## QUICK HITTERS

« Vanderbilt fell to 2-4 on the season after dropping two games at the NIT Season Tip Off in Brooklyn, N.Y., to Virginia and Seton Hall, over the Thanksgiving break.
« Matthew Fisher-Davis is the team's leading scorer with 13.8 points per game. Jeff Roberson, who has four doubledoubles on the season, is next with 13.2 points and 9.3 rebounds per game, while Riley LaChance pitches in 10.8 points per game and is shooting $46.7 \%$ from three on the season.
$\star$ Roberson is second in the SEC in rebounding and first in defensive rebounding, and began the season with three straight double-doubles, the first time a Commodore has had three straight double-doubles since Dan Langhi in 1998. He leads the SEC in double doubles with four.
$\star$ Roberson led the team in scoring (13.0) and rebounding (8.0) at the NIT Season Tip-Off and was named to the event's All-Tournament team. He posted a 20 -point, 13 -rebound performance against Seton Hall.
$\star$ Fisher-Davis' scored 31 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in Vanderbilt's last game at Memorial Gym against USC - his 30-10 game was Vanderbilt's first since A.J. Ogilvy in 2009 ( 33 and 10, at LSU, $3 / 4 / 09$ ).

* Vanderbilt shot their best percentage of the season against USC - 50.9\%. The Commodores also had season highs in three-point percentage (.478) and threes made (11).
$\star$ Vanderbilt will meet Radford for the first time on Tuesday.
* Freshman Saben Lee, who had five assists against UNC Asheville, leads the team in assists.
* Commodore head coach Bryce Drew, now in his second season, led the Commodores to the NCAA Tournament in his first season in Nashville, marking the first time in the history of the program a first-year Vanderbilt coach led his team to the tournament. Overall, the Commodores made their 15th appearance in the NCAA Tournament and their first back-to-back appearances since making three consecutive tournaments from 2010-12.
$\star$ Vanderbilt has two 1,000-point scorers on their roster - Riley LaChance and Matthew Fisher-Davis, with Jeff Roberson 90 points away from the 1,000-point mark. LaChance is 2 nd in the SEC in returning scorers while Fisher-Davis is third behind Georgia's Yante Maten.
« The Commodores return eight letter winners and three of their top four scorers in 2017-18 that advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year - seniors Matthew Fisher-Davis (13.9), Jeff Roberson (10.8), and Riley LaChance (10.5). Junior Joe Toye, who started in 13 games a year ago, also returns after averaging 6.4 points and 2.6 rebounds per game. In all, Vanderbilt returns $70.5 \%$ of its scoring and six players who started at least one game in 2016-17. $\star$ Vanderbilt had five top- 25 wins, six top- 50 victories and 11 top-100 RPI wins a year ago, the overall toughest strength of schedule and toughest non-conference schedule in the nation, and were the only SEC team to sweep Florida. The Commodores are tied for the second-most top 50 wins in SEC with Florida with six - only UK (8) had more.
* The Commodores played 11 teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2016-17 (Marquette, Bucknell, Butler, Minnesota, Middle Tennessee, Dayton, Kentucky, Florida, Arkansas, lowa State, and South Carolina) and four teams in the 2017 Postseason NIT (Belmont, Alabama, Georgia, and Ole Miss). Twenty of Vanderbilt's 34 games came against teams that advanced to the postseason. This season, nine of their potential games will be against teams who played in the postseason a year ago. Six possible opponents, USC, Rhode Island, Seton Hall, Virginia, Kansas State, and Middle Tennessee, all played in the 2017 NCAA Tournament, with NIT participant Belmont, 2017 NIT Champion TCU, and Collegelnsider.com Tournament team UNC Asheville also on the challenging slate.

## LaChance made threes at high clip in 2016-17

Riley LaChance, who played the point guard position in 2016-17 and will slide over to his more natural two-guard spot in his senior season, made $48.6 \%$ of his three-point attempts last year, which is the third-best in a single-season all-time for the Commodores - only Billy McCaffrey ( $51.2 \%$, 1992-93) and Barry Booker ( $50 \%$, 1986-87) have had better seasons from three. LaChance led the SEC in three-point shooting in 2016-17, and his three-point field goal percentage a year ago ties for the ninth-best in SEC history.

## Career and Single-Season Lists

Matthew Fisher-Davis is 8th in 3's made in a career with 236. Riley LaChance's $48.6 \%$ from three clip in 2016-17 was Vanderbilt's 3rd-best all-time.

## More Threes

Making threes is not a new thing for this year's Commodore team. Combined in their career, current players have made 610 career threes.


CONSENUS TOP 102018 RECRUTITING CLASS
Head coach Bryce Drew and his staff have assembled quite the recruiting class for 2018, with the Commodores receiving commitments from two five-star players, Darius Garland and Simi Shittu, and four-star wing player Aaron Nesmith. Most recruiting services have Vanderbilt in the top 10 nationally for their 2018 class. The Commodores, who had only signed one five-star player in the history of the program (John Jenkins, November of 2008), signed Garland and Shittu within a nine-day span.

## 700th SEC Win

Vanderbilt is in its 85th SEC season and is a charter member of the league. The Commodores won their 700th league game at Florida, and all time against current members of the conference, Vanderbilt is 709-693.

## 1,005

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 1,005 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank third only to UNLV and Kentucky for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3 -pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented.

## NBA Commodores

Vanderbilt was one of only three schools (Kentucky, Washington) with two first-round selections in the 2016 NBA Draft when Wade Baldwin IV was drafted 17th by the Memphis Grizzlies and Damian Jones was selected 30th by the Golden State Warriors. Baldwin IV and Jones became the sixth and seventh first-round picks, respectively, in the history of the program, joining Will Perdue in 1988 (11th, Chicago), Jeff Turner in 1984 (7th, New Jersey), Clyde Lee in 1966 (3rd, San Francisco), and John Jenkins (23rd, Atlanta), and Festus Ezeli (30th, Golden State) in 2012. The Commodores have had five NBA Draft selections since 2012.

## 10 or more threes

The Commodores made 10 or more threes for the first time in 2017-18 against USC on Nov. 19. In 2016-17, Vanderbilt made 10 or more threes in 18 games in 2016-17 and were 14-4 in those games.

## RECAP

BROOKLYN, N.Y. - Number-20 ranked Seton Hall outscored the Commodores 41 to 27 in the second half to come away with a $72-59$ victory over Vanderbilt in the third-place game of the NIT Season Tip-Off at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.

Vanderbilt led 32-31 at the break, but the Pirates clamped down on the defensive end of the floor in the second half, beginning the half on an 11-2 run and now allowing a Commodore second-half field goal until the 11:45 mark with Ejike Obinna put home a two-handed slam.

Senior forward Jeff Roberson led the Commodores with 20 points and 13 rebounds, while freshman Ejike Obinna scored a career-high nine points.

Seton Hall was led by Desi Rodriguez, who scored 27 points in the win for the Pirates.
"I think the biggest thing is that we didn't make shots, we were 0-12 from three in the second half," said Vanderbilt head coach Bryce Drew. "If I could go back and write that over, I would take those shots all day. We still had the lead going into half and I thought we were getting good shots. They came out, hit a couple of baskets to start second half. We did a really good job in the first half; in second half we didn't come out with same intensity and didn't really recover as far as making shots."

The Commodores return to action on Tuesday night when they welcome Radford to Memorial Gym for a 7 p.m. CT tip. The game will be televised on the SEC Network.

Historic Memorial Gymnasium In 66th Season
Storied Memorial Gymnasium is in its 66th season as the host venue of Vanderbilt basketball. The SEC's most historic hoops setting has played host to more than 950 men's contests as well as the 1984 and 1991 SEC Tournaments and 40 men's and women's NCAA Tournament contests (since the early 1980s).

As the oldest gymnasium in the SEC, Memorial Gymnasium is renown for its end zone benches, raised floor and unique atmosphere. It was dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II. It was built by the late master architect Edwin Keeble, who was commissioned to build a combination gymnasium/concert hall.

## VANDERBILT BASKETBALL

QUCK HITIERS

- This is the 115 th year of Vanderbilt basketball, with the first season taking place in 1900-01. There were no teams in 1904-05 and 1905-06.
- The Commodores have been named to 15 NCAA Tournaments and 12 NIT's. Vanderbilt advanced to the Elite 8 in 1965 (field of 23), and the Sweet 16 in 1988, 1993, 2004, and 2007. The Commodores captured the NIT Championship in 1990 and finished runner-up in 1994.
- The Commodores are a charter member of the SEC,
with the 2017-18 season being the 85th year in the conference.
- Vanderbilt is the only private institution in the SEC with the lowest enrollment of any of the 14 schools $(6,738)$.
- Vanderbilt's Perry Wallace became the first AfricanAmerican scholarship basketball player in the SEC when he took the court in 1967.
- The Commodores have 47 career 1,000-point scorers, with Shan Foster (2004-08) the all-time leading scorer with 2,011 career points.
- Vanderbilt has had 12 All-Americans since 1950. They are: Billy Joe Adcock (1950), Clyde Lee (1965), Tom Hagan (1969), Jan van Breda Kolff (1974), Will Perdue (1988), Billy McCaffrey (1993), Dan Langhi (2000), Matt Freije (2004), Derrick Byars (2007), Shan Foster (2008), and John Jenkins (2011).
- Vanderbilt had two players selected in the 2016 NBA

Draft - Wade Baldwin IV, Memphis, 17th pick and Damian Jones, Golden State 30th pick - one of only three schools with two or more players drafted in the first round. In all, 37 Vanderbilt players have been selected in the NBA Draft since 1950.

- The Commodores had three players drafted in the first 31 picks of the 2012 NBA Draft - John Jenkins, Atlanta, 23rd pick, Festus Ezeli, Golden State, 30th pick, Jeffery Taylor, Charlotte, 31st pick - the most by the Commodores in one draft.
- The Commodores ended a 61-year SEC Tournament drought in 2012 by claiming the tournament championship in New Orleans, the team's first SEC tournament championship since 1951.
- Kevin Stallings is the winningest coach in Vanderbilt history with 322 total victories (17 years, 322-220).
- All three of the university's top all-time scorers played for Kevin Stallings (Foster, Jeffery Taylor, Matt Freije). John Jenkins, who is 10th on the list, also played for him.
- Vanderbilt's intercollegiate athletics teams are nicknamed the Commodores, in honor of the nickname given to founder Cornelius Vanderbilt, who made his fortune in shipping. Vanderbilt donated $\$ 1$ million to begin "Central University" in 1875 - the campus was later renamed for Cornelius because of his generosity. Cornelius never stepped foot on the campus that bears his namesake.
