FACING LSU: Vanderbilt and LSU meet for the 102nd time in the history of the programs and ninth time in the history of the SEC Tournament on Saturday.

Despite winning five of the last six series, the Dores are just 1-7 against the Tigers at the SEC Tournament.

SEC CHAMPS: Vanderbilt captured its first since SEC regular season title since 2013 with a 12-4 win at Kentucky.

★ Vandy's 23 conference wins were its second-most in program history. The Commodores have won 20 league games four times (2007, 2011, 2013, 2019).

SURGING: Vanderbilt has won 20 of its last 21 contests including 13 straight from April 16-May 10. Here's a look at how the Commodores have played during that stretch:

GOLDEN SPIKES: JJ Bleday and Austin Martin have been named Golden Spikes Award semifinalists.

- ★ Four schools boast multiple semifinalists (Arizona State, Mississippi State, Texas A&M and Vandy).
- The 42nd Golden Spikes winner will be announced June 14 at TD Ameritrade Park in Omaha, Nebraska.
- Five Dores have been named finalists including David Price, who took home the honor in 2007.

WINNING WAYS: Vanderbilt and UCLA are tied for the national lead with 47 victories.

- The Dores have won 40 games 10 times in program history (2004, '07, '08, '10, '11, '13, '14, '15, '16 and '19) -- all under head coach Tim Corbin.
- Vanderbilt closed its season with nine-straight SEC road victories, the longest streak in team history.
- Vandy's 47-10 mark is its best through 57 games since 2013 (49-8) and among its best in team lore.

RPI RUNDOWN: Vanderbilt leads the nation in RPI after two wins at the SEC Tournament.

- ★ The Dores are 27-8 against opponents in the RPI top 50 and 7-1 vs. foes between 51-100.
- Five of the top-15 teams in the RPI and nine of the top-25 hail from the SEC.

SURVIVE AND ADVANCE: Vanderbilt is making its 14th appearance in the SEC Tournament semifinals and first since 2015. The Dores are one win shy of advancing to their 11th tournament finals (2015, 2013, 2012, 2011, 2009, 2007, 2006, 2004, 1994, 1980).

#SECTOURNEY NOTABLES: Vandy defeated Auburn and Mississippi State, posting a 0.53 ERA while limiting the pair to a .138 average and .038 (1-for-26) with runners on.

- The shutout against Mississippi State was Vandy's 10th at the SEC Tournament and first since 2016.
- During Thursday's shutout win against Mississippi State, all 27 outs were recorded on the infield.
- Right fielder JJ Bleday became the first SEC player since 2003 and first Commodore to record five hits in an SEC Tournament game, doing so vs. Auburn.

QUICK HITTERS: A few key notes on how we got here:

- Vandy's 12 wins in May are its most since boasting 13 in 2013 and second-most in the last decade.
- Vandy posted a 12-1 record in the midweek, 26-0 in night games and is 14-0 in series openers.
- The Dores won six-straight SEC series to cap the season and swept four league series.
- Vandy's .317 team batting average is its highest since hitting a school-record .324 in 2007.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Vanderbilt's current streak of 13 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the longest in the SEC and the third-longest nationally, trailing only Florida State (41) and Cal State Fullerton (27).

THE .400 CLUB: Austin Martin is looking to become the first Commodore since Warner Jones (2004) to bat above .400 in a season. He's also seeking to become the fifth Dore in the last 20 years to lead the SEC in average.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Vanderbilt leads the SEC in average (.317), slugging (.518), on-base percentage (.416), triples (16) and RBIs (449). The Dores are second in runs (477).

★ Vanderbilt has already totaled its most home runs (78) since swatting 85 in 1997. The Dores have homered in six straight games.

PITCHING PROWESS: Vandy pitching enters Saturday third nationally with 10.8 strikeouts/nine innings.

- ★ The Dores have fanned 10-plus batters in 37 of their 57 games and nine-plus in 27 of the last 33.
- Vanderbilt ranks 15th nationally and fourth in the SEC with a 2.81 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN: Head coach Tim Corbin is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).

- ★ Corbin is 728-352-1 (.673) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
- Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received firstteam recognition.
- In the Corbin era, 23 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

LET THE KIDS PLAY: Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America.

- Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.
- Eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts on opening weekend. Justyn-Henry Malloy registered a pinch-hit RBI single and Sterling Hayes scored a run among notables.

DORES ON TOP: In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

WELCOME TO THE HAWK: The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 464-164-1 (.738) alltime record at its home including a 357-105-1 (.772) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

★ The Dores all eight regular season home series this season and won 6-of-7 in 2018. Vandy has won 54of-66 three-game sets at The Hawk since 2011.

FINAL

REVENGE TOUR: Vanderbilt went 3-15 in 2018 against Belmont, Lipscomb, Florida, Auburn, MTSU, Tennessee Tech, South Carolina, Louisville and Missouri. The Dores are 18-1 vs. those teams in 2019 including an 11-1 win against Auburn on Wednesday at the SEC Tournament.

DE-FENSE: Vanderbilt leads the SEC and ranks second in the nation with a .982 fielding percentage.

- The school record for fielding percentage is .981 and was set last year as the Dores finished fifth nationally.
- The Dores have posted a fielding percentage of .975 or better in five of the last six years.

MAJOR LEAGUE DORES: In total, 13 former players made an MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

★ A total of 12 Dores have made an MLB appearance in 2019 including six pitchers with at least one start.

SENIOR LEADERS: Vandy's five-member senior class is its largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF Walker Grisanti, 1B Julian Infante, SS Ethan Paul, RHP Patrick Raby and UTL Stephen Scott.

The unit has helped Vandy to 161 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

VETERAN PRESENCE: Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last season.

- ★ Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- Returning pitchers totaled 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts.

FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS: Vandy leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including first-round supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with David Price in 2007 and Dansby Swanson in 2015.

- ★ Leads the SEC in home runs (25), slugging percentage (.752) and total bases (167) and RBIs (65)... Second in the SEC behind Austin Martin in runs (70).
- ★ Led Vandy with a .368 average, .511 slugging percentage and .494 on-base percentage in 2018.
