#### **NEED TO KNOW**

- ★ Vanderbilt heads into Tuesday looking to bounce back after dropping its first home three-game series of the season.

  The Commodores scored a combined 24 runs against South Carolina -- a season-high for a three-game set -- but were saddled with a pair of one-run, come-from-behind defeats at Hawkins Field.
- ★ Vandy and Louisville meet for the seventh installment of the **Battle of the Barrel** on Tuesday at Hawkins Field. The Cardinals have won the last two meetings for the trophy, which pays homage to Kentucky's history as a bourbon-making state and Tennessee's history as a whiskey-making state. VU and UL have split the six prior matchups for the trophy.
- ★ The Cardinals will be the 26th different opponent and second from the ACC that Vandy has faced this season. The Dores have faced foes from 14 different leagues -- the most of any team in the nation -- this season.
- ★ Commodore freshman batters have made a combined 145 starts. That mark **leads the nation** and is 24 more than UNCW who is second with 121. Three players have made 30-plus starts, which trails only Utah's four.
- ★ The Dores have hit 28 of their 36 home runs this season at Hawkins Field. Vanderbilt struck 14 homers in April after finishing with just seven in March. Twelve different VU players have hit at least one home run this season.
- ★ Vandy has stolen 83 bases this season, **eighth nationally** -- one spot behind Louisville -- and first in the SEC. The total is already 29 more than the squad finished with a season ago (54). Four Commodores have registered double-digit stolen bases and 14 different players have swiped at least one bag this season.
- ★ Vanderbilt played error-free baseball for the 25th time this season on Saturday vs. South Carolina, improving to 16-9 in those games. The Commodores are **third nationally and first in the SEC** with a .982 fielding percentage.
- ★ Vanderbilt has been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since **Tim Corbin** took the helm in 2003. During that span, the Commodores own a 416-135-1 record at the facility for an impressive .754 winning percentage.
- ★ Vandy turns the page to the month of May after an up-and-down April. The Commodores finished the month at 8-8 after dropping four of their final six games. Prior to that losing stretch, the Dores had won six of seven. The Black and Gold have produced a winning record during the month of May in each of the last eight seasons.

#### TODAY IN VANDERBILT BASEBALL HISTORY

MAY 1, 2011 (7 YEARS AG0): Vanderbilt finished off a series sweep of Tennessee with a record-setting 19-3 win at Hawkins Field. Vandy outscored the Volunteers 39-5 over the three-game series and Sunday's margin of victory was the largest in the series since 1899 when VU won 20-0. The three-game sweep of UT was the first for Vandy since 2008.



#### **BATTING A THOUSAND**

- ★ Last Thursday's matchup at Missouri marked the 1,000th game coached for **Tim Corbin** at Vanderbilt.
- ★ The 16th-year head man became the 25th active head coach to reach 1,000 games at his current institution.
- ★ Corbin also became the eighth skipper in SEC history to coach 1,000 games at a league institution and second Vanderbilt coach, joining Roy Mewbourne (1,264 games). Ole Miss' head coach Mike Bianco, who has coached 1,104 games, is the only other current SEC skipper with 1,000 or more games.

#### VANDERBILT RE-VU

- ★ Vanderbilt saw multi-run leads slip away twice as South Carolina upended the Commodores, 10-9 to clinch the series on Sunday afternoon in front of 3,158 fans at Hawkins Field.
- ★ The Gamecocks erased deficits of four and three runs before using a one-out sacrifice fly in the top of the ninth to put Vanderbilt away and hand the Dores their first home series loss of the season. Vandy led 6-3 before USC took advantage of a pair of one-out walks, evening the game at six-all with a sacrifice fly, RBI-single and RBI-double in the seventh.

#### **VANDERBILT VS. LOUISVILLE: BATTLE OF THE BARREL**

- ★ Vanderbilt and Louisville meet for the 34th time in the history of the two programs on Tuesday. The matchup will be the 10th since the programs began playing for the **Battle of the Barrel** in 2012.
- ★ The barrel trophy signifies Kentucky's history as a bourbon-making state and Tennessee's history as a whiskey-making state. Each year, the winning team will be presented with the barrel. The Cardinals have claimed the last two matchups.
- ★ Vanderbilt and Louisville are separated by only 175 miles. The two teams have met twice in NCAA Regional action, twice in the NCAA Super Regionals and once at the College World Series.

#### NATION'S TOP FRESHMEN OFF TO SIZZLING START

- ★ Vanderbilt's freshman class was named tops in the country by Baseball America last November.
- ★ Six Vanderbilt true freshmen made starts this season while 14 total have made appearances. The unit is hitting .298 (172-for-576) and has accounted for 40 percent of the Dores' RBIs (94) and 39 percent of the teams runs (104). True freshmen pitchers have posted an 12-6 record and 3.83 ERA with 140 strikeouts in 145.1 innings.
- ★ D1Baseball.com's list of 30 impact freshmen entering 2018 includes Vandy's Jake Eder (No. 16), Jayson Gonzalez (No. 18), Philip Clarke (No. 19) and Pat DeMarco (No. 25). With four players on the list, the Dores trail only Florida (5).

#### DON'T TRY THIS AT HOME

★ The Commodores have produced an 18-7 record at home this season while posting a .297 batting average and .403 on-base percentage. Here's a look at Vandy's top performers through 25 home games:

#### **GOLDEN BOYS**

- ★ For a fourth-straight year, multiple Vandy players have been named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.
- ★ Julian Infante and Patrick Raby are among those featured. The award was first presented in 1978 and is given to an amateur player who best exhibits and combines "exceptional on-field ability and exemplary sportsmanship." The award is considered the most prestigious in amateur baseball.
- ★ Five Commodores have been named finalists for the Golden Spikes Award -- all coming since the 2007 season -- including David Price, who took home the honor in 2007. Other finalists include Pedro Alvarez (2007), Tyler Beede (2013), Carson Fulmer (2015) and Dansby Swanson (2015).

#### **COMMODORE NATION**

★ Vanderbilt is one of five teams nationally to start a lineup featuring players from nine or more different states, joining Army, Elon, Kentucky and Western Kentucky. Vandy's 35-man roster boasts players from 15 different states as well as Canada with freshman **Cooper Davis** hailing from Mississauga, Ontario.

★ The Dores have received steady production from three catchers. Philip Clarke, Ty Duvall and Stephen Scott have each made their case for playing time. Here's a look at how each has performed during the 2018 season.

## **GAME NOTES**

#### A WORLD SERIES KIND OF FEEL

- ★ After playing 10 straight at home to begin the season, Vanderbilt headed west for a six-game road trip including games at Houston's Minute Maid Park and Los Angeles' Dodger Stadium -- the two sites for the 2017 World Series matchup between the Astros and Dodgers.
- ★ The Commodores took part in the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic at Minute Maid from March 2-4. The three-day, six-team tournament featured local universities squaring off against the SEC. Vandy fell to Sam Houston State on Friday and Louisiana on Saturday before bouncing back with a 9-4 victory against Houston on Sunday night.
- ★ For the fourth-straight year, the Dores headed to California, falling 4-3 to Long Beach State on Wednesday before knocking off UCLA, 6-3 on Friday and TCU, 7-4, in the Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic on Sunday.

#### FORMER PLAYERS JOIN CORBIN'S STAFF

- ★ Last September, head coach Tim Corbin and associate head coach Scott Brown welcomed back former players Mike Baxter and David Macias. Baxter serves as the Dores' hitting coach and recruiting coordinator while Macias comes on board as Vanderbilt's volunteer assistant coach.
- ★ Baxter joins the Commodores after a 12-year professional career that included playing in the big leagues for four organizations over parts of six seasons. Baxter made his major league debut with the San Diego Padres in 2010, and also played for the New York Mets (2011-13), Los Angeles Dodgers (2014) and Chicago Cubs (2015).
- ★ Macias was previously on Corbin's staff as the team's strength coach in 2014 when the Dores won the national championship and was the volunteer assistant in 2015 when the Dores returned to the College World Series finals. Prior to rejoining Corbin's staff, Macias was with the Seattle Mariners organization as a minor league manager.

#### **D1BASEBALL.COM RECOGNIZES DORES**

- ★ Last September, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the **No. 2 program nationally** in the publication's bi-annual top-100 rankings. The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye toward the next five to 10 years."

#### CORBIN BECOMES VANDY'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH

★ Head coach **Tim Corbin** became Vanderbilt's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 win against Houston on March 4. The 16th-year head coach, who owns a 671-333-1 record, surpassed Roy Mewbourne, who racked up as many wins between 1979-2002. Here is a look back at some of Corbin's milestone victories:

- ★ The Southeastern Conference has sent 58 teams to the College World Series since 1990 with Vanderbilt doing its part to represent the league in 2011, 2014 and 2015. The league has now appeared in the College World Series in 32 of the last 33 years including appearances by 18 teams in the last seven years.
- ★ In 2017, the SEC tied its own national record with six teams competing in the NCAA Super Regionals. The Commodores were among the field as part of the NCAA Corvallis Super Regional.
- ★ A total of 11 SEC student-athletes were selected on the first day of the 2017 Major League Baseball Draft including Vandy right-handed pitcher Kyle Wright (1st round/5th overall) and outfielder Jeren Kendall (1st round/23rd overall).

#### **DORES IN THE PRO NOTES**

- ★ At least one Dore has been drafted every year since 1991 with a total of 100 players signing professional contracts.
- ★ Vanderbilt is one of only two universities in the nation to produce multiple No. 1 picks with David Price (2007) and Dansby Swanson (2015), joining Arizona State (Rick Monday 1965, Floyd Bannister 1968, Bob Horner 1978).
- ★ Under Corbin, Vanderbilt pro alums have earned over \$62 million dollars in signing bonuses.
- ★ Since head coach **Tim Corbin** arrived in 2003, every Vanderbilt starting catcher has been selected in the MLB Draft.
- ★ The Dores have had at least one MLB first round selection on the mound every year in the **Tim Corbin** era.
- ★ Eighty-nine pitchers have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 55 during the Tim Corbin era (since 2003).
- ★ Vanderbilt leads the SEC with nine players drafted in the first round over the last decade. The second-closest in that span is Florida and LSU who each have five.
- ★ A total of 145 Commodores have been selected all-time in the MLB Draft including 73 in the first 10 rounds.

#### **HONORING NO. 41 DONNY EVERETT**

- ★ Vanderbilt continues to honor the memory of **Donny Everett**, who tragically passed away in a drowning accident the day before the Commodores opened the 2016 NCAA Nashville Regional.
- ★ The Donny Everett Scholarship was established during the 2016 school year. Everett's memory lives on with the display of No. 41 on the field and with the No. 41 flag among the major league players in right field.
- ★ Everett was the 2015 Tennessee Gatorade Player of the Year and one of the highest-rated players in the nation to attend college. He turned down the Milwaukee Brewers as a 29th round draft pick to join Vanderbilt.

#### **TOUGH TESTS ABUNDANT IN 2018**

- ★ Vanderbilt plays 12 teams that reached the 2017 NCAA Tournament for a total of 22 games, including Auburn (3), Florida (3), Houston, Kentucky (3), LSU (3), Long Beach State, Louisville, Mississippi State (3), Sam Houston State, TCU, Tennessee Tech and UCLA. Of the 12 teams, eight reached the NCAA Super Regionals.

#### WEEKEND REVIEW: DORES DROP SERIES TO SOUTH CAROLINA

- ★ April 27, 2018 Vanderbilt produced seven runs in the first three innings only to see South Carolina go into overdrive, sparking an 8-7 comeback victory behind six runs in the sixth inning on Friday night at Hawkins Field.
- ★ April 28, 2018 Vanderbilt pounded six runs across in the second inning and never looked back, defeating South Carolina, 8-1 to even the series. The Dores batted around in the second as the first six batters reached to spark Vandy's highest single-inning output since March 17 at Mississippi State. The Dores struck for six hits in the frame including two-run singles from Julian Infante and Philip Clarke.
- ★ April 29, 2018 Vanderbilt saw multi-run leads slip away twice as South Carolina upended the Commodores, 10-9 to clinch the series on Sunday afternoon. The Gamecocks erased deficits of four and three runs before using a one-out sacrifice fly in the top of the ninth to put VU away and hand the Dores their first home series loss of the season.

#### **COMMODORES PACE THE SEC SINCE 2006**

★ Vanderbilt has paced the Southeastern Conference in several categories since the start of the 2006 season. During that span, the Commodores rank first in overall wins (564) and NCAA Tournament wins (48). In his 16th season at Vanderbilt, Tim Corbin has transformed Vanderbilt into one of the national powers of college baseball and taken the program to unprecedented success winning the school's first-ever men's national title in 2014.

Corbin's owns a 671-333-1 (.668) at Vanderbilt and became the program's all-time winningest coach on March 4. He is also first in winning percentage for coaches with 100 games or more.

Under Corbin, Vanderbilt boasts the Southeastern Conference's longest streak of consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances at 12. The Dores have advanced to a Super Regional in four of the last five years.

In 2015, Vanderbilt returned to the College World Series for the third time in five years with team's fourth 50-win season in the last four making it back to the CWS Finals before losing in three games to Virginia. The Dores captured the SEC East with a 20-10 mark.

The 2014 Commodores topped Virginia in the College World Series finals in three games to claim the title in just the Dores' second trip to Omaha. For the third time in four years Vandy hosted NCAA Regionals and Super Regionals, topping Oregon in the Regional final and Stanford in the Super Regionals.

Vanderbilt's 2013 team was one for the ages as the Commodores matched the school record with a 54-12 record and smashed the SEC record with a 26-3 mark to win the league title.






