DROPPIN 'NOLE'DGE

- Senior star Cierra Bravard is second in the ACC in scoring at 17.5 ppg. Bravard also ranks No. 6 in rebounds (7.8) and No. 4 in FG% (.566).
- Bravard has made more free throws than anybody else in the ACC (54) in 2011-12.
- She has a streak of 32 consecutive games scoring in double figures. The streak is over a year old. It started on Dec. 21, 2010 at Connecticut.
- Although the Seminoles are 6-5 this season, they have played the nation's 11th hardest schedule according to realtimerpi.com.
- Florida State recorded a school-record 15 blocks in an 86-41 win over Alabama A&M on Monday. The previous record of 12 swats was set on Nov. 17, 1978 against Mercer.
- Florida State is 1-0 all-time against the Commodores, defeating Vandy last season, 72-66, on Nov. 21, 2010, in Tallahassee.
- Courtney Ward exploded for 31 points and made seven treys to lead FSU. Then freshman Natasha Howard added 11 points. Vanderbilt's Christina Foggie and Jasmine Lister combined to shoot 8 of 14 from the three-point line.
- FSU is 48-95 all-time versus the SEC and 0-2 in 2011-12.
- Bravard is averaging 27.0 ppg in FSU's two games against ranked opponents in 2011-12.
- · Bravard is on the Wade Award, Wooden Award and Naismith Award Watch Lists, as well as a Lowe's Senior CLASS Award Top 30 Finalist.
- The Seminoles have been to seven straight NCAA Tournaments and nine straight postseasons.
- · FSU has averaged 23 wins the last seven years.

SCORING MACHINE

In three away games this season, senior center Cierra Bravard is averaging 25.7 ppg and 11.0 rpg.

Bravard is second in the ACC in scoring at 17.5 ppg in all games. She also ranks No. 6 in rebounding (7.8) and No. 4 in field goal percentage (.566).

C'S STREAK HITS ONE YEAR

Bravard has scored in double figures in 32 consecutive games. Her streak started on Dec. 21, 2010, at UConn. It's been nearly a year since Bravard had a game where she didn't reach 10 points - she had six points on Dec. 18 at Yale. The Noles play Yale on Dec. 28. Interestingly, Vanderbilt held Bravard to just six points in their matchup last season.

BLOCK PARTY

Florida State recorded a school-record 15 blocks versus Alabama A&M on Monday in an 86-41 win. Bravard and sophomore Natasha Howard led the way with four blocks apiece, while junior Alexa Deluzio added three swats and freshman Kristi Mokube nabbed two put-backs. The mark is the most by an ACC team this season. FSU's previous record was 12 set on Nov. 17, 1978 against Mercer. The Seminoles started the game by blocking Alabama A&M's first three shot attempts.

BREAKING DOWN MONDAY

Florida State played its most complete game on Monday in an 86-41 win over Alabama A&M, registering plenty of season bests in addition to the all-time record of 15 blocks. Below is a breakdown:

- Five Noles scored in double figures.
- Largest margin of victory this season - 45 points.
- Best first-half field goal percentage (61.3) this season.
- FSU's best field goal percentage this season (56.3).

RANKING WARS

Tonight will be FSU's third game against a ranked opponent this season. The Seminoles fell to No. 11/12 Louisville, 85-76, on Nov. 25 despite tying the game up in the last five minutes. Five days later, FSU dropped a 78-75 overtime decision at No. 17/19 Ohio State.

- FSU's last win over a ranked team was on Feb. 20, 2011 against No. 17/16 Maryland (72-66) in Tallahassee.
- The Seminoles last nonconference win over a ranked opponent came against No. 20/23 Vanderbilt (72-66) on Nov. 21, 2010, in Tallahassee.
- Bravard was a star in both games against ranked opponents this season, averaging 27.0 ppg and 9.0 rpg, while shooting 50.0 percent from the field and 87.0 percent from the line.

LETHAL AT THE LINE

Cierra Bravard leads the ACC in free throws made (54) and is shooting 71.2 percent from the line.

Last season, she led the ACC with 156 free throws made, while shooting 78.8 percent.



HOWARD ON THE ROAD

Sophomore Natasha Howard is averaging 16.0 ppg and 11.0 rpg in three away games this season.

KEEP AN EYE ON ...

Sophomore Natasha Howard's rebounding numbers. lt's early, but Howard is averaging nearly 10 rebounds per game (9.2). She has six double-figure games on the glass and four double-doubles. Only five Noles have ever averaged double-figures in rebounds in a season. The last to do it was Lavys Torres (10.0) in 2000-01. Howard is second in the ACC in rebounding this season.

BRAVARD CLEANS THE GLASS

Almost as good as any Seminole ever...Bravard moved past Lorraine Rimson (83-86) for 10th-place in school history in rebounds. After grabbing a season-best six rebounds versus Alabama A&M, she now has 655 career boards.

DELUZIO NOW 10TH IN TREYS

Junior Alexa Deluzio's three-pointer versus Charlotte tied her for 10th-place in the FSU career record books in three-pointers made. She hit another at Akron and two more versus Alabama A&M.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME...

For Ohio natives Cierra Bravard and Natasha Howard. Both players had career games against Akron. Bravard, a Sandusky, Ohio, native, scored a career-best 28 point and grabbed a season-best 12 rebounds in the 90-64 win over the Zips. Howard, from Toledo, Ohio, tallied career best in points (24), rebounds (13), blocks (3) and assists (3). Both players had over a dozen friends and family members attend the game, as did Tay'ler Mingo - an Akron native. Mingo also played well, matching her career-bests in minutes (32) and assists (5). Last but not least,

Olivia Bresnahan, from Butler, Pa., also had a great game in front of family and friends. She helped FSU erase a 7-0 deficit en route the dominating victory with her hustle off the bench. She set career highs in rebounds (seven), assists (six) and minutes (29).

LIV LEADS AGAINST CHARLOTTE

Sophomore reserve guard Olivia Bresnahan sparked FSU's 64-62 win over Charlotte last Sunday by scoring a career-high 10 points, while grabbing four boards. This came just three days after Bresnahan suffered a severe ankle sprain that forced her to miss the Ohio State game. Bresnahan's toughness did not go unnoticed, as junior captain Alexa Deluzio stated after the game, "We told Liv she was our Player of the Game."

Five FSU players scored in double figures in a game that featured 14 lead changes and three ties. Bresnahan found sophomore Natasha Howard for a layup with 1:43 remaining to put FSU up for good, 63-62.

LOSING STREAK SNAPPED

Florida State prevented its first fourgame losing streak since the 2003-04 season by beating Charlotte on Dec. 4, 64-62.

HEARTBREAKER IN OHIO

Florida State fell in overtime, 78-75, at Ohio State in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Nov. 30. Sandusky, Ohio, native Cierra Bravard matched her career-high with 27 points, while grabbing a season-best 12 boards for her 13th career double-double. The Noles were down a point in overtime, when Bravard was tied up for a jump ball with the possession arrow giving the Buckeyes the ball. Tayler Hill made a pair of free throws to put OSU up three. Hill, who finished with 31 points, scored the final eight points of regulation for OSU, including two deep three-pointers. Hill's layup with two seconds left knotted the score at 69-69 to force the extra frame.

FSU had a final chance with 3.5 seconds left in overtime, but sophomore Tay'ler Mingo's inbounds pass was

Now in her 15th year at FSU, Semrau, a three-time winner of the ACC Coach of the Year award, has earned a reputation as a coach that not only keeps her team in the national rankings by leading her players to victory but also one that helps foster the personal and professional growth of the student-athletes.

Semrau is the all-time winningest coach in FSU history and currently is the Vice-President of the WBCA. She has led the Noles to 10 postseason in 14 years, including an Elite Eight finish in 2010.

SEMBAU WINS GOLD AGAIN

Head Coach Sue Semrau won a gold medal as an assistant coach for Team USA at the 2011 FIBA U19 World Championships in August in Chile. It was a year after she won gold as an assistant at the U18 World Championship.

Cierra Bravard made her first eight shots and finished with 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting, but Nebraska broke a 66-66 tie with a three in the final two minutes and nailed its free throws down the stretch.

FSU BATTLES BACK, BUT NOT ENOUGH

Down by as many as 12 points in the second half, Florida State fought back to tie the game in the final five minutes versus No. 11/12-ranked Louisville on Nov. 25 at the Donald L. Tucker Center Tallahassee. Natasha Howard capped a 10-0 Noles' run with a trev with 4:52 left to tie the game at 66-66. Louisville's Shoni Schimmel answered with a three 30 seconds later to put the Cardinals' up for good, however. Louisville hung on for the 85-76 win. The Seminoles shot a season-best 48.2 percent from the field, but made 24 turnovers and allowed Louisville to shoot 48.4 percent.

REPLACING A GREAT PAIR

Florida State must replace graduated guards Courtney Ward and Christian Hunnicutt this season. Ward, a true point guard and team-leader, capped her career as the Noles' all-time leader in assists and three-pointers and was a two-time All-ACC selection. Hunnicutt did her damage on the defensive end, routinely shutting down the opposition's best player. She was named the 2010-11 ACC Defensive Player of the Year for her efforts.

ACC'S BEST

Florida State is tied with Duke for the most wins in conference play since 2009 with 35 victories. FSU won ACC regular season co-championships in 2009 and 2010, as well.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE

Florida State has been fantastic offensively the past two seasons, leading the ACC in field goal

percentage and three-point percentage in conference games in 2009-10 and 2010-11.

During these last two years, FSU has shot 44.3 percent from the field, and 39.8 percent in 28 conference games – better than every other team in the ACC.

SEVEN-YEAR STRETCH

Florida State has been to seven straight NCAA Tournaments. During that span, the Seminoles have averaged over 23 wins and 10 ACC victories a season.

FSU captured back-to-back No. 3 seeds in the 2010 and 2011 NCAA Tournaments. The Noles advanced to the Elite Eight in 2010 and lost a heartbreaker to Georgia, 61-59, in the second round of the 2011 "Big Dance."

DELUZIO STEPS IT UP

Last season, Alexa Deluzio averaged 12.0 ppg and shot 36.6 percent from behind the arc in all game. In conference games she stepped up her game to average 13.5 ppg and shoot an ACC-best 49.0 percent from three.

HAPPENIN' HOWARD

Sophomore Natasha Howard came to Florida State as the highest-rated recruit in school history. The versatile Toledo, Ohio native averaged 10.6 ppg and 6.6 rpg while shooting 46.0 percent from the floor and 36.8 percent from three. She captured Full Court Press Third Team Freshman All-America and ACC All-Freshman Team honors. At 6-3 with the ability to defend nearly every position and score inside and out, the sky is the limit for Howard.




