

* At 25-5 overall and an SEC-leading 7-2 mark in conference, the Bulldogs are off to their best start since 2009 when that club was 25-5 (7-2 SEC) after 30 games. Georgia leads the SEC after winning its first three series including two on the road (3-0 at South Carolina, 2-1 vs. No. 10 LSU, 2-1 at Kentucky).

*Georgia's starting pitchers this year are 18-2 with a 2.19 ERA (39 ER in 160 IP). The team ERA is 2.93, and the Bulldogs began the week leading the nation in Fewest Hits Allowed/Per Nine Innings (6.0). The Bulldogs will employ the same rotation as the previous two SEC series: sophomore RHP Emerson Hancock (6-1, 0.98), who was named a Perfect Game 1st Team Midseason All-American Wednesday, for game one followed by sophomore LHP C.J. Smith (2-1, 2.49 ERA) and junior RHP Tony Locey (4-0, 2.35 ERA). VU will counter with junior RHP Drake Fellows (6-0, 3.59 ERA), senior RHP Patrick Raby (5-0, 1.22 ERA) and freshman RHP Kumar Rocker (2-3, 6.00 ERA).

*Georgia concludes a five-game week with a series against No. 5 Vanderbilt (23-6, 6-3 SEC). The Bulldogs beat No. 23 Clemson 5-3 Tuesday and concluded a six-game road swing Wednesday with a 7-6 win over Kennesaw State. The top five matchup at Foley Field will be a first since 2009 when No. 1 Georgia faced No. 5 Arkansas (Georgia won the series 2-1). Like the LSU series, all three games against VU are sellouts. In records dating back to 1950, Georgia leads the series with VU 99-95, however the last time the Bulldogs won a series over VU came when they clinched the 2008 SEC title in Nashville. The last series win over VU in Athens was in 2003 as part of a nine-game winning streak in the series. Last year, Georgia took the opener in Nashville 3-2 but dropped the next two contests 5-3 and 8-3. The Commodores feature one of the nation's best lineups including the SEC's leading hitter in sophomore Austin Martin (.449-3-16) as well as junior outfielder and projected first rounder JJ Bleday (.353-12-36).

*Georgia is fielding .980, which is on pace for a school record. In SEC play, Georgia has been even better. Georgia leads the league with a .991 Fielding Percentage, and that's with six of the nine games on the road! The Bulldogs have made just three errors in the SEC (1 @USC, 0 vs. No. 10 LSU, 2 @UK).

*The Bulldogs are batting .273 with a .389 on base percentage. Georgia's top hitters are senior 2B LJ Talley (.364-4-19), sophomore LF Riley King (.319-4-28), junior CF Tucker Maxwell (.301-6-26, 14 SB) and junior 3B/Closer Aaron Schunk (.314-5-25; 1-0 ,1.88 ERA, 10 SV). Schunk, one of the nation's top two-way talents, ranks 2nd in the NCAA with 10 saves. On Tuesday in the road win over Clemson, he went 2-for-5 with a home run and three RBI plus registered his 10th save by getting the final four outs. It marked the second time this year that he's hit a home and got a save in the same game!

GEORGIA HEAD BASEBALL COACH SCOTT STRICKLIN

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 6TH SEASON AT UGA; 15TH OVERALL

Scott Stricklin is in his sixth season as the lke Cousins Head Baseball Coach at the University of Georgia. Since arriving at UGA, Stricklin, 47, has created an atmosphere of excitement around the program, starting with the current student-athletes, extending to former lettermen and to Georgia baseball fans around the state. He has organized numerous lettermen func-



tions to help reunite former players and steered the \$12 million Foley Field Revival project that was completed prior to the 2015 season. He has engaged the fan base with the annual First Pitch banquets featuring Hall of Famers John Smoltz, Phil Niekro and Chipper Jones, Braves standout Jeff Francoeur and Bulldog legends and Major Leaguers Gordon Beckham and Kyle Farmer.

Georgia's recruiting classes have steadily improved under Stricklin, according to *Perfect Game USA* national rankings. In fact, the class that made its debut in 2017 was ranked No. 3 nationally. Additionally, the Bulldogs have excelled in the classroom, posting a 3.08 GPA for the fall semester of 2016 and 3.01 GPA in the fall of 2017. A total of 19 Bulldogs made the 2017 SEC Academic Honor Roll and 21 earned a spot on the honor roll in 2018.

The 2018 campaign saw Georgia return to prominence as a regular in the Top 25 rankings, earning a top eight national seed and playing host to an NCAA Regional for the first time in a decade. After being picked to finish fifth in the East, Georgia posted 39-21 record and its 18-12 SEC mark tied for the second best in the league. The Bulldogs were NCAA Athens Regional Finalists and set four school records (.979 fielding percentage, holding opponents to a .236 batting average, 532 strikeouts by the pitching staff and seven grand slams by the offense). Three Bulldogs earned All-America honors, four made the All-SEC squad, 21 made the SEC Academic Honor Roll and three were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. During a nine-year stint with the Golden Flashes, he posted a 350-188 record, winning five Mid-American Conference regular season crowns and five MAC Tournament titles. Also, the Golden Flashes were honored in Omaha in 2012 for having the highest team Grade Point Average of all the eight participants at the CWS, owning a 3.09 GPA.

Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in earned run average during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons of professional baseball and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (16) and Keaton (11), and a son, Cale (14).
