Bryce Drew makes NCAA Tournament in first season

Commodore head coach Bryce Drew led Vanderbilt to the NCAA Tournament in his first season in Nashville, marking the first time in the history of the program a first-year Vanderbilt coach has led his team to the tournament. Overall, the Commodores made their 15th appearance in the NCAA Tournament and their first back-to-back appearances since making three consecutive tournaments from 2010-12.

Commodores faced tough slate in 2016-17

Vanderbilt had five top-25 wins, six top-50 victories and 11 top-100 RPI wins, the overall toughest strength of schedule and toughest non-conference schedule in the nation, and were the only SEC team to sweep Florida. The Commodores tied for the second-most top 50 wins in the SEC with Florida with six - only UK (8) had more. The Commodores played 11 teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament (Marquette, Bucknell, Butler, Minnesota, Middle Tennessee, Dayton, Kentucky, Florida, Arkansas, Iowa State, and South Carolina) and four teams in the 2017 Postseason NIT (Belmont, Alabama, Georgia, and Ole Miss). Twenty of Vanderbilt's 34 games came against teams that advanced to the postseason.

Returning for the Commodores

The Commodores return eight letter winners and three of their top four scorers in 2017-18, rising seniors Matthew Fisher-Davis (13.9), Jeff Roberson (10.8), and Riley LaChance (10.5). Junior Joe Toye, who started in 13 games a year ago, also returns after averaging 6.4 points and 2.6 rebounds per game. In all, Vanderbilt returns 70.5% of its scoring and six players who started at least one game in 2016-17. In all, 261 cumulative starts return for the Commodores and a combined 532 games played between the eight letterwinners returning.

Fisher-Davis, LaChance 1,000 point scorers

Matthew Fisher-Davis and Riley LaChance each surpassed the 1,000point barrier last season, with Jeff Roberson only 169 points shy of the mark entering his senior season.

Vanderbilt record-breaking shooting

Altogether, Vanderbilt made 337 threes last season, which set a new school record for a single season. The previous best was 322 in the 2004-05 campaign. The Commodores' 77.6% clip from the charity stripe tied for the second-best in school history. Six Commodores made 30 threes or more in 2016-17 - Joe Toye, Nolan Cressler, Jeff Roberson, Riley LaChance, Luke Kornet, and Matthew Fisher-Davis - and were the SEC's best three-point shooting team (37.7%), the league's leader in three's made per game (9.9) and in free-throw percentage (77.6%).

Shooting the Lights Out

Vanderbilt made 19 threes against High Point on December 6, 2016, which set a new school record for threes in a game, surpassing an 18-three performance at Tennessee on January 8, 2005.

The Commodores also set a new record for most 3-pointers made at Memorial Gym, passing the old mark of 16 that was set on Jan. 8, 1994 vs. South Carolina and then matched on Feb. 11, 1995 vs. Arkansas. The Commodores hit 12 of their 19 3-pointers in the first half.

Kornet departs as all-time blocks leader

Vanderbilt senior center Luke Kornet, who was signed as a free agent by the New York Knicks, departs the Commodores as the program's all-time blocks leader with 210 career blocks, surpassing Festus Ezeli, who had 204 blocks in his career. Kornet was named the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year in 2017, as well as an All-SEC first team and alldefensive team selection.

LaChance made threes at high clip in 2016-17

Riley LaChance, who played the point guard position in 2016-17 and will slide over to his more natural two-guard spot in his senior season, made 49.3% of his three-point attempts last year, which is the third-best in a single-season all-time for the Commodores - only Billy McCaffrey (51.2%, 1992-93) and Barry Booker (50%, 1986-87) have had better seasons from three. LaChance led the SEC in three-point shooting in 2016-17.

Newcomers in 2017-18

Vanderbilt will welcome six newcomers to the team in 2017-18 - true freshmen guards Saben Lee (6-2, 174, Tempe, Ariz.) and Maxwell Evans (6-2, 186, Houston, Texas), true freshman big man Ejike Obinna (6-10, 234, Enugu, Nigeria), redshirt sophomore transfers Matt Ryan (6-8, 209 forward, Notre Dame) and Yanni Wetzell (6-10, 235 forward/ center, St. Mary's (Texas)), and freshman walk-on guard Isaiah Rice (5-11, 189, Carmel, Ind.).

Ranked Opponents

The Commodores won their first road game against a ranked opponent since Dec. 29, 2011, after defeating Florida on January 21, 2017, in Gainesville, 68-66. Vanderbilt won five true road games in Southeastern Conference play in 2017 (LSU, Auburn, Texas A&M, Arkansas, Tennessee), the most since 2010. Against ranked opponents in 2016-17, the Commodores finished 4-2.

999

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 999 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank third only to UNLV and Kentucky for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented.

Senior, Guard/Forward 6'5" 185 lbs. Charlotte, N.C. Butler

GENERAL \bigstar 6'5 guard considered one of best shooters in college basketball...Led SEC in field-goal percentage in all games at 44.6% as a sophomore... Finished freshman season as the SEC's freshman leader in three-pointers made (2.1), which was sixth in the conference overall, and finished second in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage (.401)...Led the Commodores in scoring as a junior, averaging 13.9 points per game.

2016-17 (JUNIOR) ★ Played in 34 games and started in 22...Averaged 27.9 minutes per game...Averaged 13.9 points and 3.2 rebounds per game...Made 84 threes on the season and shot 37.2%, which ranked seventh in all games in the SEC...Was second in threes made (2.5) per game in the SEC...Now has 234 made threes in his career, which is eighth all-time on the Vanderbilt's three's made list...Scored 20 or more points in seven, and scored in double figures in 24 games in 2016-17...Eclipsed the 1,000-point barrier in his career against Arkansas - became 47th VU player to do so...Tallied a career-high 33 points vs. Auburn - made seven threes, first Commodore to make seven three's in a game since John Jenkins made seven against Lafayette on December 21, 2011... Scored 25 points at Dayton...Made then season-high five threes vs. Flyers..Tallied 23 points in win at LSU in SEC opener.

2015-16 (SOPHOMORE) ★ Started 28 games and played in 32 contests... Scored in double figures in 17 games in 2015-16...Made three or more threes in 17 games...Tallied a career-high 20 points on three different occasions - at Arkansas, at Mississippi State, and at home against Kentucky...Tied a careerbest with six made threes at Tennessee. He also added eight rebounds and a career-high four assists in 18-point effort...Finished the season first in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage at 44.6%...Had first double-double of his career with 10 points and career-high 11 rebounds vs. Wofford.

2014-15 (FRESHMAN) ★ Played in 34 games and started 11...Averaged 7.2 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 1.4 assists per game...Made a team-high 71 threes



on the season, which was the most by a freshman in the SEC, and his 40.1% shooting percentage from three was second overall in the SEC...Made 10 threes in his last two games, including a career-high six in the NIT Quarterfinals at Stanford, where he scored a career-high 18 points...Helped propel Commodores to a win over South Dakota State in second round of the NIT, making four consecutive threes in a two-minute span in second half...Scored in double figures in 10 games and made three or more threes in a game in 12 contests...Tied then-career-high with 14 points in win at Ole Miss...Scored 13 points apiece in two wins over Alabama, scored 11 points vs. Missouri...Tallied career-high 14 points on career-best four made threes at Arkansas...Scored 12 points in a career-best 35 minutes vs. Yale.

HIGH SCHOOL * Played at Butler High School in Charlotte, N.C., and averaged 22 points, 13 rebounds, five assists, two steals and two blocks per game as a senior, and was named the SW4A Player of the Year and as a member of the Charlotte Observer's All-Observer team...Was also named as an All-County and an All-District selection, and was invited to play in the Team USA vs. Team Florida Game as well as the North Carolina East/West All-Star Game.

His three-point FG% in 2016-17 ranks third all-time in a single season for a Vanderbilt player (48.6%)...Was named to 2014-15 SEC All-Freshman Team...Led his Brookfield Central High School team in Wisconsin to a 24-1 record as a senior when he averaged 23.0 points and 2.6 assists per game...Left Brookfield as the school's all-time leading scorer (1,643 points).

2016-17 (JUNIOR) ★ Played and started in all 35 games as a junior...Averaged 10.5 points, 3.9 assists, and 3.3 rebounds per game...Scored in double figures in 20 games, including a season-high 24 points in win at LSU...Finished 8-13 from floor, 4-7 from three, and had 5 assists against LSU; was fourth time of his career he eclipsed the 20-point mark...Shot 48.6% from three in his junior season and was third in the SEC in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) and seventh in the league in assists (3.9)...His three-point FG% in 2016-17 ranks third all-time in a single season for a Vanderbilt player...Became 46th player in VU history with 1,000 points against Florida in the SEC Tournament; also named to 2017 SEC Tournament All-Tournament team...Dished out a season-high seven assists on three occasions.



2015-16 (SOPHOMORE) ★ Played in 33 games and started 19...Averaged 6.9

points and 2.4 rebounds per game...Scored double figures in 11 games in 2015-16, including a season-high 18 points vs. Alabama while tying a career-best with five threes...Scored 13 points, had six assists, and four rebounds vs. Gardner-Webb; also scored 13 points vs. Stony Brook...Named to preseason All-SEC 2nd Team by league coaches in 2015.

2014-15 (FRESHMAN) ★ Played in 35 games and started all 35...Averaged 12.3 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 2.9 assists per game...Was the SEC freshman leader in points scored in all games and second in threes made... Third on Vanderbilt's single-season freshman scoring list with 429 points - one of only four Vanderbilt freshman to ever eclipse 400-point barrier...Scored in double figures in 24 contests and scored 20 or more points in three games...Captured four SEC Freshman of the Week honors; The four freshman honors were a new program record...Ended season with 102 assists, third on the Vanderbilt freshman single-season assist list...Scored a career-high 26 points in win over Purdue (9-13 from the floor) and then followed that game with another 26-point game vs. Western Carolina...Grabbed a career-high nine rebounds vs. Missouri...Dished out career eight assists in win at Ole Miss...Garnered career-high five steals vs. Penn... Shot 87.3% from the free-throw line for the season, which tied for the 10th-best single-season percentage in the history of the program.

HIGH SCHOOL ★ Averaged 23.0 points and 2.6 assists and was named a unanimous first-team All-State by the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association and the Associated Press...Was voted the top point guard in the state of Wisconsin by Wisconsin Hoops, and was the Player of the Year for Waukesha County... Finished his career at Brookfield Central as the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,643 points, the school's single-season scoring leader with 543 points, and the all-time leader in steals with 188...Also finished fourth on the school's all-time assist list with 267, and tied the school record for most points in a conference game in his senior season with 44 points...In his senior season, LaChance shot 50.8% from the floor, 48.6% from three, and 81.5% from the free-throw line.


