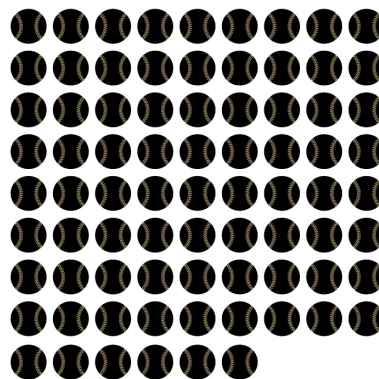

The Vanderbilt Athletic Communications Office welcomes your interest in the Vanderbilt baseball team. We will make every effort to meet your needs throughout the season.

The following is information and guidelines to help you during the season and allow Vanderbilt coaches and players to adhere to their schedules.

Vanderbilt Athletic Communications

Vanderbilt Assistant Director of Athletic Communications Kyle Parkinson is the media contact for baseball. He can be contacted in the office (615) 343-0020 or via e-mail at kyle.parkinson@vanderbilt.edu. The Vanderbilt Athletic Communications office is located directly across the street from Hawkins Field on the second floor of the McGugin Center in room 225.

Press and Photo Credentials

Requests for press and photo credentials can be made via email or mail at least one week prior to the desired game or series. Requests should be directed to Kyle Parkinson. All credentials will be available at media will call located at the front entrance of Hawkins Field.

Interview Policy

All Vanderbilt coaches and players will be available throughout the season for interviews with members of the media prior to practice. Requests for interviews should be made through Kyle Parkinson. Post-game interviews with Coach Corbin and requested players may be conducted after a mandatory 10-minute cooling off period on the field in front of the Vanderbilt dugout.

Practice Policy

Vanderbilt baseball practices are open to the media and the public. Practice starts at approximately 3 p.m. Tuesday - Friday (Monday is an off day). Media members are encouraged to arrive at Hawkins Field by 2 p.m. to conduct interviews prior to practice. Members of the media need to notify Kyle Parkinson in advance with their interview request(s).

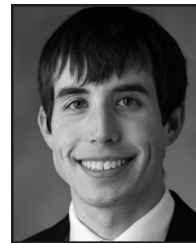
