### LEADING OFF

The No. 22 Texas A&M Aggies open SEC play with a three-game series against the No. 2 Vanderbilt Commodores starting Friday.

The Aggies begin their seventh year of SEC play, posting a 94-83 mark in league play over the span.

Vanderbilt enters the fray ranked No. 2 in the USA Today Coaches Poll and No. 1 in the rankings published by Baseball America, D1Baseball.com and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

### TEXAS A&M/VANDERBILT SERIES NOTABLES

The Maroon & White and Vanderbilt have met 16 time previously, with the Aggies holding the all-time series edge, 9-7. Texas A&M blanked the Commodores, 5-0, in their first meeting in 2013. The Aggies are currently on a two-game win streak. Texas A&M and Vanderbilt have met at least once a year since joining the South Eastern Conference.

The last meeting came in the first game of the 2018 SEC tournament with the Aggies registering a 3-1 victory. Kaylor Chafin was brilliant in a rare starting appearance, throwing six frames allowing one run on six hits and one walk while fanning five. Nolan Hoffman recorded his 14th save of season, throwing three scoreless frames scattering two hit while striking out three. Offensively, eight different Aggies accounted for their nine hits with Michael Helman recording the lone multi-hit day and one RBI.

### SUSTAINED EXCELLENCE

The Texas A&M Aggies are one of only four schools to appear in each of the last 12 NCAA Division I Baseball Championships. The Maroon and White's 12-season NCAA postseason string is the second-longest in the SEC trailing only Vanderbilt (13 years). It's also the longest active string among Texas schools.

## FRIDAY'S PROBABLE STARTER: #14 JOHN DOXAKIS

NCBWA National Pitcher of the Month for February 2019... has pitched in 46 games, including 25 starts... owns a 15-9 career record with a 3.32 ERA, .213 opponent batting average and 177 strikeouts in 164.0 innings of work... ranks seventh the nation in K-to-BB ratio (17.00), 22nd WHIP (0.68) and 26th in strikeouts (34) and (5.40)... has 10-plus strikeouts in four of his last six outings... earned All-Tournament at the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic after holding then-No. 18 Baylor to one run on four hits while striking out 12 over 8.0 innings... named SEC Pitcher of the Week and earned Golden Spikes Award Performance of the Week following his season-opening effort against Fordham, yielding just on hit while striking out a career-high 12 in 7.0 innings... pitched in 17 games for the Aggies in 2018, including 14 starts... logged an 8-5 record with a 2.70 ERA, .212 opponent batting average and 92 strikeouts in 93.1 innings... started 10 SEC games, going 3-5 with a 3.90 ERA and 48 strikeouts in 57.2 innings... outdueled No. 1 overall MLB Draft Pick Casey Mize at the SEC Tournament, notching the win as allowed just one run on two hits while striking out 10 in 7.1 innings vs. Auburn (5/24)... posted a victory against Indiana (6/1) at the NCAA Austin Regional, yielding one unearned run on one hit and two walks while fanning a career-high 12 in 6.0 innings... made three starts with the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team, finishing the summer with a 1-1 record... earned a victory against Chinese Taipei, allowing just one hit while striking out three in 3.0 innings... pitched in 25 games for the Aggies in 2017, including seven starts... pitched for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League... started four games for the Miners, posting a 3-1 record with a 1.08 ERA and 30 strikeouts in 25.0 innings... started one game in the ACL Championship series earning a win against the Peninsula Oilers, allowing one run on four hits while striking out six in 8.0 innings... selected to participate in the ABL All-Star Game... selected All-Alaska Baseball League First Team... tabbed as the No. 1 prospect in the Alaska Baseball League by D1Baseball.com and the No. 2 prospect by Baseball America and Perfect Game... four-year letter-winner for head coach David Munoz at Lamar High School... three-time all-district pitcher... selected All-District 20-6A First Team and All-Greater Houston as a senior, logging a 4-2 record on the mound with a 1.40 ERA... also hit .301 as a senior... tabbed All-District 20-6A First Team as a junior, notching a 5-2 record with a 0.84 ERA... also batted .320 as a junior... earned All-District 20-5A First Team as a sophomore.

## SATURDAY'S PROBABLE STARTER: #35 ASA LACY

Has 27 career appearances with six starts, posting a 7-1 record with a 1.85 ERA, .171 opponent batting average and 85 strikeouts in 63.1 innings... in his last five starts dating back to last year's SEC Tournament, he has yielded just one earned run in 30.0 innings, posting a 0.30 ERA, 0.80 WHIP and 45 strikeouts (12 walks)... Aggie ninth in the nation in ERA (0.38), 13th in strikeouts (37) and 28th in K/9 innings (13.88) and 38th in WHIP (0.75)... named to All-Tournament Team at the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic after holding then-No. 17 TCU to one hit while striking out nine in 7.0 innings... had 10-plus strikeouts in his first two starts of 2019... weaved 6.0 shutout innings against UIC, scattering two hits and three walks while striking out 10... opened the season with a win against Fordham, yielding one run on three hits and one walk while striking out 11 in 5.0 innings... pitched in 23 games, including two starts, in his first season in Aggieland... logged a 3-1 record with one save, a 2.75 ERA, .200 opponent batting average and 48 strikeouts in 39.1 innings... stranded 15 of 22 inherited runners... pitched out of the bullpen in nine SEC games, going 0-1 with one save, a 4.30 ERA and 13 Ks in 14.2 innings... started SEC Tournament game against Georgia (5/23), scattering three hits and three walks with a career-high eight Ks in 6.0 innings to earn the victory... pitched for the Matsu Miners of the Alaska Baseball League, posting a 3-1 record with a 2.16 ERA, 1.09 WHIP and 47 strikeouts in 33.1 innings... named Alaska Baseball League Top prospect by Baseball America and Perfect Game... three-year letterwinner at Kerrville Tivy for Coach Chris Russ, an Aggie from 1998-2001... selected Collin Street Baker/TSWA Class 5A All-State First Team as a senior in 2017 as well as being selected to pitch in the THSBGA All-Star Game... also named All-District 26-5A First Team and District 26-5A MVP as a senior... logged a 13-1 record with a 0.93 ERA and 128 strikeouts in 97.1 innings in 2017... set a school record in 2017 with 13 wins... notched a 2-2 mark with an 0.60 ERA as a junior... tabbed All-District 26-5A Second Team in 2016... named District 26-5A Newcomer of the Year as a sophomore in 2015... Posted a 4-1 record with a 1.04 ERA as a sophomore.

## FOURTH INNING SEPARATION

The Aggies are outscoring opponents 28-3 in the fourth inning. Texas A&M's offense clicks best in the fourth frame, posting a .407 batting average. **LOGAN FOSTER** leads the way batting .727 (8-for-11) with two doubles, four runs and three RBI. **BRYCE BLAUM** is hitting .667 (4-for-6) with one walk and five runs. **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** is batting .500 (4-for-8) with one home run, one walk, five RBI and four runs.

On the mound, the Aggies are holding opponents to a .167 batting average (11-for-66) with just one extra-base hit.

## NON-CONFERENCE HOME DOMINANCE

The Aggies are 88-7 in regular-season non-conference home games since 2015, including 19-1 in 2018. The highlight of the current run came in 2015 when Texas A&M went 22-0 against non-conference foe at Blue Bell Park in regular-season play. They went 18-1 in 2016 and 18-2 in 2017. Sam Houston State accounted for two of the losses, including 5-0 in 2016 and 8-2 in 2017. The other losses are against Pepperdine (2-1) in 2017, UT Arlington (5-1 - 18 inn.) in 2018 and both UIC (7-2) and Incarnate Word (6-5) in 2019.

## WHAT'S BACK IN 2019: OFFENSE

The Aggies bring back five position players who started at least 50 percent of the games (31 of 62) for last season's team – **ZACH DELOACH** (61), **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** (61), **LOGAN FOSTER** (55), **HUNTER COLEMAN** (49), **WILL FRIZZELL** (49) and **ALLONTE WINGATE** (31). Two other field returnees started games in 2018, including **AARON WALTERS** (22), **CAM BLAKE** (12), **CHANDLER MORRIS** (9) and **COLE TAYLOR** (1).

## TOUGH TESTS SPANGLE THE 2019 SCHEDULE

The Aggies will face 12 different opponents who made the 2018 NCAA Championship for a total of 28 games, including Arkansas (3), Auburn (3), Gonzaga (3), LSU (3), Mississippi State (3), Ole Miss (3), South Carolina (3), Vanderbilt (3), Baylor, Dallas Baptist, Houston and Texas.

Thirty-six of Texas A&M's games will be against teams that finished in the top 100 of the final RPI rankings in 2018, including 13 games against teams which finished in the RPI top 25. The Aggies play seven games against College World Series squads from 2018, including three against runner-up Arkansas.

FIRST SEC TEAM TO 2,700 WINS

The Aggies own the most wins of any SEC program with 2,700 victories, which ranks 11th nationally. Texas A&M enters play with a 2,710-1,509-42 mark. On February 20, 2019, the Aggies became the first SEC team to reach the 2,700-win mark with a 9-1 win against Prairie View A&M. Texas A&M's all-time winning percentage of .640 also leads the SEC and ranks 15th among NCAA Division I schools.

POST-SEASON STREAK CONTINUES HEADING INTO 2019

Prior to the arrival of head coach **ROB CHILDRESS**, Texas A&M had never appeared in the NCAA Tournament more than four consecutive years. Last year's regional bid extended the Aggies' current string to 12 consecutive years, something that had never happened before in the program's 116-year history.

Childress has led the Aggies to the postseason each of the last 12 seasons, topping the previous-high water mark of four-straight trips, a feat that had happened only twice before at Texas A&M. Former head coach Tom Chandler led his squad to the NCAA Regionals each season from 1975 to 1978 and 11 years later the Aggies enjoyed a similar four-year run from 1986-89 under the direction of head coach Mark Johnson.

PRESEASON HONORS FOR DOXAKIS AND SHEWMAKE

**JOHN DOXAKIS** and **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** were named to the Preseason All-SEC team as voted on by the conference's coaches.

The duo were both named to the All-SEC Second Team. The pair have each hauled in Preseason All-America recognition with Doxakis earning a spot on the D1Baseball.com All-America Second Team and Shewmake named to the Rawlings/Perfect Game All-America Third Team.

In 2018, Doxakis posted an 8-5 record with a 2.70 ERA, .212 opponent batting average while striking out 92 in his 93.1 innings of work.

The Houston native shined in the postseason, notching a 2-0 record, 0.68 ERA and 22 strikeouts over 13.1 innings in his two starts. At the SEC Tournament, Doxakis outpitched Auburn's Casey Mize, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2018 MLB Draft, by yielding just one run on two hits while striking out 10 in 7.1 innings. In regional play, he worked 6.0 innings against Indiana, allowing one unearned run on one hit and two walks while striking out 12.

Last season, Shewmake earned All-SEC First Team recognition as a shortstop. He played in 61 games, notching a .327 batting average with 43 runs, eight doubles, four triples, five home runs, 45 RBI and 12 stolen bases.

As a freshman, Shewmake filled up his trophy case playing second base. In addition to earning the Aggies' first SEC Freshman of the Year honor, he was named All-America First Team by Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and All-America Second Team by the American Baseball Coaches Association and D1Baseball.com. Collegiate Baseball named him National Freshman of the Year and the NCBWA christened Shewmake the District VII Player of the Year.

He was the only Aggie to start all 64 games in 2017. As a rookie, he batted .328 with 90 hits, 47 runs, 18 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 69 RBI and 11 stolen bases. Shewmake logged a .529 slugging percentage. His 34 RBI in SEC play ranked third in the league. He hit .307 with 15 runs, five doubles and seven home runs in conference action.

STACKING UP WINS

The Aggies are one of just five teams to log 40 or more wins in every season since 2015. The other four squads are Dallas Baptist, Florida, Florida State and Louisville.

Texas A&M pitchers are holding opponents to a .206 batting average with runners in scoring position. **JOHN DOXAKIS** is holding opponents to a 2-for-11 mark with two HBP, one sac fly and six strikeouts in 19 RISP situations. **ASA LACY** is 2-for-11 with two walks and six strikeouts in 13 RISP attempts. Closer **KASEY KALICH** is 1-for-9 with one HBP and four strikeouts in 10 RISP situations.

With runners in scoring position and two outs, the opponent average drops to .162 (11-for-68).

WEEKEND WARRIORS

The Aggies' weekend rotation has been one of the nation's best through the first four weekends. **JOHN DOXAKIS**, **ASA LACY**, **JONATHAN CHILDRESS** and **CHRISTIAN ROA** have combined for a 1.23 ERA, .158 opponent batting average, 0.73 WHIP and 6.92 K-to-BB ratio in their weekend starts.

SHRINERS CLASSIC CHAMPS

For the second time in the last three trips, the Aggies claimed the title at the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic. The Maroon & White earned victory against two Top 25 teams, including No. 18 Baylor (5-2) and No. 17 TCU (1-0). They capped off the 3-0 performance with a 3-2 victory over Houston.

Texas A&M's pitching staff allowed just three earned runs on the weekend, holding opponents to a .126 batting average. The Aggies registered a 4.00 K-to-BB ratio, 0.74 WHIP and 12.00 strikeouts per nine innings. **JOHN DOXAKIS** equaled a career high with 12 strikeouts in the opener against Baylor, holding the Bears to one run on four hits. On Saturday, **ASA LACY**, **BRYCE MILLER**, **JOSEPH MENEFEE** and **KASEY KALICH** held TCU to one hit. On Sunday, **JONATHAN CHILDRESS** worked 3.0 hitless innings before the bullpen had to take over. CHANDLER JOZWIAK, Miller, Menefee and **CHRISTIAN ROA** combined to allow one earned run over 6.0 innings.

**BRYCE BLAUM** had a pair of home runs and **ZACH DELOACH** batted .375 (3-for-8) on the offensive end.

Four Aggies earned All-Tournament Team recognition at the Classic, including Doxakis, Foster, Lacy and Shewmake.

TOP 10 PITCHING

The Aggies rank in the top 10 in the nation in numerous pitching categories, including **K-to-BB Ratio** (3rd - 4.51), **WHIP** (4th - 1.00), **Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings** (5th - 2.52), **ERA** (7th - 2.25), **Strikeouts Per Nine Innings** (7th - 11.4) and **Shutouts** (8th - 3).

Individually, **JOHN DOXAKIS** ranks 7th in the nation K-to-BB Ratio (17.00), 17th in Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings (0.72), 22nd in WHIP (0.68) and 25th in Strikeouts (34).

**ASA LACY** ranks 9th in the nation in ERA (0.38), 10th in Hits Allowed Per Nine Innings (3.38) and 13th in Strikeouts (37).

STIRRING THE DRINK

**BRYCE BLAUM** has blossomed as the Aggies' leadoff hitter. The Houston native and Ole Miss transfer is batting .324 (24-for-74) with a .412 on-base percentage in the top spot in the lineup. He leads the team with 22 runs and four home runs. He has led off three games with home runs in 2019.

When leading off an inning, Blaum has reached base in 19 of 36 opportunities (.528).

In the last five games, Blaum is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with six runs, one double, one home run and three RBI.

PICKING UP STEAM

After stumbling out of the gate and hitting just .185 (5-for-27) and one RBI in the first eight games, **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** has started to heat up at the plate. In the last 11 games, Shewmake is batting (15-for-47) with three doubles, one home run and 16 RBI. He has put in a four-RBI effort against A&M-Corpus Christi and a three-RBI game in the second contest vs. Gonzaga. He has recorded multiple hits in six of the last 11 games.

KLOSING TIME

It's early in the season, but closer **KASEY KALICH** is on pace to threaten the Aggies' single-season saves record. The A&M mark of 14 was set by Jason Jester in 2013 and matched by Nolan Hoffman last season.

Kalich is a perfect 5-for-5 in save opportunities. He enters weekend play with a 0.87 ERA, 0.58 WHIP and 14 strikeouts in 10.1 innings over eight appearances.

UP NEXT

The Aggies host the Rice Owls in a 6:32 p.m. contest Tuesday on Olsen Field at Blue Bell Park.
