

## **NEED TO KNOW**

- ★ For the sixth time in the history of the two programs, Vanderbilt and Mississippi State face off to open SEC play (2000, 2003, 2005, 2011, 2016, 2018). The Commodores are 5-10 in 15 Opening Weekend matchups against the Bulldogs and are opening league play in Starkville, Miss., for the first time since the 2005 season.
- ★ Vanderbilt fell to No. 22 in the RPI on Thursday after checking in at No. 14 in the inaugural rankings on Monday. The Commodores are 5-3 against opponents in the RPI's Top 50 and boast the nation's No. 37 strength of schedule.
- ★ Mississippi State will be the fifth D1Baseball.com ranked opponent Vanderbilt has faced in 2018. The Dores are 5-1 in games vs. ranked opponents, including wins against No. 25 Duke (2x), No. 24 Houston, No. 11 UCLA and No. 8 TCU.
- ★ Vandy is the only team nationally to rank in the Top 30 for batting average, earned run average and fielding percentage. The Dores are second in fielding percentage (.989), 27th in batting average (.304) and 30th in earned run average (2.91).
- ★ Five Vanderbilt freshmen have made starts this season while 15 total have made appearances. The unit is hitting .334 (80-for-239) with 3.11 runs per game and 3.11 RBIs per game while posting a 2.28 ERA with 69 strikeouts in 59 innings.
- ★ Vanderbilt pitching has been lights-out with runners on base. The staff has held opponents to a .194 batting average (47-for-242). Friday starter Drake Fellows has faced 34 batters with runners on base, yielding only five hits (.134).
- ★ Following a 2-1 week that featured victories over No. 11 UCLA and No. 8 TCU, Vanderbilt rose in four polls. The Commodores made their biggest jump in the Baseball America poll, moving ahead seven spots from No. 21 to No. 14.
- ★ Vanderbilt's .989 fielding percentage ranks second nationally and first in the SEC. The Commodores have committed just seven errors in 610 total chances. The program record for fielding percentage is .979 set in 2015.
- ★ Vandy ranks 10th nationally in stolen bases (34) and is on pace to swipe 100-plus bags for the fourth time in six years.





## **INSIDE THE MATCHUP VS. MISSISSIPPI STATE**

- ★ Vanderbilt and Mississippi State meet for the 116th time in the history of the two programs on Friday.
- ★ The Bulldogs own a 69-44-2 advantage in the series, although Vandy owns a slight 6-4 edge in the last 10 matchups.
- ★ The Commodores are 23-10 against the Bulldogs in the **Tim Corbin** era (2003-present). Corbin led Vanderbilt to its first-ever sweep of the Bulldogs in 2004 and 12-straight victories against Mississippi State between 2007-11.
- ★ Vandy and Mississippi State last met in 2016 when the Bulldogs took 2-of-3 in Nashville. Current junior **Alonzo**Jones batted .308 (4-for-13), scoring four runs while driving in a pair. Right-hander **Patrick Raby** recorded a save, logging 2.1 innings while striking out three without allowing a hit.

### NATION'S TOP FRESHMEN OFF TO SIZZLING START

- ★ Vanderbilt's freshman class was named tops in the country by Baseball America last November.
- ★ Five Vanderbilt freshmen made starts this season while 15 total have made appearances. The unit is hitting .334 (80-for-239) with 3.11 runs per game and 3.11 RBIs per game while posting a 2.28 ERA with 69 strikeouts in 59 innings.
- ★ D1Baseball.com's list of 30 impact freshmen entering 2018 includes Vandy's Jake Eder (No. 16), Jayson Gonzalez (No. 18), Philip Clarke (No. 19) and Pat DeMarco (No. 25). With four players on the list, the Dores trail only Florida (5).

## VANDERBILT RE-VU

- ★ Vanderbilt stranded the bases loaded on three different occasions and was limited most of the night by Eastern Kentucky pitching in a 6-5 loss on Wednesday at Hawkins Field.
- ★ The No. 13 Commodores, who threw nine different pitchers for one inning apiece, were saddled with a four-run deficit after three innings, thanks to three RBIs from Alex Holderbach.
- ★ After being limited to six hits in the first eight innings, Vanderbilt made a comeback-bid in the ninth, scoring four runs, including three with two outs, to trim the deficit to one. **Connor Kaiser** drove in two on a line-drive triple and **Harrison Ray** fought off a 0-2 pitch for an RBI-single up the middle before **Julian Infante** lined out.

## **GOLDEN BOYS**

- ★ For a fourth-straight year, multiple Vandy players have been named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.
- ★ Julian Infante and Patrick Raby are among those featured. The award was first presented in 1978 and is given to an amateur player who best exhibits and combines "exceptional on-field ability and exemplary sportsmanship." The award is considered the most prestigious in amateur baseball.
- ★ Five Commodores have been named finalists for the Golden Spikes Award -- all coming since the 2007 season -- including David Price, who took home the honor in 2007. Other finalists include Pedro Alvarez (2007), Tyler Beede (2013), Carson Fulmer (2015) and Dansby Swanson (2015).

## **VANDY PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN SEC EAST**

- ★ Vanderbilt has been picked to finish in the same position according to the league's head coaches.
- ★ Florida was picked as the preseason favorite to win both the East and the SEC with a total of 91 points and 13-of-14 first-place votes. Arkansas was picked to win the West behind 12 first-place votes and a total of 90 points.

## **GAME NOTES**

## A WORLD SERIES KIND OF FEEL

- ★ After playing 10 straight at home to begin the season, Vanderbilt headed west for a seven-game road trip including games at Houston's Minute Maid Park and Los Angeles' Dodger Stadium -- the two sites for the 2017 World Series matchup between the Astros and Dodgers.
- ★ The Commodores took part in the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic at Minute Maid from March 2-4. The three-day, six-team tournament featured local universities squaring off against the SEC. Vandy fell to Sam Houston State on Friday and Louisiana on Saturday before bouncing back with a 9-4 victory against Houston on Sunday night.
- ★ For the fourth-straight year, the Dores headed to California, falling 4-3 to Long Beach State on Wednesday before knocking off UCLA, 6-3 on Friday and TCU, 7-4, in the Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic on Sunday.

## FORMER PLAYERS JOIN CORBIN'S STAFF

- ★ Last September, head coach Tim Corbin and associate head coach Scott Brown welcomed back former players Mike Baxter and David Macias. Baxter serves as the Dores' hitting coach and recruiting coordinator while Macias comes on board as Vanderbilt's volunteer assistant coach.
- ★ Baxter joins the Commodores after a 12-year professional career that included playing in the big leagues for four organizations over parts of six seasons. Baxter made his major league debut with the San Diego Padres in 2010, and also played for the New York Mets (2011-13), Los Angeles Dodgers (2014) and Chicago Cubs (2015).
- ★ Macias was previously on Corbin's staff as the team's strength coach in 2014 when the Dores won the national championship and was the volunteer assistant in 2015 when the Dores returned to the College World Series finals. Prior to rejoining Corbin's staff, Macias was with the Seattle Mariners organization as a minor league manager.

## D1BASEBALL.COM RECOGNIZES DORES

- ★ Last September, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the **No. 2 program nationally** in the publication's bi-annual top-100 rankings. The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye toward the next five to 10 years."

## **CORBIN BECOMES VANDY'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH**

★ Head coach **Tim Corbin** became Vanderbilt's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 win against Houston on March 4. The 16th-year head coach, who owns a 658-320-1 record, surpassed Roy Mewbourne, who racked up as many wins between 1979-2002. Here is a look back at some of Corbin's milestone victories:

## THE SEC: IT JUST MEANS MORE

- ★ The Southeastern Conference has sent 58 teams to the College World Series since 1990 with Vanderbilt doing its part to represent the league in 2011, 2014 and 2015. The league has now appeared in the College World Series in 32 of the last 33 years including appearances by 18 teams in the last seven years.
- ★ In 2017, the SEC tied its own national record with six teams competing in the NCAA Super Regionals. The Commodores were among the field as part of the NCAA Corvallis Super Regional.
- ★ A total of 11 SEC student-athletes were selected on the first day of the 2017 Major League Baseball Draft including Vandy right-handed pitcher Kyle Wright (1st round/5th overall) and outfielder Jeren Kendall (1st round/23rd overall).

- ★ The Donny Everett Scholarship was established during the 2016 school year. Everett's memory lives on with the display of No. 41 on the field and with the No. 41 flag among the major league players in right field.
- ★ Everett was the 2015 Tennessee Gatorade Player of the Year and one of the highest-rated players in the nation to attend college. He turned down the Milwaukee Brewers as a 29th round draft pick to join Vanderbilt.

In his 16th season at Vanderbilt, Tim Corbin has transformed Vanderbilt into one of the national powers of college baseball and taken the program to unprecedented success winning the school's first-ever men's national title in 2014.

Corbin's owns a 658-320-1 (.672) at Vanderbilt and became the program's all-time winningest coach on March 4. He is also first in winning percentage for coaches with 100 games or more.

Under Corbin, Vanderbilt boasts the Southeastern Conference's longest streak of consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances at 12. The Dores have advanced to a Super Regional in four of the last five years.

In 2015, Vanderbilt returned to the College World Series for the third time in five years with team's fourth 50-win season in the last four making it back to the CWS Finals before losing in three games to Virginia. The Dores captured the SEC East with a 20-10 mark.

The 2014 Commodores topped Virginia in the College World Series finals in three games to claim the title in just the Dores' second trip to Omaha. For the third time in four years Vandy hosted NCAA Regionals and Super Regionals, topping Oregon in the Regional final and Stanford in the Super Regionals.

Vanderbilt's 2013 team was one for the ages as the Commodores matched the school record with a 54-12 record and smashed the SEC record with a 26-3 mark to win the league title.






