
Game 1 Vanderbilt at Wake Forest

WINSTON-SALEM, N.C. — For the first time since 1993, the Commodores opened their season with a road victory, earning a 24-20 comeback over ACC foe Wake Forest. The game was aired nationally on ESPNU.

The victory was sparked by a fourth quarter drive by senior QB Jay Cutler, who connected with freshman Earl Bennett to spark a 49-yard possession that ended with tailback Jeff Jennings' 5-yard TD carry.

After going ahead, the Commodore

defense held the Demon Deacons out of the end zone. In the closing seconds, Wake Forest's last-gasp pass was knocked down by cornerback Josh Allen.

Cutler completed 25 of 36 passes for 276 yards and a TD, and added 89 rushing yards. Jennings had 43 rushing yards and two TDs. Marlon White had a gamehigh seven catches.

Andrew Pace, playing his first game at cornerback, finished with 10 tackles. Kelechi Ohanaja and Allen had nine and eight tackles, respectively.



VANDERBILT 28 ARKANSAS 24

FAYETTEVILLE, ARK. — For the second time in as many weeks, Vanderbilt orchestrated a late-minute comeback victory, defeating the Arkansas Razorbacks 28-24.

The last time Vanderbilt logged consecutive road victories was in 1999, when the 'Dores beat Ole Miss and Duke.

After a slow start, the Commodore defense limited Arkansas to less than 100 yards in the final three quarters while Jay Cutler directed a remarkable comeback. The win

was sealed by an last-second interception by Moses Osemwegie.

Cutler guided the 'Dores to a pair of fourth quarter touchdowns, ended each with a pass to Marlon White. Erik Davis also had seven catches for 110 yards. Cutler completed 23 of 45 for 278 yards.

Linebacker Jonathan Goff had a game-high 14 tackles. Osemwegie and Kelechi Ohanaja each had eight tackles; and Kevin Joyce and Andrew Pace had seven.



NASHVILLE - The Commodores defeated Ole Miss Rebels 31-23 to remain undefeated for the first time since 1984. The game, played before a home opener crowd of 34,847, was televised regionally on Jefferson-Pilot Sports.

Quarterback Jay Cutler (24-41-0, 314 yards) moved from fourth place to second place in Vanderbilt's all-time passing yards. Receiver Erik Davis caught eight passes for 107 yards, and tight end Dustin Dunning

caught four for 86 yards. Jeff Jennings ran for a game-high 103 yards and three touchdowns. Cassen Jackson-Garrison had eight carries for 36 yards and a touchdown. Jennings leads the SEC with seven touchdowns.

The defense was led by Osemwegie with 11 tackles, and Reshard Langford (5).

NASHVILLE – The red-hot Commodores continued its undefeated streak, beating the Richmond Spiders 37-13 to move to 4-0 on the season.

Jay Cutler broke two records tonight before a season-high crowd of 38,446 in the team's strongest start in nearly 50 years.

Cutler's 277 total-yard performance carried his career total to 7,956, placing him in lone ownership of the school record. His five-yard pass to Erik Davis in the second

quarter also moved him to first in career touchdown passes (42). Two of Cutler's teammates crossed the century mark tonight: Cassen Jackson-Garrison ran for a career-high 119 yards and his second career touchdown, and Earl Bennett caught 11 passes for 124 yards.

Linebacker Moses Osemwegie led the Commodore defense with five solo tackles, followed by safety Ben Koger, who had four total tackles and two assists.



NASHVILLE - The Cardiac Commodores, who have earned a national reputation with a pair of come-from-behind victories this season, lost 17-15 to MTSU in Vanderbilt Stadium. The Blue Raiders thwarted a wouldbe game-winner for the Dores, blocking a 36-yard FG attempt with :03 left on the clock.

In the final two minutes, Jay Cutler marched the Commodores from the own oneyard line to the MTSU 19-yard line, but a last second field goal attempt by Bryant

Handfeldt was blocked. His previous three kicks were successful.

For the game, Cutler threw for 245 yards (44-26-1) and ran for 21. Erik Davis caught seven passes for a game-high 92 yards and one touchdown. Earl Bennett also caught seven passes (63 yards). Cassen Jackson-Garrison led the Dores on the ground, with nine carries for 46 yards.

Moses Osemwegie led the Dores' defense with 13 tackles and Andrew Pace had 10 tackles.

Commodores' six points, a 36-yard field goal and a second from a career-long 48. Linebacker Moses Osemwegie had 11 tackles for the Commodores, including



NASHVILLE - The fifth-ranked Georgia Bulldogs rained on Vanderbilt's homecoming party, beating the 'Dores 34-17 before 38,822 fans and an ESPN2 TV audience.

Jay Cutler completed 15-of-28 pass attempts for 160 yards and one score. But a persistent Bulldog defense limited the senior's overall effectiveness, sacking him four times and intercepting him once.

Cutler connected with Marlon White midway through the third quarter on a 14-yard

pass into the end zone, bringing the Dores within 10 points (24-14). But the last Vanderbilt score would come from Bryant Hahnfeldt's 45-yard field goal in the third quarter.

Moses Osemwegie tied a career high with 13 tackles, a pair of tackles for loss, and an inteception, while cornerback Andrew Pace had nine tackles.






