NEED TO KNOW

- ★ Vanderbilt enters Thursday having won six of its last seven games including a pair of wild wins in doubleheader action against No. 5 Ole Miss on Sunday. SEC Freshman of the Week Austin Martin is batting .375 (9-for-24) in the last seven games while Connor Kaiser is hitting .348 (8-for-23) with five runs, five RBIs and a home run.
- ★ Vanderbilt has won four of its first five SEC series to begin the season for the first time since accomplishing the feat in 2015. That team went on to play Virginia in the College World Series finals.
- ★ The Commodores have scored a combined 36 runs over their last six games including eight runs on three occasions. Vandy had produced a combined 35 runs over its 12 games prior to the stretch (March 18-April 5).
- ★ On Sunday, Vandy recorded its first SEC doubleheader sweep since downing Auburn twice on May 19, 2015. The 8-7, eight-inning win in the opener marked the first walk-off victory for Vandy since Feb. 27, 2016, when then-freshman Alonzo Jones worked a game-winning walk in the 14th inning to defeat UIC, 6-5.
- ★ Thursday marks the 1,000th career game at the helm of Vanderbilt for head coach **Tim Corbin**. The 16th-year head man becomes the 25th active coach to reach the milestone. For more, see page 2.
- ★ The Dores rank second nationally and are first in the SEC with a .985 fielding percentage. Vandy has committed just 20 errors in 1,301 total chances. The team fielding percentage record is .979, set in 2015.
- ★ Vandy has stolen 68 bases this season, ranking 13th nationally and first in the SEC. The Commodores have swiped more than twice as many bags as they had through 37 games a season ago (32).
- ★ Twelve different Commodores have accounted for 33 home runs this season. Vanderbilt is one of nine teams nationally to have 12 or more players produce a homer this year. Tennessee Tech leads the country with 15.
- ★ The Commodores are 14-7 against ranked teams this season. Vandy boasts the nation's fourth-toughest schedule -- trailing only West Virginia, Miami (FL) and Rhode Island -- and enters Thursday No. 21 in the RPI.
- ★ Vanderbilt has had its fair share of success against Missouri. The Commodores are 16-1 against the Tigers since Mizzou joined the SEC. Vandy is a perfect 6-0 in two series in Columbia, Mo., with the last coming in 2015.



BATTING A THOUSAND

- ★ Thursday's matchup at Missouri will mark the 1,000th game coached for Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt.
- ★ The 16th-year head man will become the 25th active head coach to reach 1,000 games at his current institution.
 - ★ Corbin is set to become the eighth skipper in SEC history to coach 1,000 games at a league institution and second Vanderbilt coach, joining Roy Mewbourne (1,264 games). Ole Miss' head coach Mike Bianco, who has coached 1,094 games, is the lone current SEC skipper with 1,000 or more games.

VANDERBILT RE-VU

- ★ Vanderbilt second baseman Ethan Paul belted two home runs and Commodore pitching limited Evansville to four hits in a 6-1 victory on Tuesday night at Hawkins Field.
- ★ The No. 10 Commodores managed just six hits but made the most of opportunities, putting across four runs with two down including a two-run homer from Paul to ignite the scoring in the third. Making his first career start, redshirt freshman Reid Schaller (1-0) was masterful, retiring all nine batters he faced while striking out four in the win.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP VS. MIZZOU

- ★ The Commodores have won 16 of 17 games against Mizzou since the Tigers joined the SEC for the 2013 season. Vandy has won all six previous SEC matchups against the Tigers in Columbia, Mo., with the last visit coming in 2015.
- ★ Vandy took 2-of-3 a season ago at Hawkins Field, clinching the series with a 14-5 victory in the series finale.
- ★ Julian Infante drove in seven runs and Zach King turned in 5.1 no-hit innings to lead Vanderbilt to a series-clinching 14-5 win last year at Hawkins Field. Infante's seven RBIs were the most by a Commodore since Dominic de la Osa drove in seven against Georgia in 2006

NATION'S TOP FRESHMEN OFF TO SIZZLING START

- ★ Vanderbilt's freshman class was named tops in the country by Baseball America last November.
- ★ Six Vanderbilt true freshmen made starts this season while 14 total have made appearances. The unit is hitting .294 (146-for-496) and has accounted for 41 percent of the Dores' RBIs (84) and 40 percent of the teams runs (93). True freshmen pitchers have posted an 11-5 record and 3.80 ERA with 130 strikeouts in 130.0 innings.
- ★ D1Baseball.com's list of 30 impact freshmen entering 2018 includes Vandy's Jake Eder (No. 16), Jayson Gonzalez (No. 18), Philip Clarke (No. 19) and Pat DeMarco (No. 25). With four players on the list, the Dores trail only Florida (5).

TAKING THE HIGH ROAD

★ The Commodores are looking to snap a four-game skid on the road. Combined with a pair of neutral-site losses, Vandy has lost six-straight away from Hawkins Field. Here is a look at Vandy's top performers through nine road games:

GOLDEN BOYS

- ★ For a fourth-straight year, multiple Vandy players have been named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.
- ★ Julian Infante and Patrick Raby are among those featured. The award was first presented in 1978 and is given to an amateur player who best exhibits and combines "exceptional on-field ability and exemplary sportsmanship." The award is considered the most prestigious in amateur baseball.
- ★ Five Commodores have been named finalists for the Golden Spikes Award -- all coming since the 2007 season -including David Price, who took home the honor in 2007. Other finalists include Pedro Alvarez (2007), Tyler Beede (2013), Carson Fulmer (2015) and Dansby Swanson (2015).

COMMODORE NATION

★ Vanderbilt is one of five teams nationally to start a lineup featuring players from nine or more different states, joining Army, Elon, Kentucky and Western Kentucky. Vandy's 35-man roster boasts players from 15 different states as well as Canada with freshman Cooper Davis hailing from Mississauga, Ontario.

WHAT'S THE CATCH?

★ The Dores have received steady production from three catchers, Philip Clarke, Ty Duyall and Stephen Scott have each made their case for playing time. All three started on Tuesday, doing so at DH, catcher and left field, respectively.

GAME NOTES

A WORLD SERIES KIND OF FEEL

- ★ After playing 10 straight at home to begin the season, Vanderbilt headed west for a six-game road trip including games at Houston's Minute Maid Park and Los Angeles' Dodger Stadium -- the two sites for the 2017 World Series matchup between the Astros and Dodgers.
- ★ The Commodores took part in the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic at Minute Maid from March 2-4. The three-day, six-team tournament featured local universities squaring off against the SEC. Vandy fell to Sam Houston State on Friday and Louisiana on Saturday before bouncing back with a 9-4 victory against Houston on Sunday night.
- ★ For the fourth-straight year, the Dores headed to California, falling 4-3 to Long Beach State on Wednesday before knocking off UCLA, 6-3 on Friday and TCU, 7-4, in the Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic on Sunday.

FORMER PLAYERS JOIN CORBIN'S STAFF

- ★ Last September, head coach Tim Corbin and associate head coach Scott Brown welcomed back former players Mike Baxter and David Macias. Baxter serves as the Dores' hitting coach and recruiting coordinator while Macias comes on board as Vanderbilt's volunteer assistant coach.
- ★ Baxter joins the Commodores after a 12-year professional career that included playing in the big leagues for four organizations over parts of six seasons. Baxter made his major league debut with the San Diego Padres in 2010, and also played for the New York Mets (2011-13), Los Angeles Dodgers (2014) and Chicago Cubs (2015).
- ★ Macias was previously on Corbin's staff as the team's strength coach in 2014 when the Dores won the national championship and was the volunteer assistant in 2015 when the Dores returned to the College World Series finals. Prior to rejoining Corbin's staff, Macias was with the Seattle Mariners organization as a minor league manager.

- ★ Last September, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the **No. 2 program nationally** in the publication's bi-annual top-100 rankings. CORBIN BECOMES VANDY'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH

★ Head coach Tim Corbin became Vanderbilt's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 win against Houston on March 4. The 16th-year head coach, who owns a 669-328-1 record, surpassed Roy Mewbourne, who racked up as many wins between 1979-2002. Here is a look back at some of Corbin's milestone victories:

THE SEC: IT JUST MEANS MORE

- ★ The Southeastern Conference has sent 58 teams to the College World Series since 1990 with Vanderbilt doing its part to represent the league in 2011, 2014 and 2015. The league has now appeared in the College World Series in 32 of the last 33 years including appearances by 18 teams in the last seven years.
- ★ In 2017, the SEC tied its own national record with six teams competing in the NCAA Super Regionals. The Commodores were among the field as part of the NCAA Corvallis Super Regional.
- ★ A total of 11 SEC student-athletes were selected on the first day of the 2017 Major League Baseball Draft including Vandy right-handed pitcher Kyle Wright (1st round/5th overall) and outfielder Jeren Kendall (1st round/23rd overall).

DORES IN THE PRO NOTES

- ★ At least one Dore has been drafted every year since 1991 with a total of 100 players signing professional contracts.
- ★ Vanderbilt is one of only two universities in the nation to produce multiple No. 1 picks with David Price (2007) and Dansby Swanson (2015), joining Arizona State (Rick Monday - 1965, Floyd Bannister - 1968, Bob Horner - 1978).
- ★ Under Corbin, Vanderbilt pro alums have earned over \$62 million dollars in signing bonuses.
- ★ Since head coach **Tim Corbin** arrived in 2003, every Vanderbilt starting catcher has been selected in the MLB Draft.
- \star The Dores have had at least one MLB first round selection on the mound every year in the **Tim Corbin** era.
- ★ Eighty-nine pitchers have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 55 during the **Tim Corbin** era (since 2003).

- ★ The Donny Everett Scholarship was established during the 2016 school year. Everett's memory lives on with the display of No. 41 on the field and with the No. 41 flag among the major league players in right field.
- ★ Everett was the 2015 Tennessee Gatorade Player of the Year and one of the highest-rated players in the nation to attend college. He turned down the Milwaukee Brewers as a 29th round draft pick to join Vanderbilt.

TOUGH TESTS ABUNDANT IN 2018

- ★ Vanderbilt plays 12 teams that reached the 2017 NCAA Tournament for a total of 22 games, including Auburn (3), Florida (3), Houston, Kentucky (3), LSU (3), Long Beach State, Louisville, Mississippi State (3), Sam Houston State, TCU, Tennessee Tech and UCLA. Of the 12 teams, eight reached the NCAA Super Regionals.

Then, after loading the bases in the sixth, VU catcher Ty Duvall roped a one-out, three-run double into the right field corner in what proved to be the game-winning knock ... The offense erupted for a combined 15 hits – including eight of the extra-base variety – in 50 at-bats on Sunday.

In his 16th season at Vanderbilt, Tim Corbin has transformed Vanderbilt into one of the national powers of college baseball and taken the program to unprecedented success winning the school's first-ever men's national title in 2014.

Corbin's owns a 669-329-1 (.670) at Vanderbilt and became the program's all-time winningest coach on March 4. He is also first in winning percentage for coaches with 100 games or more.

Under Corbin, Vanderbilt boasts the Southeastern Conference's longest streak of consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances at 12. The Dores have advanced to a Super Regional in four of the last five years.

In 2015, Vanderbilt returned to the College World Series for the third time in five years with team's fourth 50-win season in the last four making it back to the CWS Finals before losing in three games to Virginia. The Dores captured the SEC East with a 20-10 mark.

The 2014 Commodores topped Virginia in the College World Series finals in three games to claim the title in just the Dores' second trip to Omaha. For the third time in four years Vandy hosted NCAA Regionals and Super Regionals, topping Oregon in the Regional final and Stanford in the Super Regionals.

Vanderbilt's 2013 team was one for the ages as the Commodores matched the school record with a 54-12 record and smashed the SEC record with a 26-3 mark to win the league title.






