## EVERYTHING YOU NEED IS AVAILABLE AT WWW.VUCOMMODORES.COM

Pre-game and post-game materials for the working media are updated regularly on Vanderbilt's athletic website, [www.vucommoedores.com](http://www.vucommoedores.com). Most documents are available in .pdf format.

Pre-game materials include game notes, current statistics, player and coaching bios, releases and press conference transcripts. A live radio feed and live statistic package are provided during games. Official game finals and statistics, and quotes from Coach Bobby Johnson, Commodore players and opponent quotes are among the post-game materials.

### PRESEASON CAMP COVERAGE

Coach Johnson opens the first 30 minutes of each August practice to media outlets. *The coaching staff may close practices without prior notice.*

### CREDENTIAL REQUESTS

For the second straight year, Vanderbilt will offer on-line credentialing for home games. The web address is: [www.sportssystems.com/Vanderbilt/](http://www.sportssystems.com/Vanderbilt/)

To fax, send your request on company letterhead to (615) 343-7064. All applications will be notified of their credential status at least 10 days before the game requested.

When feasible, credentials will be mailed at least 10 days in advance. However, credentials can also be picked up in advance at the Vanderbilt Media Relations Office, located on the second

floor of McGugin Center (across from stadium) or at Media Will Call on game day, which is located at Gate 1 (stadium entrance nearest the Vanderbilt Marriott).

### GAME DAY MEDIA PARKING

Media parking will be located in the Kensington Garage, located next to Memorial Gymnasium. Please access the garage entrance off 25th Avenue.

### PRESS BOX ACCESS

Media must wear "PRESS" or "PHOTO" credentials to gain access to the stadium press box, which is located on the third floor. The field elevator is located near Gate 1. Seating charts are posted in various press box sites.

### WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS AVAILABLE IN PRESS BOX

The Vanderbilt football press box is equipped with wireless internet access for the working press. The only area to transmit for working photographers is in the press box.

### GAME DAY TELEPHONES

A limited number of phone lines are available in the press box at no charge. However, media working on deadline are encouraged to order their own phone line in advance. To order, call the following pager: (615) 748-8889.

### IN-GAME FIELD ACCESS

Field access is restricted to working photojournalists from kickoff until five minutes remaining in the game. To gain field access, photographers must pick up a "PHOTO" armband at Media Will Call at Gate 1 (north endzone stadium gate nearest the Marriott) before the game.

## RUSSELL-RICE SCHOLARSHIP

This is the 50th anniversary of a prestigious Vanderbilt scholarship intended for aspiring sportswriters – the Fred Russell-Grantland Rice Scholarship.

The scholarship, which pays \$10,000 annually for four years of education, honors two former Commodores and giants of the industry – Rice, the legendary sports columnist of the 1920s-30s, and Russell, the longtime *Nashville Banner* sports editor.

The scholarship is sponsored jointly by Vanderbilt and the Thoroughbred Racing Association.

Several recipients have gone on to distinguished writing careers, such as Roy Blount, Jr., Skip Bayless, David Sheinin, Tyler Kepner and Lee Jenkins.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must apply and be accepted for admission to the Vanderbilt College of Arts and Science.

## COACH JOHNSON'S POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Media wishing to participate in postgame interviews should meet at the elevator with 5:00 left in the game to be escorted to the south end zone area of the field.

Coach Johnson's post-game press conference is held immediately after he addresses the team following the game. The conference is in Room 153 of McGugin Athletic Center, which is located across Jess Neely Drive from the stadium. Please use the McGugin entrance marked "Press Conference Area" for access into the building, then enter the media room through the either of the first two doors on your right.

## COMMODORE PLAYER POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

The Vanderbilt Player Locker Room is closed to all media.

Up to five student-athletes will be made available for post-game interviews. These interviews will be conducted in the same room as Coach Johnson's post-game remarks. The players will enter this area when Johnson concludes with his press conference.

During Commodore home games, the visiting team interview room is located in the south endzone of the stadium. The entrance is located in the stadium tunnel. Vanderbilt media relations personnel will make every effort to provide quickie stats to the media.

## SATELLITE FEEDS

Vanderbilt does not offer satellite feeds and teleconferencing of the Monday press gathering with Johnson.

Vanderbilt will provide a postgame highlight feed for any non-televised SEC game. Transmission info will be provided Thursday before the game.

## JOHNSON INTERVIEW OPPORTUNITIES

### • WEEKLY PRESS CONFERENCE

Johnson meets with local media each Monday prior to a game, starting at 12 noon, CT. The conference is held in the McCall Room, McGugin Center.

### • WEEKLY SEC TELECONFERENCE

Each Wednesday of the season, Johnson is available to out-of-town media via the SEC Coaches' Teleconference at 10:56 a.m., CT. Call 205-458-3010 for info.

## PLAYER INTERVIEWS (GAME WEEK)

Media wishing to interview players during the week should contact the VU Media Relations in advance.

Practice interviews are available Tuesday-Wednesday, prior to position meetings (typically 90 minutes before practice). Upon request, the head coach and players also are available briefly at the end of practice those days.

Media outlets are permitted to shoot the first 30 minutes of practice; afterward, sessions are closed to all cameras. *The staff may close practice without notice.*

Out of town media can arrange phone interviews on a 24-hour notice through the Media Relations Office.

Joe Fisher, John Gromos and Kevin Ingram provide concise and insightful coverage on the Vanderbilt Football Radio Network.

A Nashville native, Fisher enters his 10th season as the team's play-by-play announcer. He handles similar duties for Vanderbilt men's basketball and baseball.

Prior to announcing Vanderbilt games, Fisher was a television sports anchor in the Nashville market from 1987-96, with stints at WSMV-4 and WKRN-2. He also worked two years in public relations.

Fisher also serves as Vanderbilt athletics' Director of Broadcasting.

A resident of Nashville, Gromos enters his 12th season as color analyst. A four-year Commodore quarterback, Gromos ranks seventh on the team's career passing yardage charts.

Gromos serves as Manager of Business Development for Turner Universal, a subsidiary of Turner Construction Co. He earned a degree in Mechanical Engineering from Vanderbilt in 1990.

Ingram enters his sixth season providing sideline commentary. A respected member of the Nashville radio market, Ingram co-hosts the popular "Wake Up Zone" Show on FM-104.5 The Zone.

For more than two decades, Bob Horner has served as the producer and engineer for Vanderbilt football and men's basketball.

Take I-65 North to I-40 West to Exit 209A (Broadway-West End). Turn left to go west on Broadway. When Broadway splits, stay to the right to enter West End Ave. Take West End past the University on the left and turn left on 25th Avenue. The Kensington Garage entrance is located just one block on the right, just before Memorial Gymnasium, home of Commodore basketball.

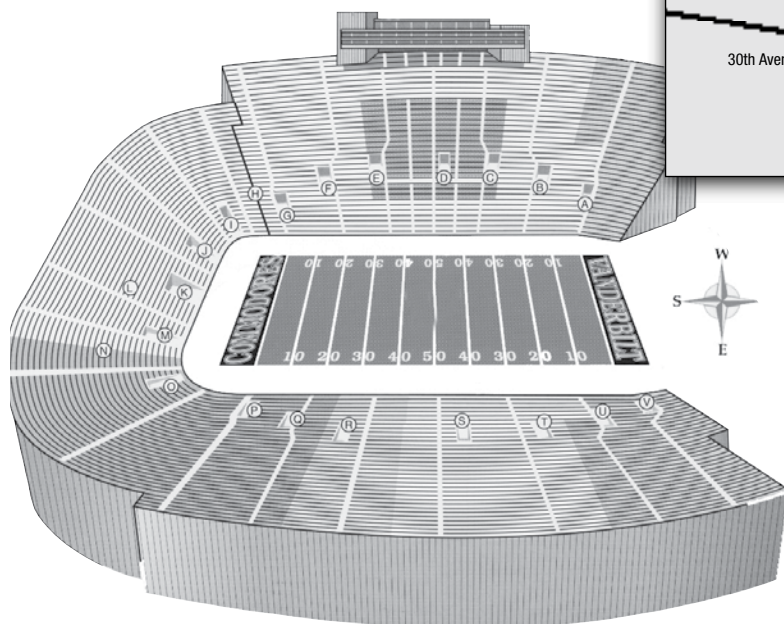
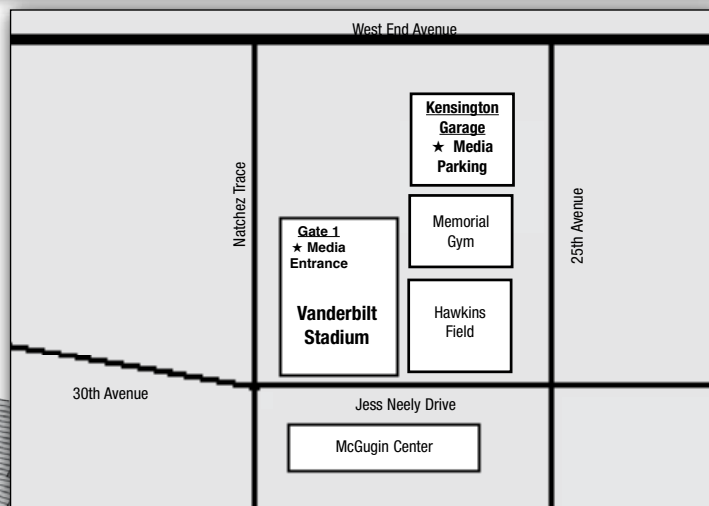
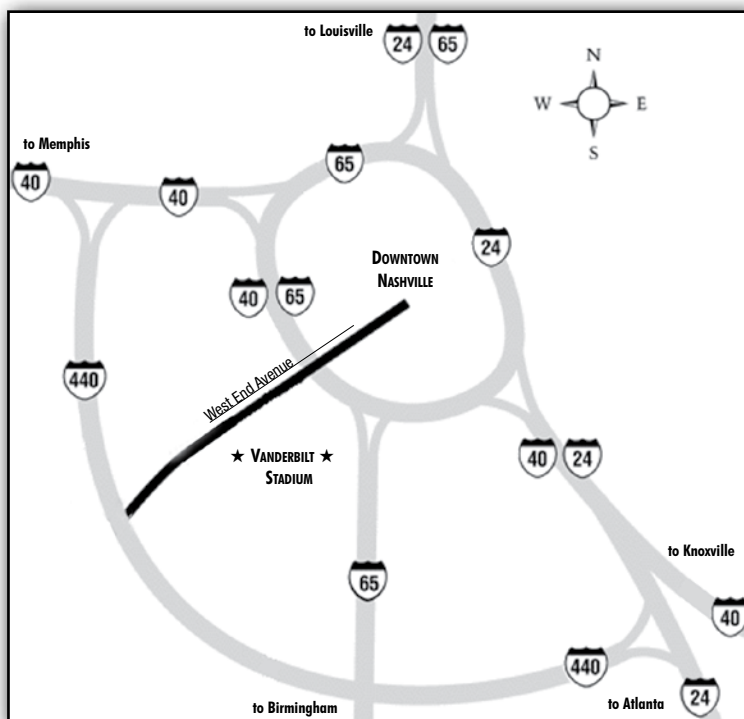
