Storylines

Blazers, Commodores Clash at Memorial Gymnasium

For the fifth time in school history, UAB faces the Vanderbilt Commodores on Thursday night at Memorial Gymnasium in Nashville, Tenn. Opening tip is scheduled for 7 p.m. CT.

2-0 For First Time Since 1996-97

UAB picked up its first season-opening win since 2009-10 on Nov. 9, when the Blazers ran past Austin Peay, 72-54. Coach Audra Smith's team accomplished yet another task this past Monday when the Blazers defeated Alabama A&M, 72-53 -- that win marked the first time since 1996-97 that a UAB team has started a season at 2-0. The Blazers last went 3-0 back in 1994-95.

Chapman, Jones Lead Blazers

Senior guard Amber Jones and junior forward Karisma Chapman led UAB against Alabama A&M as each came close to setting new career highs in points scored. Jones scored 17 first-half points on her way to a game-high 23, finishing two short of her career-high of 25. Meanwhile, Chapman knocked in eight buckets for 21 points -- just four below her career-high of 25 points scored in a game.

Anderson Named Freshman of the Week

Freshman forward Kayla Anderson has made an immediate impact on the Blazer women's basketball program, garnering a Conference USA Freshman of the Week honor this past week after scoring 13 points in her UAB debut against Austin Peay. The 6-foot-1 forward scored six in the first seven minutes of that contest to jump start her team on its way to a season-opening win.

UAB Against SEC

The Blazers will play against a team from the Southeastern Conference for the 108th time in school history on Thursday. UAB is 29-78 (.271) all time against the SEC, with the program's last win coming in 2005 -- a 70-62 victory against Alabama.

UAB Notes

VETERANS LEAD EARLY ON

Senior guard Amber Jones and junior forward Karisma Chapman combined for 44 of their team's 72 points in the win against Alabama A&M on Nov. 12.

Jones finished just two points shy of her career high of 25 with 23 points on the night, while Chapman scored 21. The two also paced the Blazers on the boards with five rebounds each.

JONES FINDS THE BASKET

Senior guard Amber Jones has been a scoring threat for the Blazers since her arrival in Birmingham as a freshman in 2009. Already 19th on the school's all-time scoring list, she has racked up 1,166 points through four seasons and is within striking distance of the top 10 in school history.

Last season, Jones became the 25th Blazer ever to eclipse the 1,000-point mark for a career and just the 13th to reach the mark before her senior season. The Town Creek, Ala., product is coming off a junior season in which she averaged a career-best 12.9 points per game.

CHAPMAN DOES IT ALL

Junior forward Karisma Chapman returns in 2012-13 as one of the top all-around players in Conference USA. The Calumet City, Ill., product ranked in the top 10 in the league in scoring (13.8 ppg, 8th), steals (2.6 spg, 4th) and blocks (0.9 bpg, 9th) a season ago.

Chapman, who scored double figures in 25 of UAB's 30 games last year, led the Blazers in the points and steals categories while finishing third on the team with 5.1 rebounds per game. She already owns 132 career steals and 51 career blocks over just two seasons and can reach the top 10 in UAB history in both categories with a good junior year in 2012-13.

ANDERSON NAMED FOW

Freshman Kayla Anderson made an immediate impact in her UAB debut against Austin Peay on Nov. 9. The 6-foot-1 forward scored 13 points, including seven in the first six minutes of the game on her way to being named the C-USA Freshman of the Week.

BLAZERS PICKED THIRD IN C-USA

UAB has been picked to finish third in the Conference-USA standings this season, as voted on by the 12 league coaches. Last season, the Blazers finished league play at No. 4 in the standings.

CHAPMAN PRESEASON ALL-C-USA

A second-team all-conference selection in 2011-12, Blazer junior forward Karisma Chapman has been tabbed a Preseason All-Conference USA performer. The Calumet City, Ill., native led the Blazers in scoring (13.8 ppg) and was third on the squad in rebounding (5.1 rpg) last season.

SMITH ENTERING NINTH SEASON

The fifth coach in UAB women's basketball history and already the second-winningest, Audra Smith enters her ninth season on the bench for the Blazers in 2012-13. A former player and assistant coach at Virginia, Smith took over the UAB program in 2004.

She has coached UAB to three top-3 finishes in the Conference USA standings, two postseason berths and one Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) championship. Smith has guided the Blazers to three straight winning campaigns heading into the 2012-13 season.

HANGING THEIR HAT ON DEFENSE

Through two games on the season, UAB has held each opponent under 60 points, while forcing a combined 44 turnovers. The Blazers scored 36 points off turnovers against Austin Peay, before holding Alabama A&M to a 32-percent shooting performance, including a 25-percent clip in the first half. Coach Audra Smith's team has also made a combined 17 more shots than its two opponents.

UAB's performance on the defensive end of the floor has played a major role in its recent success. The Blazers have set school and Conference USA records for scoring defense in each of the past two seasons, allowing 55.3 points per game in 2010-11 and a remarkable 49.1 points per contest in 2011-12. Last year's scoring defense mark ranked third in the nation behind only Connecticut and Hampton.

THREE-STRAIGHT WINNING SEASONS

UAB enters the 2012-13 season looking to build on three-straight winning seasons. Dating back to 2009, the Blazers have compiled 56 wins and claimed a Women's Basketball Invitational Championship during the 2010-11 season.

Last year, the Blazers finished third in the C-USA standings -- the second-best mark in the Coach Audra Smith era. UAB finished second in the standings at the conclusion of the 2006-07 season on its way to a WNIT berth.

RETURNING TWO ALL-CONFERENCE PLAYERS

This season's UAB team features a pair of returning second-team All-Conference USA selections in senior guard Amber Jones and junior forward Karisma Chapman. Chapman, who was a C-USA All-Freshman Team selection a year earlier, also became the first UAB player ever named to the league's all-defensive team last year.

The Blazers are one of only two C-USA teams (Southern Miss is the other) to return two players named first- or second-team all-conference last season. It is the first time a Blazer team has returned multiple all-conference players from the previous year since 1995-96, when the team brought back two All-Great Midwest Conference players (Uvette Dabney and Mary Morning) for its first year of Conference USA play. Both players went on to earn all-conference honors again.

POST PLAYERS PART

The Blazers lose three players off last year's roster, including post players Meagan Brown and TaRonda Randall. The two seniors accounted for a combined nine rebounds per contest, while Randall finished her career second in school history with 113 blocks in her career. Brown finished with 73 blocks during her time at UAB -- good for fifth most in Blazer history.

BLAZERS WELCOME LARGE CROP OF NEWCOMERS

The Blazers, which carried an active roster of just nine healthy players for much of last season, will be a much deeper team in 2012-13. UAB has added eight newcomers -- seven freshmen and one junior college transfer -- to go along with seven returning players.

The incoming group features a pair of Birmingham-area products in Kayla Anderson from Hoover High School and Chelsee Black from Bessemer City High School. The other new freshmen are Schenia Battle -- a former high school teammate of Karisma Chapman -- from Calumet City, Ill., Essence Baucom from Charlotte, N.C., Khorria Newman from Irving, Texas, Dyman Webb from Flint, Mich., and Brittany Winborne from Baltimore, Md. The JUCO addition is Selma, Ala., product Ashley Grimes, who starred at Wallace Community College-Selma.

WATSON, JONES CLOSING IN ON GAMES PLAYED RECORD

Seniors Khalilah Watson and Amber Jones are on pace to approach, if not surpass, Amanda Peterson's school record for career games played. Peterson (2007-11), a former teammate of both players, saw action in 126 games as a Blazer. Heading into the 2012-13 season, Watson has played in all 97 games in her UAB career, while Jones has played in 96.

YEAR TWO FOR KLEIST, WEYNAND

The only new faces to see meaningful action on last year's team, Michaela Kleist and Kelsie Weynand are back for another year in 2011-12. Both former junior college transfers will be seniors this year.

Kleist, a forward who started 25 games in her first year with the Blazers, ranked second on the team with 5.2 rebounds per game and added 4.6 points per game. Weynand, a guard, provided UAB with some long-range shooting off the bench, connecting on 31.4 percent of her 3-point attempts (34.9 percent in league play) and contributing 4.1 points per game.

Taking a look back at 2011-12...

2011-12

The UAB women's basketball team came up just short of its postseason aspirations in 2011-12, but the Blazers still had plenty of noteworthy accomplishments on and off the court.

Picked before the season to finish sixth in Conference USA, the Blazers put together a 9-7 league mark to tie for third and then won a conference tournament game for the third straight year and advanced to the tournament semifinals for the second time in the past three seasons.

Coach Audra Smith's team also featured several individual award winners, including:

Karisma Chapman, F -- *All-Conference USA Second Team; C-USA All-Defensive Team*

Amber Jones, G -- *All-Conference USA Second Team; C-USA All-Academic Team*

TaRonda Randall, F/C -- *C-USA Spirit of Service Award; C-USA Postgraduate Scholarship*

Additionally, the Blazers had six representatives on the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll and one (Randall) who received the league's Academic Medal.

Here is a look back at some more of the accomplishments from UAB's 2011-12 season:

NO. 3 SCORING DEFENSE

UAB's scoring defense average in 2011-12 ranked as the third-best in the country. The Blazers surrendered just 49.1 points per contest and trailed only Connecticut (47.0) and Hampton (47.6) in the final NCAA statistics.

UAB held 20 of its 30 opponents to 47 points or fewer and kept four -- Western Kentucky, Hampton, Clemson and East Carolina -- below 40 points. The 36 points scored Nov. 26 by Western Kentucky and Dec. 30 by Clemson matched the fewest allowed by the Blazers since the 1994-95 season.

RECORD-BREAKING DEFENSE

UAB shattered its own school and Conference USA records for scoring defense in 2011-12. The Blazers' 49.1 points allowed per game broke the UAB and C-USA record of 55.3, set just a year earlier, by more than six full points per game.

The Blazers also blew past their own school and league records for scoring defense in conference play, limiting their C-USA opponents

to 49.6 points per game. The previous record was 56.1 points per game set by UAB's 2010-11 team.

UAB also matched the school record for fewest points allowed in a single half when the Blazers held Rice to just 11 points over the opening 20 minutes of their Jan. 5 Conference USA opener.

ONE OF THE BEST STARTS EVER

UAB finished the 2011-12 campaign at 19-11, but its 17-5 record through 22 games matched the best start in program history, joining the 1991-92 and 1993-94 teams. The 1991-92 squad went on to a 23-5 start before finishing with a 24-8 record and a WNIT appearance. The 1993-94 group also went on to start 23-5 before finishing 23-6 and playing in the NCAA tournament.

UAB's 8-2 league start last year tied for the best in its C-USA history with the 1995-96 and 2006-07 teams. The Blazers went on to finish 9-7 in league play.

JONES JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

With 11 points Jan. 26 against Tulsa, Amber Jones surpassed the 1,000-point milestone for her career. She finished her junior season with 1,131 career points.

Jones became the 25th 1,000-point scorer in program history and the 13th to accomplish the feat before her senior season.

TRIPLE THREAT

UAB got the majority of its scoring last season from a trio of players. Forward Karisma Chapman (13.8 ppg) and guards Amber Jones (12.9 ppg) and LaShaunda Pratt (11.1 ppg) combined for 67.9 percent of the team's scoring with 1,121 of the Blazers' 1,650 points for the season.

BLOCK PARTY

UAB set a school record with 140 blocked shots (4.7 per game) in 2011-12, topping the previous record of 3.4 (1998-99). Four Blazers ranked in the top 10 in C-USA in blocks per game: Meagan Brown (1.3, 7th), TaRonda Randall (1.1, 8th), Karisma Chapman (0.9, 9th) and Michaela Kleist (0.9, 10th).

UAB set a single-game school record with 12 blocked shots in the Jan. 12 win over UCF. The Blazers topped the previous best mark of 11, set during the 2010-11 season against Tulsa (2/10/11).

2012-13 Game Recaps

Game 1

UAB 72, Austin Peay 54
Friday, Nov. 9 • Bartow Arena

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – The UAB women's basketball team forced 29 Austin Peay turnovers while four Blazers scored in double figures in the 72-54 season-opening victory at Bartow Arena.

With the win, UAB moves 1-0 to start the season, while Austin Peay falls to 0-1. The Blazers also picked up their first season-opening victory since 2009-10 when they defeated Alcorn State, 76-62.

"All in all, I am proud of our performance today," head coach Audra Smith said. "This is a team that we beat by four last season, so for us to force turnovers and jump out to a lead it really speaks volumes to how far our team has come in the offseason."

UAB stormed out to an early lead in the first half, thanks in large part to freshman Kayla Anderson's eight points that helped the Blazers grab an 18-8 advantage at the 11-minute mark of the first period.

After extending its lead to 25-11 off the three-point bucket from senior guard Kelsie Weynand, UAB faced a sizable comeback from the Lady Governors as they cut six points off UAB's advantage before the Blazers took a 33-23 lead at the half.

Austin Peay failed to climb any closer the rest of the way, as the Blazers forced 19 second-half turnovers. Senior guard Amber Jones and junior forward Karisma Chapman combined for 12 points in the final period to put a stop to any Austin Peay comeback effort.

"It was very important for us to come out in the second half and play with that kind of intensity," Smith added. "Because of that, we were able to get some newcomers in the game, which is what you want to see this early in the season."

Leading the charge for the Blazer newcomers was Anderson, who scored 13 points in the contest. Meanwhile, junior forward Ashley Grimes registered six points and four rebounds in the win.

Game 2

UAB 72, Alabama A&M 53
Monday, Nov. 12 • T.M. Elmore Gym

NORMAL, Ala. - Seniors Amber Jones and Karisma Chapman combined for 44 points Monday evening as the UAB women's basketball team improved to 2-0 with a 72-53 victory against Alabama A&M at T.M. Elmore Gymnasium.

Jones, who scored a game-high 23 points, finished just two shy of her career mark of 25, while Chapman finished four behind her previous career high of 25 points with 21 on the night.

UAB established an early lead in the game and was able to maintain that advantage the rest of way. Jump starting the Blazer opening surge was the play of Jones, who scored 17 first half points.

Along with her point total in the first half, the Town Creek, Ala., native was 3-for-3 from the three-point line, including a 6-for-7 mark from the field to guide UAB to a 36-20 halftime advantage.

The Lady Bulldogs came storming back in the second half with a tough defensive effort in the final 20 minutes. In fact, Alabama A&M held the Blazers to just seven points in the first six minutes of the final period, before pulling to within 12 at the 9:57 mark.

Up 48-36, UAB was able to pull away in the final 10 minutes for the 72-53 victory.

The Blazers finished the game with another strong defensive performance, holding the Lady Bulldogs to a 32-percent shooting performance for the game and an 0-4 clip from behind the arc.

As a team, UAB shot 51 percent for the game, including a 16-for-20 mark at the free-throw line and a 4-for-8 performance from behind the three-point line.



Audra Smith

Head Coach • Ninth Season • Virginia, 1992

In her eight seasons at the helm of the UAB women's basketball program, Audra Smith has turned the Blazers into one of the top squads in Conference USA, while continuing to increase their national recognition.

The Blazers, under Smith's direction, are coming off three straight winning seasons and the program's best two-year stretch in a decade. Her team capped a 20-15 season in 2010-11 with the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) championship and followed that with a 19-11 campaign in 2011-12.

UAB's third-place finish in the 2011-12 Conference USA standings marked its third top-3 finish in the past six seasons under Smith. Prior to her arrival before the 2004-05 season, the Blazers had finished that high in the C-USA standings only once.

The WBI championship in 2011 was the first-ever postseason title for the UAB women's basketball team, which won its first three tournament games on the road before coming home to defeat Cal State Bakersfield in the title game. The victory in the finals secured the Blazers' first 20-win season since the 2000-01 campaign.

It was UAB's second postseason appearance under Smith, who guided the Blazers to the second round of the WNIT following a breakout 2006-07 season. UAB went 19-13 that year, posted its best-ever Conference USA record (12-4) and managed its highest C-USA finish (second).

Smith has also led the Blazers to Conference USA tournament success recently with the Blazers winning at least one tournament game in each of the past three seasons, advancing to the finals in 2010 and reaching the semifinals in 2012. The 2010 team became the first No. 6 seed in the league's history to make the championship game.

Smith has coached her share of standout players in Birmingham, including two honorable mention All-Americans -- Carmen Guzman (2006-07) and Diamond Rogers (2007-08). Guzman, who was developed and polished under Smith and her staff, became just the second Conference USA Player of the Year in program history and was also invited to the WNBA Pre-Draft Camp.

Numerous players under Smith's guidance have taken home postseason honors from Conference USA, including: Nine All-Conference USA selections: Guzman (2005-06, 2006-07), Rogers (2006-07, 2007-08), Crystal McFadden (2007-08), Britney Jones (2008-09), Jala Harris (2009-10), Karisma Chapman (2011-12) and Amber Jones (2011-12).

Three C-USA Sixth Player of the Year winners: Britney Jones (2006-07), Amanda Peterson (2007-08) and Harris (2009-10).

Four C-USA All-Freshman Team members: Britney Jones (2005-06), Peterson (2007-08), Harris (2009-10), who was also chosen as the league's freshman of the year, and Chapman (2010-11).

Harris became the first player in C-USA history to earn the top freshman and sixth player awards in the same season, while Peterson wrapped

up her career as the all-time leading 3-point shooter in the history of UAB basketball, men's or women's. She hit 319 treys for her career, including a league-record 103 as a senior.

Peterson was also highly decorated academically as a three-time member of the Conference USA All-Academic Team and a two-time C-USA Scholar-Athlete of the Year for women's basketball. Amber Jones became the fourth all-academic team selection under Smith in 2011-12.

Smith has coached a total of 39 Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll selections at UAB, including 25 over the past three seasons. She has also mentored eight C-USA Commissioner's Academic Medal recipients.

Named the fifth head coach in UAB women's basketball history on April 7, 2004, Smith owns an overall record of 120-125 with the Blazers.

Her first team in 2004-05 battled through a challenging season with seven players missing a combined 106 games. Only three Blazers played in all 28 contests as the team finished with a 7-21 record.

But Smith quickly turned things around, coaching the Blazers to their first .500 season in five years with a 14-14 mark in 2005-06 before breaking through with the 19-13, WNIT campaign in 2006-07.

The 2007-08 team worked its way through a tough non-conference schedule and, despite a 14-16 overall record, finished third in the conference race with a 10-6 league mark.

Following a 10-20 season in 2008-09, Smith's Blazers began their active streak of three consecutive winning campaigns. UAB is averaging 18.7 wins per year over that stretch, going 17-15 in 2009-10, 20-15 in 2010-11 and 19-11 in 2011-12.

Before arriving at UAB, Smith spent 14 years under Debbie Ryan at Virginia as a player and assistant coach. She was associated with the Cavalier women's basketball program for 10 years as a coach and four as a player.

"I am so excited," Smith said upon her hiring. "I could tell when I came here that the administration is very serious about the success of the women's basketball program. That was apparent. The program at UAB has experienced success in the past and my goal is to get back to that level and beyond."

After finishing her playing career at Virginia in 1992 and graduating with a degree in sociology, Smith worked as a child and adolescent counselor and as a social worker with the Department of Family and Children Services in her hometown of Milledgeville, Ga., before joining the Cavaliers' coaching staff in 1994 as the restricted earnings coach.

After two years, she was elevated to a full-time position, assisting with player development of the guards and working extensively in recruiting and scouting. In May of 2000, she was promoted to recruiting coordinator and helped Virginia attract four recruiting classes rated among the nation's top 20.

As an assistant coach, Smith helped Virginia to the NCAA tournament in nine consecutive seasons (1995-2003), the Sweet 16 four times (1995-97, 2000) and the Elite Eight twice (1995-96). Seventeen Cavalier players were

named to the ACC Academic Honor Roll a total of 28 times while she was there.

As a player, she was a four-year letterwinner and a member of a Cavalier program that competed in three consecutive Final Fours (1990-92). Virginia reached the championship game in 1991, falling 70-67 in overtime to Tennessee.

Smith played for a Virginia squad that won a pair of ACC tournament titles (1990 and 1992) and started a streak of six straight ACC regular-season championships for the program from 1991-96. She was a part of the first two of those championships as a player and the last two as an assistant. She was also an assistant on Virginia's 2000 ACC title team.

An honorable mention high school All-American at Baldwin High in Milledgeville, Smith was named Miss Georgia Basketball in 1988. She led Baldwin to three consecutive Georgia AAAA state championships (1986-88) and was named the MVP of the state tournament as a junior in 1987.

Smith, 40, is married to former Virginia basketball player Anthony Oliver and has a son, A.J. (13) and a daughter, Adria (12). She has been a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association since 1994 and the Black Coaches Association since 2002.
