Game Day Traditions

Dore Alley

Join the Spirit of Gold and Vanderbilt Spirit squads as they greet the team in Vandyville! The Vanderbilt football team arrives on Natchez Trace two hours and ten minutes before kickoff.

The Admiral's Horn

The Admiral's Horn is sounded to notify fans when kickoff is 60 and 30 minutes out. The Admiral's Horn is also sounded after each Commodore score and every victory.

Star Walk

During Star Walk (located on Jess Neely Drive), fans can line the walkway from the entrance of McGugin down to the sidewalk just before the tunnel to welcome the team to the stadium 48 minutes prior to kickoff. Get there early to secure your front-row spot!

Anchor Drop

Anchor Drop is a pregame tradition that honors Commodore greats or significant members of the community. Just before the team takes the field, the Anchor Drop honoree is escorted to midfield by Vanderbilt's Naval ROTC and drops the anchor in preparation for kickoff.

Victory Flag

After every Commodore victory, be sure to stay in your seat to watch as the victory flag is raised over the west side of Vanderbilt Stadium. The victory flag flies after every win and can be seen waving on West End until the next game.

STADIUM MAP



PARKING INFORMATION

Season parking passes for 2019 are available to football season ticket holders for \$200. Season ticket holders may purchase a total of three parking passes for the season. Parking is available on a general admission first come, first serve basis. Handicap Accessible Parking is also available for purchase for \$200 for the season. A valid handicap placard must be shown to Vanderbilt Ticketing Office prior to obtaining pass.

Reserved parking is for National Commodore Club members with lifetime giving to Vanderbilt Athletics of \$100,000 or more. To learn more about the reserved parking option, please call the NCC at 615-322-4114.

Clear Bag Policy



Fans are encouraged not to bring any types of bags inside SEC stadiums during football games; however, the following outlines bags that are permitted:

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12";
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags (Ziploc bag or similar); and
- Small clutch bags, with or without a handle or strap, that do not exceed 4.5" x 6.5" (approximately the size of a hand).
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose.

An approved logo no larger than 4.5" x 3.4" may be displayed on one side of a permissible clear bag.

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag; briefcases; backpacks, cinch bags, and fanny packs that are not clear and/or exceed the size restriction; luggage of any kind; computer bags/cases; camera bags/cases; binocular bags/cases or any bag larger than the permissible size.

New this season is the Family Fan Stand which will offer five items for \$3 or less including hot dogs, nachos, soft drink, water and popcorn. This stand will be located in the Southwest Concourse.



Alcohol Policy

- All guests must be 21 years of age to purchase alcoholic beverages; a valid ID is required for purchase.
- A limit of two beers purchased at one time per legal ID.
- Sales will begin when gates open (two hours prior to kickoff).
- Per conference requirements, sales will end at the end of the third quarter once time has expired.
 - A security officer or Spectra staff member will begin to close the line with three minutes remaining in the third quarter and only the guests that were already standing in line will be able to purchase alcohol.
