

NOTABLES

- Saint Louis has won five in a row and enter Monday's game at Vanderbilt with an 11-2 record. During the streak, SLU has won by an average of 16 ppg.
- Dwayne Evans was named the Atlantic 10 Conference's Player of the Week Dec. 22. He averaged 23.0 ppg and 10.0 rpg last week as the Billikens knocked off Indiana State and North Carolina A&T.
- In SLU's last outing, Dwayne Evans posted the 20th double-double (22 points and 13 rebounds) of his career in a 79-57 victory against North Carolina A&T.
- Five Billikens average 8.0 ppg or more. Senior forward **Dwayne Evans** (15.9 ppg) and senior quard Jordair Jett (10.7) lead the way for SLU. Senior quard Mike McCall Jr. and senior forward Rob Loe contribute 9.7 ppg apiece. Sophomore guard Austin McBroom averages 8.2 ppg.
- Junior forward **Grandy Glaze** is SLU's top rebounder with 6.8 rpg. He also scores 5.6 ppg. Dwayne Evans is second on the squad with 5.9 rpg.
- Senior guard Jordair Jett is fourth in the A-10 with 4.6 assists per game and 12th in the league with 1.46 steals per contest. Senior guard Mike McCall Jr. is tied for 10th in the A-10
- The Billikens lead the A-10 and are fourth nationally in scoring defense, yielding 58.4 ppg. SLU is second in the A-10 in field goal percentage defense (.393) and first (fourth in nation) in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.253). The Billikens are also first in the A-10 in scoring margin (+13.8) and second in assist-turnover ratio (+1.3).
- Saint Louis, which has advanced to back-to-back NCAA Tournaments, is the reigning Atlantic 10 Conference champion. The Billikens captured the 2012-13 A-10 regular-season title outright, then claimed the A-10 Championship at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y. SLU was picked to finish second in the A-10 preseason poll. Dwayne Evans was a first-team preseason All-Conference selection, while Jordair Jett was voted to the third team and preseason All-Defensive team.
- Next up, the Billikens host Yale (5-6) at Chaifetz Arena on Saturday, Jan. 4, at 4:30 p.m.






SETTING THE SCENE

Saint Louis, a winner of its last five, searches for its fourth non-conference road win Monday when it travels to Nashville, Tenn., to face Vanderbilt. Tip time from Memorial Gymnasium is scheduled for 8 p.m. (CT). The game will be televised on ESPNU.

FOLLOWING THE ACTION

Monday's game will be televised on ESPNU, with **Rich Hollenberg** and **Carolyn Peck** on the call. The radio broadcast will air on 101 ESPN and 101Sports.com. As always, Billiken Hall of Famer **Bob Ramsey** will provide the play-by-play, while St. Louis American sports editor **Earl Austin Jr.** handles the analysis. The game will also be streamed through WatchESPN.

SCORE AND STATS ON YOUR PHONE

StatBroadcast is the live stats provider for Billiken basketball home games and is designed for media and public use. The web address is slu.statbroadcast.com. You can receive live stats on your mobile device by typing slustats.com into your browser. The stats are updated in real time, whether you are watching from your seat inside Chaifetz Arena or following on your phone in the Czech Republic (like **Kwamain Mitchell**) or Australia (like **Brian Conklin** and **Cody Ellis**).

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶Dwayne Evans notched his second straight 20-plus-point performance to lead the Billikens to a 79-57 win over North Carolina A&T Saturday at Chaifetz Arena. The victory was Saint Louis's fifth in a row.
- ► Evans scored 22 points on 5-of-10 shooting and snagged a game-high 13 rebounds for his 20th career double-double.
- ► As he did against Indiana State in his last outing a SLU season-high 24-point effort Evans did most of his damage at the free-throw line. Evans went 11 of 14 from the charity stripe today after going 16 of 20 from the line against the Sycamores.
- ▶ Mike McCall Jr. became the 29th player in Saint Louis history to reach 1,000 career points when he sunk a second-half free throw. During the ensuing media timeout, McCall Jr. was given a standing ovation from the crowd. He finished the contest with 13 points on 5-of-10 shooting.
- ▶Rob Loe netted 12 points and blocked four shots, while Austin McBroom canned three first-half 3-pointers and scored 10 points.
- ▶ The Billikens held North Carolina A&T to 33.9 percent shooting for the game, including 8.3 percent shooting (1 of 12) from 3-point range. SLU forced 12 Aggie turnovers, while the Bills had more assists (16) than turnovers (10) for the 10th time this season.

1,000-POINT CLUB

- ▶Dwayne Evans and Mike McCall Jr. are two of 29 Billikens who have scored 1,000 or more points in their careers.
- ► Evans, the Billikens' active leading scorer with 1,231 career points, became the 28th player in SLU's 1,000-point club last year in the NCAA Tournament win against New Mexico State.
- ► McCall Jr. entered "the club" in the North Carolina A&T game with a free throw. He now has 1,004 career points.
- ▶ **Jordair Jett** needs 96 points to reach 1,000 for his career.

BALANCING ACT

- ▶The Billikens are continuing their trend from last season by having a balanced scoring attack.
- ► SLU features five players who average 8.0 ppg or more. Last season, the Billikens had six players finish with 7.0 ppg or more.
- ►SLU's scoring was so spread out last year that no Billiken finished in the top 10 in scoring in the A-10. In A-10 games only, no Billiken appeared in the top 10 despite ranking seventh in the league in scoring offense. SLU's leading scorer from last year, **Dwayne Evans** (14.0 ppg), was 15th in the A-10 in scoring.
- ▶Only **Dwayne Evans** (8th in A-10 with 15.9 ppg) is in the top 30 in scoring in the league.

ALL-TIME WINNERS

- ► Saint Louis' senior class has the chance to go down as the winningest class in school history. Currently, the group has 77 victories. The Billikens need to post 24 victories this season to better the four-year class of **Cory Remekun** and **Cody Ellis**, who had 89 wins in their careers from 2009-10 to 2012-13.
- ► The all-time winningest player in school history is **Kwamain Mitchell**. He was a part of 95 victories in his career from 2008-09 to 2009-10, and 2011-12 to 2012-13.

- ► Here are other notable classes and their total victories:

ROAD WARRIORS

- ► Saint Louis is 3-0 so far this season in non-conference road games.
- ▶That is SLU's best start in non-conference road tilts since 1993-94, when the Billikens went 4-0 with wins at SMU, Creighton, Murray State and UMKC.
- ▶ Prior to this year, the Billikens had gone 1-15 in non-conference road tilts in the regular season since the 2007-08 campaign.

CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD

- **▶Dwayne Evans** is moving up SLU's career rebounding list with 797 career boards.
- Evans needs eight more rebounds to surpass **Eugene Moore** for fourth on the all-time list.
- ▶ In the latest NCAA men's basketball statistical report (Dec. 22), Evans ranked eighth in the nation among all NCAA Division I players in total career rebounds.

ALL-TIME STEAL

- ► Another record to watch is the Billikens' all-time steals list. **Jordair Jett** and **Mike McCall Jr.** have been battling all season for a better spot in the top 10.
- ►Currently, Jett is sixth with 142 steals, while McCall Jr. follows in seventh with 138 steals.

DOUBLE TIME

- ▶Dwayne Evans recorded his 20th career double-double in the win against North Carolina A&T. He is one of three active Billikens with double-doubles, joining **Grandy Glaze** and **Rob Loe** who have one apiece.
- ▶Loe neared a double-double against Oral Roberts but fell one rebound shy. **Mike McCall Jr.** was one rebound away from his first double-double at Southern Illinois. **Jordair Jett** needed one more assist at Valpo for the rare points-assists double-double.

EVANS HAS CLASS

- ► Saint Louis senior forward **Dwayne Evans** is one of 30 men's basketball players in the NCAA selected as a candidate for the 2013-14 Senior CLASS Award.
- ▶To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievement in four areas of excellence community, classroom, character and competition.
- ▶The list of 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season. Those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot, which will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans. Together, they will select the one candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

BARNETT A NOMINEE FOR NABC GOOD WORKS TEAM

- Saint Louis senior **Jake Barnett** is a nominee for the 2014 Allstate NABC Good Works Team.
- ▶The award recognizes a select group of college basketball student-athletes who have made significant contributions to the greater good of their communities through volunteerism and civic service.
- ▶ In its second year, the Allstate NABC and WBCA Good Works Teams® honor players at all levels of college basketball who represent the sport's finest in the areas of leadership and charitable achievements amongst their peers. The student-athletes nominated for this prestigious award embody the true spirit of teamwork and giving back.

BILLIKENS SIGN FIVE TO NLIS

- Saint Louis University head men's basketball coach **Jim Crews** announced today that five standouts have signed National Letters of Intent to attend the University and play for the Billikens. All begin their four years of eligibility next season. Said Crews of the class: "We are excited to welcome these five young men into our program. They are all intelligent, have strong athletic backgrounds and have very high character. The lasting impression someone in our program can have is to be a good teammate, and all of these players fit that mold. We are proud they are a part of Saint Louis basketball."

HOME SWEET CHAIFETZ

- ▶The Billikens are in their sixth season at Chaifetz Arena and have posted a 80-18 record on their home floor.
- ►SLU is 39-4 the last three seasons in the 10,600-seat arena, including a 17-2 mark last season.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- ▶The Billikens close out the non-conference season Saturday, Jan. 4, against Yale (5-6). Game time at Chaifetz Arena is scheduled for 4:30 p.m. and the game will be televised nationally on NBC Sports Network.
- ▶The Billikens open league play with a two-game road trip, beginning at Rhode Island Tuesday, Jan. 7. SLU then heads to Dayton to face the Flyers Saturday, Jan. 11.

BILLIKENS IN THE ATLANTIC 10

- Saint Louis is in its ninth season in the Atlantic 10 Conference. The 13-team league will grow to 14 next season with the addition of Davidson.
- ▶The Billikens are 75-53 all-time in A-10 contests.
- ▶ Last season, the Billikens captured their first A-10 conference crown after winning the regular-season and tournament titles.
- ▶The Atlantic 10 is coming off the most successful season in league history in which nine postseason teams (five of those in the NCAA Tournament) earned seven NCAA wins, including a Sweet 16 run by La Salle.
- ▶The A-10 had 10 teams in the top 100 of the RPI and three ranked teams (La Salle, Saint Louis, VCU) at season's end last year. It marked the sixth straight year an A-10 team made the Sweet 16 and sixth straight year the league has received multiple at-large bids.

A-10 TOURNEY RETURNS TO BARCLAYS CENTER

- ▶ For the second year in a row, the A-10 Championship will be played at the state-of-theart Barclays Center in Brookly, N.Y., home of the Brooklyn Nets.
- ▶ All 13 teams will be in NYC for the league tournament, which begins with the opening round Wednesday, March 12. The top four seeds receive a bye in the opening and first rounds and begin play in the quarterfinals on Friday, March 14.
- ▶Once again, the A-10 title game (Sunday, March 16) will be televised live on CBS on Selection Sunday at noon (CT).

BILLIKENS VS. RANKED FOES

- Last season, the Billikens had a school-record five victories against ranked foes (New Mexico, Butler, VCU, Butler, VCU).
- ▶No. 9 Butler was the highest-ranked opponent SLU has beaten since knocking off No. 2 Louisville in 2003.

TV TIME

- ▶The Billikens have a record 28 games televised this season 16 national telecasts and 12 on FOX Sports Midwest.
- Six games air on CBS Sports Network, five on NBC Sports Network and five on the ESPN family of networks.
- ▶St. Louis is the No. 21 television market in the country.

JIM CREWS NAMED HEAD COACH

- After leading Saint Louis to unprecedented success as interim head coach, **Jim Crews** was named head coach following the 2012-13 campaign.
- ▶ Crews was tabbed interim head coach in August 2012 after it was announced **Rick Majerus** would not coach that year due to an ongoing heart ailment. Majerus died in December.
- ▶ Both SLU and Crews agreed to not discuss the permanent head-coaching job until after the season, and on April 12, it was announced that Crews would remain as head coach of the Billikens.

BANQUET SEASON

- Saint Louis men's basketball was honored at various events recently.
- ▶SLU received the Champion's Award at the St. Louis Hall of Fame enshrinement ceremony on November 20, 2013, at the Millennium Hotel in downtown St. Louis. **Cody**

Ellis accepted the award on the program's behalf.

▶On Wednesday, Dec. 11, Jim Crews and Dwayne Evans received the Carl O. Bauer Award at the Jack Buck Sports Awards at the Missouri Athletic Club. The Bauer Award is given annually to the top amateur sports figure in the St. Louis area.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

- ▶ All four of the Billikens' seniors from last year are continuing their basketball careers.
- ▶ Cody Ellis has joined the Sydney Kings in Australia, with whom he signed a contract in July. Ellis was in St. Louis during the fall semester working toward his degree.
- ▶Femi John played for the Billikens in 2009-10 before suffering a serious knee injury that forced him to temporarily give up basketball. However, he remained a part of the team, attending almost every practice and sitting on the bench during home games. John earned his degree from SLU and is using his final year of eligibility to play NCAA Division II ball at Missouri-St. Louis.
- ▶Kwamain Mitchell is playing in Usti nad Labem in the Mattoni NBL in the Czech Republic.
- ▶ Cory Remekun is playing with the Dragons in Bad Honnef, Germany, which plays in the ProB League.

LAST SEASON AT A GLANCE

- ▶The Billikens qualified for their eighth NCAA Tournament appearance and second in as many seasons. SLU earned a No. 4 seed in the Midwest Region, its best seeding ever. The Billikens knocked off New Mexico State in San Jose, Calif., in the second round before falling to Oregon in the third round.
- Saint Louis captured the Atlantic 10 Conference tournament championship at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, defeating Charlotte, Butler and VCU for the Billikens' first conference crown since 2000.
- ▶The Billikens marched through conference play with a 13-3 record, earning the outright regular-season championship resulting in a No. 1 seed at the A-10 tourney.
- ►SLU set a school record with 28 victories.
- ▶ Dwayne Evans and Kwamain Mitchell were named to the A-10 All-Tournament team. Evans was named Most Outstanding Player after averaging a team-best 21.7 ppg and 9.3 rpg during the three games. Mitchell scored a team-high 19 points in the championship game against VCU.
- ▶Dwayne Evans ended the season with 1,024 career points, joining teammates **Kwamain Mitchell** and **Cody Ellis** as active members of the Billikens' 1,000-point club.
- ▶ Dwayne Evans was named first-team All-Conference, while Cody Ellis was tabbed the Sixth Man of the Year. Jordair Jett and Kwamain Mitchell were selected to the third team. Jett was chosen to the All-Defensive squad, while Evans was named All-Academic.
- SLU ended the regular season ranked No. 13 in the AP Top 25. The Billikens came in at No. 16 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll, released in the postseason.

SCOUTING VANDERBILT

- ▶ Vanderbilt enters Monday's game 7-3 overall and riding a three game winning streak.
- Sophomore guard Eric McClellan leads the Commodores with 14.8 ppg. He has also posted a team-high 10 steals.
- Senior forward **Rod Odom** contributes 13.3 ppg and a team-high 5.4 rpg, while senior guard Kyle Fuller has 10.0 ppg. Odom is among the SEC's top 3-point shooters, hitting 28-of-61 for 45.9 percent.
- ▶ Last season, Vanderbilt went 16-17 overall and 8-10 in the SEC.
- ▶ Kevin Stallings, a native of St. Louis suburb Collinsville, Ill., is 284-178 in 15 seasons at Vanderbilt. He is 407-241 in 20 seasons, which also includes a six-year stint at Illinois State.

SERIES HISTORY

- ► Vanderbilt leads the all-time series 5-3.
- ▶The last meeting came during the 1997-98 season, with the Billikens posting a 78-74 victory at Scottrade Center. In that game, freshman Larry Hughes scored a game-high 27 points and added 12 rebounds. That Billiken victory avenged a 20-point loss to the Commodores a year prior in Nashville.
- ▶ Vanderbilt and Saint Louis met in the 1990 NIT title game at Madison Square Garden in New York. The Commodores captured the title with a 74-72 victory.
- ► Saint Louis is 58-46 all-time against SEC squads.

HeadCoachJIM CREWS



- Formally introduced as the Billikens' 26th head men's basketball coach on April 12, 2013.
- ► Has a 26-year head coaching record of 393-357 that includes stints at SLU (one year), Army (seven years) and Evansville (17 years). He is 39-9 in his second year at SLU.
- ► Tabbed the UPS NABC Division I Coach of the Year, Sporting News' National Coach of the Year and the A-10 Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year award.
- Has been a part of 15 NCAA Tournaments as a player, assistant coach and head coach. Played on Indiana's 1976 national championship team and also won a title as an assistant coach in 1981.

Jim Crews was introduced as the Billikens' 26th head men's basketball coach on April 12, 2013. He led the Billikens to unprecedented success as interim head coach last year.

Crews was named interim head coach at the beginning of the 2012-13 campaign when it was announced that Rick Majerus would not coach. Crews led the Billikens to a school-record 28 victories (28-7), Atlantic 10 Conference regular-season and tournament championships and a second straight NCAA Tournament bid.

Crews' coaching performance, as well as the Billikens' success on the court, did not go unnoticed on the national scene. Crews earned national coach of the year awards from the Sporting News and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). He was one of four finalists for the Naismith Coach of the Year award. In addition, he earned his fifth conference coach of the year honor when he was named A-10 Coach of the Year.

Crews is in his 26th season as a collegiate head coach and has a **393-357** career record. Previously, he served seven seasons at Army from 2002-09. Preceding his appointment at West Point, Crews coached for 17 years at Evansville (1985-2002) and played and coached at Indiana.

Crews had a successful 17-year stint at Evansville, accumulating a 294-209 record. He guided the Purple Aces to six postseason appearances, including four trips to the NCAA Tournament. All six of those squads registered at least 21 victories. A four-time conference coach of the year (1987, 1989, 1992 Midwestern Collegiate; 1999 Missouri Valley), Crews is the only coach in Evansville's tradition-rich history to post nine consecutive non-losing seasons.

Crews learned from the legendary Bob Knight at Indiana for 12 seasons, four as a player and eight as an assistant coach.

During his four-year playing career from 1972 to 1976, the Hoosiers forged a remarkable 108-12 record. As a senior in 1976, Crews helped IU to a 32-0 record and a national championship, the last time a Division I men's program has posted an undefeated record.

After graduating from Indiana, Crews returned for an eight-year stint on Knight's coaching staff. Indiana captured another national championship in 1981, won three Big Ten championships (1980, 1981 and 1983) and posted a 174-76 record during his tenure as an assistant.
