

## Vanderbilt Women's Basketball - A Winning Tradition

- 19th winningest program in NCAA history (.674 .719 in 10 years under Melanie Balcomb)
- 25 NCAA Tournament appearances & 13 straight NCAA bids (one of eight teams)

### **Scouting The Commodores**

Vanderbilt moves to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the ninth time in the last 10 years under Melanie Balcomb, now sporting a 23-9 overall record. First Team All-SEC selection Christina Foggie leads Vanderbilt with 17.5 points per game. Right behind her is a trio of double-digit scorers. Classmate and backcourtmate Jasmine Lister is averaging 12.4 points per game following a 19-point performance in the first round win over Middle Tennessee. Lister is also posting 5.3 assists per game. Next is a pair of post players in Tiffany Clarke and Stephanie Holzer. Clarke is a junior forward posting 11.3 points and 7.3 rebounds per game. A redshirt sophomore center, Holzer posts 11.0 points and a team-best 7.4 rebounds per game and is coming off a 10-point, nine-rebound performance against MTSU. Vanderbilt is one of the top shooting teams in the nation, shooting 46% from the field and 36% from three.

### **Scouting The Blue Devils**

Second-seeded Duke is 25-5 following an 82-47 win over 15th-seeded Samford in the first round. Elizabeth Williams, who was the ACC Rookie and Defensive Player of the year, as well as the ESPN.com National Freshman of the Year, is averaging a team-high 14.2 points and 8.2 rebounds per game. She scored 11 points in the opening round win over Samford. Behind her are three more players in double-figures. Chelsea Grey is posting 12.2 points and 6.0 assists per contest (16 vs. Samford), while Tricia Liston is averaging 11.5 points per game following a game-high 22 points against Samford and Haley Peters is recording 10.6 points per outing. She had 13 points and seven rebounds in the first round. Duke will be looking to advance to the Sweet 16 for the 14th time in the past 15 seasons. The Blue Devils have an all-time record of 47-18 in the NCAA Tournament.

### Vanderbilt vs. Duke - The Series

The Commodores and Blue Devils, two of the more storied programs in women's basketball, have met just five times, with the Blue Devils holding a 2-3 edge in the series. The first meeting came in the 1982 AIAW Tournament, with the Commodores taking a 75-57 win in Johnson City, Tenn. Duke then won both contests during a two-game series played in the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 seasons. The Blue Devils won 79-71 at Memorial Gym before taking a 68-59 win at Cameron Indoor Stadium. The programs played another two-game series in 2006-07 and 2007-08, with Duke winning again in Durham, 69-48, before the Commodores took the most recent meeting, 68-55, at Memorial Gym.

## **On-Deck**

The winner of the Vanderbilt-Duke game will move on to the Fresno Region semifinals to face the winner of Tuesday night's contest between third-seeded St. John's and sixth-seeded Oklahoma in Norman, Okla. Action at the Save Mart Center in Fresno, Calif., gets underway Saturday, March 24. The regional final will be on Monday, March 26.

## **Vanderbilt In The NCAA Tournament**

Vanderbilt is making its 25th appearance in the NCAA Tournament and 13th-consecutive. All-time, Vanderbilt is 38-24 in NCAA play, following the first round win over Middle Tennessee. The Commodores have now one one game in the tournament during 19 of ther 25 NCAA apearances. Vanderbilt has made 14 Sweet 16 appearances, including six over the last 11 seasons (last in 2009). The last Elite Eight trip came in 2002, while Vanderbilt's lone Final Four appearance was in 1993. In first and second round contests, Vanderbilt is 32-10.

## March Madness With A Dose Of Memorial Magic

This marks the 10th season in which Vanderbilt will play host to NCAA action at Memorial Gym. All-time, Vandy is 15-1 in NCAA play at Memorial, including the first round win over Middle Tennessee. During the previous nine times they hosted, the Commodores advanced to regional play on eight occasions. This is just the second time Melanie Balcomb gets to coach her squad at Memorial during the Tournament. Her 2005-06 team lost to top-seeded North Carolina, 89-70, in the second round that year. It is the only time Vanderbilt has lost an NCAA Tournament game at Memorial Gym. Since the field expanded to 64 teams in 1994, this is the seventh time Vanderbilt will host. It is just the second time during that

stretch that the Commodores are not the highest-seeded team at the site (2006 - Vandy was eight seed with North Carolina as the one seed).

## **Lucky Number Seven**

This is the first time in Vanderbilt's 25 NCAA Tournament appearances that they have been a seven seed. Last season, Vanderbilt was a 10 seed in the Spokane Region, while the season before they were the six seed in the Sacramento Region. As the seven seed in the Fresno Region, Vanderbilt will be looking to improve upon a 7-5 record in the West/Westernmost Region. The Commodores have been in the region five previous times (including 2008 & 2011 in the Spokane Region and 2010 in the Sacramento Region). The first three times in the region (1995, 1997 & 2008), Vanderbilt advanced to the Sweet 16. In 2010, it fell in the second round, while last season it was defeated in the first round.

### **Last Time Out**

The Vanderbilt women's basketball team overcame the heat and foul trouble to advance to the second round of the 2012 NCAA Tournament. The seventh-seeded Commodores defeated 10th-seeded Middle Tennessee, 60-46, on Sunday, March 18 at Memorial Gym. Vanderbilt improves to 23-9 while the Blue Raiders' season comes to an end at 26-7. Vanderbilt will move on to play second-seeded Duke in the second round on Tuesday, March 20. Duke defeated Samford, 82-47, in the first round on Sunday at Memorial. Tipoff at Memorial Gym is set for 8:30 p.m. The winner will move on to the Fresno Regional Semifinals. Vanderbilt overcame significant foul trouble by its posts thanks to strong defense and strong point play. The Commodores were led by 19 points from Jasmine Lister. The sophomore point guard was 4-10 from the field, but hit 11 of 14 free throw attempts. She also had five assists and five rebounds. Junior guard Elan Brown added 12 points and nine rebounds. Redshirt sophomore center Stephanie Holzer also just missed a double-double, scoring nine points and grabbing 10 rebounds. Middle Tennessee was led by 12 points from Kortni Jones. Ebony Rowe recorded a double-double with 10 points and 16 rebounds. Icelyn Elie also grabbed 16 rebounds while adding seven points. The story of the first half was foul trouble. With about four minutes remaining, Vanderbilt had been whistled for nine fouls while MTSU had been called for just one. This included three on Holzer and three on junior forward Tiffany Clarke, Vanderbilt's starting forwards. Despite the foul trouble, Vanderbilt was able to take a 25-18 lead into the break thanks to holding the Blue Raiders to 22.6% (7-31) from the field. That was especially thanks to the play of Brown, junior guard Gabby Smith and senior guard Jordan Coleman. The second half saw Holzer play 14 minutes, score seven points an grab five rebounds while committing just one more foul. Vanderbilt was able to pull away thanks largely to her and Lister, who scored 14 of her 19 points in the second half. Vanderbilt's patience on the defensive end was demonstrated by the fact that the Blue Raiders pulled down 25 offensive rebounds but managed just four second-chance points. The Commodores scored 14 second-chance points on 16 offensive boards.

## **First Round Quick Hits**

- Vanderbilt is 15-1 in NCAA play in Memorial Gym. This year it reached the NCAA Tournament for the 25th time, and 13th in a row. This is the first year Vanderbilt has played an NCAA Tournament game in Nashville since 2006
- Vanderbilt is now 38-24 in the NCAA Tournament all-time and has won at least game in each tournament during 12 of the last 13 appearances.
   Vanderbilt is now 18-1 at home during the 2011-2012 season and 11-0 at home against non-conference opponents. This was the second consecutive season that Vanderbilt ran the table during the non-conference season at home.

Versus MTSU:

- Center Stephanie Holzer recorded 3 blocks, which tied a season-high (7 times, last versus Florida on 2/16/12.
- Guard Elan Brown recorded 12 points, tied for her second highest output of the season (season high is 13, 12/2/11 versus Denver).
- Guard Jasmine Lister set career highs for both free throws made (11) and free throws attempted (14).
