DEFINITION OF BOOSTER/REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETIC INTERESTS

NCAA Bylaw 13.02.14

A “representative of the institution’s athletics interests” is an individual, independent agency, corporation entity (e.g., apparel or equipment manufacturer) or other organization who is known (or who have been known) by a member of the institution’s executive or athletics administration to:

- a) Have Participated in or to be a member of an agency organization promoting the institution’s intercollegiate athletics program;
- b) Have made financial contributions to the athletics department or to an athletics booster organization of that institution;
- c) Be assisting or to have been requested (by the athletics department staff) to assist in the recruitment of prospective student-athletes
- d) Be assisting or to have assisted in providing benefits to enrolled student-athletes or to their families; or
- e) Have been involved otherwise in promoting the institution’s athletics program.
