#### Championship Game Preview:

#### Vanderbilt Faces Appalachian State For San Juan Shootout Crown

Vanderbilt will face Appalachian State for the championship of the 2006 San Juan Shootout at the Mario Morales Coliseum, Thursday, Dec. 21 at 3 p.m. CT.

Vanderbilt (8-3) enters the final round having won seven consecutive games after outlasting in-state foe Tennessee Tech, 75-62, on Wednesday. Ted Skuchas scored a career-high 16 points to go along with six rebounds and three blocked shots. Alex Gordon tied a season-high with 15 points. Dan Cage (13), Derrick Byars (12) and Shan Foster (10) also reached double figures.

The Commodores will be looking to win their first regular-season tournament crown since claiming the 1987 Hawaiian Airlines Silversword Invitational in Wailuku, Hawaii to open the season.

Appalachian State (9-3) has been impressive in wins over Virginia (80-69) and Central Florida (75-64) in San Juan. Nate Cranford tallied 18 points thanks to six 3-pointers in the Mountaineers' second-round win against Central Florida. The Mountaineers have won four consecutive games.

Vanderbilt has won both previous meetings with Appalachian State. The Commodores topped the Mountaineers 63-48 on Dec. 22, 2003 and 68-51 on Dec. 22, 2004. Both games were played at Vanderbilt's Memorial Gymnasium.

### **Second Round Recap:**

#### **Vanderbilt Advances to Championship Round of San Juan Shootout with 75-62 win over Tennessee Tech**

San Juan, PUERTO RICO – Ted Skuchas posted a career-high 16 points to go along with six rebounds and three blocked shots as Vanderbilt advanced to the championship round of the San Juan Shootout with a 76-62 victory against in-state foe Tennessee Tech Wednesday at Mario Morales Coliseum.

The Commodores (8-3) will play Appalachian State for the championship Thursday, Dec. 21, at 3 p.m. CT. The Mountaineers beat Central Florida 75-64 in second-round play.

Alex Gordon matched his season-high with 15 points, hitting key 3-pointers in the second half as Tennessee Tech attempted a comeback. Derrick Byars tallied 12 points and a team-high eight rebounds. Dan Cage added 13 while Shan Foster contributed 10.

“We knew it was going to be a hard-fought game,” Vanderbilt head coach Kevin Stallings said. “We had it make it a bigger game for us than it was for them. They came out and punched us in the face with a 7-0 lead, but we were able to respond.

“Ted was awesome all the way through the game,” Stallings said of his fifth-year senior center. “He played big for us. It was easily his best game in a Vanderbilt uniform.”

Tennessee Tech (5-5) scored the game’s first seven points less than two minutes into the contest. However, Vanderbilt answered with a 22-2 run to build a 22-9 lead after a 3-pointer by Shan Foster with 9:15 remaining in the first half.

The Golden Eagles trimmed Vanderbilt’s lead to eight points at 31-23 on a layup by Francis Kabore at 2:29 before intermission. However, Cage nailed a 3-pointer, Gordon and Foster converted two free throws each and JeJuan Brown slammed in a Jermaine Beal miss to help give the Commodores a 40-26 halftime lead.

Vanderbilt seemed to respond to any Tennessee Tech challenge in the second half. Derrick Byars had a lay-in at 10:14 that extended the Commodore lead to 52-42. Gordon netted two key 3-pointers within a span of a minute and a half to push Vanderbilt ahead 61-50 at 7:30.

The Golden Eagles never trimmed Vanderbilt’s lead inside eight points in the second half.

Belton Rivers topped all Tennessee Tech scorers with 14 points. Anthony Fisher added 13.

The Commodores forced the Golden Eagles into 17 turnovers. Tennessee Tech won the rebounding battle 40-33.

### **First Round Recap:**

#### **Vanderbilt Cruises Past PR-Mayaguez in San Jan Shootout Opener; Cage, Byars En Fuego in Victory**

San Juan, PUERTO RICO -- Dan Cage tied a career high with 18 points to lead six Commodores in double figures as Vanderbilt cruised past tournament-host Puerto Rico-Mayaguez, 102-59, Tuesday in the first round of the San Juan Shootout at Mario Morales Coliseum.

The victory extended Vanderbilt’s win streak to six games.

Cage put Vanderbilt on track early with eight consecutive points, including a layup and two 3-pointers for a 17-6 advantage less than four minutes into the game. The last 3-pointer caught the attention of the local public address announcer who enthusiastically noted that Cage was “En Fuego.”

Cage ended the game seven of 11 from the field with four 3-pointers. He tallied 15 of his 18 points in the first half.

“I haven’t been shooting the ball well lately, but I got some easy looks early and that helped set the tone for the team,” Cage said. “The great thing about this team is we have a lot of unselfish guys and they were working hard to keep getting me open looks at the basket.”

Teammate Derrick Byars caught fire in the second stanza with 12 of his 16 points coming after intermission. Like Cage, Byars collected his points early, hitting two jumpers, a break away dunk and a pair of 3-pointers in the first seven minutes of the second half.

Byars finished seven of 12 from the field and also earned “En Fuego” acclaim from the public address announcer during the second half.

“If we want to have the success that we’re looking for in this tournament then Dan and Derrick are going to have to play well,” Vanderbilt head coach Kevin Stallings said. “I was very pleased with their effort today.”

Vanderbilt, who led 52-30 at intermission, started the second half on a 24-8 run and never led by less than 30 points after the 14-minute mark. The Commodores enjoyed as much as a 44-point lead twice in the game before finishing with their largest margin of victory under Stallings.

Ross Neltner scored 15 points and grabbed seven rebounds. Ted Skuchas was perfect from the field in five attempts in posting 12 points and seven rebounds. Shan Foster had 11. Jermaine Beal added 10.

Mayaguez post player Williset Del Valle led the Bulldogs with a game-high 24 points to go along with seven rebounds.

### **Scouting the Opponent: Appalachian State (9-3)**

Vanderbilt is 2-0 all-time against Appalachian State with both games coming during the Kevin Stallings era ... The Commodores topped the Mountaineers, 63-48, on Dec. 22, 2003 and 68-51 on Dec. 22, 2004.

Appalachian State went to 3-0 in the Southern Conference after posting an 87-84 victory over Georgia Southern on Dec. 16.

The Mountaineers posted an 80-69 first round win over Virginia in the first round of the San Juan Shootout. Nate Cranford netted a game-high 24 points on 7-of-12 shooting, including six 3-pointers. He also hit six 3-pointers against Central Florida in the second round during Appalachian State’s 75-64 on Wednesday. D.J. Thompson leads all Mountaineers, averaging 15.8 points and 4.4 assists.

The Mountaineers are returning five starters from last year’s 14-16 squad that advanced to the semifinals of the Southern Conference Tournament.

### **Against the Southern Conference**

Vanderbilt is 39-5 (.886) all-time against teams from the Southern Conference... The Commodores dropped a 70-62 decision at home against Furman on Nov. 28. The loss was Vanderbilt’s first against the league since a 101-84 setback at Davidson on Dec. 7, 1968... Commodore Head Coach Kevin Stallings is 13-1 against current members of the Southern Conference, including a 12-1 mark while at Vanderbilt.

**More on the Tennessee Tech Win:**

Vanderbilt's win over Tennessee Tech moved the Commodores' win streak to seven games matching the second-longest win streak under eighth-year head coach Kevin Stallings. Vanderbilt won seven consecutive games during the 2004-05 campaign from Dec. 18 victory against TCU (78-55) through the win at Tennessee (88-63) on Jan. 8 ... A win over Appalachian State would give the Commodores eight consecutive wins – the longest streak since Vanderbilt won 12 straight to start the 2004 season ... Vanderbilt has forced an average of 21.7 turnovers in its last three games, including a season-high 25 against Georgia Tech ... Shan Foster (182) was 1-of-5 from 3-point range against Tennessee Tech to move to within two 3-pointers of moving past former Commodore Matt Freije (183) for seventh place on the career list ... Vanderbilt head coach Kevin Stallings (130) moved into sole possession of third place on the school list for coaching victories. Stallings passed C.M. Newton (129) after the Tennessee Tech win and ranks behind only Roy Skinner (278) and Bob Polk (197) ... Vanderbilt extended its streak of most consecutive games with a made 3-pointer to 641 games. The Commodores have made at least one 3-pointer in every game since the 3-point line was adopted prior to the 1985-86 campaign.

**General Commodore Trends:**

Vanderbilt is: 6-1 when it scores first; 8-0 when leading with five minutes remaining; 6-0 when holding its opponent under 70 points; 7-0 in December; 8-1 with the starting line up of Alex Gordon, Shan Foster, Derrick Byars, Dan Cage and Ross Neltner ... Dan Cage is shooting 46.7 percent (7-of-15) from 3-point range at the San Juan Shootout ... Ted Skuchas has made 12-of-14 field goal attempts (85.7 percent) in San Juan ... Vanderbilt has allowed an average of 61.4 points during its seven-game win streak.
