
# MIDDLE TENNESSEE 37 VANDERBILT 28



Nashville, Tenn., Aug. 30 - Vanderbilt's most productive quarter in nearly two years wasn't enough to stop Middle Tennessee from pulling an opening-season 37-28 upset in front of 39,885 fans. The Commodores lost despite one of the greatest receiving games in Vanderbilt history by junior wideout M.J. Garrett. The Old Hickory, Tenn. native, who entered the game with 12 career catches, had eight receptions for 219 yards, including a 73varder in the second quarter that put Vanderbilt ahead 28-24 at the half. The 219yard effort was the second highest singlegame accumulation ever by a VU receiver. After two touchdowns by halfback Dwone Hicks gave Middle Tennessee an early 14-0

lead, Vanderbilt scored 28 points in the second quarter to gain the four-point half-time margin. The points were provided on runs by Rodney Williams and Lew Thomas, and touchdown passes from Greg Zolman to Dan Stricker and Garrett. The 28-point outburst was Vanderbilt's highest since Oct. 9, 1999 against The Citadel. Midway through the third quarter, the Commodores lost the lead on an 80-yard drive by MTSU, culminated by Hicks' fourth rushing touchdown. The Commodores failed on several opportunities late in the game to regain control, including a dropped TD pass and a field goal miscue from 23 yards. Besides Garrett's performance, Zolman passed for 300 yards and Thomas showed promise, gaining 72 yards on just seven carries



### ALABAMA 12 VANDERBILT 9



Nashville, Tenn., Sept. 8 - The Commodores went toe-to-toe with Alabama before falling 12-9 in front of 37,318 spectators and a regional television audience. In the closing seconds, Vanderbilt missed an opportunity to send the game into overtime. The Commodore defense played superb, holding the Tide to 357 total yards and the first SEC opponent without a touchdown since Nov. 6, 1993 (vs. Kentucky). Chuck Folino kicked three field goals and punter Joe Webb had a career day, averaging 57 yards on three attempts, including a career-long, 78-yarder. Besides Webb's performance, the Commodores received career highs from running back Lew Thomas (89 yards on 10 car-

ries), Brandon Smith (73 yards on three receptions) and true freshman Jason Mathenia (three catches for 41 yards). Zolman completed passes to eight different receivers. Defensively, linebacker Antuian Bradford had 12 tackles while end Chuck Losey added a forced fumble.



## RICHMOND 22 Vanderbilt 28



Nashville, Tenn., Sept. 22 - One week after the SEC postponed all games due to the Sept. 11th attacks, the Commodores captured their first 2001 win with a 28-22 victory over visiting Richmond. The win didn't come early as Richmond, coming off a narrow loss to crossstate rival Virginia, jumped out to a 10-0 first quarter lead and a 16-14 halftime margin. In the second half, the Commodores controlled much of the game. The defense limited Richmond to six points and 145 total yards. Greg Zolman lead the VU attack with 236 passing yards, two touchdowns and no interceptions, connecting with nine different receivers. including six passes to Stricker for 84 yards. Ronald Hatcher had his finest game receiving,

hauling in three catches for 61 yards, including a career-high 54 yarder. Thomas was the top rusher and achieved a career high for the third consecutive game, gaining 93 yards on 15 carries. Freshman linebacker Pat Brunner paced the defense with 10 tackles. Safety Justin Giboney added nine tackles, while linebackers Antuian Bradford and Nate Morrow contributed eight and seven tackles, respectively.



## **AUBURN 24** VANDERBILT 21



Nashville, Tenn., Sept. 29 - One week after battling Alabama to the wire, Vanderbilt found itself in the same situation against another SEC foe. Auburn, before 39,366 spectators. This game would prove even more heartbreaking., resulting in a 24-21 loss. The Commodores played their finest game of the year, holding the Tigers to 24 rushing yards in the second half while controlling tempo with an effective offense. Yet, Auburn walked off with the win. VU fans watched the emergence of RB Lew Thomas, who shredded the Auburn defense in a fourth consecutive career performance, piling up 173 yards and two touchdowns on 27 carries. The Commodores showed plenty of heart, battling back three

times to tie the score. Down 24-21, the 'Dores moved 54 yards to the Auburn 26, but was unsuccessful with a fake field goal with just :37 seconds left. Nate Morrow had eight tackles to top the Vanderbilt defense. Linebacker Hunter Hillenmeyer and Lorenzo Parker contributed fumble recoveries for the Commodores. Defensive end Chuck Losey had a forced fumble in the effort.

NASHVILLE, Tenn., Oct. 13 - The Commodores played hard in front of a homecoming audience, but fell to the talented Bulldogs 30-14. The final score easily could have been different. The Commodores' first and last drives of the game ended unsuccessfully at the Ga 1. Another fourth quarter drive resulted in a missed 38-yard field goal. Vanderbilt managed 23 first downs and 436 total yards on the Georgia defense, and controlled the clock, 34:40-25:20, by running a season-high 88 offensive plays. Greg Zolman passed for 316 yards, completing 24 of 50 attempts. Lew Thomas gained 75 yards on 23 carries. Dan Stricker had an outstanding game, catching eight passes for 137 yards. Linebacker Antuian





# Game Results

## VANDERBILT 42 DUKE 28



Durham, N.C., Oct. 27 - Rodney Williams, in support of injured running back Lew Thomas, ran for 155 yards and two touchdowns as Vanderbilt notched a 42-28 victory over Duke. Williams had an extremely productive day despite losing a pair of fumbles. He ran 18 times, averaging 8.6 yards per carry, and had a game-high rush of 56 yards. QB Greg Zolman, shaken in the opening series, completed just eight of 18 attempts, but threw touchdown passes of 54 yards to M.J. Garrett and 45 yards to Dan Stricker. The VU running game had its most productive game. Thomas, who entered the game as the SEC's second leading rusher, was superb early, gaining 123 yards on just eight carries. Thomas' season

ended when he suffered multiple fractures in his right foot. The Commodore defense contributed to the win with several big plays, including a season-high four interceptions, a fumble recovery and two quarterback sacks. Justin Giboney had two interceptions and three deflected passes. A 48-yard interception return by cornerback Aaron McWhorter led to a two-play scoring drive, while Lorenzo Parker's first collegiate interception stopped another Duke drive. Antuian Bradford was in on 15 tackles and forced a fumble.







## Vanderbilt 27 OLE MISS 38



Oxford, Miss., Dec. 1 - For three quarters, the Commodores played their best football in weeks. Ole Miss QB Eli Manning dominated the final stanza, leading the Rebels to a 38-27 victory over a spirited Vanderbilt team playing for the last time under head coach Woody The Commodores, playing Widenhofer. before a regional television audience, shocked Ole Miss with 14 unanswered points in the third quarter to open a 20-3 lead late in the third quarter as the defense limited the Rebels to 265 total yards. Zolman threw for 286 yards, tying a career high with three touchdown passes, 26 yards to M.J. Garrett, 50 yards to Dan Stricker, and 28 yards to Jason Mathenia. Down 27-17, Manning guided Ole

Miss to three TDs in the final eight minutes to provide the victory. Several Commodore offensive players sparkled. Stricker caught 11 passes for 169 yards. His season total of 1,079 yards receiving is the third highest in VU history. Rodney Williams ran for 96 yards, becoming just the seventh 'Dore to surpass 2,000 career rushing yards. Defensively, junior safety Jerrol Jackson had a season-high two interceptions. Senior linebacker Nate Morrow contributed nine tackles. Vanderbilt's three interceptions were the second highest total of the season.
