QUICK HITTERS

- ★ Vanderbilt dropped to 9-4 on the season and 0-1 in league play after falling to Ole Miss, 81-71, on Saturday evening at Memorial Gym in the league opener for both teams. Freshman Simisola Shittu scored a career-high 21 points to lead the Commodores, while senior forward Joe Toye also scored in double figures with 12 points.
- ★ The Commodores were limited to 40% from the floor, 30% from three, and 58.6% from the free-throw line in the loss.
- ★ Shittu was named the conference's Freshman of the Week after averaging 19 points, nine rebounds and 3.5 assists against UNC Asheville and Ole Miss. Shittu is the Commodores' second Freshman of the Week selection, joining Darius Garland, who won the honor in the first week of the season.
- ★ Shittu's 21 points was the most by a Vanderbilt freshman in an SEC opener since A.J. Ogilvy scored 25 points in an 80-73 win over South Carolina at Memorial Gym on January 9, 2008.
- ★ Vanderbilt, an inaugural member of the Southeastern Conference, are in their 86th season of SEC competition. Vanderbilt has won two SEC Tournament titles (1951, 2012) and three regular season titles in 1965, 1974, and 1993. This will be the 67th SEC season in Memorial Gym for the Commodores.
- ★ The Commodores enter the game as the 304th-most experienced team in the country according to KenPom.com. Sophomore Saben Lee is Vanderbilt's returning scorer from league play a year ago when he averaged 11.7 points per game. In all, 34.9% of the team's scoring in league play returns from 2017-18. Only four Vanderbilt players, Lee, Maxwell Evans, Clevon Brown, and Joe Toye, played in an SEC game prior to the team's opener with Ole Miss.
- ★ Nine Commodores have scored in double figures in a game so far this season.
- ★ Vanderbilt's average height is 78.5 inches (6 feet, 5 inches) and ranks 17th nationally according to KenPom.
- ★ Earlier this season, Vanderbilt knocked off nationally-ranked Arizona State at Memorial Gym on December 17th. The win snapped an eight-game losing streak to ranked opponents, dating back to a 72-62 overtime win over 17th-ranked Florida at the 2017 SEC Tournament (3/10/17) at Bridgestone Arena. The Sun Devils went on to defeat Kansas later in the month.
- ★ The Commodores have marched to the charity-stripe 357 times this season, which tops all SEC schools and ranks 35th nationally. Vanderbilt also leads the SEC and is 32nd nationally in free throw makes with 255.
- ★ Vanderbilt also ranks in the top five in the SEC in 3FG Attempts (4th, 310), Defensive rebounds per game (3rd, 29.31), Fewest Fouls (4th, 222), Fewest Turnovers (4th, 168), Scoring Offense (4th, 82.0), 3FG% Defense (5th, 31.9), 3FG Made per game (5th, 8.2), Total 3FG made (5th, 107), Total Rebounds (3rd, 520), Rebounds per game (4th, 40.0), and Turnovers per game (3rd, 12.9).
- ★ Individually, Lee is ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in assists per game (9th, 3.8), free throw attempts (2nd, 90), and free throws made (2nd, 65). Ryan is ranked in 3FG attempts (5th, 84), 3FG per game (6th, 2.5), 3FG% (6th, 39.3), and total threes made (6th, 33), while Shittu is ranked in defensive rebounds per game (5th, 6.1), double doubles (8th, 2), free throw attempts (6th, 81), free throws made (5th, 56), rebounds per game (8th, 7.8), and total rebounds (7th, 102).
- ★ Freshman point guard Darius Garland, a five-star recruit and a 2018 McDonald's All-American, was lost for the season after suffering a meniscus injury in his left knee against Kent State on November 23. He suffered the injury two minutes into the game against the Golden Flashes. Garland was named the SEC's Freshman of the Week in the opening week of the year after averaging 21.5 points per game in two Commodore wins over Winthrop and USC.
- ★ Joe Toye scored in double figures in three straight games for the first time of his four-year career in the first three games of the 2018-19 season and has double-digit points in nine games this season, including four of his last five.
- ★ Vanderbilt won their 800th career game at Memorial Gym against Arizona State on December 17. Memorial Gym, which opened in 1952, is the oldest basketball arena in the SEC.
- ★ Vanderbilt won its first road game of the season at USC, the first time the Commodores have had a season-opening road win since a 72-70 win over St. Mary's on November 20, 2009.

- ★ Rayshaun Hammonds leads the Bulldogs in scoring, averaging 13.8 points per game. Nicolas Claxton adds 12.7 points per game, while Tyree Crump pitches in 10.8. Claxton leads also leads the Bulldogs in rebounding, assists, blocks, and steals.
- ★ Vanderbilt leads the series 89-50 but the Bulldogs lead the series in Athens, 35-31. Georgia has won the last two games in the series in Athens, with Vanderbilt's last win coming at Georgia on January 29, 2014 (59-54).

Three Commodores on NBA Rosters

Former Commodores Damian Jones, Luke Kornet, and Wade Baldwin IV are currently on NBA active rosters. Jones averaged 17.1 minutes and 5.4 points per game with the Golden State Warriors this season before being sidelined with a torn left pectoral muscle. He has won two championships with the team in his three seasons in the Bay Area. Kornet is a two-way player with the New York Knicks and is averaging 13.1 minutes and 6.2 points per game in 18 games and five starts. Baldwin is averaging 5.5 minutes per game in 13 games with the Portland Trail Blazers.

The Commodores are one of only four programs (Duke, UNC Asheville, Pittsburgh) in the nation to have three separate freshman score 20 points or more in a game (Darius Garland, Aaron Nesmith, Simisola Shittu)

Replacing Three 1,000 Point Scorers

Matthew Fisher-Davis, Riley LaChance and Jeff Roberson each departed Vanderbilt in 2018 as 1,000-point scorers. Each were four-year players for the Commodores who advanced to the postseason on three different occasions (2015 NIT, 2016 and 2017 NCAA Tournaments). There has been only one other class of Vanderbilt players to have three 1,000-point scorers - the vaunted "F Troop" - Butch Feher, Joe Ford and Jeff Fosnes in 1976. Roberson and Fisher-Davis are now playing in the NBA G League, while LaChance has taken his talents to play professionally in Poland.

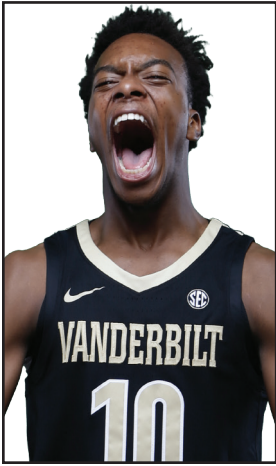

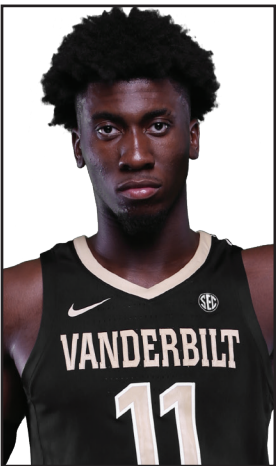

Recap

NASHVILLE (AP) -- Breein Tyree scored a career-high 31 points, and Mississippi opened Southeastern Conference play by beating Vanderbilt 81-71 Saturday night for the Rebels' eighth straight victory.

Ole Miss now has won four straight in Memorial Gym and seven of the last nine between these teams. First-year coach Kermit Davis picked up where he left off winning his fourth consecutive in a streak he started at Middle Tennessee. The Rebels led 35-32 at halftime and simply outshot Vanderbilt in the second. They hit 57.7 percent (15 of 26) in the second half.

Blake Hinson, Terence Davis and Devontae Shuler added 11 points each for Ole Miss (11-2).

Vanderbilt (9-4) snapped a two-game winning streak after finishing its nonconference slate winning four of the last five.

Freshman Simisola Shittu led the Commodores with a career-high 21 points, and Joe Toye added 12.

In a tight game with 10 ties and 13 lead changes, Vanderbilt had its biggest lead at 53-47 on a 3-point play by Shittu with 14:23 left.

Then the Rebels took over with a 20-7 run. Davis hit a 3 and then stole the ball to set up Shuler for a fast-break layup and a 65-60 lead that matched their largest of the game to that point. Tyree added a pair of free throws for the Rebels' biggest lead to finish the run.

Ole Miss then put away the game as Davis hit a 3 and Shuler added a layup with 4:01 left for a 79-63 lead.

Vanderbilt didn't hit a bucket after Aaron Nesmith's 3 with 3:46 left as the Commodores finished the game hitting only one of their final seven shots.

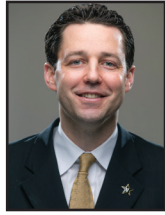

MEMORIAL MAGIC - THE HOME TO VANDERBILT HOOPS SINCE 1952

HISTORIC MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM IN 67TH SEASON

Storied Memorial Gymnasium is in its 67th season as the host venue of Vanderbilt basketball. The SEC's most historic hoops setting has played host to more than 950 men's contests as well as the 1984 and 1991 SEC Tournaments and 40 men's and women's NCAA Tournament contests (since the early 1980s).

As the oldest gymnasium in the SEC, Memorial Gymnasium is renowned for its end zone benches, raised floor and unique atmosphere. It was dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II. It was built by the late master architect Edwin Keeble, who was commissioned to build a combination gymnasium/concert hall.

**VANDERBILT BASKETBALL
QUICK HITTERS**

- This is the 116th year of Vanderbilt basketball, with the first season taking place in 1900-01. There were no teams in 1904-05 and 1905-06.
- The Commodores have been named to 15 NCAA Tournaments and 12 NIT's. Vanderbilt advanced to the Elite 8 in 1965 (field of 23), and the Sweet 16 in 1988, 1993, 2004, and 2007. The Commodores captured the NIT Championship in 1990 and finished runner-up in 1994.
- The Commodores are a charter member of the SEC, with the 2018-19 season being the 86th year in the conference.
- Vanderbilt is the only private institution in the SEC with the lowest enrollment of any of the 14 schools (6,738).
- Vanderbilt's Perry Wallace became the first African-American scholarship basketball player in the SEC when he took the court in 1967.
- The Commodores have 48 career 1,000-point scorers, with Shan Foster (2004-08) the all-time leading scorer with 2,011 career points.
- Vanderbilt has had 12 All-Americans since 1950. They are: Billy Joe Adcock (1950), Clyde Lee (1965), Tom Hagan (1969), Jan van Breda Kolff (1974), Will Perdue (1988), Billy McCaffrey (1993), Dan Langhi (2000), Matt Freije (2004), Derrick Byars (2007), Shan Foster (2008), and John Jenkins (2011).
- Vanderbilt had two players selected in the 2016 NBA Draft - Wade Baldwin IV, Memphis, 17th pick and Damian Jones, Golden State 30th pick - one of only three schools with two or more players drafted in the first round. In all, 37 Vanderbilt players have been selected in the NBA Draft since 1950.
- The Commodores had three players drafted in the first 31 picks of the 2012 NBA Draft - John Jenkins, Atlanta, 23rd pick, Festus Ezeli, Golden State, 30th pick, Jeffery Taylor, Charlotte, 31st pick - the most by the Commodores in one draft.
- The Commodores ended a 61-year SEC Tournament drought in 2012 by claiming the tournament championship in New Orleans, the team's first SEC tournament championship since 1951.
- Kevin Stallings is the winningest coach in Vanderbilt history with 322 total victories (17 years, 322-220).
- All three of the university's top all-time scorers played for Kevin Stallings (Foster, Jeffery Taylor, Matt Freije). John Jenkins, who is 10th on the list, also played for him.
- Vanderbilt's intercollegiate athletics teams are nicknamed the Commodores, in honor of the nickname given to founder Cornelius Vanderbilt, who made his fortune in shipping. Vanderbilt donated \$1 million to begin "Central University" in 1875 - the campus was later renamed for Cornelius because of his generosity. Cornelius never stepped foot on the campus that bears his namesake.
