

STARTING FIVE

- \star The Commodores will hit the hardwood one last time before the holiday break when they welcome crosstown rival, Belmont to Memorial Gym for a Thursday afternoon matinee Thursday's game will be the third 12 pm tip for the Commodores this season and will be the third consecutive home game for Vanderbilt after spending the majority of November on the road.
- ★ Vanderbilt is coming off an 83-72 loss to NC State on Tuesday night. Rachel Bell, who scored her 1,000th career point, led the offense with a game-high 21 points while Christa Reed (12 points) and Cierra Walker (10 points) and Kayla Overbeck (10 points) also reached double figures. Overbeck also lead the rebounding efforts with a game-high nine rebounds. With the win, the Wolfpack have won the last two meetings in the series and moved to 4-2 overall.
- ★ Thursday's matchup with Belmont marks the second mid-Tennessee team the Commodores will take on this season. Vanderbilt opened the season against Middle Tennessee and will also face Belmont and Lipscomb. In total, the Dores will face five teams, including Tennessee twice in SEC action, from the state of Tennessee. Vanderbilt leads the series with Belmont, 10-4, and has won the last eight meetings with the last win coming in 2014-15.
- ★ Rachel Bell became the 37th member of Vanderbilt's 1,000-polint club in the Commodores last outing against NC State. With 39 seconds left in the game, the Cumberland Furnace native, hit a jumper to push her over the mark. Bell is the first Vanderbilt player to reach 1,000 points since the 2012-13 season, when the Dores had three players reach the milestone. Bell is currently sitting at 1,002 career points has a chance to move into the top 25 by the end of the season.
- ★ The Commodores debuted new lineups in both its game against Memphis and NC State with several players earning their first starts of the season in the last two outings. Kayla Overbeck started against Memphis while Cierra Walker earned her first start of the season against NC State. On the season, Vanderbilt has used just four lineups and has gone primarily with Rachel Bell, Chelsie Hall, Kaleigh Clemons-Green, Autumn Newby and Christa Reed.



Former Indiana Fever Head Coach **Kentucky Assistant**

Stephanie White enters her second season at the helm of the Vanderbilt women's basketball team in 2017-18. White was named the head coach of the Vanderbilt women's basketball team in May of 2016, becoming just the fifth alltime head coach in the history of the Vanderbilt program.

When she arrived in Nashville, White inherited a young Vanderbilt team that featured only two seniors and relied heavily on five freshmen. White guided the Commodores to a 14-16 overall record in her first season with the team, including a 4-12 mark in the SEC during the 2016-17 campaign.

White's inaugural season on West End featured plenty of highlights, and was capped by a late-season surge that saw the Commodores win three of their final five games of the regular season. Other highlights included:

*The Commodores were ranked among the nation's top-5 in 3-point percentage throughout the season, and finished the season ranked No. 6 after shooting 38.6 for the year. Vanderbilt also led the SEC in 3-pointers per game (7.1).

* White guided Vanderbilt to 10 wins in its first 11 games during the first six weeks of the season. The hot start included a nine-game winning streak that spanned from Nov. 16 to Dec. 18. The winning streak was highlighted by an impressive victory over Duke on Nov. 20, along with quality wins over Robert Morris, Drexel and Tulane.

* At season's end, a pair of Vanderbilt freshmen -- Kayla Overbeck and Erin Whalen -- were named to the SEC's All-Freshman Team, as voted upon by the

Having enjoyed success at virtually every level of basketball as a player and coach, White arrived at Vanderbilt after spending two seasons as the head coach of the WNBA's Indiana Fever. She took the Fever to the playoffs in each of her two seasons, including a trip to the WNBA finals in 2015.

"The opportunity to lead Vanderbilt's women's basketball program is an opportunity that I simply could not pass up," White said at her introductory press conference. "The combination of Vanderbilt's culture, where achievement both on and off the court - is so highly valued, together with the institution's fan support, and a legacy of winning basketball to build upon, is incredibly exciting to me. I appreciate the support and understanding that I have received from the Indiana Fever, from management to the players, regarding my passion to coach college basketball at an elite institution."

White -- who played five seasons in the WNBA after a decorated playing career at Purdue -- was named head coach of the Fever in September 2014. In 2015, she guided the Fever to the WNBA finals, becoming the first rookie coach in league history to lead a team to the finals. As a collegiate player, White enjoyed a highly successful career at Purdue, where she earned national Player of the Year honors after helping lead the Boilermakers to the 1999 NCAA championship as a senior. That season, she also received the Wade Trophy (given to the nation's top female player) and was named Big Ten Conference Player of the Year.

"Stephanie White has been a winner in every phase of her career," Vanderbilt athletic director David Williams said. "She was the nation's high school player of the year, she was the NCAA's Player of the Year on a national championship team and she led her WNBA team into the finals in her first year. She was an outstanding scholar. She wants to coach at Vanderbilt and we believe she is just the person to lead our program back into national prominence."

White averaged double-figure scoring in all four seasons of her college career, including 20.2 points per game as a senior, and amassed 2,182 points for her career. White was inducted into the Purdue Athletics Hall of Fame on April 21,

She was also a star in the classroom at Purdue. She was a member of Phi Beta Kappa and was an Academic All-American.

White was an assistant coach with the Chicago Sky from 2007-2010, then joined the Fever staff as an assistant in 2011. She was promoted to associate head coach in 2014 before being named head coach after Lin Dunn's retirement. While coaching in the WNBA, White served as a college basketball analyst for ESPN and the Big Ten Network. She also covered the NBA's Indiana Pacers for FOX Sports

Prior to coaching in the WNBA, White coached in the college ranks, serving as an assistant at Toledo (2005-07), Kansas State (2004-05) and Ball State (2003-04).

Before beginning her coaching career, White enjoyed a productive five-year WNBA career, spending one season with the Charlotte Sting and four with the Indiana Fever, before retiring in 2004.

At the completion of her four seasons with the Fever, she ranked third in games played (112) and 3-pointers (92), and fourth in scoring (684). She was named to the Fever's All-Decade Team that was announced in 2009.

White and her wife, Michelle, have three young boys: Landon, and twins, Aiden & Avery.





Setting the Scene

-The Commodores continue their four-game homestand when they take on Belmont on Thursday. The Dores and Bruins will square off at 12 pm from Memorial Gym. The matchup is the third 12 pm start for the Commodores this season.

Last Time Out

-Vanderbilt was on the wrong end of an 83-72 loss to NC State on Thursday. Rachel Bell scored 21 points to lead all-scorers and reached the 1,000-point milestone in the contest while Kayla Overbeck led all-rebounders with nine boards.

-Sophomore guard Cierra Walker made her first start of the season against the Wolfpack, marking the second newcomer to the starting lineup in as many games.

-The loss was the third straight for the Commodores and gives NC State a 4-2 advantage in the series.

Scouting Report

-Belmont enters the game with a 9-3 record after falling to Wright State, 91-81 on Monday. Kylee Smith lead the offense with 19.0 points per game. Darby Maggard, and Sally McCabe are also in double figures with 16.8 and 13.8 points, respectively. Jenny Roy leads the defense with 7.8 rebounds per game.

-The Commodores and Bruins have a common opponent in Lipscomb. Belmont defeated the Lady Bison and Vanderbilt will close the nonconference slate with Lipscomb on Dec. 28.

With A Win

-The Commodores will move to 4-9 on the season and will stop their three-game skid after winning back-to-back games against Saint Louis and Iowa State.

-Give Vanderbilt its ninth straight victory in the series.

Big RPI Opportunities on Tap for the Dores

The Commodores are going to have several opportunities to move up the RPI rankings in its next several games. Vanderbilt will have two opportunities against top 75 opponents in NC State (52) and Belmont (72). Additionally, the

Commodores will open SEC action at LSU who is currently No. 90 in the RPI rankings. According to RealTimeRPI, the Commodores strength of schedule is No. 19 and atop the SEC with South Carolina coming in just behind Vanderbilt at No.

Home Sweet Memorial

The Commodores will be back in the friendly-confines of Memorial Gym for its next three games. The Dores opened a four-game home stretch on Saturday vs. Memphis. The upcoming four game home stretch will be the longest of the season although the Dores will have a three-game homestand in SEC play in mid-January when they host Missouri, Kentucky and South Carolina. Vanderbilt is quite successful at Memorial Gym sporting a 468-121 all-time record with only one sub-.500 home record, during the 1982-83 season in 40 seasons played at Memorial.

Tennessee Foes on Tap

Saturday's matchup with Memphis was the first of three matchups with foes from Tennessee in the next four games. Vanderbilt has already squared off with Middle Tennessee to open the season and will face three other Tennessee foes including two games with Tennessee in SEC action. When the non-conference is all set and done, the Dores will have played three teams from the Middle Tennessee area in Middle Tennessee, Belmont and Lipscomb.

Bell Makes it 1,000

Senior guard Rachel Bell became the 37th member of Vanderbilt's 1,000-point club against NC State with a jumper with 39 seconds left in the contest. Bell, who now has 1,002 career points, is the first Commodore to reach 1,000 points since the 2012-13 season when the Dores had three players reach the mark. Bell is just a point out of the 36th spot and has a chance to move into the top 25 by the end of the season.

Familiar Faces on the Belmont Sideline

Thursday's game will be a homecoming for Belmont assistant coach Amy Mahlo, who played for the Commodores from 2005-09. Mahlo helped Vanderbilt reach the Sweet 16 twice. Additionally, Belmont's leading scorer Kylee Smith started her career on West End in 2013-14 before transferring to Belmont.

Cierra Gets the Starting Nod

Cierra Walker earned her first start of the season against NC State. Walker, who started 12 games as a freshman, had 10 points, four rebounds and 3 assists in 37 minutes against the NC State.

Lineup Shakeup

The Commodores have been pretty consistent with their lineup this season but have made some changes in the last two games. Kayla Overbeck started in the place of Autumn Newby against Memphis as Newby missed due to a death in the family, while Cierra Walker started against NC State due to an injury to Kaleigh Clemons-Green. Vanderbilt has gone primarily with Chelsie Hall, Rachel Bell, Christa Reed, Autumn Newby and Kaleigh Clemons-Green this season and this group has a 3-7 record when they start.

Overbeck Cleans the Glass

Kayla Overbeck posted a season-best nine rebounds against NC State. It was Overbeck's fourth game of five or more rebounds this season and was just one short of giving the California native a double-double. Overbeck is averaging 3.7 rebounds per game and has grabbed a rebound in nine consecutive games.

Turnover Woes

Vanderbilt is struggling with turnovers and NC State capitalized on them. 23 of NC State's 83 points came from Vanderbilt miscues. In the last three losses, Vanderbilt has given up 73 points on turnovers and opponents are averaging 24.3 points off turnovers in the last three games.

Strong Start Against Cardinals

Vanderbilt had one of its best starts of the season against Louisville, in fact the Commodores led 24-20 after one period of play. The Dores 24 points are the most scored in the first period this season and marked the first time Vanderbilt has led after one period of play this season. The Dores are averaging 16.2 points per quarter.

Bell and Hall Team Up in First Half at Louisville

Rachel Bell and Chelsie Hall have been a good combination all year but they were spectacular in the first half against Louisville, combining for 28 of Vanderbilt's 33 first-half points. The pair have accounted for 40 percent of the Commodores scoring this season. Hall has been in double figures in six of the last seven games and in each of the last four while Bell has reached double figures in four of the last five games.

Vanderbilt Bench Brings the Heat

The Vanderbilt bench has been vital this season. In the last tour contests, the Commodore reserves have outscored their counterparts, 103-62 including a 20-3 advantage against Memphis. On the season, the Vanderbilt bench has outscored its opponents, 272-163, and have only been outscored on three occasions in losses to Syracuse, Middle Tennessee and NC State. On average, the Commodore bench

is averaging 24.0 points per game and on the season is accounting for 34 percent of Vanderbilt's scoring this season.

Dores are "Youthful"

Of the 14 players on the Vanderbilt roster 10 are underclassmen meaning that the 2017-18 Commodore roster is 71.4 percent underclassmen. The Dores added four true freshmen this season and had a five-member freshman class last year while welcoming Boston College transfer and redshirt sophomore Mariella Fasoula.

40 is the Magic Number on the Glass For the fourth time this season, the Commodores tallied 40+ rebounds against lowa State with 42 rebounds. In games in which Vanderbilt grabs at least 40 rebounds they are 3-1. Conversely, when they fail to get to 40 rebounds Vanderbilt is 0-7.

Bell Tough Against Syracuse In Paradise Jam

Senior Rachel Bell was on fire against Syracuse in the second game of the Paradise Jam. The Tennessee native tied her career best with 31 points against the Cuse and went 7-of-10 from long range to set a new career best and tie the Paradise Jam single-game three-point record. Bell's 31 points are the most points and individual scored in a single game over the three-day tournament. Bell averaged 18.0 points per game at the Paradise Jam.

Bell Shoots Her Way into Vandy Record Books

Bell's seven triples against Syracuse will earn her a spot in the Vanderbilt record books as her seven long-range bombs tie her for the second-most triples in a single-game. She joins Christina Foggie, Caroline Williams, Jillian Danker and Julie Powell as Dores to hit seven in a game. The senior was just one away from tying the program record and two away from holding the top spot by herself. For her career, Bell is shooting .369 percent from long range.

Dores Were Road Strong in November

In the first month of the season, Vanderbilt has played six of its eight games on the road in a true or neutral site fashion. Vanderbilt sports a 2-4 road record to date. Through the first month of the season the Commodores traveled 2,115.3 miles for six road games. Vanderbilt is looking to right its road woes this season. Last season, the Commodores posted a 3-10 record away from Nashville and were 0-8 on the road in the SEC. Vanderbilt already has two road wins in the bag this season with wins at George Washington and at Saint Louis.

This season, Vanderbilt will face five teams from the state of Tennessee in Middle Tennessee, Memphis, Belmont, Lipscomb and Tennessee. Additionally, the Commodores are playing three teams from the greater Nashville area in Middle Tennessee, Lipscomb and Belmont. This will be the most teams from the state of Tennessee that Vanderbilt has played in the last six seasons. In each of the last three seasons, including this season, Vanderbilt has played at least two nonconference opponents from the Tennessee.

The Dores will add two more from the state of Tennessee when they welcome Nashville area natives Brinae Alexander (Murfreesboro) and Jordyn Cambridge (Nashville).

The five-member class of LeaLea Carter, Kaleigh Clemons-Green, Kayla Overbeck, Cierra Walker and Erin Whalen was a consensus top-20 class and was ranked as high as No. 6 by Blue Star Basketball. As freshman, the quintet averaged 32.7 points per game and 16.2 rebounds per game. The group also accounted for 48 percent of the Commodores scoring. This group gained valuable experience as freshman which will be beneficial in 2017-18.

Whalen Looks to Build On Strong Close to Freshman Season

SEC All-Freshman selection, Erin Whalen, is looking to keep the momentum from the end of the season going into the 2017-18 season. Whalen averaged 18.6 ppg over the last three game of the regular season and earned Freshman of the Week after the final week of the regular season. For comparison, Whalen averaged 13.0 ppg and 3.8 rpg over the last 11 SEC contests compared to just 1.4 ppg and 0.8 rpg in the first five SEC games.

HOME SWEET HOME

Memorial Gymnasium, the Southeastern Conference's most historic venue for college basketball, serves as the home court for the Vanderbilt Commodores. Dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II, the arena was built as a combination gymnasium and concert hall by the late master architect Edwin Keeble.

Six decades later, the unique style of Memorial Gym — with its benches on the baselines, a playing court that sits above portions of the crowd and deafening acoustics — continues to make the Commodores' home a dreaded stop for opponents. "Memorial Magic," with its capacity crowds, overflowing student section and lively pep band, have assisted in numerous Commodore victories. In the stands, fans across Middle Tennessee have helped Memorial Gymnasium rank among the NCAA's Top 30 attendance leaders on numerous occassions.

On the floor, Vanderbilt has compiled a 467-118 record at home, and has only had one losing season at Memorial Gym (1982-83).

When the 2012-13 season tipped off, Memorial Gym featured a new video board, installed during the summer of 2012. The display, manufactured by Utah's Young Electric Sign Company, features four screens that measure 16 feet by nine feet and includes a two-foot tall LED display that wraps around the bottom of the board.

Before the 2008-09 season, Vanderbilt's locker rooms, the video room, the training room and media room were renovated and are now state-of-the-art. The floor was also replaced before the 08-09 season. During the 2009-10 season, the building received new championship banners.

In 2002, a \$25 million renovation of Memorial Gymnasium was completed. Connected to the facility sits a practice gym that includes three cross-court playing floors, coaching offices, a donor room and a Hall of Champions. Other aspects of the renovation included upgrades of the seating areas, private suites, a new lighting and sound system and a new court design.

In all, Memorial Gym has been expanded three times. Constructed with a seating capacity of 6,583, the University saw its first need to increase seating in 1965 with the addition of two north-side balconies. Two years later, a pair of balancing balconies were erected on the south side of the gym and dubbed "The Balconies That Clyde Lee Built."

Capacity has fluctuated throughout the history of the building. It reached its highest number of 15,646 in 1969 when 4,000 seats were added in the east and west ends. When chairback seats in the end zones and suites on the north side were installed in the late 1990s capacity lowered to 14,168. Shortly thereafter, university officials removed portions of media press row on the south side in an effort to expand the student section by nearly 150 seats. Official capacity is now 14,326.
