THROWING UP ZEROS: Vandy pitching had not permitted a run in 25 consecutive innings before Florida broke through with a pair in the seventh inning on Friday.

- The streak was the longest for a Vandy staff since boasting 32 consecutive from March 13-20, 2011
- In two games this series, the Dores have limited the Gators to a .138 average including a .125 mark (3-for-24) with runners and .063 (1-for-16) with two outs.

ON FRIDAY'S WIN: Vanderbilt used a season-high 19 hits to defeat Florida, 15-2, and clinch the series on Friday.

- It was Vandy's highest run total in SEC play since scoring 17 against Texas A&M on March 25, 2017.
- The series win is the first against Florida since May 8-10, 2014 and is the Dores' 50th home series win since the start of the 2011 season.

PITCHING PROWESS: Vandy pitching entered Friday second nationally with 11.3 strikeouts per nine innings.

- The Commodores have struck out 10-plus batters in 15 of their 23 games.
- Vanderbilt's 15 strikeouts on Tuesday vs. Belmont were the most since having as many on March 8 against Illinois State.

IN THE RANKINGS: Vanderbilt fell out of the top spot in the D1Baseball.com poll after last weekend's series loss.

★ The Commodores had maintained their No. 1 preseason ranking until Monday, falling to No. 8.

SENIOR SLUGGER: Senior Ethan Paul has been on a tear as the Commodores' seven-hole hitter this season.

- The shortstop set a career-high with five hits Friday.
- Paul is the team leader with 12 multi-hit games and is tied for first with eight multi-RBI games.

TABLE SETTERS: Vanderbilt's top of the order -- Cooper Davis, Austin Martin and JJ Bleday -- has batted .376 (95-for-252) with 3.0 runs/game and 2.08 RBIs/game.

★ Martin is second in the SEC in batting average (.423). Davis is tied for fourth in triples (2) and Bleday is fourth in total bases (56).

2018 REWIND: Vandy advanced to its seventh NCAA Super Regional in the last nine seasons before falling one win shy of reaching the College World Series. The Dores won 10 of their final 14 games and finished ranked No. 18.

VETERAN PRESENCE: Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last year.

- ★ Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- Commodore returning pitchers contributed 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts in 2018.

EYEING 700: Head coach Tim Corbin is one victory shy of reaching 700 at Vanderbilt.

- Corbin captured his 800th career win March 10 with a 9-1 result vs. Illinois State, becoming just the 26th active head coach to reach the milestone
- Corbin is in his 22nd year as a head coach. He has 699 wins at Vanderbilt and 106 at Presbyterian.

TO THIS POINT: Through 23 games, Vanderbilt boasts a 18-5 record. It is Vandy's best start since posting a 19-4 record to begin the 2016 season.

★ Vanderbilt's .320 average is its highest through 23 games since batting .349 through as many in 2010.

FACING FLORIDA: Vanderbilt is looking for its first sweep of Florida since April 27-29, 2007, in Nashville.

- Vanderbilt's 15 runs on Friday were the most against the Gators since scoring 16 on May 10, 2014.
- Vanderbilt snapped a four-game losing streak to Florida with a 5-0 win on Thursday night.
- The Dores are 15-11 vs. Florida under head coach Tim Corbin (2003-present) at Hawkins Field.
- Corbin and Florida coach Kevin O'Sullivan served as coaches together at Clemson from 1999-02.

OUT OF THE GATE: Vandy has scored in the first inning in 12 of its 23 games including six of the last 11.

- The Dores are 11-1 when scoring in the first inning.
- JJ Bleday delivered a one-out, RBI-double in the first inning on Thursday against No. 14 Florida.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Vanderbilt ranks first in the SEC in batting average (.320), on-base percentage (.423), hits (256) and triples (11). The Dores are second in RBIs (171).

Vandy has scored five-plus runs 18 times and 10plus runs nine times. The Dores have produced double-digit hit outings in 15 games.

**DE-FENSE:** Vandy is second in the SEC and ninth nationally with a .982 fielding percentage.

- ★ In 2018, Vandy set a new school record and finished fifth nationally with a .981 fielding percentage.
- The Dores have posted a fielding percentage of .975 or better in five of the last six years.

LET'S PLAY TWO: Due to inclement weather, Vandy has played three doubleheaders this season. That is the most regular season twin bills since playing as many in 2006.

It is also the most doubleheaders hosted at Hawkins Field (2002-present) in a single season.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Vanderbilt's current streak of 13 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the longest in the SEC and the third-longest nationally, trailing only Florida State (41) and Cal State Fullerton (27).

**NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN:** Head coach **Tim Corbin** is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).

- ★ Corbin is 699-347-1 (.668) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
- ★ Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received firstteam recognition.
- In the Corbin era, 22 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America.

- ★ Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.
- Eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts on opening weekend. Justyn-Henry Malloy registered a pinch-hit RBI single and Sterling Hayes scored a run among notables.

**DORES ON TOP:** In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- ★ The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

**WELCOME TO THE HAWK:** The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 449-161-1 (.735) all-time record at its home including a 342-102-1 (.769) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

★ The Dores won 6-of-7 regular season three-game home series in 2018 and have won 50-of-63 threegame sets at The Hawk since 2011. SENIOR LEADERS: Vandy's five-member senior class is its largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF Walker Grisanti, 1B Julian Infante, SS Ethan Paul, RHP Patrick Raby and UTL Stephen Scott.

★ Since arriving on campus in 2016, the unit has helped Vandy to 132 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

**THE 2019 SCHEDULE:** Vanderbilt's 2019 schedule is another formidable slate. The Commodores face 10 teams that reached the NCAA Tournament in 2018 a total 22 times (39.2 percent of games).

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION: Vandy led the nation as four student-athletes were named to the 2018 Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American Team. Philip Clarke, Pat DeMarco, Mason Hickman and Austin Martin -- all returning for 2019 -- were recognized for their efforts.

FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS: Vanderbilt leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including first-round supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with **David Price** in 2007 and **Dansby Swanson** in 2015.

**FAR AND WIDE:** The 2019 roster features players from 14 different states as well as one (**Cooper Davis**) from Ontario, Canada. In total, 12 players hail from Tennessee and another eight call Florida home.

★ Three Commodores are from Ohio while two players are represented from California, Georgia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey and New York.

**MAJOR LEAGUE DORES:** In total, 13 former players made a MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

★ The Commodores led the nation with seven pitchers who made at least one MLB start and eight total hurlers who made an appearance in 2018.




