GETTING OFFENSIVE: Through two games, Vanderbilt is batting .383 as a team and has scored a combined 29 runs.

- The last time Vandy scored 14-or-more runs in each of its first two games of the season was 1973.
- Vanderbilt is batting .457 with two outs and has produced 15 two-out RBIs this season.

LET THE KIDS PLAY: Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America, the publication announced in September.

- ★ The Dores current sophomore class was ranked No. 1 by Baseball America. Vandy has produced 14-straight ranked classes by the publication.
- The Dores' 14-member class features six pitchers and eight position players. Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.

MAJOR LEAGUE DORES: In total, 13 former players made a MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

- ★ The Commodores led the nation with seven pitchers who made at least one MLB start and eight total hurlers who made an appearance in 2018.
- The Black and Gold also had a major presence in the 2018 MLB Postseason with four alumni on playoff rosters. The mark was tied for the most in the SEC and was second nationally.

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION: Vandy led the nation as four student-athletes were named to the 2018 Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American Team. Philip Clarke, Pat DeMarco, Mason Hickman and Austin Martin -all returning for 2019 -- were recognized for their efforts.

WHO'S AT SHORT?: While the Commodores return a bulk of their production from 2018, the squad will look to replace shortstop Connor Kaiser. The junior was selected in the third round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Pirates.

- ★ Kaiser's was the 2018 NCAA Clemson Regional MVP as well as an SEC All-Defensive Team honoree and finalist for the ABCA Gold Glove.
- Ethan Paul, who started all 62 games at second base a season ago, started at shortstop on opening day. It marked the fifth time the senior had started at shortstop and the first time since Feb. 27, 2016.

DE-FENSE: Vanderbilt set a school record and finished fifth nationally with a .981 fielding percentage in 2018. The Commodores committed 41 errors in 2,211 chances.

- ★ The Black and Gold played error-free baseball in 33 games and committed one or no errors in 53 outings.
- It marked the second time in four seasons Vandy has * set a new program record. The 2015 team set the previous standard by fielding .979.



PRESEASON NO. 1: For the second time in a five-year span, Vanderbilt enters the season ranked No. 1 nationally.

- The Commodores were tabbed No. 1 by D1Baseball, Baseball America and NCBWA. It marks the first time since April 7, 2015, Vandy has received the top ranking in any poll.
- The Dores' last preseason No. 1 ranking came in 2015 when the program was the unanimous top spot following their 2014 national championship.

AN OMAHA FEEL: Vanderbilt faced three teams in Omaha, Nebraska, during the 2015 College World Series -- TCU, Cal State Fullerton and Virginia. Vandy is 3-1 alltime against TCU and has won three consecutive games against the Horned Frogs including two in the 2015 CWS. The Dores also downed the Frogs, 7-4 at Dodger Stadium a season ago.

ROTATION INTACT: Vanderbilt welcomes back its entire weekend rotation from a season ago. The last time the Commodores returned all three pitchers was 2009 (Mike Minor, Caleb Cotham and Nick Christiani).

- Vanderbilt, LSU and Tennessee are the only three * teams in the SEC to return its entire rotation.
- The trio of Drake Fellows. Patrick Raby and Mason Hickman combined to go 20-11 with a 4.22 ERA across 48 appearances and 41 starts in 2018.

ON THE TRIP TO ARIZONA: This weekend marks Vanderbilt's first trip to Arizona since May 30-June 1, 2008, when the squad competed in the NCAA Tempe Regional.

★ Vanderbilt also began the 2008 season in Tempe, competing against Oregon State, Arizona State and Miami (Ohio) at Packard Stadium. The Dores defeated OSU, 8-1, and Miami, 4-3, but dropped the middle game, 18-6 to host Arizona State.

OPENING WEEKEND: Vanderbilt has won its opening weekend series six consecutive seasons (2013-present).

- ★ Vanderbilt has now won six of its last seven opening day matchups. The Commodores are 11-5 on opening day under head coach Tim Corbin.
- Vanderbilt's matchup against Virginia marked the second consecutive season in which the Dores have opened against an ACC opponent. In 2018, Vandy took 2-of-3 against No. 25 Duke in Nashville.

VETERAN PRESENCE: Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last year's NCAA Super Regional squad to its 2019 unit.

- Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- Commodore returning pitchers contributed 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts in 2018.

NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN: Head coach Tim Corbin is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).

- ★ Corbin is 683-342-1 (.665) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
- Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received firstteam recognition.
- In the Corbin era, 22 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

BEG, BORROW OR STEAL: For the third time in six years, Vanderbilt finished atop the SEC in stolen bases, raking in 101 swiped bags during 2018.

- ★ The Commodores have stolen 100-plus bases in four of the last of six seasons (2013, 2014, 2015, 2018).
- After recording just 54 stolen bases in 2017, Vandy nearly doubled its total last year. The 2018 squad swiped its 54th stolen base on April 5 (Game #30).

DORES ON TOP: In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

WELCOME TO THE HAWK: The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 435-159-1 (.732) alltime record at its home including a 328-100-1 (.765) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

★ The Dores won 6-of-7 regular season three-game home series in 2018 and have won 47-of-60 threegame sets at The Hawk since 2011.

SENIOR LEADERS: Vanderbilt's five-member senior class is the program's largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF Walker Grisanti, 1B Julian Infante, INF Ethan Paul, RHP Patrick Raby and C Stephen Scott.

★ Since arriving on campus in 2016, the unit has helped Vandy to 116 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

THE 2019 SCHEDULE: Vanderbilt's 2019 schedule will be another formidable slate. The Commodores are set to face 10 teams that reached the NCAA Tournament in 2018 a total 22 times (39.2 percent of games).

- ★ Vandy will host 19 of its 26 nonconference games including 15 consecutive from Feb. 22-March 17.
- The schedule is highlighted by a season-opening trip to Talking Stick, Ariz., for the MLB Collegiate Baseball Tournament, where the Dores will reunite with three opponents they previously faced in the College World Series.

FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS: Vanderbilt leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including firstround supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with David Price in 2007 and Dansby Swanson in 2015.

FAR AND WIDE: The 2019 roster features players from 14 different states as well as one (Cooper Davis) from Ontario, Canada. In total, 12 players hail from Tennessee and another eight call Florida home.

★ Three Commodores are from Ohio while two players are represented from California, Georgia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey and New York.

BEST OF THE BEST: Catcher Philip Clarke and second baseman Austin Martin are preseason first-team All-SEC honorees and outfielder JJ Bleday is a second-team allleague representative as voted on by SEC head coaches.

★ SEC head coaches picked Vanderbilt to win the SEC East and finish second overall behind LSU.
