GAMEDAY MEDIA PARKING

Media parking will be located in Kensington Garage next to Memorial Gym. Please access the garage entrance off 25th Avenue. All media representatives must have a proper credential to access parking garage.

PRESS BOX ACCESS

Media must wear "PRESS" or "PHOTO" credentials to gain access to the stadium press box, which is located on the third floor. The field elevator is located near Gate 1. Seating charts are posted in various press box sites.

IN-GAME FIELD ACCESS

Field access is restricted to working photojournalists from kickoff until five minutes remaining in the game. To gain field access, photographers must pick up a "PHOTO" armband at Media Will Call at Gate 1 (located at north endzone stadium gate nearest the Marriott) before the game.

COACH FRANKLIN'S POSTGAME PRESS CONFERENCE

Coach Franklin's post-game press conference is held immediately after he addresses the team. <u>Only properly credentialled working media will be</u> allowed into the conference.

Media wishing to participate in postgame interviews should meet at the elevator with 5:00 left in the game to be escorted to the south end zone area of the field.

The postgame press conference and interviews are held in Room 153 of McGugin Athletic Center. To attend, cross Jess Neely Drive and enter McGugin Center at the entrance marked "Press Conference Area." Once inside McGugin, enter the media room through either of the first two doors on your right.

PLAYER POSTGAME AVAILABILITY

The Vanderbilt Player Locker Room is closed to media. Up to five student-athletes will be made available for post-game interviews. These interviews will be conducted in the same room as Coach Franklin's post-game remarks. The players will enter this area when Franklin concludes with his press conference.

During Commodore home games, the visiting team interview room is located in the south endzone of the stadium. The entrance is located in the stadium tunnel. Vanderbilt athletic communications personnel will make every effort to provide quickie stats to the media.

WIRELESS IN PRESS BOX

The press box is equipped with wireless internet access for the working press. The only area to transmit for working photographers is in the press box. TV production crews can order phone lines in advance. To order, call the following phone number: (615) 343-2012.

VANDERBILT STADIUM



VANDERBILT STADIUM: HOME VENUE SINCE 1981

All of the Commodores' home games will be played in Vanderbilt Stadium, their on-campus venue for the last 30 years.

The stadium, with a capacity of 39,773, was opened in 1981 on the same site as Dudley Field, which stood at the corner of Jess Neely Drive and Natchez Trace since 1922. Though the old stadium was demolished prior to the 1981 project, the Commodores continue to play on the original Dudley Field surface.

In recent years, the stadium has been given an exterior renovation. An expansion concourse, two gate entrances and a plaza outside Gate 2 were introduced in 2009, one year after crews began an exterior paint and brick effort to unity the three largest athletic facilities on campus: Vanderbilt Stadium, Hawkins Field and Memorial Gymnasium.


In addition, an on-going building project calls for a renovation of Gate 1 near the Marriott Vanderbilt.

DIRECTIONS TO VANDERBILT STADIUM AND KENSINGTON PARKING GARAGE

ARRIVING FROM SOUTH OF NASHVILLE Take I-65 North to I-40 West to Exit 209A (Broadway-West End). Turn left to go west on Broadway. When Broadway splits, stay to the right to enter West End Ave. Take West End past the University on the left and turn left on 25th Avenue. The Kensington Garage entrance is located just one block on the right, just before Memorial Gymnasium.

ARRIVING FROM NORTH OF NASHVILLE Take I-65 South to I-265 to I-40 East to Exit 209B (Broadway-West End). Turn right on Broadway. When Broadway splits, stay to the right to enter West End Ave. Take West End past the University on the left and turn left on 25th Avenue. Access to Kensington Garage is one block on right just before Memorial Gym.


