- Named University of Dayton head baseball coach on June 29, 2017, Jayson King led Dayton Baseball to the program's most wins (both overall and in conference) since 2014 in his first season at the helm. The Flyers also made an 85 spot improvement in the RPI during his first season.

- Prior to Dayton, King was the Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator at Army in 2017 after spending the previous 18 seasons as head coach at NCAA Division II Franklin Pierce. In his first season in Division I, King produced the No. 33 overall recruiting class as ranked by Perfect Game, with 24 high school commitments from 14 states.

- In his 21-year career as a head coach, King has amassed a record of 696-369-3 (.651) at Dayton, Franklin Pierce and UMass-Boston.

- He led Franklin Pierce to 10 NE-10 Conference Championships, seven NCAA Northeast Regional appearances, and seven trips to the NCAA Division II College World Series.

- 2015 Franklin Pierce Hall of Fame inductee

- King earned the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year honor on seven occasions, most recently in 2016.

- In his time at Franklin Pierce, 25 of his student-athletes were drafted in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.

- Coach King also has experience with USA Baseball, including a role as one of the managers for the 16U National Development Team for the 2018 summer and previously serving as an assistant coach for the 18U National Team.

- King also coached in the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League as well as working a season with the Lowell Spinners, the short-season affiliate of the Boston Red Sox.

Cleary, as well as starting pitcher Aaron Ernst were all recognized as top freshman in the league.

NEWCOMERS

- 10 of the newcomers are pitchers, while six are position players.
- The Flyers had a Top-100 Recruiting Class nationally by Perfect Game and the No. 2-rated class in the Atlantic 10.
- Five different newcomers have started in the field including juniors Alex Brickman and Eddie Pursinger, along with true freshmen Benjamin Blackwell, Marcos Pujols and Jay Curtis.
- JUCO transfers Hunter Wolfe and Cole Pletka have also earned starts on the mound for the Flyers, while Corey Imbriano is often the first man out of the bullpen.
