TCU NOTABLES

- TCU enters the season ranked in the top 20 in five of the six polls. The Frogs are ranked as high as No. 16 (Perfect Game) and as low as No. 19 (D1Baseball.com and Collegiate Baseball).
- TCU was picked to finish third in the Big 12 this season. It's the lowest it has been picked since joining the league in 2012.
- Over the last five seasons, TCU ranks fourth in the nation with 231 victories.
- Nick Lodolo is a preseason All-American, including first-team accolades from Baseball America.
- TCU welcomed 16 newcomers in the fall, consisting of eight freshmen and eight transfers.
- TCU is one of just 10 teams nationally with over 475 stolen bases the last five years. The 499 stolen bases rank seventh in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.
- TCU's 3.02 ERA since the start of the 2014 campaign is fifth nationally.
- Johnny Rizer carries a five-game hitting streak into the season. He's reached base in 12 straight.

TOURNAMENT NOTABLES

- The 2019 season marks the fourth time in program history the Horned Frogs will play in multiple tournaments during the regular season (2002, '06, '07, '15).
- TCU is 29-17 in regular-season tournaments under head coach Jim Schlossnagle.

NEUTRAL SITE NOTABLES

- TCU is playing seven neutral site games in 2019.
- The Horned Frogs are 77-44 in neutral site contests under Schlossnagle.
- TCU is 26-16 in regular season neutral site games under Schlossnagle.

SEASON OPENER NOTABLES

- TCU is opening the season away from home for the second straight season.
- TCU is opening at a neutral site for the fourth time in program history (1999 Gateway Classic in Laredo, 2002 and 2006 Houston College Classic).
- The Frogs are 2-1 in neutral site season openers.
- TCU is opening away from home for just the fifth time under the guidance of Jim Schlossnagle.
- TCU is 2-2 in season-openers away from home under Schlossnagle.
- TCU is opening a season against Cal State Fullerton for the third time (2008, '09). The Frogs are 0-2 against the Titans in season-openers.
- TCU is 10-5 in season-openers under his guidance.

SERIES NOTABLES

- TCU and Cal State Fullerton are meeting for the 23rd time. The Titans own a 15-7 series lead.
- The Frogs and the Titans meet for six consecutive seasons (2008-13) in a home/away series.
- Friday's meeting will be the first at a neutral site.
- Saturday's meeting against Virginia will be just the third in a series that is tied at one.
- Both meetings have come in the postseason.
- In 2014, UVA topped TCU 3-2 in 15 innings at the College World Series.
- TCU topped the Cavaliers by a 5-1 score in the 2017 NCAA Fort Worth Regional.
- TCU and Vanderbilt are meeting for the fifth time.
- The Commodores hold a 3-1 series lead. All four meetings have been at a neutral site.
- Vanderbilt won two of three meetings (both in the CWS) in 2015.
- The two teams have split a pair of meetings at Dodger Stadium (TCU won in 2015; Vandy won in 2018).

UP FOR GRABS

TCU bid adieu to five everyday field starters and one starting pitcher at the end of the 2018 campaign. The Frogs welcomed an influx 16 newcomers in the fall that will have a chance to make an immediate impact.

The lineup suffered the biggest loss with the departure of five everyday starters. The Frogs will have to replace 55 percent of their offense from a year ago. Gone are 270 hits, 21 home runs and 167 RBIs. The returners combined to hit .241 with 18 home runs and 123 RBIs.

On the mound, while only one starter and three relievers have departed, they took with them 124 innings of work and six saves. The returning group boasts a 3.49 ERA with 398 strikeouts and a 26-17 record.

PRESEASON RESPECT

The last 15 seasons have seen the Horned Frogs gradually imprint themselves on the national scene. No stranger to the rankings, the Frogs find themselves in the preseason polls for the 10th consecutive season.

TCU is a consensus No. 25 team in five major polls. The Frogs are ranked as high as No. 16 (Perfect Game) and as low as No. 21 (National Collegiate Baseball Writer's Association Poll).

Additionally, Nick Lodolo has earned a spot on various preseason All-American teams. It marks the ninth straight season the Horned Frogs have had at least one player recognized on a preseason All-America team.

AMONG THE BEST IN THE COUNTRY

Since taking over the program in 2004, head coach Jim Schlossnagle has done nothing but win. In 15 years under his guidance, the Horned Frogs are 648-295. TCU has posted 11 seasons with at least 40 wins and three of 50+ wins. The Horned Frogs have appeared in 13 NCAA Regionals.

The 648 victories are tops among Division I programs in the state of Texas as is the .687 winnings percentage.

Since the start of the 2010 campaign, the Frogs boast the seventh-best winning percentage (.694) and the seventh-most wins (397) in the nation.

ELITE COMPANY

Despite missing the postseason for just the second time in Schlossnagle's tenure, TCU is still among the nation's elite. The Frogs are one of just 16 programs to have appeared in 13 of the last 15 NCAA postseasons. Additionally, TCU's five appearances in the CWS since 2010 are the second-most in the NCAA.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

In two of the last three years, TCU has ranked in top 50 in scoring and near the bottom nationally in sac bunts. TCU has averaged 6.5 runs the last three seasons, while tallying just 20 sacrifices.

Over the last five years, TCU has scored multiple runs in 477 innings. In 139 innings, TCU has produced four or more runs.

TCU has scored 10 or more runs 60 times over the last five seasons and tallied 108 wins of 5+ runs. Conversely, the Frogs have lost just 26 games by five or more runs since 2014.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs ranked second in the Big 12 and 37th nationally with 83 stolen bases in 2018.

The Frogs are one of just 10 teams to have stolen at least 475 bases over the last five years. The 499 stolen bases rank seventh in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

STINGY STAFF

The Frogs' 3.02 ERA since 2014 is fifth nationally. TCU led the nation with a 2.22 ERA in 2014 and ranked second in 2015 with a 2.45 ERA. Additionally, the TCU pitching staff has tossed the second-most shutouts (43) nationally over the last five years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 150 times over the last 323 games played. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 104 times.

THE K-ZONE

The Frogs set a school and Big 12 record in 2017 with 643 strikeouts. TCU ranked 10th in K/9 at 9.5 in 2017. Since 2014, the Frogs has ranked in the top 10 three times in K/9 (2014, 8.4; 2017, 9.6).

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 147 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

VACUUMS

In two of the last four seasons, the Frogs have established a school-record fielding percentage. TCU has fielded .971 or better each of the last six years, including a school-record .979 in 2015.

Over the last four seasons, the Frogs have produced a combined .975 fielding percentage. The Frogs have one or fewer errors in 238 of their last 323 games played.

CHASING ANOTHER MILESTONE

In a career that has been marked by milestones each and every year, the 2019 season will be no different. Last season, Schlossnagle notched his 700th career win. Already the all-time winningest coach in TCU history (648), Schlossnagle will be chasing his 650th victory at TCU and his 750th career win when the season begins.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Schlossnagle has a .681(725-339) winning percentage. He ranks sixth in winning percentage among active coaches with at least five years of experience. His 725 wins rank 32nd nationally among active coaches.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 62 extra inning games since 2004 and holds a 40-22 mark in those games.

The Frogs went to extra innings for the fourth time in 2018 against Abilene Christian. TCU dropped a 4-2 decision in 11 innings, giving them a 9-3 record in extra innings dating back to the 2015 campaign. The 13-innings played against Minnesota is the longest game this season. It is the most played since TCU defeated Texas A&M in 15 innings on March 4, 2016.

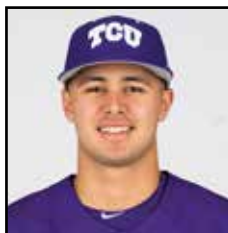

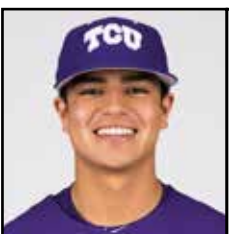
