Tim Corbin became the 21st head baseball coach in Vanderbilt history in June, 2003.

In six seasons at Vanderbilt, Tim Corbin has turned Vanderbilt into one of the national powers of college baseball.

Vanderbilt reached its third straight NCAA tournament in 2008 and won 40 games for the second straight season, both firsts for the program.

In 2007, Corbin guided the Commodores to their best season ever, finishing with a school record 54 wins. The team also achieved a No. 1 national ranking for the first time in school history and held that honor for 13 of 15 weeks during the regular season.

The Vanderbilt baseball team also swept through the Southeastern Conference, winning both the regular season and tournament crown for the first time ever, and it marked the first time an SEC team had done it since 1996. The team lost only one conference series the entire season against SEC West Division winner Arkansas in Fayetteville and avenged the series loss by defeating the Razorbacks in the SEC tournament title game.

The conference recognized Corbin for the work he had done, naming him SEC Coach of the Year. Corbin also picked up Co-National Coach of the Year by College Baseball Insider and regional coach of the year honors by the American Baseball Coaches Association.

The Commodores hosted their first ever NCAA regional as the No. 1 National Seed and arrived as a power in college baseball.

Roy Mewbourne
Vanderbilt Head Coach

A fixture around Vanderbilt baseball for nearly a quarter century, Roy Mewbourne retired following the 2002 campaign, ending his career as the Commodores' all-time winningest skipper and one of most successful coaches in collegiate baseball history. The native of Birmingham, Ala., compiled a 655-608-9 mark in 24 seasons at Vanderbilt, and finished his 30-year coaching tenure with a 922-683-9 overall record.

In his final season as Vanderbilt's head coach, Mewbourne achieved several personal milestones, most notably becoming the 35th coach in college baseball history to reach the 900-win plateau. He registered his 900th career win against West Virginia (2/16) and his 650th victory at Vanderbilt against Mississippi State (4/28). The win over the Bulldogs also came in Mewbourne's 1,600th game as a collegiate head coach.

At the start of the season, the then-56-year-old skipper also saw his dream of a new stadium become a reality with the unveiling of Hawkins Field. A catalyst in the stadium's construction, Mewbourne played a vital role in fund-raising, planning and oversight for the \$5.8 million facility.

Mewbourne fielded some outstanding teams in his Vanderbilt tenure, highlighted by his 1980 squad that captured the SEC Championship, which earned him SEC Coach of the Year honors.

He coached 19 all-Americans, 19 all-SEC honorees and 59 players who signed professional baseball contracts. 111 Commodores earned SEC Academic honors, including a school record 16 in 2002.

Larry Schmittou arrived at Vanderbilt in 1968 and immediately changed the mindset of Commodore baseball in the Music City. After combining for 13 total wins the previous three seasons, he guided VU to eight wins his first year, 12 in 1969 and 24 in 1970.

In 1971, Vanderbilt broke through with a 34-19 record and won the SEC Eastern Division with an 11-5 record. That would be the first of four consecutive division crowns for the Commodores. In 1973 and 1974, the Commodores swept Alabama, 2-0, in a pair of best-of-three series for the overall SEC championship earning him SEC Coach of the Year honors. He coached 20 All-SEC, eight All-SEC East, eight All-South Region, and seven Academic All-SEC. He had 21 players in Major League Baseball with 14 of those players taken in the draft.

Schmittou retired following the 1978 campaign after 11 years as the Vanderbilt head coach. He amassed a 306-252-1 overall record and a 98-98 mark in Southeastern Conference play.

During the time Schmittou roamed the dugout at McGugin Field, Vanderbilt won more games than any other SEC school and was one of only two schools to win four divisional titles.

Upon his retirement as Vanderbilt's head coach, Schmittou acquired the rights to a Southern League expansion franchise team, the Nashville Sounds.






