# Commodore Honors

## Jeff Peeples Most Valuable Player Award 2006 Recipient – Pedro Alvarez

Freshman third baseman jumped on to the national scene as the National Freshman of the Year and is the 2006 Jeff Peeples Most Valuable Player Award winner.

Alvarez blasted a school record 22 homers with 64 RBI en route to first team All-American honors by *Baseball America*. He was a first team All-SEC selection by the coaches and the conference Freshman of the Year as well. The New York City product also fared well in the classroom earning SEC Freshman Honor Roll plaudits.

The award pays tribute to Jeff Peeples, who was a four-year letterwinner at Vanderbilt from 1970-73. He was a three-time All-Southeastern Conference selection who helped guide the Commodores to three SEC Tournaments and the 1972 SEC Championship. Peeples was one of only two pitchers in SEC history to lead the league in earned run average for two consecutive years (1971-72). He also led the conference in victories (12) and strikeouts (113) in 1973. Peeples still holds Vanderbilt career records for wins (29) and earned run average (1.68). He went on to play professionally for the St. Louis Cardinals and was inducted into the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame in spring 2001.

Hunter Bledsoe, a first baseman from Kingsport, Tenn., was named the 1999 Southeastern Conference Player of the Year after one of the most impressive seasons in school history.

Bledsoe led the conference, and ranked sixth nationally, with a .459 batting average – a mark that is tied for fourth in league history. He also led the SEC with a .552 on-base percentage.

Additionally, he broke the Vanderbilt single-season record for hits (95), while posting 10 home runs, 51 RBI, 24 doubles and 31 stolen bases. Bledsoe led all Commodore hitters in 10 offensive categories and ranked among the SEC's top 10 in doubles (third), slugging percentage (third), stolen bases (fifth) and hits (seventh).

For his efforts, he was named first team All-America by *Collegiate Baseball* and was also selected to the GTE Academic All-America team, the SEC Academic Honor Roll and the SEC Good Works. He was also selected to the NCAA Today's Top VIII.

His career batting average of .425 ranks first in Vanderbilt history and second in SEC history.

He led the 1997 squad with a .389 batting average and ranked second with 10 stolen bases.

He graduated in 2000 with a degree in Engineering Science and Economics before spending four years in professional baseball.



## Vanderbilt and USA Baseball

Over the last decade Vanderbilt has been represented extremely well on various USA Baseball Teams. Last season the Commodores had a squad high three players on the team that won a gold medal at the FISU World University Championships in Havana, Cuba.

### Ryan Mullins (Years at Vanderbilt: 2003-2005)

USA National Team (Summer, 2004)

Mullins was one of five pitchers who combined to throw the first no-hitter in USA Baseball recorded history (since 1984) as the US A National Baseball Team defeated Canada, 9-0, at Durham Bulls Athletic Park June 24, 2004. Mullins went 2.1 innings facing eight batters and striking out one.

### David Price (Years at Vanderbilt: 2005-present)

USA National Team (Summer, 2005-06)

Price was the ace of the 2006 USA Baseball National Team's Gold Medal Winning squad that competed at the FISU World University Championships in Cuba. Finished 5-1 with a 0.20 ERA in eight starts with 61 strikeouts and only seven walks in 44.0 innings. Baseball America tabbed his their Summer Player of the Year and the No. 1 pro prospect on the Team USA. Price was named a Summer All-American by *Baseball America* after a solid summer for Team USA. He went 2-0 with a 1.26 ERA in five games with 39 strikeouts and 13 walks in 28.2 innings. Price capped off his summer experience with a complete game five-hit shutout over Nicaragua on Aug. 2.

### Pedro Alvarez (Years at Vanderbilt: 2006-present)

USA National Team (Summer, 2006)

Alvarez followed right behind his teammate Price and was named the second best prospect on the National Team by *Baseball America*. He showed no-ill effects with the wood bat and led the all-star contingent with a .379 batting average to go along with five homers, 12 doubles and 43 RBI.

### Casey Weathers (Years at Vanderbilt: 2006-present)

USA National Team (Summer, 2006)

Weathers was a late addition to the squad after dominating in the Alaska Summer League where he was named closer of the year. He finished his USA stint with an appearance in the gold medal game against Chinese Taipei. He pitched a total of nine innings in seven games and notched 17 strikeouts.

### Tim Corbin (Years at Vanderbilt: 2003-present)

USA National Team (2006- Head Coach, 2000- Assistant Coach)


Corbin guided the National Team to its best record ever as the team went 28-2-1 over the summer, culminating with a gold medal at the World University Championships in Havana, Cuba.

In 2000, Southern Cal head coach Mike Gillespie served as head coach and chose Tim Corbin as an assistant for his staff. That group won a gold medal at the World Championships in the Netherlands.
