SUSTAINING NO. 1: After going 2-1 on opening weekend, including wins against Virginia and No. 25 Cal State Fullerton, Vandy maintained its No. 1 ranking (D1Baseball.com).

- ★ The Commodores were tabbed preseason No. 1 by the publication. It was the first time since April 7, 2015, Vandy has received the top ranking in any poll.
- The Dores' last preseason No. 1 ranking came in 2015 when they held the top spot in all six polls.

ABOUT OPENING WEEKEND: Vandy took 2-of-3 on opening weekend thanks to a pair of offensive outbursts.

- ★ Vandy batted .359 (23-for-64) with runners on base, .417 (20-for-48) with two outs and .514 (37-for-72) with opportunities to advance runners.
- Austin Martin was named SEC Player of the Week after scoring nine runs, drawing five walks and batting .600 with a .750 on-base percentage.

PHIL IN THE BLANK: For a second consecutive opening weekend, Philip Clarke led the Commodores in RBIs. The catcher produced six against No. 25 Duke in 2018 and eight at the 2019 MLB4 Collegiate Baseball Tournament.

★ Clarke's eight RBIs on opening weekend are the most for a Vanderbilt player since at least 2006.

HOME NONCON SUCCESS: Vanderbilt is 97-20 (.829) in nonconference games at Hawkins Field since the start of the 2013 season. The Commodores went 12-4 in those games a season ago. Vandy's best mark during that stretch came in 2016 when the squad finished 20-1.

**ROTATION INTACT:** Vanderbilt welcomes back its entire weekend rotation from a season ago. The last time the Commodores returned all three pitchers was 2009 (Mike Minor, Caleb Cotham and Nick Christiani).

- ★ Vanderbilt, LSU and Tennessee are the only three teams in the SEC to return its entire rotation.
- The trio of Drake Fellows, Patrick Raby and Mason Hickman combined to go 20-11 with a 4.22 ERA across 48 appearances and 41 starts in 2018.

2018 REWIND: Vandy advanced to its seventh NCAA Super Regional in the last nine seasons before falling one victory shy of reaching the College World Series. The Dores, who won 10 of their final 14 games, finished the 2018 campaign 35-27 and ranked No. 18 by D1Baseball.com.

VETERAN PRESENCE: Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last year's NCAA Super Regional squad to its 2019 unit.

- Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- Commodore returning pitchers contributed 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts in 2018.

AGAINST EVANSVILLE: Wednesday marks the 59th alltime meeting between Vanderbilt and Evansville with the Commodores holding a 39-19 advantage.

- The Commodores have won three consecutive in the series including a 6-1 decision a season ago
- Vanderbilt is 25-10 against the Purple Aces all-time in Nashville and 5-2 at Hawkins Field.

LET THE KIDS PLAY: Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America, the publication announced in September.

- ★ Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.
- Eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts on opening weekend. Justyn-Henry Malloy registered a pinch-hit RBI single and Sterling Hayes scored a run among notables.

MAJOR LEAGUE DORES: In total, 13 former players made a MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

★ The Commodores led the nation with seven pitchers who made at least one MLB start and eight total hurlers who made an appearance in 2018.

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION: Vandy led the nation as four student-athletes were named to the 2018 Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American Team. Philip Clarke, Pat DeMarco, Mason Hickman and Austin Martin -all returning for 2019 -- were recognized for their efforts.

WHO'S AT SHORT?: While the Commodores return a bulk of their production from 2018, the squad will look to replace shortstop Connor Kaiser. The junior was selected in the third round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Pirates.

- ★ Kaiser was the 2018 NCAA Clemson Regional MVP as well as an SEC All-Defensive Team honoree and finalist for the ABCA Gold Glove.
- Ethan Paul started all 62 games at second base a season ago. His start at shortstop on opening day was his fifth career and was the first at that position since Feb. 27, 2016 vs. UIC.

DE-FENSE: Vanderbilt set a school record and finished fifth nationally with a .981 fielding percentage in 2018. The Commodores committed 41 errors in 2,211 chances.

- ★ The Black and Gold played error-free baseball in 33 games and committed one or no errors in 53 outings.
- It marked the second time in four seasons Vandy has set a new program record. The 2015 team set the previous standard by fielding .979.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Vanderbilt's current streak of 13 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the longest in the SEC and the third-longest nationally, trailing only Florida State (41) and Cal State Fullerton (27).

NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN: Head coach Tim Corbin is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one

national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).

- ★ Corbin is 683-343-1 (.665) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
- ★ Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received firstteam recognition.
- In the Corbin era, 22 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

**BEG, BORROW OR STEAL:** For the third time in six years, Vanderbilt finished atop the SEC in stolen bases, raking in 101 swiped bags during 2018.

- ★ The Commodores have stolen 100-plus bases in four of the last of six seasons (2013, 2014, 2015, 2018).
- After recording just 54 stolen bases in 2017, Vandy nearly doubled its total last year. The 2018 squad swiped its 54th stolen base on April 5 (Game #30).

**DORES ON TOP:** In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- ★ The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

**WELCOME TO THE HAWK:** The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 435-159-1 (.732) all-time record at its home including a 328-100-1 (.765) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

★ The Dores won 6-of-7 regular season three-game home series in 2018 and have won 47-of-60 threegame sets at The Hawk since 2011. SENIOR LEADERS: Vandy's five-member senior class is its largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF Walker Grisanti, 1B Julian Infante, SS Ethan Paul, RHP Patrick Raby and UTL Stephen Scott.

★ Since arriving on campus in 2016, the unit has helped Vandy to 116 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

**THE 2019 SCHEDULE:** Vanderbilt's 2019 schedule is another formidable slate. The Commodores face 10 teams that reached the NCAA Tournament in 2018 a total 22 times (39.2 percent of games).

★ Vandy hosts 19 of its 26 nonconference games including 15 consecutive beginning today against Evansville. The Commodores next road game is March 15 at Texas A&M

FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS: Vanderbilt leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including first-round supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with **David Price** in 2007 and **Dansby Swanson** in 2015.

**FAR AND WIDE:** The 2019 roster features players from 14 different states as well as one (**Cooper Davis**) from Ontario, Canada. In total, 12 players hail from Tennessee and another eight call Florida home.

★ Three Commodores are from Ohio while two players are represented from California, Georgia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey and New York.

**BEST OF THE BEST:** Catcher **Philip Clarke** and second baseman **Austin Martin** are preseason first-team All-SEC honorees and outfielder **JJ Bleday** is a second-team all-league representative as voted on by SEC head coaches.

★ SEC head coaches picked Vanderbilt to win the league, just ahead of LSU in second.


