## **REMAINING NO. 1:** For a fourth consecutive week, Vandy is ranked the nation's top team per D1Baseball.com.

★ Vandy moved into the top spot in the USA Today Coaches and NCBWA polls for the first time this year Monday following a weekend sweep of Dayton.

**PITCHING PROWESS:** Vandy leads the SEC and ranks third nationally with 12.85 strikeouts per nine innings.

- ★ Vandy has fanned 15-plus batters on five occasions including 15 last night vs. Illinois State.
- ★ In 10 home games, Vandy has posted a 2.79 ERA while limiting opponents to a .193 average.

#### TABLE SETTERS: Vanderbilt's top of the order -- Cooper Davis, Austin Martin and JJ Bleday -- has batted .428 (69-for-161) with 4.0 runs/game and 2.35 RBIs/game.

★ Martin ranks second nationally in hits (26) while Bleday is seventh (24) and Davis is 59th (19).

**ATTA BOY JJ:** Junior **JJ Bleday** enters Saturday riding a 42-game on-base streak (March 4, 2018-present).

- ★ It is the second-longest active streak nationally behind Cal State Fullerton's Hank LoForte (56 games).
- ★ Bleday produced the longest hit streak (20 games) for a Dore since 2014, reaching the mark in Game 1 last Saturday. He went 0-for-3 in the finale.

**HOME NONCON SUCCESS:** Vanderbilt is 107-21 (.835) in nonconference games at Hawkins Field since the start of the 2013 season. The Commodores went 12-4 in those games a season ago. Vandy's best mark during that stretch came in 2016 when the squad finished 20-1.

**FEBRUARY IN REVIEW:** Vanderbilt produced a winning record in February for a seventh consecutive season and ninth time in the last 10 years.

- ★ Vandy batted .340 -- the fourth time in the last five seasons the squad hit over .300 in the month.
- ★ The Commodores fielded .982 -- the third time in the last four years the team fielded above .980.

**2018 REWIND:** Vandy advanced to its seventh NCAA Super Regional in the last nine seasons before falling one victory shy of reaching the College World Series. The Dores, who won 10 of their final 14 games, finished the 2018 campaign 35-27 and ranked No. 18 by D1Baseball.com.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last year's NCAA Super Regional squad to its 2019 unit.

- ★ Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- ★ Commodore returning pitchers contributed 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts in 2018.

**PATH TO 800:** Vanderbilt head coach **Tim Corbin** is one victory shy from reaching 800 career.

- ★ Only 25 active head coaches have reached the 800win milestone. Of those 25, only 11 have a higher career winning percentage than Corbin's .668.
- ★ Corbin is in his 22nd year as a head coach. He has 693 wins at Vanderbilt and 106 at Presbyterian.

**OUT OF THE GATE:** Vanderbilt has scored in the first inning in nine of its 13 games including three straight.

- ★ The Dores are 8-1 when scoring in the first inning.
  ★ Vandy has scored five runs in the frame on two
- ★ Vandy has scored five runs in the frame on two occassions and three runs a total of four times.

**ON YESTERDAY'S WIN:** Vanderbilt overcame a four-run deficit and scored 10 unanswered runs in last night's win.

- ★ ISU recorded just three hits after the first inning.
- ★ The victory was the seventh consecutive for Vandy.

**FACING ILLINOIS STATE:** Vanderbilt and Illinois State meet for the 13th time on Saturday. The Commodores hold a 9-3 edge and enter the day having won eight consecutive.

- Vandy swept Illinois State in a three-game series during the last meeting (Feb. 27-March 1, 2015) at Hawkins Field. The Dores outscored the Redbirds 35-13 in the series and scored 16 runs twice.
- ★ The two teams also met in the 2010 NCAA Louisville Regional with Vanderbilt downing Illinois State, 8-7 in 13 innings and 10-4 two days later.

**ON THE OFFENSIVE:** Vanderbilt ranks first in the SEC in batting average (.337), hits (166), runs (129), on-base percentage (.444) and triples (8).

- ★ Vandy has scored five-plus runs 12 times and 10plus runs in three consecutive games.
- ★ The Commodores produced six consecutive double-digit hit performances (Feb. 20-March 1) for the first time since a season ago.

**DE-FENSE:** Vanderbilt is first in the SEC and ranks 13th nationally in fielding percentage (.986).

- ★ In 2018, Vandy set a new school record and finished fifth nationally with a .981 fielding percentage.
- ★ The Dores have posted a fielding percentage of .975 or better in five of the last six years.

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION: Vandy led the nation as four student-athletes were named to the 2018 Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American Team. Philip Clarke, Pat DeMarco, Mason Hickman and Austin Martin -all returning for 2019 -- were recognized for their efforts.

**THE STREAK CONTINUES:** Vanderbilt's current streak of 13 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the longest in the SEC and the third-longest nationally, trailing only Florida State (41) and Cal State Fullerton (27).

**NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN:** Head coach **Tim Corbin** is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).

- ★ Corbin is 693-344-1 (.668) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
- ★ Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received firstteam recognition.
- ★ In the Corbin era, 22 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America.

- ★ Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.
- ★ Eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts on opening weekend. Justyn-Henry Malloy registered a pinch-hit RBI single and Sterling Hayes scored a run among notables.

**DORES ON TOP:** In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

WELCOME TO THE HAWK: The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 445-160-1 (.735) alltime record at its home including a 338-101-1 (.769) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

★ The Dores won 6-of-7 regular season three-game home series in 2018 and have won 48-of-61 threegame sets at The Hawk since 2011. SENIOR LEADERS: Vandy's five-member senior class is its largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF Walker Grisanti, 1B Julian Infante, SS Ethan Paul, RHP Patrick Raby and UTL Stephen Scott.

★ Since arriving on campus in 2016, the unit has helped Vandy to 126 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

**THE 2019 SCHEDULE:** Vanderbilt's 2019 schedule is another formidable slate. The Commodores face 10 teams that reached the NCAA Tournament in 2018 a total 22 times (39.2 percent of games).

★ Vandy hosts 19 of its 26 nonconference games including 15 consecutive from Feb. 20-March 12. Vandy's next road game is March 15 at Texas A&M.

**FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS:** Vanderbilt leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including first-round supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with **David Price** in 2007 and **Dansby Swanson** in 2015.

**FAR AND WIDE:** The 2019 roster features players from 14 different states as well as one (**Cooper Davis**) from Ontario, Canada. In total, 12 players hail from Tennessee and another eight call Florida home.

★ Three Commodores are from Ohio while two players are represented from California, Georgia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey and New York.

**MAJOR LEAGUE DORES:** In total, 13 former players made a MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

★ The Commodores led the nation with seven pitchers who made at least one MLB start and eight total hurlers who made an appearance in 2018.
