NEED TO KNOW

- ★ On Sunday at Auburn, the Commodores started six freshmen for the first time since April 26, 2016. Vanderbilt's freshman class leads the nation with a combined 176 starts between the unit.
- ★ Vanderbilt is in the midst of a five-game losing streak, one shy of a season-high six (March 27-April 5). The Commodores are batting just .192 during the losing stretch while averaging 3.8 runs per game. The pitching staff has also struggled to find its groove, recording a 9.64 ERA with opponents batting .333.
- ★ Vanderbilt is still searching for its first win in May after suffering its first sweep at the hands of Auburn since 2002 last weekend. The Dores were outscored 29-6 and never led while posting a .156 batting average and 10.50 ERA. The Black and Gold have produced a winning record during the month of May in each of the last eight seasons.
- ★ The Commodores have fared much better at home, boasting an 18-8 record at Hawkins Field. The team is batting .293 in 26 home outings while four players have turned in a .300 average or higher. In home non-conference games, Vandy has recorded an 11-3 mark backed by nine wins in its first 10 games to begin the season.
- ★ Vanderbilt played error-free baseball for the 26th time this season on Saturday against Auburn. The Commodores are 16-10 in games without an error. The Commodores are **fourth nationally** and first in the SEC with a .982 fielding percentage. The program record for fielding percentage is .979, set in 2015.
- ★ Vandy has stolen 85 bases this season, **12th nationally**, and first in the SEC. The total is already 31 more than the squad finished with a season ago (54). Four Commodores have registered double-digit stolen bases and 14 different players have swiped at least one bag this season.
- ★ Tennessee Tech will be the 28th different opponent that Vandy has faced this season. The Dores have faced foes from 14 different leagues -- the most of any team in the nation -- this season.
- ★ The Commodores will play five of their final eight regular-season games at Hawkins Field beginning on Tuesday. Vandy finds itself in an uncharacteristic situation, looking for a strong finish to finalize a berth in the NCAA Tournament. The Dores slipped eight spots to No. 39 in the RPI after going 0-4 last week.

MAY 8, 2011 (7 YEARS AGO): Vanderbilt rallied for three runs with two outs in the top of the ninth inning to down Kentucky 6-3 and clinch the series Sunday afternoon at Cliff Hagan Stadium. Two-out singles from Anthony Gomez and Aaron Westlake put runners on the corners for Jason Esposito in the ninth and the Dores' third baseman came singled on the first pitch he saw to break a three-all tie.



BATTING A THOUSAND

- ★ Vandy's April 19 matchup at Missouri marked the 1,000th game coached for **Tim Corbin** at Vanderbilt.
- ★ The 16th-year head man became the 25th active head coach to reach 1,000 games at his current institution.
- ★ Corbin also became the eighth skipper in SEC history to coach 1,000 games at a league institution and second Vanderbilt coach, joining Roy Mewbourne (1,264 games). Ole Miss' head coach Mike Bianco, who has coached 1,108 games, is the only other current SEC skipper with 1,000 or more games.

- ★ Auburn sent 12 batters to the plate in the fifth inning, scoring seven times to vault past No. 23 Vanderbilt, 14-0 and complete the three-game series sweep on Sunday afternoon at Plainsman Park.
- ★ The Dores walked four Tigers hitters and balked home another in the fifth while suffering their first sweep at the hands of Auburn since 2002. Vandy mustered just two hits while dropping its eighth game in the last 10 outings.
- ★ Mason Hickman allowed four hits and four runs while walking three and striking out two in 4.1 innings in the loss. Jackson Gillis recorded just one out, giving up four runs on three hits alongside two walks.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP VS. TENNESSEE TECH

- ★ Vanderbilt and Tennessee Tech square off for the 67th time in the history of the two programs on Tuesday.
- ★ The Commodores own a 43-22 advantage all-time and have captured seven wins in the last 10 meetings.
- ★ The two teams have split the last four matchups with Tennessee Tech winning 5-2 a season ago in Nashville.
- ★ Last year's 5-2 loss to Tech snapped Vandy's nine-game winning streak at a rain-soaked Hawkins Field. Chandler Day took his first loss of the year despite striking out nine. The right-hander combined with four relievers to strike out 16.

NATION'S TOP FRESHMEN OFF TO SIZZLING START

- ★ Vanderbilt's freshman class was named tops in the country by Baseball America last November.
- ★ Seven Vanderbilt true freshmen made starts this season while 14 total have made appearances. The unit is hitting .285 (181-for-633) and has accounted for 40 percent of the Dores' RBIs (97) and 39 percent of the teams runs (107). True freshmen pitchers have posted an 12-8 record with 149 strikeouts in 160.2 innings.
- ★ D1Baseball.com's list of 30 impact freshmen entering 2018 includes Vandy's Jake Eder (No. 16), Jayson Gonzalez (No. 18), Philip Clarke (No. 19) and Pat DeMarco (No. 25). With four players on the list, the Dores trail only Florida (5).

★ The Commodores have produced an 18-8 record at home this season while posting a .293 batting average and .401 onbase percentage. Here's a look at Vandy's top performers through 26 home games:

PLANES, TRAINS AND AUTOMOBILES

- ★ If nothing else, Vanderbilt has been well traveled this season. In fact, the Commodores have covered 7,061 miles highlighted by out-of-state trips to Alabama, California, Florida, Mississippi, Missouri and Texas.
- ★ The Dores became the first program to compete in both the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic (Houston -Minute Maid Park) and Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic (Los Angeles) in the same season. The trip spanned 11 days (March 1-11) and totaled 4,009 miles with three games at Minute Maid Park and as many in Southern California.
- ★ Over the last four seasons, Vanderbilt baseball has visited 14 different states including Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Oregon, South Carolina and Texas.

COMMODORE NATION

★ Vanderbilt is one of five teams nationally to start a lineup featuring players from nine or more different states, joining Army, Elon, Kentucky and Western Kentucky. Vandy's 35-man roster boasts players from 15 different states as well as Canada with freshman **Cooper Davis** hailing from Mississauga, Ontario.

WHAT'S THE CATCH?

★ The Dores have received steady production from three catchers. Philip Clarke, Ty Duvall and Stephen Scott have each made their case for playing time. The trio has started in seven games this year including twice last weekend at Auburn. Here's a look at how each has performed during the 2018 season.

GAME NOTES

A WORLD SERIES KIND OF FEEL

- ★ After playing 10 straight at home to begin the season, Vanderbilt headed west for a six-game road trip including games at Houston's Minute Maid Park and Los Angeles' Dodger Stadium -- the two sites for the 2017 World Series matchup between the Astros and Dodgers.
- ★ The Commodores took part in the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic at Minute Maid from March 2-4. The three-day, six-team tournament featured local universities squaring off against the SEC. Vandy fell to Sam Houston State on Friday and Louisiana on Saturday before bouncing back with a 9-4 victory against Houston on Sunday night.
- ★ For the fourth-straight year, the Dores headed to California, falling 4-3 to Long Beach State on Wednesday before knocking off UCLA, 6-3 on Friday and TCU, 7-4, in the Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic on Sunday.

FORMER PLAYERS JOIN CORBIN'S STAFF

- ★ Last September, head coach Tim Corbin and associate head coach Scott Brown welcomed back former players Mike Baxter and David Macias. Baxter serves as the Dores' hitting coach and recruiting coordinator while Macias comes on board as Vanderbilt's volunteer assistant coach.
- ★ Baxter joins the Commodores after a 12-year professional career that included playing in the big leagues for four organizations over parts of six seasons. Baxter made his major league debut with the San Diego Padres in 2010, and also played for the New York Mets (2011-13), Los Angeles Dodgers (2014) and Chicago Cubs (2015).
- ★ Macias was previously on Corbin's staff as the team's strength coach in 2014 when the Dores won the national championship and was the volunteer assistant in 2015 when the Dores returned to the College World Series finals. Prior to rejoining Corbin's staff, Macias was with the Seattle Mariners organization as a minor league manager.

- ★ Last September, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the **No. 2 program nationally** in the publication's bi-annual top-100 rankings. The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye toward the next five to 10 years."

CORBIN BECOMES VANDY'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH

★ Head coach **Tim Corbin** became Vanderbilt's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 win against Houston on March 4. The 16th-year head coach, who owns a 671-337-1 record, surpassed Roy Mewbourne, who racked up as many wins between 1979-2002. Here is a look back at some of Corbin's milestone victories:

- ★ Julian Infante and Patrick Raby are among those featured. The award was first presented in 1978 and is given to an amateur player who best exhibits and combines "exceptional on-field ability and exemplary sportsmanship." The award is considered the most prestigious in amateur baseball.
- ★ Five Commodores have been named finalists for the Golden Spikes Award -- all coming since the 2007 season -- including David Price, who took home the honor in 2007. Other finalists include Pedro Alvarez (2007), Tyler Beede (2013), Carson Fulmer (2015) and Dansby Swanson (2015).

DORES IN THE PRO NOTES

- ★ At least one Dore has been drafted every year since 1991 with a total of 100 players signing professional contracts.
- ★ Vanderbilt is one of only two universities in the nation to produce multiple No. 1 picks with David Price (2007) and Dansby Swanson (2015), joining Arizona State (Rick Monday 1965, Floyd Bannister 1968, Bob Horner 1978).
- ★ Under Corbin, Vanderbilt pro alums have earned over \$62 million dollars in signing bonuses.
- ★ Since head coach **Tim Corbin** arrived in 2003, every Vanderbilt starting catcher has been selected in the MLB Draft.
- ★ The Dores have had at least one MLB first round selection on the mound every year in the **Tim Corbin** era.
- ★ Eighty-nine pitchers have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 55 during the Tim Corbin era (since 2003).
- ★ Vanderbilt leads the SEC with nine players drafted in the first round over the last decade. The second-closest in that span is Florida and LSU who each have five.
- ★ A total of 145 Commodores have been selected all-time in the MLB Draft including 73 in the first 10 rounds.

HONORING NO. 41 DONNY EVERETT

- ★ Vanderbilt continues to honor the memory of **Donny Everett**, who tragically passed away in a drowning accident the day before the Commodores opened the 2016 NCAA Nashville Regional.
- ★ The Donny Everett Scholarship was established during the 2016 school year. Everett's memory lives on with the display of No. 41 on the field and with the No. 41 flag among the major league players in right field.
- ★ Everett was the 2015 Tennessee Gatorade Player of the Year and one of the highest-rated players in the nation to attend college. He turned down the Milwaukee Brewers as a 29th round draft pick to join Vanderbilt.

TOUGH TESTS ABUNDANT IN 2018

- ★ Vanderbilt plays 12 teams that reached the 2017 NCAA Tournament for a total of 22 games, including Auburn (3), Florida (3), Houston, Kentucky (3), LSU (3), Long Beach State, Louisville, Mississippi State (3), Sam Houston State, TCU, Tennessee Tech and UCLA. Of the 12 teams, eight reached the NCAA Super Regionals.

- ★ May 4, 2018 Vanderbilt was unable to solve Auburn ace Casey Mize while the Tigers countered with a pair of homers to defeat the Commodores, 4-1 in Friday night's series opener at Plainsman Park.
- ★ May 5, 2018 Auburn launched a pair of home runs in the second inning including a two-out grand slam from Edouard Julien and held off a late rally from No. 23 Vanderbilt for an 11-5 series-clinching victory on Saturday afternoon at Plainsman Park. Eight different Commodores tallied one hit including Ty Duvall who contributed two RBIs and reached base twice while going 1-for-2 with a run.
- ★ May 6, 2018 Auburn sent 12 batters to the plate in the fifth inning, scoring seven times to vault past No. 23 Vandy, 14-0 and complete the three-game series sweep on Sunday afternoon. The Dores suffered their first sweep at the hands of Auburn. Vandy mustered just two hits dropping its eighth game in the last 10 outings.

★ Vanderbilt has paced the Southeastern Conference in several categories since the start of the 2006 season. During that span, the Commodores rank first in overall wins (564) and NCAA Tournament wins (48). THE SEC: IT JUST MEANS MORE

- ★ The Southeastern Conference has sent 58 teams to the College World Series since 1990 with Vanderbilt doing its part to represent the league in 2011, 2014 and 2015. The league has now appeared in the College World Series in 32 of the last 33 years including appearances by 18 teams in the last seven years.
- ★ In 2017, the SEC tied its own national record with six teams competing in the NCAA Super Regionals. The Commodores were among the field as part of the NCAA Corvallis Super Regional.
- ★ A total of 11 SEC student-athletes were selected on the first day of the 2017 Major League Baseball Draft including Vandy right-handed pitcher Kyle Wright (1st round/5th overall) and outfielder Jeren Kendall (1st round/23rd overall).

Hawkins Field serves as the home of the Vanderbilt Commodores and with recently completed facilities it stands as one of the top college baseball parks in the country. Now in its 16th season of existence, greets fans with chairback seats close to the field of play with bleacher seating in the outfield.

Nestled alongside Vanderbilt Stadium and Memorial Gymnasium

on the west end of campus, the ballpark was constructed as the Commodores' first baseball-only facility in school history. It was built near the exact location of McGugin Field, which served as baseball's home field for 76 years and part-time football practice field.

In his 16th season at Vanderbilt, Tim Corbin has transformed Vanderbilt into one of the national powers of college baseball and taken the program to unprecedented success winning the school's first-ever men's national title in 2014.

Corbin's owns a 671-337-1 (.665) at Vanderbilt and became the program's all-time winningest coach on March 4. He is also first in winning percentage for coaches with 100 games or more.

Under Corbin, Vanderbilt boasts the Southeastern Conference's longest streak of consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances at 12. The Dores have advanced to a Super Regional in four of the last five years.

In 2015, Vanderbilt returned to the College World Series for the third time in five years with team's fourth 50-win season in the last four making it back to the CWS Finals before losing in three games to Virginia. The Dores captured the SEC East with a 20-10 mark.

The 2014 Commodores topped Virginia in the College World Series finals in three games to claim the title in just the Dores' second trip to Omaha. For the third time in four years Vandy hosted NCAA Regionals and Super Regionals, topping Oregon in the Regional final and Stanford in the Super Regionals.

Vanderbilt's 2013 team was one for the ages as the Commodores matched the school record with a 54-12 record and smashed the SEC record with a 26-3 mark to win the league title.




