BY COMPARISON: Vandy won its 32nd game Thursday vs. Auburn. A season ago, the Dores did not secure their 32nd win until blanking St. John's, 2-0 in the NCAA Regional opener.

The Commodores have won 30-plus games in 16 consecutive seasons (2004-present) and are searching for their 10th 40-plus win season in that time frame.

DORES ROLL TIDE: Vandy swept Alabama in Tuscaloosa for the first time sine 1906 last weekend. The SEC road sweep was the Dores first since March 2018 at Mississippi State. The road series win was Vandy's first in 2019

BLEDINGERS: Vanderbilt's JJ Bleday swatted five homers in four games last week, moving his season total to 20.

- The junior is one shy of Tulane's Kody Hoese's national-best 21. Bleday is third in program history for single-season homers and is two shy of Pedro Alvarez's program record of 22 set in 2006.
- Bleday is looking to become the first Commodore since Scotti Madison (1979) to lead the SEC in homers.

REVENGE TOUR: Vanderbilt went 0-9 a season ago against Belmont, Lipscomb, Florida, Auburn and at MTSU. Entering Friday, the squad is 7-0 vs. those teams.

RPI RUNDOWN: Vandy ranks No. 2 in the RPI, holding steady there following Thursday's win against Auburn.

- The Dores are 17-7 against opponents in the RPI top 50 and 4-1 vs. foes between 51-100.
- Auburn heads into Friday at No. 16 in the RPI Six of the top 15 in the RPI hail from the SEC

WITH THURSDAY'S WIN: Vanderbilt defeated Auburn, 12-6 in the series opener on Thursday.

- The Commodores improved to 17-0 in night games.
- Vanderbilt improved to 11-0 in series openers.
- **Drake Fellows** became the first pitcher nationally to reach nine victories, moving to 9-0 this season.

THE .400 CLUB: Austin Martin is looking to become the first Commodore since Warner Jones (2004) to bat above .400 in a season. He's also seeking to become the fifth Dore in the last 20 years to lead the SEC in average.

SENDING OUT AN SOS: Vanderbilt boasts the nation's toughest strength of schedule with its opponents boasting a 1,014-56-7 (.644) record entering play Friday.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Vanderbilt leads the SEC in slugging (.510) and on-base percentage (.411). The Dores are second in average (.312), runs (333) and hits (451).

★ Vandy is the only Power 5 program to have three players with 40-plus RBIs (JJ Bleday, Philip Clarke and Ethan Paul) and one of two nationally.

**DE-FENSE**: Vandy leads the SEC and ranks second in the nation with a .983 fielding percentage.

- ★ In 2018, Vandy set a new school record and finished fifth nationally with a .981 fielding percentage.
- The Dores have posted a fielding percentage of .975 or better in five of the last six years.

THE MIDWEEK DIFFERENCE: Vandy boasts a 10-1 record in midweek games including posting eight consecutive wins. A season ago, Vandy went 6-5 through its first 11.

PITCHING PROWESS: Vandy pitching enters Friday fourth nationally with 10.6 strikeouts/nine innings

★ The Dores have fanned 10-plus batters in 26 of their 41 games and nine-plus in 13 of the last 17.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Vanderbilt's current streak of 13 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the longest in the SEC and the third-longest nationally, trailing only Florida State (41) and Cal State Fullerton (27).

WATCH IT FLY: Vanderbilt has already totaled more home runs (55) than it did in six of the last eight seasons.

- ★ The Commodores rank 10th nationally and second in the SEC in home runs (South Carolina, 62).
- Twelve Vanderbilt players have totaled at least one home run led by JJ Bleday's 20.

- **NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN:** Head coach **Tim Corbin** is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).
  - ★ Corbin is 713-351-1 (.670) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
  - ★ Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received firstteam recognition.
  - ★ In the Corbin era, 23 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America.

- ★ Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.
- Eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts on opening weekend. Justyn-Henry Malloy registered a pinch-hit RBI single and Sterling Hayes scored a run among notables.

**DORES ON TOP:** In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- ★ The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

**WELCOME TO THE HAWK:** The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 458-163-1 (.737) all-time record at its home including a 351-104-1 (.770) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

★ The Dores won 6-of-7 regular season three-game home series in 2018 and have won 52-of-64 threegame sets at The Hawk since 2011. **MAJOR LEAGUE DORES:** In total, 13 former players made a MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

★ Eleven Dores have made an MLB appearance in 2019 including five pitchers with at least one start.

SENIOR LEADERS: Vandy's five-member senior class is its largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF Walker Grisanti, 1B Julian Infante, SS Ethan Paul, RHP Patrick Raby and UTL Stephen Scott.

★ The unit has helped Vandy to 146 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last season.

- ★ Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- ★ Returning pitchers totaled 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts.

**MARCHING ON:** Vanderbilt's 16 wins in March were the most since producing as many in 2013. It marked the fourth time ('10, '11, '13, '19) in the **Tim Corbin** era that Vandy has won as many games in March.

FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS: Vanderbilt leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including first-round supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with **David Price** in 2007 and **Dansby Swanson** in 2015.

**STATES' RIGHTS:** Vanderbilt has faced six in-state foes this season for a total of eight games.

- ★ The Commodores are 6-2 in those games including taking 2-of-3 against Tennessee to close March.
- ★ In eight contests vs. in-state foes, the Dores have batted .344 and averaged 8.8 runs per game. Vandy has limited opponents to a .197 average and 2.96 ERA.




