LEADING OFF

For the second consecutive season and second time in program history, Duke (34-25, 15-15 ACC) is headed to an NCAA Super Regional as the Blue Devils face No. 2 national seed Vanderbilt (52-10, 23-7 SEC) at Hawkins Field in Nashville, Tenn., June 7-9. The Commodores host the Blue Devils first at 6 p.m. (ET), Friday, June 7 on ESPN2. Saturday's matchup is set for 9 p.m. (ET) on ESPNU while Sunday's if necessary game is scheduled for 3 p.m. (ET) on ESPN2.

BY THE NUMBERS

1 Duke is the only institution to win a bowl game, send a men's basketball team to the Elite Eight and advance to a Super Regional in each of the last two years.

2 The Blue Devils are making their second consecutive, and the program's second, appearance in an NCAA Super Regional, This postseason marks Duke's eighth trip to the NCAA Tournament, and third over the last four seasons.

5 Sophomore Bryce Jarvis ranks fifth in the ACC in strikeouts per nine, with a mark of 11.14. The second-year right-hander places has recorded 85 strikeouts this season, which place him first on the team.

6 Graduate student **Ben Gross** leads the team in wins with seven on the season. Gross earned his seventh win of the season in his last start against Texas A&M in the NCAA Morgantown Regional. The righthander worked 7.0 innings, allowing only one earned run to help Duke to advance in the winner's bracket.

8 Sophomore Matt Dockman has posted scoreless outings in eight of his last nine appearances. Dockman has earned saves in back-to-back outings. which both came in the NCAA Morgantown Regional.

9 Sophomore Thomas Girard is tied for third in the ACC in saves with nine on the season. Girard is a perfect nine-for-nine on save opportunities to lead the team across his team-high 27 appearances. The second-year right-hander owns a 2.15 ERA (11 ER/46.0 IP), while limiting opposing hitters to a .171 average.

81 Senior co-captain Kennie Taylor is tied for fourth in the ACC in hits with 81, while tying for third in the conference in hits per game with 1.40. The senior stands ninth in the league in doubles with 19, 15th in total bases (128) and 16th in batting average (.324).

105 Senior *Kennie Taylor* and freshman *Ethan* Murray received All-ACC honors this season, to push Duke's total to 105 All-ACC honorees in program history. Taylor was named to the All-ACC first team while Murray received ACC All-Freshman Team honors.

569 The Blue Devil pitching staff has recorded 569 strikeouts this season, averaging 9.7 strikeouts per nine innings. Duke ranks third in the ACC in strikeouts per nine innings and 19th in the nation. The team's 569 punchouts are good for third in the league and 17th in the country, while ranking as the second most in school history.

SERIES HISTORY VS. THE COMMODORES

Friday's contest to open the NCAA Nashville Super Regional will the just the fourth matchup between Duke and Vanderbilt in program history. The Commodores own the series advantage over the Blue Devils, 1-2, with all three matchups coming in Nashville. The two teams met for a weekend series to open the 2018 season, with Vanderbilt taking the bookend games of the three-game set to secure the series win. Duke fell in game one, 9-1, before bouncing back with a 5-4 victory in game two to even the series. The Commodores claimed the series finale, 9-1, in the rubber match of the series to earn the series victory. Head coach *Chris Pollard* also owns a 1-2 career record against Vanderbilt.

RECAPPING THE MORGANTOWN REGIONAL

Duke went a perfect 3-0 last weekend to sweep the NCAA Morgantown Regional and earn its second consecutive NCAA Super Regional appearance. The Blue Devils defeated second-seeded Texas A&M, 8-5, in the opening round before taking down top-seeded West Virginia, 4-0, to advance to the regional finals. In the final matchup of the weekend, Duke downed Texas A&M, 4-1, Sunday evening to secure the regional victory and advance in the NCAA Tournament. Five Blue Devils were named to NCAA Morgantown Regional All-Tournament Team in junior *Erikson Nichols*, sophomores *Bryce Jarvis* and *Chris Crabtree*, graduate students *Ben Gross* and *Kyle Gallagher*. Jarvis was selected as the regional's Most Valuable Player for his career performance against West Virginia, when he tossed eight shutout innings, collecting a career-high 11 strikeouts.

PROGRAM TRENDING UPWARD

The Blue Devils are headed to their second consecutive, and the program's second, NCAA Super Regional. Duke is also making its third NCAA Tournament appearance in four years. The last time Duke won two consecutive NCAA Regional championships in the NCAA postseason was the 1952 and 1953 seasons, when the team made back-to-back runs to Omaha. The Blue Devils are making their eighth overall appearance in the NCAA Tournament, owning a record of 26·17 in the postseason. Duke has been to three College World Series, with the last appearance coming in 1961.

STARTING FAST

The Blue Devils hold a sizeable advantage when getting off to fast starts, as the team owns a 25-7 record when it scores first as opposed to a 9-18 mark when the opponent scores first. Duke also holds a 17-8 record when the team scores in the first inning compared to a 7-13 mark when the opponent scores in the first inning.

DETAILS

On October 2, 2015, Duke renewed its agreement with the Durham Bulls to play home games at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park (DBAP), home of the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays. Beginning in 2016, the contract renewal is a seven-year agreement that allows Duke to play up to 36 exhibition and home games at the DBAP each year. The agreement also called for a limited number of Duke practices at the DBAP as well as a new permanent Duke locker room and clubhouse at the facility. Duke and the Durham Bulls began their partnership prior to the Blue Devils' 2010 season. The 2019 campaign marks the 10th consecutive season in which Duke will play homes games at the DBAP. Under the new agreement, the Blue Devils will play the vast majority of their home schedule at the minor league venue.

A NEW ERA IN THE POSTSEASON

The Duke pitchers posted an impressive 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP) across the NCAA Morgantown Regional on its way to going a perfect 3-0 across the weekend. The Blue Devils' earned run mark tied for third among the 64 teams in the NCAA Tournament, and first among schools in the ACC. The Duke starting pitchers notched an earned run average of 0.92 (2 ER/19.2 IP) across the three games, highlighted by sophomore *Bryce Jarvis'* 8.0 shutout innings. Graduate student *Ben Gross* only allowed one earned run across his 7.0 innings of work, while junior *Bill Chillari* also yielded one run over his 4.2 innings in the regional.

WELCOME TO K-VILLE

The Blue Devil pitching staff has been impressive this season, recording 569 strikeouts to rank third in the ACC and 17th in the nation. Duke is 19th in the country in strikeouts per nine innings with 9.72, while also ranking third in the league in that category. The team's 569 punchouts are currently the second most in school history — only six shy of the school record which was set last season — as the team continues its postseason run. Sophomore *Bryce Jarvis* leads the way with 85 strikeouts, while freshman *Cooper Stinson* is second with 78 punchouts.

ROTHENBERG TURNING IT ON

Sophomore *Michael Rothenberg* has turned it on as of late, emerging as one of Duke's top hitters across the last 24 games. Over the span, Rothenberg is batting .321 (25-78), which ranks second on the team, while sporting a team-high on-base percentage of .443. Six of Rothenberg's 10 home runs this season have come across the 24-game span, along with a team-high 27 RBI -- 14 more than any other player. The Blue Devil backstop has cut down 10 runners on the base paths in 24 chances across the past 24 games, compared to only eight in 30 chances in the first 35 games of the season. Rothenberg was named to the 2019 ACC Baseball Championship All-Tournament Team for his performance in the league tournament. The Boca Raton, Fla., native, recorded six RBI across the team's two games in the tournament, including a career-high five RBI in the opening game against Notre Dame. Rothenberg launched his first career grand slam in the win over the Fighting Irish, marking only the 23rd grand slam in ACC Tournament history.

WELCOME BACK JOEY

After a 23-game absence due to injury, sophomore infielder **Joey Loperfido** returned to the lineup on April 3 and has provided the Blue Devils with an offensive spark. Duke is an impressive 25-11 when Loperfido is a part of the lineup, including a 20-11 mark since his return. Across the 36 games that Loperfido has played, the Blue Devils are fielding at a .977 percentage with 30 errors, opposed to fielding at a rate of .955 with 38 errors in the 23 games when he was injured.

DOCKMAN, DAVIS AND GIRARD BOLSTER BULLPEN

The trio of sophomore *Matt Dockman*, senior co-captain *Hunter Davis* and sophomore *Thomas Girard* have bolstered the Duke bullpen across the 2019 season, combining for 13 of the team's 17 saves. Dockman has been Duke's go-to arm as of late, posting scoreless appearances in eight of his last nine outings, while Davis and Girard rank first and second on the Blue Devil pitching staff in ERA. Davis sports a team-low ERA of 1.47 (6 ER/36.2 IP), while Girard owns a mark of 2.15 (11 ER/46.0 IP). Girard is a perfect nine-for-nine on save opportunities this season to tie for third in the ACC and lead the team. The trio has combined for a 2.37 ERA (32 ER/121.1 IP) across their 69 appearances this season.

JARVIS AMONG THE STRIKEOUT LEADERS

Sophomore **Bryce Jarvis** ranks fifth in the ACC in strikeouts per nine innings with a mark of 11.14. Jarvis leads the team in strikeouts with 85 this season across his 68.2 innings pitched, which rank second on the squad. The second-year right-hander posted a career-high 11 strikeouts in his last start against West Virginia, working a career-long 8.0 shutout innings to earn NCAA Morgantown Regional Most Valuable Player honors.

TAYLOR AND MURRAY NAMED ALL-ACC

The Atlantic Coast Conference announced the 2019 All-ACC Baseball Teams, with a pair of Blue Devils receiving all-conference recognition. Senior outfielder *Kennie Taylor* and freshman infielder *Ethan Murray* both earned All-ACC accolades for the 2019 campaign, with Taylor being named to the all-conference first team—the first such honor of his career—and Murray receiving a nod for the ACC All-Freshman Team. With the selections, Duke has now had 105 All-ACC honorees in program history, including 12 in the last four years.

30 WINS FOR POLLARD

Head coach *Chris Pollard* notched his 30th win of the season in game two of the Miami series, marking his sixth consecutive season with 30-plus wins. The Duke skipper became the first head coach to lead the Blue Devils to six 30-win seasons in his first seven campaigns. This spring, Pollard has notched his 200th win at Duke and his 600th career win as head coach. Pollard's victory total of 232 ranks third in school history, only behind *Jack Coombs* (381-171-3, 1929-52) and *Steve Traylor* (356-286-1, 1988-99).

POLLARD HEAD COACH SEVENTH SEASON AT DUKE

Chris Pollard became Duke University's 25th head baseball coach in June 2012, taking the reigns of the Blue Devil program after successful stints at Pfeiffer University and Appalachian State University. In addition to guiding the Blue Devils to five straight 30-win seasons, Pollard led Duke to an at-large bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament, ending the program's 55-year drought without making the postseason event. Pollard became the fastest Duke head coach to reach 100 wins with the Blue Devils, recording his 100th victory at Duke March 15, 2016, against Maryland Eastern Shore. During Pollard's tenure, 21 Blue Devils have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.
