NEED TO KNOW

- ★ Vanderbilt opens its fifth weekend of SEC play when Ole Miss coming to town on Friday. For the second-straight year, the matchup pits a pair of Top 25 teams. Vanderbilt won seven-consecutive games against the Rebels between 2009-13 but has gone just 2-6 in the last eight games since including dropping 2-of-3 a season ago in Oxford, Miss.
- ★ Vanderbilt has won three of its first four SEC series to begin the season for the first time since taking four-consecutive to begin the 2015 league slate. That team went on to play Virginia in the College World Series finals.
- ★ Vanderbilt pitching has been masterful since allowing 26 runs in three games at Florida. The Dores have posted a 2.51 ERA in five games since while limiting opponents to a .231 average. The bullpen has spearheaded the dominance, posting a 1.74 ERA and allowing just three runs in 18.1 innings. The pen has struck out 28 batters in that span.
- ★ Vanderbilt pitching has limited opponents to three runs or fewer 13 times in 18 home games this season. Offensively, the Dores have batted .309, averaging 7.77 runs and 10.55 hits per game while boasting a .417 on-base percentage.
- ★ The Dores rank third nationally and are second in the SEC with a .984 fielding percentage. Vandy has committed just 19 errors in 1,162 total chances. The team fielding percentage record is .979, set in 2015.
- ★ Vandy has stolen 63 bases this season, ranking seventh nationally and first in the SEC. The Commodores have swiped nearly twice as many bags as they had through 33 games a season ago (32).
- ★ Eleven different Commodores have accounted for 26 home runs this season. Vanderbilt is one of 16 teams nationally to have 10 or more players produce a homer this year. Tennessee Tech leads the country with 15.
- ★ After spending 16 of the previous 20 games away from home, Vandy opened an eight-game homestand last Thursday against Georgia. The stretch includes 12 of the next 15 at Hawkins Field. Friday's game will be the fifth-straight at home.
- ★ The Commodores are 12-6 against ranked teams this season. Vandy boasts the nation's ninth-toughest schedule and enters Friday No. 26 in the RPI. Ole Miss will be the second Top 5 team the Dores have faced. Vandy dropped all three games at second-ranked Florida and is looking for its first victory against a Top 5 opponent since defeated top-ranked Texas A&M, 6-5 on May 25, 2016 at the SEC Tournament. The Dores have lost their last four games at Top 5 teams.



VANDERBILT RE-VU

- ★ Vanderbilt used two swings of the bat and stellar relief pitching to halt its midweek woes, defeating Western Kentucky 3-2 on Tuesday night at Hawkins Field.
- ★ The No. 15 Commodores overcame a two-run deficit, scoring three runs in the sixth courtesy of a leadoff home run from Pat DeMarco and go-ahead, two-run homer off the bat of Connor Kaiser to snap a five-game losing streak in midweek games. Four Commodore pitchers limited the Hilltoppers to a combined three hits.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP VS. OLE MISS

- ★ Vanderbilt and Ole Miss meet for the 113th time in the history of the two programs on Friday.
- ★ The Commodores are 10-8 against the Rebels at Hawkins Field (2002-present) and have won three of the last five series between the two teams at the venue. Ole Miss has won two-straight series against the Dores.
- ★ Vanderbilt and Ole Miss have met each season over the last six years including twice in the SEC Tournament.
- ★ Vandy bats will be tested by an Ole Miss pitching staff that ranks first in the SEC in strikeouts (337). Offensively, the Rebels are second in the league in doubles (75) and third in batting average (.303).

NATION'S TOP FRESHMEN OFF TO SIZZLING START

- ★ Vanderbilt's freshman class was named tops in the country by Baseball America last November.
- ★ Six Vanderbilt true freshmen made starts this season while 14 total have made appearances. The unit is hitting .293 (132-for-450) and has accounted for 41 percent of the Dores' RBIs (74) and 40 percent of the teams runs (83). Freshmen pitchers have posted an 10-5 record and 3.39 ERA with 120 strikeouts in 119.1 innings.
- ★ D1Baseball.com's list of 30 impact freshmen entering 2018 includes Vandy's Jake Eder (No. 16), Jayson Gonzalez (No. 18), Philip Clarke (No. 19) and Pat DeMarco (No. 25). With four players on the list, the Dores trail only Florida (5).

★ The Commodores have produced an 14-4 record at home this season while posting a .309 batting average and .417 on-base percentage. Here's a look at the top performers from the Commodores' 18 home games in 2018:

GOLDEN BOYS

- ★ For a fourth-straight year, multiple Vandy players have been named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.
- ★ Julian Infante and Patrick Raby are among those featured. The award was first presented in 1978 and is given to an amateur player who best exhibits and combines "exceptional on-field ability and exemplary sportsmanship." The award is considered the most prestigious in amateur baseball.
- ★ Five Commodores have been named finalists for the Golden Spikes Award -- all coming since the 2007 season -- including David Price, who took home the honor in 2007. Other finalists include Pedro Alvarez (2007), Tyler Beede (2013), Carson Fulmer (2015) and Dansby Swanson (2015).

COMMODORE NATION

★ Vanderbilt is one of five teams nationally to start a lineup featuring players from nine or more different states, joining Army, Elon, Kentucky and Western Kentucky. Vandy's 35-man roster boasts players from 15 different states as well as Canada with freshman **Cooper Davis** hailing from Mississauga, Ontario.

VANDY PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN SEC EAST

- ★ Vanderbilt was picked to finish third in the SEC East by the league's head coaches after taking third a season ago.
- ★ Florida was picked as the preseason favorite to win both the East and the SEC with a total of 91 points and 13-of-14 first-place votes. Arkansas was picked to win the West behind 12 first-place votes and a total of 90 points.

GAME NOTES

A WORLD SERIES KIND OF FEEL

- ★ After playing 10 straight at home to begin the season, Vanderbilt headed west for a six-game road trip including games at Houston's Minute Maid Park and Los Angeles' Dodger Stadium -- the two sites for the 2017 World Series matchup between the Astros and Dodgers.
- ★ The Commodores took part in the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic at Minute Maid from March 2-4. The three-day, six-team tournament featured local universities squaring off against the SEC. Vandy fell to Sam Houston State on Friday and Louisiana on Saturday before bouncing back with a 9-4 victory against Houston on Sunday night.
- ★ For the fourth-straight year, the Dores headed to California, falling 4-3 to Long Beach State on Wednesday before knocking off UCLA, 6-3 on Friday and TCU, 7-4, in the Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic on Sunday.

FORMER PLAYERS JOIN CORBIN'S STAFF

- ★ Last September, head coach Tim Corbin and associate head coach Scott Brown welcomed back former players Mike Baxter and David Macias. Baxter serves as the Dores' hitting coach and recruiting coordinator while Macias comes on board as Vanderbilt's volunteer assistant coach.
- ★ Baxter joins the Commodores after a 12-year professional career that included playing in the big leagues for four organizations over parts of six seasons. Baxter made his major league debut with the San Diego Padres in 2010, and also played for the New York Mets (2011-13), Los Angeles Dodgers (2014) and Chicago Cubs (2015).
- ★ Macias was previously on Corbin's staff as the team's strength coach in 2014 when the Dores won the national championship and was the volunteer assistant in 2015 when the Dores returned to the College World Series finals. Prior to rejoining Corbin's staff, Macias was with the Seattle Mariners organization as a minor league manager.

- ★ Last September, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the **No. 2 program nationally** in the publication's bi-annual top-100 rankings. The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye toward the next five to 10 years."

CORBIN BECOMES VANDY'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH

★ Head coach **Tim Corbin** became Vanderbilt's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 win against Houston on March 4. The 16th-year head coach, who owns a 666-328-1 record, surpassed Roy Mewbourne, who racked up as many wins between 1979-2002. Here is a look back at some of Corbin's milestone victories:

THE SEC: IT JUST MEANS MORE

- ★ The Southeastern Conference has sent 58 teams to the College World Series since 1990 with Vanderbilt doing its part to represent the league in 2011, 2014 and 2015. The league has now appeared in the College World Series in 32 of the last 33 years including appearances by 18 teams in the last seven years.
- ★ In 2017, the SEC tied its own national record with six teams competing in the NCAA Super Regionals. The Commodores were among the field as part of the NCAA Corvallis Super Regional.
- ★ A total of 11 SEC student-athletes were selected on the first day of the 2017 Major League Baseball Draft including Vandy right-handed pitcher Kyle Wright (1st round/5th overall) and outfielder Jeren Kendall (1st round/23rd overall).

DORES IN THE PRO NOTES

- ★ At least one Dore has been drafted every year since 1991 with a total of 100 players signing professional contracts.
- ★ Vanderbilt is one of only two universities in the nation to produce multiple No. 1 picks with David Price (2007) and Dansby Swanson (2015), joining Arizona State (Rick Monday 1965, Floyd Bannister 1968, Bob Horner 1978).
- ★ Under Corbin, Vanderbilt pro alums have earned **over \$62 million dollars** in signing bonuses.
- ★ Since head coach **Tim Corbin** arrived in 2003, every Vanderbilt starting catcher has been selected in the MLB Draft.
- ★ The Dores have had at least one MLB first round selection on the mound every year in the **Tim Corbin** era.
- ★ Eighty-nine pitchers have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 55 during the **Tim Corbin** era (since 2003).
- ★ Vanderbilt leads the SEC with nine players drafted in the first round over the last decade. The second-closest in that span is Florida and LSU who each have five.
- ★ A total of 145 Commodores have been selected all-time in the MLB Draft including 73 in the first 10 rounds.

HONORING NO. 41 DONNY EVERETT

- ★ Vanderbilt continues to honor the memory of **Donny Everett**, who tragically passed away in a drowning accident the day before the Commodores opened the 2016 NCAA Nashville Regional.
- ★ The Donny Everett Scholarship was established during the 2016 school year. Everett's memory lives on with the display of No. 41 on the field and with the No. 41 flag among the major league players in right field.
- ★ Everett was the 2015 Tennessee Gatorade Player of the Year and one of the highest-rated players in the nation to attend college. He turned down the Milwaukee Brewers as a 29th round draft pick to join Vanderbilt.

TOUGH TESTS ABUNDANT IN 2018

- ★ Vanderbilt plays 12 teams that reached the 2017 NCAA Tournament for a total of 22 games, including Auburn (3), Florida (3), Houston, Kentucky (3), LSU (3), Long Beach State, Louisville, Mississippi State (3), Sam Houston State, TCU, Tennessee Tech and UCLA. Of the 12 teams, eight reached the NCAA Super Regionals.

- ★ April 5, 2018 Vanderbilt suffered its sixth-consecutive loss on Thursday night, falling 3-2 in the series opener against Georgia ... The Commodores took a 2-0 lead into the eighth inning, but a pair of Commodore errors and two walks helped Georgia score three runs despite just one hit in the frame.
- ★ April 6, 2018 Vanderbilt rode the arm of right-hander Chandler Day and busted through with a three-run fourth to snap a six-game losing streak and defeat No. 16 Georgia, 5-3 on Friday ... The Dores overcame a one-run deficit, scoring three times in the fourth on one-out RBI-base hits from Stephen Scott, Connor Kaiser and Harrison Ray.
- ★ April 7, 2018 Vanderbilt broke through offensively, roughing up Georgia with four runs in the fifth and three more in the seventh as part of a series-clinching 8-3 victory on Saturday afternoon ... The Commodores smacked 12 hits, including five in the fifth, highlighted by aggressiveness at the plate and on the base paths to jump ahead 5-1.

★ Vanderbilt has paced the Southeastern Conference in several categories since the start of the 2006 season. During that span, the Commodores rank first in overall wins (559) and NCAA Tournament wins (48). Hawkins Field serves as the home of the Vanderbilt Commodores and with recently completed facilities it stands as one of the top college baseball parks in the country. Now in its 16th season of existence, greets fans with chairback seats close to the field of play with bleacher seating in the outfield.

Nestled alongside Vanderbilt Stadium and Memorial Gymnasium

on the west end of campus, the ballpark was constructed as the Commodores' first baseball-only facility in school history. It was built near the exact location of McGugin Field, which served as baseball's home field for 76 years and part-time football practice field.

In his 16th season at Vanderbilt, Tim Corbin has transformed Vanderbilt into one of the national powers of college baseball and taken the program to unprecedented success winning the school's first-ever men's national title in 2014.

Corbin's owns a 666-328-1 (.669) at Vanderbilt and became the program's all-time winningest coach on March 4. He is also first in winning percentage for coaches with 100 games or more.

Under Corbin, Vanderbilt boasts the Southeastern Conference's longest streak of consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances at 12. The Dores have advanced to a Super Regional in four of the last five years.

In 2015, Vanderbilt returned to the College World Series for the third time in five years with team's fourth 50-win season in the last four making it back to the CWS Finals before losing in three games to Virginia. The Dores captured the SEC East with a 20-10 mark.

The 2014 Commodores topped Virginia in the College World Series finals in three games to claim the title in just the Dores' second trip to Omaha. For the third time in four years Vandy hosted NCAA Regionals and Super Regionals, topping Oregon in the Regional final and Stanford in the Super Regionals.

Vanderbilt's 2013 team was one for the ages as the Commodores matched the school record with a 54-12 record and smashed the SEC record with a 26-3 mark to win the league title.






