Vanderbilt held the Yellow Jackets scoreless for the first quarter, then watched Georgia Tech produce 31 second quarter points.

Early in the first quarter, Commodore offensive guard Jordan Pettit suffered a leg fracture that ended his season. Moses Osemwegie, making his first collegiate start, led the Vanderbilt defense with nine tackles.



The Commodores' three fourth-quarter touchdowns was the most Vanderbilt has scored in the final stanza of SEC play since Sept. 29, 1990 against Alabama.






