2006 Review

When the 2006 baseball season opened in February, the Vanderbilt coaching staff did not know how the season would play out and how this team would perform. That is understandable, considering that only three position starters returned from last year and that the club was full of talented, yet unproven players. The team struggled out of the gate, but by the time the season had ended, had developed into a cohesive unit that will carry high expectations into the 2007 campaign.

The Commodores had their moments in the non-conference portion of the slate, finishing with an 11-6 record prior to the opening of SEC play. They started the conference season with series wins over Mississippi, Auburn and Florida and stood at 7-2 in the league (20-9 overall). They rose as high as 12th in the national polls heading into a home weekend series against Arkansas. The Dores lost two tight contests to the Razorbacks, but rebounded the next weekend with a series victory over Georgia to stand at 10-5 and in a tie for first place in the SEC East at the halfway point of the conference slate.

The young Vanderbilt team then had its struggles to start the second half of SEC play with consecutive series losses to Alabama, Kentucky and Tennessee and stood at 12-12 in league play heading into a key series against LSU.

The Commodores led the Tigers for most of the game before giving up three runs in the final two innings to lose 4-3. At this point they had five league games left and stood under .500 in SEC play for the first time all year.

The gritty young team came together after that game and destroyed LSU 19-4 in the second game of the series, handing the Tigers their worst conference home loss in school history. They finished LSU off the next day and then took two of three against South Carolina to finish the regular season with a 33-23 overall record and sixth place finish in the SEC. Vandy's offense continued to roll through the first two rounds of the SEC tournament as the team outscored Georgia and South Carolina 20-5 to move into the semifinals. After Georgia rallied to defeat the Commodores 5-4 in the first semifinal matchup. VU came back to pound the Bulldogs 11-1 in a run-rule seven inning contest and advanced to the championship game for the second time in three seasons. The Commodores ran out of gas against a rested Ole Miss club that swept through the tourney field with a 9-3 win in the tourney finale.

Vanderbilt posted two wins over Michigan in the NCAA Atlanta Regional and advanced to the championship round for the second time under head coach Tim Corbin. A deep and talented Georgia Tech squad proved to be too much as they beat the Commodores twice to win the regional. VU ended the year with a 38-27 mark, the second most wins in school history.

"The first lesson was getting to the regional and playing in somebody else's ballpark," said Tim Corbin. "This is the first time any of these kids have been to a regional. We have to go further than this. This is a tough place to play and a tough team to play. We want to get this program to the Super Regional and to the College World Series. I am proud of all that we accomplished and I think it was a good year."

The Commodores struggled offensively in the month of February, posting a .208 team batting average in the first eight games of the year. As the players became more experienced and confident at the collegiate level, those numbers gradually climbed throughout the year. Vanderbilt finished the year with a .308 batting average, third best in the Southeastern Conference and fourth best in school history. In fact every starter on offense finished the year with a .300 average or better.

The pitching staff had some stellar performances along the way including a school record 38.2 consecutive innings scoreless streak during the middle part of the season. Sophomore southpaw David Price established himself as one of the top pitchers in the country with dominating performances throughout the year. He was a three-time National Pitcher of the

Week award winner and also picked up the SEC Pitcher of the Week award four times, including a conference record three straight times. Price finished the year with a 9-5 ledger, with a school single season record 155 strikeouts in 110.1 innings pitched. The Murfreesboro native was invited to play for Team USA for the second straight year and was a Golden Spikes Award finalist and Roger Clemens Award semifinalist.

Overall, the staff sported a 4.18 ERA with a school record 574 strikeouts in 579.1 innings pitched.

The Vanderbilt freshman duo of third baseman Pedro Alvarez and Ryan Flaherty helped lead the offensive attack throughout the year and were rewarded with postseason honors. Alvarez was named Collegiate Baseball's National Freshman Player of the Year after hitting .329 with a school single season record 22 homers and 64 RBI. He was the first Commodore ever to receive the national honor. In addition, Alvarez was a clutch performer in conference and postseason play as he was named SEC Freshman of the Year, All-SEC First Team at third and made both all-tourney teams at the SEC and NCAA Atlanta Regional fields.

Flaherty was named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball after batting a team high .339 on the year with 19 doubles and 49 RBI. The Maine native was a versatile performer having played 39 games at first base and 19 games at short, including the last 15 games of the year. Vanderbilt loses two veteran stalwarts who were calming presences to both the players and the coaching staff. Senior pitcher Matt Buschmann, the team's SEC Good Works Team Member, finished the year 6-4 with a 3.95 ERA. He was named to the NCAA Atlanta Regional all-tournament team after pitching a complete game win over Michigan on June 2. His 23 career wins were the fourth most in school history and he was a 15th round selection of the San Diego Padres.

Senior catcher Brian Hernandez started in 64 of the Commodores 65 games and hit .302 with 21 doubles (tied for fifth best in a single season at VU) and 43 RBI. The Florida native made the most of his two years at Vanderbilt after transferring from Duke and will join Buschmann in the Padres organization as he was drafted in the 19th round.

The excitement for next year can be found in the starting lineup for the Commodores in the championship game of the Atlanta Regional. All eight position players return with a wealth of experience and knowledge of what it takes to get to the next level. With a talented crew of players, combined with a tireless coaching staff that is focused on winning, the future of Vanderbilt baseball looks as good as it ever has been.
