, Chanda Rigby took over, and now the Trojans are looking for back-to-back 20-win seasons.
- In 2014-15, Troy went 20-11 overall to grab just the fourth 20 -win season in program history and the first since 1996-97.
- Troy also made a postseason appearance as the Trojans played in the WBI. It was just the second postseason appearance in program history and the first since 1997.
- Troy finished in third place in the Sun Belt standings, a program best, with a 15-5 league record, setting the program record for most conference wins.

- Rigby says that the Trojans have prepared throughout the offseason when the end of this 2015-16 season in mind.
- In Troy's program history, the Trojans have never had back-to-back 20 win seasons.

## TROJANS PICKED FIFTH

- Despite finishing third last season and returning their top scorer, the Trojans have been picked to finish fifth in the Sun Belt Preseason Coaches Poll this season.
- However, the Trojans were just 11 points behind the second place team, and all of the top five teams, including Troy, received first place votes.
- ""It shows how good our conference is, but it is fodder for motivation. In no way, shape or form do we see ourselves as fifth, but we have to prove it. We won't be happy at all unless we finish first, and that's what we're striving for everyday," Rigby says of the prediction.


## NUMBERS WATCH

1 Troy ranks first in the NCAA in scoring offense, averaging 97.4 points per game through its first five games in 201516. The Trojans are over 7.0 points ahead of second place UConn (90.2).

1 Caitlyn Ramirez leads the NCAA in field goal percentage, shooting 69.0 percent (29-of-42) on the season. Ramirez is also shooting 50.0 percent ( 5 -of-10) from long range and 1.000 percent ( 9 -of-9 from the free throw line.

2 Troy ranks second in the NCAA in turnovers forced ( $26.8 / \mathrm{g}$ ) and steals (14.0/g). The Trojans have forced three opponents into 30 -plus turnovers this season.

5 Troy ranks fifth in the NCAA in field goal percentage, shooting 50.5 percent as a team this season. The Trojans have shot at least 47.0 percent in every game this season.

14 Ashley Beverly Kelley has 197 steals in her career, just 14 away from breaking the Troy career record of 210, which has stood since 1997.

69 Ashley Beverly Kelley has scored in double figures 69 times in her career, including in 19 straight games dating back to last season.

Chanda Rigby is in her fourth season as the head coach at Troy in 2015-16. In her first three seasons, Rigby has quickly turned around the Troy program. The program won just two games in 2011-12, the season prior to Rigby's arrival, and has most recently won 20 games in 2014-15.

Troy's 2014-15 team won 20 games for just the fourth time in program history and made the second postseason appearance in program history. The Trojans posted a 15-5 Sun Belt record, good for a program-best third place finish, then played in the Women's Basketball Invitational, making a postseason appearance for the first time since 1997. The team also tied the Troy Division I era record with six straight wins in January before breaking the record with eight straight wins to close the regular season.

In addition to a winning culture, Rigby has also brought an exciting, fast-paced tempo to Troy. All three of her teams at Troy have led the Sun Belt in scoring offense, and the most recent two teams have both finished in the NCAA's top 20 in scoring offense.

Rigby has also brought a pressure defense to Troy as the Trojans have forced 46 opponents into 20-plus turnovers in the last three seasons. Most recently, in 2014-15, the Trojans averaged 12.1 steals per game, ranking first in the Sun Belt and fourth in the NCAA.

In her three seasons, Rigby has coached five first or second team All-Sun Belt selections, more than the program had in its previous seven combined seasons in the Sun Belt Conference. Most recently, in 2014-15, Ashley Beverly Kelley and Ronita Garrett were both named to the All-Sun Belt First Team, giving Troy two first team selections for the first time in over a decade.

Rigby came to Troy after seven seasons as the head coach at Pensacola State, including a state championship and Final Four trip in each of her last two seasons. She led the Pirates to a combined 64-6 record over the last two seasons with two trips to the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Final Four; the Pirates were victorious in third-place games on both occasions.

With over 20 years of head coaching experience, Rigby has been successful at every level of competition, posting a 421-173 record at the high school, two-year college and four-year college levels.

## RIGBY'S SYSTEM

## HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE

- Troy again has one of the nation's top scoring offenses in 2015-16, averaging 97.4 points per game. In fact, it is the No. 1 ranked scoring offense through Troy's first five games.
- Troy's high scoring numbers are a product of head coach Chanda Rigby's signature uptempo system. Now in her fourth season, Rigby isn't slowing down. The Trojans' goal on every possession is to get a shot off within 7 seconds.
- Under Rigby, the Trojans have scored 100 points in nine games, including in three so far in 2015-16. Prior to her arrival Troy had last scored 100 in a game in 1996-97, a span of 441 games between 100-point efforts.
■ Troy's 103 points in their season opener against West Alabama this season were the most ever for the Trojans in a season opener. It also gave Troy a 100-point game in four straight seasons for the first time in program history.
- Rigby's Troy teams have scored 80-plus points 41 times in her four seasons, something Troy did just seven times in the previous four seasons.
- Troy has led the Sun Belt in scoring in each of Chanda Rigby's first three seasons, including in 2013-14 when it averaged 80.4 points per game. Troy became just the second Sun Belt team since 2000 to average over 80.0 points per game (Middle Tennessee, 200910, 80.8)
- Rigby has had success with the system at numerous levels, including the JUCO level where she was before coming to Troy. Rigby's last two teams at Pensacola State averaged 79.3 and 90.1 points per game on their way to two straight NJCAA Final Four appearances.


## PRESSURE DEFENSE

- Chanda Rigby has also brought a pressure defense with her to Troy. So far this season, the Trojans are forcing 26.8 opponent turnovers per game, the best mark in the Sun Belt and the second highest mark in the NCAA. Troy's 14.0 steals per game also lead the Sun Belt and also rank second in the NCAA.
- Last season, the Trojans forced 20-plus turnovers 19 times, including in 11 of the last 18 games.
- Troy forced 30-plus turnovers four times last season, including a season-high 39 against ULM. The 39 turnovers by the Warhawks were the most forced by a Troy team since at least 1999-2000 when opponent turnover stats were first available.
- In Chanda Rigby's four seasons, Troy has forced 49 opponents into 20-plus turnovers and 11 into 30-plus turnovers.
- In addition to increasing their number of opponent turnovers and steals in each season under Chanda Rigby, Troy has also lessened its own turnovers. Troy currently has a +8.40 turnover margin, which ranks second in the Sun Belt and ninth in the NCAA.


## TROJAN ARENA



- The Trojans are in their fourth season in the 5,200-seat Trojan Arena in 2015-16.
- The jewel of Sun Belt basketball facilities features seven luxury suites, seats 5,200 for basketball and features a state-of-the-art sound and video system.
- The state-of-the-art arena is equipped with two 767-square foot high-definition video boards, a continuous ribbon board around the arena and LED display scorer's tables.
- Trojan Arena also houses the Troy University Sports Hall of Fame which opened in August 2012 and now has 27 members, including women's basketball greats Denise Monroe and Joyce Sorrell.
- The facility also features a six-basket practice court, coaches offices for basketball, volleyball and track and field, film room and more.
- Design support for Trojan Arena was provided by Populous whose other projects include Yankee Stadium, the London Olympics and Wimbledon Tennis Club.
- The Trojans played their previous 37 seasons in Sartain Hall, posting a 288-175 record.
