Commodores Claim First SEC Tournament Championship Since 1951

Vanderbilt defeated eventual national champion Kentucky, 71-64, in the SEC Tournament Championship in New Orleans on March 11 to win its first SEC Tournament championship since 1951, ending a 60-year drought.

Three Commodores Drafted In First 31 Picks of NBA Draft

History was made for Vanderbilt basketball on NBA Draft night, when Festus Ezeli, John Jenkins, and Jeffery Taylor each heard their names called at the Prudential Center in Newark, N.J., at the 2012 NBA Draft. It marks the first time the Commodores have had three picks in the first two rounds of the draft, and with John Jenkins being selected as the 23rd pick by the Atlanta Hawks, it was the first time since 1988 that a Vanderbilt player was chosen in the first round (Will Perdue).

Ezeli was chosen 30th, the final pick of the first round, by the Golden State Warriors, while Taylor was picked one pick later at 31 by the Charlotte Bobcats.

All Five Starters Depart From 2011-12

Besides the three NBA draftees, the Commodores also saw the departure of senior point guard Brad Tinsley, who ended his career second all-time on Vanderbilt's assist list, and starting four-man Lance Goulbourne, who averaged 8.7 points and a team-high 6.9 rebounds per game. The Commodores also lost senior sixth man Steve Tchiengang.

In all, 88% of Vanderbilt's total point production must be replaced in 2012-13.

Stallings Closing In On Becoming All-Time Winningest Vanderbilt Coach

Vanderbilt head coach Kevin Stallings, who is in his 14th season as Commodore head coach, has 261 career victories with the Black and Gold, and trails all-time coaching leader Roy Skinner by only 17 wins (278 career wins). Stallings' record as Vanderbilt head coach is 261-159.

Stallings' Success

After the 2011-12 campaign, Coach Stallings has had seven 20-win seasons in the last eight, with six NCAA tournament appearances and two Sweet 16's (2004 and 2007). Stallings has the most 20-win campaigns in Vanderbilt history, and is the first Commodore coach to lead Vanderbilt to three consecutive NCAA Tournaments (2010, 2011, 2012).

Win Totals

Vanderbilt's 25 wins in 2011-12 was the most since the 2007-08 season and the second-most win total since the 1992-93 season. Additionally, the Commodores' seven 20-win seasons in the last nine years is only third to Florida, who has had nine, and Kentucky, who has had eight. Other school totals: Miss. St. (6), Tennessee (5), Ole Miss (4), S. Carolina (4), LSU (3), Alabama (3), Arkansas (3), Auburn (1), Georgia (1).

International Presence

The Commodores are represented by three countries on this year's roster - the United States, Cameroon (James Siakam), and Germany (Kevin Bright) - to continue Vanderbilt's line of foreign players. VU has had a player from outside of the United States on its roster for every season dating back to the 1996-97 campaign. The countries represented in the last 16 years (Ivory Coast, Poland, Austria, England, Australia, Cameroon, Nigeria, Sweden, Germany).

3-Point Streak Continues Through 26th Season; VU One Of Three Teams To Hit A Trey In Every Game Since 1986-87 Season

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 832 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank second only to UNLV for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented.

Individual Notes

- Jenkins led the SEC in scoring for the second consecutive season for the first time since 1996 and 1997. Jenkins was named a first-team All-SEC selection and a third-team Associated Press All-American.
- Taylor was also a first-team All-SEC selection. Jenkins and Taylor's selection to the first team was the first time the Commodores had two players on the first team since 1989, when Barry Goheen and Frank Kornet were selected.
- Taylor leaves Vanderbilt has the school's second all-time leading scorer, behind Shan Foster, with 1,897 career points.
- Jenkins' 696 points is second all-time on Vanderbilt's single season scoring list, behind Billy McCaffrey's 699 points in the 1992-93 season.
- Ezeli is now the Commodores' all-time leading career shot blocker with 207. He surpassed former VU great Will Perdue in his senior season (157).

NASHVILLE - The Xavier Musketeers have lots of experience. They also have experienced guards in senior Tu Holloway and junior Mark Lyons.

They sure know how to take over a game at the right time.

Holloway scored 10 of his 24 points in overtime after Lyons tied it up in the final seconds of regulation, and No. 11 Xavier rallied from 10 down to beat 20th-ranked Vanderbilt 82-70.

Xavier trailed by as much as 10. The Musketeers scored the final four points of regulation, including Lyons' short jumper with 6.5 seconds left to force overtime. Wells hit two free throws, and Holloway knocked down two 3-pointers to cap a 12-0 run ending with 2:27 remaining in overtime that put Xavier up 74-66.

John Jenkins led Vanderbilt with 20 points. Lance Goulbourne and Jeffery Taylor had 18 apiece. The Commodores went cold after Jenkins' 3 with 3:56 left put Vandy up 66-62. They didn't score again until Jenkins' jumper with 2:17 left in overtime, but coach Kevin Stallings was more disappointed in his Commodores turning the ball over 18 times.

"Turnovers are generally careless or selfish," Stallings said. "Neither of those has anything to do with the other team."

Notes

- ★ Vanderbilt played its first overtime game of the season against Xavier - VU played three in 2010-11, and was 0-3 in those games.
- ★ The Commodores were outrebounded 54-33, and outscored 15-9 in second-chance points.
- ★ Xavier shot 37.8% from the floor, Vanderbilt's best defensive performance of the season.
- ★ XU (20-27) shot 15 more free throws than Vanderbilt (9-12).
- ★ Former four-year Vanderbilt player Andre Walker, now a graduate student at Xavier, had a career-high 14 rebounds.
- ★ Jenkins (20), Goulbourne (18), and Taylor (18) were the only VU players in double figures - the next highest scorer was Brad Tinsley with four points.
- ★ Tinsley had a season-high seven assists.
- ★ Goulbourne's 18 points tied a career high.

LOUISVILLE - John Jenkins twice gave Vanderbilt leads late. The 20th-ranked Commodores found a way to lose them both.

Jenkins scored 27 points, but Peyton Siva drove through the middle of Vanderbilt's defense for a layup with 1.4 seconds left to rally No. 6 Louisville over the Commodores 62-60 in overtime.

Jenkins finished 9 of 15 from the field and 5 of 11 from 3-point range as the Commodores (5-3) took a nine-point lead midway through the second half and a five-point lead in overtime. They couldn't hold on to either.

Jenkins' jumper gave the Commodores a 43-34 lead, but Jeffery Taylor made a steal and missed a layup that would've pushed it to double digits.

Louisville answered with a 13-4 run that ended with Shane Behanan's steal and slam that tied it with 2:28 left. With the game tied again in the closing seconds, Siva drove the clock down near halfcourt, then drove into the lane around Taylor and found Behanan down low.

Behanan took the ball to the floor once to slice across the lane, but missed the shot off the backboard and rim and slumped down in frustration at failing to hit the winner.

Jenkins scored the first five points of overtime, but Louisville rallied again.

Behanan answered with a three-point play. After the two teams traded a pair of free throws, Kyle Kuric, who finished with 15 points, hit a 3-pointer that gave Louisville a 58-57 lead.

Brad Tinsley tied it with a free throw before Kuric hit a jumper that set up the final sequence when Jenkins hit two free throws and Siva easily passed Lance Goulbourne down the lane, hitting a finger-roll layup with 1.4 seconds left.

Notes

- ★ The loss was Vanderbilt's second consecutive overtime defeat after falling to Xavier earlier in the week in overtime, 82-70, and the fifth straight overtime loss dating back to the beginning of the 2010-11 campaign.
- ★ John Jenkins led the Commodores with 27 points, his fourth 20-point game of the season and 24th of his career.

COLUMBIA, S.C. - It's been two Southeastern Conference games and two lights-out shooting performances from Vanderbilt and the league's leading scorer John Jenkins.

Jenkins had all but two of his 14 points in the second half and four of Vanderbilt's 13 3-pointers as the Commodores built a 24-point lead before holding on to defeat South Carolina 67-57. It was Vanderbilt's sixth straight win and second consecutive SEC blow-out after a 65-35 win over Auburn to start league play last Saturday.

"I sure hope so" Jenkins said when asked if the on-target, long-range barrage can continue throughout the SEC season. "We work hard at it every day. It's good to see the hard work pay off."

Even if it took a half to truly get it going.

The Commodores (12-4, 2-0 SEC) had only 15 attempts and were held to 22 points in the opening period. Still, their defense and South Carolina's struggles from the outside gave them a 22-12 lead at the break. Jenkins, who had just a bucket the first 20 minutes, found his shooting touch with two wide-open 3's that were part of 24-13 run as Vanderbilt took control of things. The Commodores led by 24 points before South Carolina's 14-0 run the final 4 minutes made the game look closer than it really was.

Vanderbilt finished 13 of 22 from behind the arc against South Carolina after a 13 of 29 long-range performance in the Auburn win. Jenkins went 5 of 8 on 3-pointers and scored 17 points against the Tigers.

Brad Tinsley had 13 points, three 3-pointers and nine assists for the Commodores. Jeffery Taylor had 11 points and Steve Tchiengang added 10 for Vanderbilt.

Bruce Ellington had 20 points to lead the Gamecocks (8-8, 0-2).

NASHVILLE - The Vanderbilt Commodores have proven time and again how well they can shoot the ball, especially beyond the arc. Now they are showing they can win a bit ugly, too.

John Jenkins scored 18 points, hitting all nine of his free throws, and Jeffery Taylor added 16 points as Vanderbilt held off Georgia 77-66. It's the Commodores' seventh straight win and keeps them undefeated in Southeastern Conference play along with only No. 2 Kentucky.

Vanderbilt coach Kevin Stallings credited his team's experience with four senior starters for helping pull out this victory.

"Not a thing of beauty, but over the course of 16 games it's not going to be pretty all the time," Stallings said. "So we won one that was a little ugly today, and we'll take it."

The Commodores (13-4, 3-0) didn't lead by more than six until Lance Goulbourne grabbed a rebound off Festus Ezeli's missed free throw and laid it back up for a 68-60 lead with 2:58 left. Vanderbilt sealed this victory at the free-throw line where the Commodores hit 15 of 22 in the final 4:53.

Vanderbilt wound up outbounding Georgia 35-27 and had a big edge at the free-throw line (30 of 44) compared to Georgia (16 of 20). It was Vandy's most free throws made and attempted since going 35 of 45 on Dec. 4, 2010, in a win over Belmont.

Georgia (9-8, 0-3) never went away in losing its third straight overall and fifth straight in this series. Vincent Williams hit a 3 to pull the Bulldogs within 62-60, but they never got any closer. Kantavious Caldwell-Pope had a team-high 19 points, including four 3-pointers.

The result was another double-digit win that threatened to get really lopsided. John Jenkins had 20 points and Jeffery Taylor scored 17 to help the Commodores beat the Crimson Tide 69-59 for their eighth straight win.

NASHVILLE - Rick Stansbury drew up a play in the huddle, something his Mississippi State Bulldogs hadn't used this season. He saw Vanderbilt overplaying Dee Bost, and his senior guard made it work.

Bost scored on a layup with 51.8 seconds left in overtime and No. 18 Mississippi State edged Vanderbilt 78-77, snapping the Commodores' eight-game winning streak.

The Bulldogs (16-4, 3-2 Southeastern Conference) won in Memorial Gym for the first time since 2004 and snapped their own three-game skid in Nashville. They appeared headed toward another loss after trailing 39-28 at halftime.

Vanderbilt (14-5, 4-1) had plenty of chances to extend its winning streak but missed three shots after Bost's layup, the last a 3-point attempt by John Jenkins that hit the front of the rim just before the buzzer.

Bost scored 24 points, Steele finished with 15, and Arnett Moultrie had his 11th double-double with 21 points and 14 rebounds.

Jenkins led Vanderbilt with 21 points, Jeffery Taylor had 19, and Festus Ezeli had 12 points and 14 rebounds. Lance Goulbourne added 12 points with a career-high four 3s.

In a game featuring four of the SEC's top scorers - and with 16 NBA scouts watching - these teams put on a show from beyond the arc. The Bulldogs hit nine of 10 after halftime, while Vanderbilt was 14 of 27 overall - its most 3s since hitting 15 against Mississippi State on March 5, 2008.

FAYETTEVILLE- Arkansas picked the right time to start draining 3-pointers.

Ricky Scott scored 18 points and the Razorbacks equaled their Southeastern Conference-best with nine 3s in pulling away to an 82-74 victory over No. 25 Vanderbilt on Tuesday night.

Five players scored in double figures for the Razorbacks (16-6, 4-3), who improved to 16-0 in Bud Walton Arena this season. Julysses Nobles added 17 points for Arkansas.

The Commodores (16-6, 5-2) led 40-37 in the second half before Arkansas' Hunter Mickelson tied the game with a 3-pointer. That started a stretch where the Razorbacks hit six of seven field goals from behind the arc and took a 59-46 lead.

Vanderbilt, which was led by John Jenkins' 19 points, was unable to get closer than seven points after that.

Jeffery Taylor added 18 points for the Commodores, while Festus Ezeli had 14 and Steve Tchiengang 10.

Arkansas equaled the best start to open a season since the 1993-94 national championship team had the same home mark for the entire season. Only that team and the 1997-98 team have gone undefeated at home since the arena opened in 1993.

The Razorbacks entered Tuesday night with home wins over two ranked teams already this season: then-No. 15 Mississippi State and then-No. 20 Michigan. They used big first-half runs in both of those wins, but didn't follow that script in falling behind 34-32 at halftime to the Commodores.

This time, Arkansas pulled away in the second half with its 3-point barrage against a Vanderbilt team that had won 11 of 12.

Notes

- ★ The loss to Arkansas snapped a four-game road winning streak. Vanderbilt's last loss on the road was at Louisville on December 2 (60-62, OT). The Commodores moved to 4-2 in true road contests in 2011-12.
- ★ Vanderbilt shot 50% from the floor for the second consecutive game and dropped its first game of the season when shooting 50% or better. VU has a 7-1 record in games when it surpasses the 50% barrier from the floor.

Of course, it helps when the Gators are making 3-pointers and forcing turnovers.

Kenny Boynton scored 18 points, Bradley Beal added 16 and No. 12 Florida beat No. 25 Vanderbilt 73-65 Saturday for its seventh consecutive victory.

The Gators (19-4, 7-1 Southeastern Conference) won for the second time in about 36 hours, improving to 5-0 on two-day turnarounds this season. They are 6-1 in Saturday games that follow Thursday night affairs in the three years the SEC has scheduled those. The latest one had everything to do with 3-pointers and turnovers.

Florida made 11 of 24 shots from behind the arc and forced Vanderbilt into 17 turnovers, most of them coming in the press.

Vanderbilt (16-7, 5-3) had been able to overcome turnovers issues in recent weeks, winning at Marquette, at South Carolina and at Alabama with at least 17 turnovers. No such luck in Gainesville. The Commodores had their hands full defending Boynton and Beal, too.

The guards came up huge in the second half. Beal scored 14 points after the break. Boynton drained a 3-pointer with 1:10 remaining after the Commodores made it a four-point game and then sank two free throws with 25.9 seconds left to seal Florida's 19th consecutive victory at home.

Erving Walked scored 11 points for Florida, and Mike Rosario had 10 off the bench.

Jeffery Taylor led the Commodores with 25 points. John Jenkins, the league's leading scorer, added 15.

- ★ Vanderbilt trailed at the half, 37-34, only the second time this season VU has trailed at the midway point. The game against Cleveland State was the only other time this year (24-37).

NASHVILLE - Kentucky finally got another test in the Southeastern Conference and the Wildcats' stingy, sticky defense helped them pass yet again and take a big step toward the regular-season conference title.

Doron Lamb hit a 3-pointer with 3:18 left to put No. 1 Kentucky ahead to stay, and the Wildcats beat Vanderbilt 69-63 Saturday night for their 17th straight win by not allowing a point inside the final 4 minutes.

Kentucky (25-1, 11-0) disrupted Vanderbilt with aggressive defense in the first half, and the Wildcats held off a furious charge in a sold-out and electric Memorial Gym by scoring the final eight points of the game. The young and talented Wildcats wound up holding off the experienced Vanderbilt squad that had been predicted to be their best challenge this season. Lamb finished with 16 points, Anthony Davis added 15 points and seven blocks, Terrence Jones scored 14 and Marquis Teague had 13.

Vanderbilt (17-8, 6-4) led 63-61 with 4:08 to go on a jumper by Brad Tinsley. The Commodores didn't score again and snapped a four-game home winning streak over No. 1 teams. They missed a chance to pull into a tie with Florida for second in the SEC.

Vanderbilt top scorers in league play are Jeffery Taylor and John Jenkins, but neither matched their average. Jenkins led Vanderbilt with 15 points and Taylor had 13. Tinsley and Festus Ezeli also added 13 each.

NASHVILLE - The Vanderbilt Commodores have the Southeastern Conference's top two scorers in John Jenkins and Jeffery Taylor. They also can play some stingy defense, which helps on a night when either struggles to find the basket.

Jenkins scored 21 points, but Taylor was held to a season-low four as Vanderbilt beat South Carolina 59-48 for its third straight victory.

The Commodores held South Carolina to a season-low in points and made the Gamecocks the third Southeastern Conference opponent they've held below 50 points this season.

The Commodores (20-8, 9-4) also won their 20th game, giving them seven such seasons in the past nine, all under Stallings who passed Roy Skinner (six) for most 20-win seasons. Vanderbilt stayed in sole possession of third in the SEC, a game behind No. 12 Florida before Saturday's trip to top-ranked Kentucky.

The Commodores won despite a sloppy performance saved mostly by going 23 of 26 at the free-throw line in the second half. South Carolina (10-17, 2-11) hit all its free throws but took only four the whole night to lose for the seventh time in eight games.

Festus Ezell added 14 points and had five of Vanderbilt's nine blocks, and Lance Goulbourne added 12 points. Taylor, who came in as the SEC's second-leading scorer averaging 17.8 points per game, was 1 of 8 from the floor and missed all five 3-point attempts.

Ellington led the Gamecocks with 15 points and Damontre Harris had 10.

LEXINGTON - Freshman Anthony Davis again found himself with the ball and only a few seconds left to react. The 6-foot-10 forward squared up, burying a long jumper that buoyed his national player of the year push in one superb sequence.

Davis scored a career-high 28 points on 10-of-11 shooting, and No. 1 Kentucky beat Vanderbilt 83-74.

The Wildcats (28-1, 14-0) have won 51 straight at home and are on a 20-game winning streak overall. Kentucky trailed at halftime, however, and needed a late surge to put away the scrappy Commodores.

Davis, who had 11 rebounds and five blocks, hit an 18-foot jumper as the shot clock expired with 1:06 left. Terrence Jones added a dunk, and Davis blocked Lance Goulbourne's shot with 31 seconds to go to put the game away and maybe the question of who is the nation's best player.

Jeffery Taylor scored 19 points for Vanderbilt (20-9, 9-5), and John Jenkins added 15 of his 18 points in the second half as Vanderbilt proved to be a big test, taking a 37-36 halftime lead.

Jenkins, the reigning SEC player of the week, hit a 3 that tied it at 45, but Kentucky took a 66-56 lead with 7:47 left sparked by Wildcats senior Darius Miller, who hit a 3 and added a jumper that gave the Wildcats their first double-digit lead.

Vanderbilt, which starts four seniors who had won at every venue in the SEC over their four years except Rupp Arena, had one more run.

Taylor scored on a drive, and Jenkins, a junior, hit consecutive 3-pointers and one of two free throws that cut it to 66-65 with 4:22 left. Davis answered with a turnaround jumper as the shot clock expired.

Kentucky led by as many as eight in the first half, but the Commodores used a 9-0 run capped by three free throws by Brad Tinsley to take a 36-34 lead early in the first half. Davis hit two free throws, but Tinsley answered with one more with 3.2 seconds left that let the Commodores join North Carolina as the only teams to have a halftime lead at Rupp Arena this season.

KNOXVILLE - Senior Cameron Tatum scored 18 points to help Tennessee clinch a first-round bye in the Southeastern Conference tournament with a 68-61 win over Vanderbilt.

The Vols (18-13, 10-6 SEC) can earn the No. 2 seed in the tournament if Florida loses to No. 1 Kentucky on Sunday. Vanderbilt had locked up a bye in the tournament before Saturday's game.

Tennessee overcame its 18.8 percent shooting (3 of 16) from 3-point range by making 12 of 15 free throws down the stretch. Freshman Jarnell Stokes had a double-double with 11 points and 14 rebounds.

John Jenkins, the SEC's leading scorer, did his best to keep Vanderbilt (21-10, 10-6) in the game, scoring eight of his team-high 18 points in the final 11 minutes.

The Vols threatened to put the game out of reach on several occasions -- three times pushing their lead to nine -- but Jenkins consistently scrapped out an answer on an off-shooting night for the junior.

Jenkins and Jeffery Taylor scored consecutive baskets to pull the Commodores within 56-53, but Tatum made four straight free throws to give Tennessee a late cushion.

Trae Golden added 15 and Jeronne Maymon 12 for Tennessee.

The Vols cut down significantly on the season-high 25 turnovers that contributed to the Commodores' 65-47 win on Jan. 24. Tennessee finished with just 10 on Saturday.

Tennessee made only eight field goals in the second half but made 79.3 percent of its free throws (23 of 29), compared to its season average of 69.8 percent.

The Vols led early, but Jenkins hit three 3-pointers and Brad Tinsley added another in a 12-1 run that put Vanderbilt on top 21-15. Tennessee countered with a 13-2 run of its own and led 30-29 at halftime.

NEW ORLEANS - John Jenkins scored 15 points and Vanderbilt overcame a shaky first half for a comfortable 63-41 victory over Georgia on Friday night in the second round of the Southeastern Conference tournament.

Brad Tinsley added 12 points on 5-of-7 shooting for the Commodores (22-10), whose triumph set up a semifinal matchup on Saturday with Mississippi, a 77-72 overtime winner over Tennessee.

Dustin Ware scored 10 for Georgia (15-17), which had upset Mississippi State a night earlier but faded against the Commodores while missing 21 of 27 shots in the second half.

Vanderbilt trailed by a point when the second half began but quickly vaulted in front with a 12-2 run that began when Tinsley hit a driving layup as he was fouled and followed that up with a driving finger roll.

Lance Goulbourne capped the spurt with a two-handed jam set up by Taylor's drive and no-look pass. Goulbourne added a 3 and a dunk soon after, and Vandy led 50-35 when Festus Ezeli scored inside.

Vanderbilt outshot Georgia 43.9 percent (25 of 57) to 31.9 percent (15 of 47). The Bulldogs were plagued by 17 turnovers, while the Commodores lost the ball eight times.

Vanderbilt entered the game shooting 40 percent from 3-point range on the season, but made only 3 of 13 from long range in the first half, and shot only 34.6 percent (9 of 26) overall in the opening 20 minutes.
