The Commodores have won 30-plus games in 16 consecutive seasons (2004-present) and are searching for their 10th 40-plus win season in that time frame.

NINE STRAIGHT: Vandy enters Saturday having won a season-high nine-straight games. The active streak is tied for the second longest nationally. Here's a look at the stretch:

BLEDINGERS: Right fielder JJ Bleday matched Pedro Alvarez's single-season home run record (2006) with his 22nd, coming in the fourth inning Friday at South Carolina.

- Bleday overtook Tulane's Kody Hoese's for the national lead with his 16th homer in 22 games.
- Bleday is looking to become the first Commodore since Scotti Madison (1979) to lead the SEC in homers.

REVENGE TOUR: Vandy went 2-12 in 2018 vs. Belmont, Lipscomb, Florida, Auburn, MTSU, Tennessee Tech and South Carolina. The squad is 11-0 vs. those teams in 2019.

RPI RUNDOWN: Vandy ranks No. 2 in the RPI, holding steady there following Friday's win at South Carolina.

- The Dores are 19-7 against opponents in the RPI top 50 and 6-1 vs. foes between 51-100.
- South Carolina is currently No. 74 in the RPI Seven of the top 15 in the RPI hail from the SEC.

FEELIN' 22: Vanderbilt downed South Carolina 22-11 on Friday. The Commodores' 22 runs were their..

- Most in 92 all-time meetings against South Carolina
- Most ever in an SEC road game
- Most in an SEC game since 1988 (27 vs. Alabama)

#### WITH FRIDAY'S WIN:

- ★ Vanderbilt has scored 20-plus runs in consecutive games for the first time in program history.
- Vandy is 20-0 in night games and 12-0 in series openers.
- The Dores are riding a seven-game SEC win streak, the program's longest since April 20-May 16, 2013.
- Vandy has won five-straight road games for the first time since March 21-April 16, 2015 (seven straight).

THE .400 CLUB: Austin Martin is looking to become the first Commodore since Warner Jones (2004) to bat above .400 in a season. He's also seeking to become the fifth Dore in the last 20 years to lead the SEC in average.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Vanderbilt leads the SEC in batting average (.321), slugging (.525), on-base percentage (.420), runs (390), and total bases (840). The Dores are second in hits (515), doubles (108) and home runs (63).

Vandy is the only Power 5 program to have three players with 45-plus RBIs (JJ Bleday, Philip Clarke and Ethan Paul).

DE-FENSE: Vandy leads the SEC and ranks fourth in the nation with a .981 fielding percentage.

- In 2018, Vandy set a new school record and finished fifth nationally with a .981 fielding percentage.
- The Dores have posted a fielding percentage of .975 or better in five of the last six years.

PITCHING PROWESS: Vandy pitching entered Friday fourth nationally with 10.7 strikeouts/nine innings.

★ The Dores have fanned 10-plus batters in 30 of their 45 games and nine-plus in 17 of the last 21.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Vanderbilt's current streak of 13 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the longest in the SEC and the third-longest nationally, trailing only Florida State (41) and Cal State Fullerton (27).

WATCH IT FLY: Vanderbilt has already totaled more home runs (63) than it did in six of the last eight seasons. The Dores rank ninth nationally and second in the SEC.

Vanderbilt has homered in 11 consecutive games, its longest stretch in the last 10 seasons.

- **NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN:** Head coach **Tim Corbin** is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).
  - ★ Corbin is 717-351-1 (.671) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
  - ★ Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received firstteam recognition.
  - In the Corbin era, 23 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America.

- ★ Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.
- Eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts on opening weekend. Justyn-Henry Malloy registered a pinch-hit RBI single and Sterling Hayes scored a run among notables.

**DORES ON TOP:** In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- ★ The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

**WELCOME TO THE HAWK:** The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 461-163-1 (.738) all-time record at its home including a 354-104-1 (.772) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

★ The Dores won 6-of-7 regular season three-game home series in 2018 and have won 53-of-65 threegame sets at The Hawk since 2011. **STATES' RIGHTS:** Vanderbilt has faced seven in-state foes this season for a total of nine games.

- ★ The Commodores are 7-2 in those games including taking 2-of-3 against Tennessee to close March.
- ★ In nine contests vs. in-state foes, the Dores have batted .357 and averaged 11.5 runs per game. Vandy has limited foes to a .208 average and 3.62 ERA.

**MAJOR LEAGUE DORES:** In total, 13 former players made a MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

★ Tyler Beede, who made the start Friday for the Giants, became the 12th Commodore to make an MLB appearance in 2019 and sixth pitcher to make a start.

SENIOR LEADERS: Vandy's five-member senior class is its largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF Walker Grisanti, 1B Julian Infante, SS Ethan Paul, RHP Patrick Raby and UTL Stephen Scott.

★ The unit has helped Vandy to 150 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last season.

- ★ Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- ★ Returning pitchers totaled 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts.

**SENDING OUT AN SOS:** Vanderbilt boasts the nation's toughest strength of schedule with its opponents boasting a 1,203-727 (.623) record entering play Saturday.

FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS: Vanderbilt leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including first-round supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with **David Price** in 2007 and **Dansby Swanson** in 2015.


