## NOTES AND NOTABLES

### LEADING OFF

Austin Peay begins its first road trip of the season when it meets nationally-ranked Vanderbilt in a 4:30 p.m., Wednesday contest at Hawkins Field in Nashville.

The Governors hit the road after picking up their first two wins of 2019, sweeping a Sunday doubleheader against Northern Illinois. Austin Peay enjoyed its two biggest offensive outings of the young campaign against the Huskies, scoring a combined 23 runs in the doubleheader after posting just 13 runs in their season's first four games.

Vanderbilt also swept its home Sunday doubleheader against Pepperdine, improving to 3-0 at Hawkins Field this season. The Commodores are ranked among the nation's top 40 in batting average (9th, .336) and scoring (39th, 8.0 runs per game) after the season's first two weekends.

### FIRST HACKS

- Center fielder **Garrett Spain** has a hit and a RBI in each of his first six collegiate games. He is ranked 13th among Division I freshmen in batting average (.458).
- Senior catcher **David Martinez** went 5-for-8 in the three-game SAF Dirt Classic, last weekend. He pushed his season average to team-leading .467, which ranks 11th among Division I catchers.
- Utility man **Parker Phillips** hit three home runs in Game 1 of the Northern Illinois doubleheader, going 3-for-4 with five RBI. The redshirt junior also scored six times on the weekend and leads the Govs with nine runs scored in 2019.
- Sophomore shortstop **Bobby Head** had three hits last weekend, but two of those left the park as he finished with five RBI. He had just one home run last season.
- Senior outfielder **Aaron Campbell** had a hit and three walks (.333 OBP) during the SAF Dirt Classic, driving in two runs with a double in Game 1 against Northern Illinois.
- Redshirt senior second baseman **Garrett Kueber** moved into the leadoff spot for the first two games of the SAF Dirt Classic and he responded with a 4-for-9, two RBI outing in the two games.
- Junior **Malcolm Tipler** began the weekend at third base but moved into left field for the NIU doubleheader. He also moved into the No. 2 spot in the lineup versus the Huskies, going 1-for-4 with a RBI and two runs scored in Game 1.
- With Tipler's move into left field, freshman **Gino Avros** started at third base in both halves of Sunday's doubleheader. He went 1-for-3 with a walk in the first game, batting ninth, before moving to the leadoff spot in Game 2 and posting a 1-for-5 outing.
- Making his first appearance of the year, freshman **Matt Joslin** was the Govs starting designated hitter in the NIU twinbill. He had a RBI single in Game 1 of the set.

- Sophomore transfer **Griffin Rivers** started the season's first four games in left field before Tipler was moved into that spot against NIU.
- Senior catcher **Alex Sala** started Game 2 of the 2019 season behind the plate and has seen action three times off the bench for the Govs.

### TOEING THE RUBBER

- Junior **Tyler Thompson** is scheduled to make his fifth career start in Wednesday's contest.
- He made three starts in 2018, the last coming March 13 against Middle Tennessee. He also made 13 relief appearances last season.
- Austin Peay starting pitchers have combined for a 2-2 record and 3.90 ERA with 33 strikeouts in 30 innings pitched.

### GOVS vs. VANDERBILT

- Austin Peay has played Vanderbilt more than any other Southeastern Conference team, Wednesday's meeting will be the 80th meeting between the two in-state foes.
- The Commodores own a 53-24-2 lead in the all-time series, including a 31-10-2 mark in Nashville.
- Vanderbilt has won all three meetings since the series resumed in 2016.
- Austin Peay's last victory against Vanderbilt was an April 27, 2010 contest in Clarksville, the last meeting between the two before a six-season hiatus in the series.
- In the Govs last win, Matt Kole hit a game-tying grand slam in the sixth inning and took the lead when Adam Browett walked, stole second, reached third on an error and scampered home on a wild pitch. David Vicini picked up the win in relief and Zach Gerler notched the save.

## NEXT LEVEL NOTES

### SUN'S OUT, GUNS OUT?

For the first time in 2019, Austin Peay played its twinbill against Northern Illinois with the sun in full effect. Whether that had an impact on the field is up for conjecture, but the results spoke volumes. The Govs entered the day with 13 runs scored in their first four games – all cloudy affairs – but broke out for 23 runs in Sunday's sun-soaked doubleheader.

### RECOGNIZE THE NAMES

Austin Peay's home is currently styled Joe and Cathi Maynard Field at Raymond C. Hand Park. The park was named after local businessman Raymond C. Hand, a lifelong baseball fan, after his family contributed to the park's modernization in 1993. The Maynard's contributions to the baseball program were recognized by naming the playing surface after them during the 2018 season.

### PUCHEU, PHILLIPS TAKE IN THE CAPE

Senior Jacques Pucheu and redshirt junior Parker Phillips both spent time in the Cape Cod League last summer. Pucheu joined the Hyannis Harbor Hawks in July and made five appearances. Phillips saw action with the Wareham Gatemen during a four-week span in June and early July before returning to Clarksville.

### PUCHEU PRESEASON FAVORITE

Govs starter Jacques Pucheu was tabbed by the OVC's coaches and baseball contacts as the league's Preseason Pitcher of the Year and a Preseason All-OVC pick. It is the second time since the preseason team and awards were presented in 2008 an Austin Peay pitcher earned the preseason nod (Alex Robles, 2016).

### PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN PHILLIPS

Collegiate Baseball set the bar high for Austin Peay utility man Parker Phillips, naming him a Louisville Slugger First-Team Preseason All-American. It is the first time an APSU player has received first team preseason recognition.

### PHILLIPS GETS PRESEASON OVC NOD

Phillips also was named to the Preseason All-OVC team at first base. The redshirt junior was a Second-Team All-OVC choice last season after posting 19 home runs, including 17 homers in OVC play.

### GOVS PICKED FOURTH

After finishing fifth in the 2018 regular-season OVC race, Austin Peay was tabbed to finish fourth in the 2019 title run. The Govs, with 143 points, were picked to finish just ahead of Southeast Missouri (142 points). Morehead State, Jacksonville State and Tennessee Tech were the top three choices, respectively.

### 35°51' NORTH

In an odd quirk, Austin Peay is not scheduled to travel farther south than 35 degrees 51 minutes north latitude – also known as the location of home plate at Reese Smith Jr. Field, the home of Middle Tennessee's baseball team. It is the first time since 1969 that Austin Peay will not visit any of the states below Tennessee during its regular-season schedule.

### GIANT KILLERS

In head coach Travis Janssen's first three seasons, Austin Peay has accumulated six victories against "Power 5" conference schools, including three wins in 2018: Illinois, Kansas State and Clemson. The Govs are scheduled to play Kentucky, Vanderbilt and Tennessee during the 2019 season.

### FIFTY SEASONS AT THE HAND

Austin Peay is concluding its 49th season at its current location, currently called Raymond C. Hand Park. When the Govs host Southern Illinois, April 16, it will mark the 50th anniversary of the first game played at then Governors Park. Austin Peay enters 2019 with 735 wins and a .591 win percentage all-time in its current home.

### GOVS BASEBALL ENTERS 80TH YEAR

In addition to the upcoming 50th anniversary of Raymond C. Hand Park, Austin Peay also begins its 80th season of play. The program started in 1931 and survived a pair of stoppages in the 1930s and 1940s. The Governors baseball program won its 1,500th game on April 21, 2018 at Morehead State and enters this season with 1,507 all-time wins.

### GOVS PRO TRANSACTIONS

A.J. Ellis (2000-03, HOF 2009), an 11-year MLB veteran, announced his retirement as a player in February and accepted a position as a special assistant with the San Diego Padres... Shawn Kelley (2003-07, HOF 2014) signed a one-year deal that includes a club option for 2020 with the Texas Rangers, continuing his 10-year MLB career... Ryne Harper (2008-11) is a non-roster invitee to the Minnesota Twins spring training which begins Feb. 23.


